<u>TODAY'S NEWS</u>: The Reds have agreed to terms on 1-year contracts with LHP Bill Bray, C/IF/OF Bill Bray and IF Paul Janish...8 players remain unsigned.

TODAY IN CHARLOTTE COUNTY: Today's game is the first 2009 exhibition for the Reds and Rays and TB's first spring training game in its new facility...is the first spring training game in Port Charlotte since the Twins beat the host Rangers, 9-8, on 3/27/02 at Charlotte County Stadium and the Reds' first visit here since a 4-3 loss to Tex on 3/2/02... Cin's last scheduled game here, a split-squad trip on 3/7/02 vs Tex, was rained out...this afternoon's game is the first of 5 between the clubs (3/14 & 3/29 at Sarasota, 3/18 & 3/28 at Port Charlotte).

TODAY IN GOODYEAR: The Cleveland Indians open their exhibition schedule this afternoon in Arizona against the Giants at **Goodyear Ballpark**, a facility they will share with the Redlegs beginning next spring...this spring the Indians returned to the Cactus League after 16 seasons in **Winter Haven**, Florida (1993-2008)...they trained in **Tucson**, Arizona from 1947-1992.

ON THE HILL: Pitchers traveling today include RHP Johnny Cueto, RHP Homer Bailey, LHP Aaron Fultz, RHP Jared Burton, LHP Daniel Ray Herrera, RHP Jeff Kennard, RHP Sam LeCure and LHP Adam Pettyjohn...in the bullpen tomorrow vs Min will be RHP David Weathers, RHP Mike Lincoln, RHP Francisco Cordero, LHP Arthur Rhodes, RHP Ramon Ramirez and RHP Josh Roenicke...on Fri vs Phi, relievers will include RHP David Thompson, LHP Pedro Viola, LHP Daniel Ray Herrera, LHP Matt Maloney and LHP Ron Flores...Sat's travel roster at Bos will include Pettyjohn, LeCure and Kennard.

WBC NEWS: World Baseball Classic final rosters include Reds players 1B Joey Votto (Canada), RHP Johnny Cueto (Dominican Republic), RHP Edinson Volquez (DR), OF Willy Taveras (DR), IF/OF Jerry Hairston Jr. (Mexico) and C Ramon Hernandez (Venezuela) along with minor leaguers IF Yen-Wen Kuo (Chinese Taipei), LHP Alexander Smit (The Netherlands) and RHP Juan Carlos Sulbaran (The Netherlands)...special assistant to the general manager Mario Soto will be the pitching coach for the Dominican Republic...Class AAA Louisville's Tomas Vera will serve as the head athletic trainer for Venezuela...the World Baseball Classic begins in Tokyo on 3/5, in San Juan and Toronto on 3/7 and in Mexico City on 3/8...the second round begins in Miami on 3/14 and in San Diego on 3/15...the semifinals are 3/21-3/22 and the final on 3/23, all at Dodger Stadium...ticket information and the complete schedule can be found at www.WorldBaseballClassic.com.

ED SMITH SPRING OPENERS: The Reds open the home portion of their spring schedule tomorrow with a 1:05 p.m. start vs the Twins at **Ed Smith Stadium**...following are the Sarasota ballpark's spring training **Opening Day** paid attendance figures: **2008** (3,084), **2007** (4,889), **2006** (3,835), **2005** (3,827), **2004** (3,164), **2003** (4,483), **2002** (7,197), **2001** (5,854), **2000** (3,439), **1999** (2,549), **1998** (2,950), **1997** (3,249), **1996** (2,088), **1995** (1,503), **1994** (7,091), **1993** (5,022), **1992** (5,047), **1991** (5,063), **1990** (748 & 6,160), **1989** (6,892).

SPRING TRAINING ROSTER: The Reds began spring training camp with **63** players, including 29 pitchers, 8 catchers, 16 infielders, 10 outfielders and 23 non-roster invitees...most recently, the club invited to Major League camp **65** (2008), **57** (2007), **63** (2006), **55** (2005), **56** (2004), **64** (2003), **70** (2002), **58** (2001), **72** (2000) and **54** (1999) players.

<u>OUT OF OPTIONS</u>: The following players on the 40-man roster do not have options: RHP Bronson Arroyo, RHP Francisco Cordero, IF/OF Jeff Keppinger, RHP Mike Lincoln, RHP Nick Masset, 2B Brandon Phillips, LHP Arthur Rhodes and RHP David Weathers.

<u>OPENING DAY STARTER</u>: If RHP Aaron Harang is tabbed the Opening Day starter (vs NYM, 1:10pm), he would become the first Reds pitcher to start 4 consecutive Opening Day games since RHP Jose Rijo had the honors in 4 straight seasons from 1992-95...the only other Reds pitchers to make at least 3 consecutive Opening Day starts are Pete Donohue (5 straight, 1923-27), Si Johnson (3, 1932-34) and Mario Soto (5, 1982-86)...Soto holds the franchise record for most Opening Day starts (6).

THE BIG ONE: Next week, Reds on Radio rightsholder 700 WLW will broadcast its nightly SportsTalk show live from Fin Daddy's on Beneva Road in Sarasota...host Paul Daugherty and Executive Vice President of Player Procurement Bill Dennison can be heard Monday from 6:00 to 9:00 p.m. ET, Tuesday from 6:00 to 7:00, next Wednesday from 6:00 to 8:00, next Thursday from 6:00 to 8:30 and next Friday from 6:00 to 9:00.

REDS ON TV: Reds television rightsholder FOX Sports Ohio will broadcast 3 spring training games, including 3/19 vs Red Sox at Sarasota (7:05 p.m. ET), 3/20 vs Astros at Kissimmee (live at 1:05, replayed at 7:00) and 3/21 vs Pirates at Sarasota (1:05)...Reds Season Preview '09, hosted by George Grande and Jeff Piecoro, will air on 3/31 at 10:00 p.m. and will be replayed on 4/1 (6:30), 4/2 (7:00), 4/4 (7:00) and 4/5 (8:00)...the Emmy-Award winning Reds Live pregame show returns in 2009 with popular hosts Piecoro and Jim Day...the pre-game show will air half an hour prior to each of FOX Sports Ohio's regular-season telecasts.

GOING GREEN AT THE ED: Fans can park for half price at Ed Smith Stadium lots for Reds spring training games if their vehicles have at least 4 people...regular parking is \$10 per vehicle but just \$5 if at least 4 fