Pitcher of the Week

Class AAA Louisville RHP Homer Bailey has been named International League Pitcher of the Week for the second time this season...he didn't allow a run in either of his victories last week over Pawtucket and Leigh Valley (14.2ip, 11h, 2bb, 14k)...he also was IL Pitcher of the Week for 4/20-4/26...Bailey made 1 start for the Reds, on 5/23 vs Cle, and in 3 starts since his return to Louisville has gone 3-0, 0.87.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is **Game 1** of a 3-game series vs **Brad Bernsen's Nationals** and **Game 1** of a 6-game road trip that also includes an upcoming weekend visit to **KC** (3g)...the Reds are coming off a **1-2** homestand vs **Cubs**...is **Game 11** (3-7) in a stretch of 13-16g on the road (0-3 at Mil, 2-2 at StL, 1-2 vs Cubs, **3g at Wsh**, 3g at KC).

CENTRAL CASTING: On Sunday the Reds completed a **6-7** stretch vs **National League Central Division** rivals (3-0 vs Hou, 0-3 at Mil, 2-2 at StL, **1-2 vs Chi**)...the Reds began the stretch in third place, 2.5g out of first and finished in fourth place, 3.5g out...the Reds won't play within the division again until **Fourth of July** weekend (3g at StL), a drought that includes 21 consecutive games outside the **Central** and 12 interleague contests.

DRAFT DAY: Tonight's first-year player draft begins at 6:00 p.m. and will include the first 111 picks of Round 1, Compensation Round A, Round 2, Round 3 and Compensation Round B...the draft resumes at noon tomorrow with Rounds 4 through 30 and will conclude Thursday at 11:30 a.m. with Rounds 31 through 50...tonight, the Reds will draft **eighth, 43rd** (compensation for losing Type B free agent **LHP Jeremy Affeldt**), **57th** and **88th**...the Nationals have the No. 1 overall pick...the lists of Cin's 2008 draft picks and No. 1 draft picks are on pages **212-213** of the media guide...**OF Jay Bruce** is the only first-round pick currently on the Reds' roster (2005 by Cin, 12th overall)...senior director of scouting **Chris Buckley** will be available to the local media immediately following tonight's first-round pick (approximately 6:45 p.m.) and again following the conclusion of today's selections.

MORE DRAFT TIDBITS: The Reds will select eighth in tonight's first-year player draft...notable Major League players selected with the eighth pick overall include **Todd Helton** (Col), **Jay Bell** (Min), **Todd Walker** (Min), **Jim Abbott** (Cal) and **Paul Maholm** (Pit)...7 of the 31 players who have played for the Reds this season were drafted by the organization, including **1B Joey Votto** (2002, 2nd round), **OF Chris Dickerson** (2003, 16th round), **RHP Homer Bailey** (2004, 7th overall), **IF Paul Janish** (2004, 5th round), **OF Jay Bruce** (2005, 12th overall), **RHP Carlos Fisher** (2005, 11th round), **IF Adam Rosales** (2005, 12th round).

M*A*S*H: From the **Opening Day** roster the Reds are missing starters **1B Joey Votto** and **3B Edwin Encarnacion** along with starting **RHP Edinson Volquez**...all are on the disabled list...several other players missed action recently because of various ailments, including **2B Brandon Phillips** (hairline fracture, tip of right thumb), **SS Alex Gonzalez** (strained left oblique muscle), **Willy Taveras** (tight right hamstring) and **IF/OF Jerry Hairston Jr.** (flu).

SOUTHPAW: In his Major League debut on Sat vs Cubs, **Matt Maloney** became the first the first **lefthander** to start for the Reds this season and only the second LH starter in a span of **236 games**...in 2008, righthanded pitchers started Cin's first 161 games until **Adam Pettyjohn** took the hill for the season finale...**Pettyjohn's start** snapped a streak of **180 consecutive starts** by Reds righthanders.

MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUT: RHP Carlos Fisher and LHP Matt Maloney made their Major League debuts this season...in 2008, 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts: **RHP Johnny Cueto**, **IF Paul Janish**, **OF Jay Bruce**, **LHP Daniel Ray Herrera**, **RHP Daryl Thompson**, **IF Adam Rosales**, **OF Chris Dickerson**, **RHP Ramon Ramirez**, **C/IF OF Wilkin Castillo** and **RHP Josh Roenicke**.

ZEROES: The Reds are tied for the National League lead with **6 team shutouts**...the Reds produced their 6 shutouts in the first **26g**, their fastest to 6 blankings since the **1914 staff** threw its sixth shutout in the **25th** game...Cin produced 6 team shutouts all of last season.

GILLETTE CIVIL RIGHTS GAME: At Great American Ball Park on **Sat, 6/20** the Reds and Chicago White Sox will meet in the **Gillette Civil Rights Game**, the first time the contest will be played during the regular season...the weekend's festivities will include a roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's **Harriet Tubman Theater** (Fri, 6/19, 4:00 p.m.), a luncheon at **Duke Energy Center** honoring the 3 winners of Major League Baseball's **Beacon Awards** (Sat, 6/20, 11:30 a.m.) and a **Youth Summit** at **Fountain Square** downtown (Sat, 6/20, 4:00 p.m.)... scheduled to attend the **Sat, 6/20** luncheon are Beacon of Change winner **Muhammad Ali**, Beacon of Hope winner **Bill Cosby** and Beacon of Life winner **Hank Aaron**...Beacon Award presenters include **Sugar Ray Leonard** (Ali), Hall of Fame pitcher **Bob Gibson** (Cosby) and **Commissioner Allan H. (Bud) Selig** (Aaron)...Grammy Award-winning gospel artist **BeBe Winans** will perform at the luncheon and at that night's game...former **President Bill Clinton** will be the keynote speaker at the luncheon...for more information, log on to www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (14-14, .500): The Reds went **3-5-2** in their **10 home series** and produced a winning record on just 2 of their 5 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3, 1-2).

REDS ON THE ROAD (15-13, .536): The Reds went **5-2-2** in their **previous 9 road series**...produced winning records on each of their first 2 road trips (7-3, 3-2), a .500 record on the third trip (3-3) and a losing record in their most recent road trip (2-5)...entering this season and dating to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

IN THE STANDINGS (64): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: **FIRST - 1, SECOND - 8, THIRD - 30, FOURTH - 21, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1**...at **20-14** and again at **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g over .500** at **36-24**...have spent **52** days above, **5** days at and **7** days below .500.

REDS vs NATIONALS: The Reds are 224-189 all-time vs the franchise formerly known as the Montreal Expos, including 4-3 last season when they swept the 4-game series in July at GABP and were swept in a 3-game set at Nationals Park in August...**at Nationals Park:** Reds are 0-3...**at RFK Stadium:** Reds went 5-4...**at Montreal:** Reds went 98-92, including 28-20 at **Jarry Park** and 70-72 at **Olympic Stadium**...in April 2003 the Reds went 1-2 vs the Expos at Hiram Bithorn Stadium in San Juan, Puerto Rico.

Last Pitched: Wed at StL and earned the 9-3 win (6.1ip, 7h, 1er, 0bb, 3k, 101 pitches, 69 strikes)...left leading, 4-1...allowed his only run on consecutive doubles by Rasmus and Ryan in the seventh inning.

Red Hots: The 23-year-old righthander is making his 12th start of the season and the 43rd start of his career...ranks fourth in the National League with a 2.43era and .213 opponents batting average...in his 11 starts the Reds went 7-4 and scored 47 runs (4.27 r/g)...leads the team with 8 quality starts, all in his last 9 apps and including 3 straight...his string of 5 consecutive QS from 4/22-5/13 was the longest stretch of quality starts by a Reds pitcher this season...last year, **Edinson Volquez** produced a string of 12 straight QS (4/22-6/20)...on 4/22 at Chi singled twice off Ted Lilly for his first career 2-hit game.

Streiking I: In 5 starts from 4/22-5/13 went **4-0, 1.25** (36ip, 5er)...the 4-game winning streak was the longest of his career...allowed 4 earned runs in his first start of the season (6ip) and 16 earned runs in his last 10 starts (68ip, 2.12era).

Streiking II: In each of 4 starts from 4/22-5/8 threw at least 7.0 innings while allowing no more than 1 run, the longest streak of that kind by a Reds pitcher since **Tim Belcher** had a 4-game run from **5/27-6/13, 1992** (courtesy Elias Sports Bureau).

World Baseball Classic: Started the Dominican Republic's second game of the tournament and threw 4.2 scoreless innings to earn the 9-0 win vs Panama in the San Juan bracket (4.2ip, 3h, 1bb, 5k).

Career Highs: Innings: 8.0, 5/3/09 at Pit (longest) & 1.2 (shortest), 4/29/08 at StL; **Hits:** 9 (2x), 5/27/08 vs Pit & 8/8/08 vs Hou; **Runs:** 7, 4/29/08 at StL; **Earned Runs:** 6 (4x), last on 7/17/08 vs NYM; **Walks:** 8, 6/11/08 vs StL; **Strikeouts:** 10 (2x), 4/3/08 vs Ari (ML debut) & 7/22/08 vs SD; **HR allowed:** 3, 5/16/08 vs Cle (Blake & Hafner, Peralta).

Cueto's Most Recent Starts: **4/22 at Chi**, in one of the best starts of his career threw 7.0 shutout innings to earn the 3-0 victory (4h, 0bb, 3k, 108 pitches, 68 strikes)...left leading, 1-0...the Reds added insurance runs in the eighth and ninth innings...singled twice off Lilly, his first career 2-hit game...**4/27 vs Hou** and received no decision in the 4-1 loss (7ip, 7h, 1er, 1bb, 5k, 1hr, 98 pitches, 64 strikes)...left with the score tied, 1-1...allowed only a solo HR to Berkman leading off the sixth inning, snapping his scoreless streak at career-high 12 innings...was Berkman's 20th career homer at Great American Ball Park, the most by any opposing player...the Astros scored 3 runs in the ninth off Cordero...**5/3 at Pit**, in the 5-0 victory threw 8.0 shutout innings in the best start of his young career (4h, 1bb, 9k, 109 pitches, 68 strikes)...the 8.0 innings are a career high...allowed only 4 singles...**5/8 vs StL** and earned the 6-4 victory (7ip, 5h, 1er, 2bb, 3k, 98 pitches, 67 strikes)...left leading, 6-1...allowed only a run-scoring GIDP by Thurston in the seventh inning, snapping his career-high scoreless streak at 15 innings...**5/13 at Ari** and earned the 10-3 victory (7ip, 4h, 3er, 2bb, 4k, 2hr, 100 pitches, 67 strikes)...in the first inning allowed a solo HR to Gerardo Parra in Parra's first career plate appearance, followed by a walk to Justin Upton...then retired 12 consecutive batters until Chad Tracy walked with 1 out in the fifth...after Parra's HR didn't allow another hit until Upton doubled with 2 outs in the sixth, followed by Stephen Drew's RBI-single...with 2 outs in the seventh inning allowed a solo HR to Ojeda, his first homer since 6/15/07 at Bal (410ab)...as a batter, led off the third inning with his second bunt single of the season to spark a 3-run rally...**5/19 vs Phi** and suffered the 4-3 loss (7ip, 7h, 4er, 0bb, 4k, 1hr, 112 pitches, 68 strikes)...in the second inning allowed a solo HR to Howard...allowed 3 runs in the fifth on Rollins' RBI-double, Utley's RBI-single and a sac fly by Ibanez...**5/24 vs Cle** and received no decision in the 11-inning, 4-3 victory (7ip, 6h, 3r, 2er, 3bb, 7k, 2hnp, 1wp, 111 pitches, 67 strikeouts)...left with the score tied, 3-3...allowed all 3 runs with 2 outs...in the fourth inning gave up a run-scoring double to Luis Valbuena...in the seventh allowed an RBI-triple to Grady Sizemore, who then scored on the play after obstruction was called on 3B Adam Rosales...**5/29 at Mil** and suffered the 3-2 loss (7ip, 3h, 3er, 4bb, 3k, 2hr, 104 pitches, 64 strikes)...left trailing, 3-2...allowed just 3 hits, but 2 of the hits were home runs that produced all 3 Brewers runs...in the first inning retired the first 2 batters but then walked Braun and allowed a 2-run HR to Fielder...Hart homered leading off the Brewers' seventh.

Tomorrow's Pitcher: RHP Aaron Harang

Last Started: Thu at StL, in the 200th start of his career threw his second complete game of the season in the 3-1 loss (8h, 3er, 2bb, 4k, 1hr, 115 pitches, 74 starts)...Pujols drove in all 3 runs on a 2-out, 2-run HR in the third inning and an RBI-double in the sixth...induced 4 inning-ending GIDP.

Red Hots: Tomorrow will make his 13th start of the season...in his previous 12 starts the Reds went 5-7 and scored 45 runs (3.75 r/g)...in his 12 starts **Reds batters** hit .247 (97-393).

Home Cookin': Is **4-2, 2.84** (38ip, 12er) in 6 starts at Great American Ball Park and **1-4, 5.35** (38.2ip, 23er) in 6 starts on the road.

Streiking: Has allowed a home run in 8 consecutive apps, tied with Pit's **Ross Ohlendorf** for the longest such streak by a pitcher in the Major Leagues this season (courtesy Elias Sports Bureau)...is the longest streak by a Reds pitcher since **RHP Ramon Ortiz** tied the National League record by allowing a home run in **15** consecutive apps from **5/1-7/17, 2005**.

Milestones: On 4/23 at Chi recorded the **1,000th** strikeout of his career (**Derrek Lee**)...his 3-hitter in the club's fifth game, a 2-0 win on 4/12 vs Pit, was the quickest complete game by a Reds pitcher since **Pete Harnisch** threw a CG in the Reds' fourth game of **1999**.

Staff Ace: Since he was acquired from the Athletics at the **2003 trading deadline** is the Reds' leader in most statistical pitching categories, including starts (179), wins (68), innings pitched (1145.2) and strikeouts (966)...since the beginning of the **2006 season** leads the National League in innings pitched (**727.0**)...in 2005 and 2007 won the BBWAA's Johnny Vander Meer Award as the club's Most Outstanding Pitcher.
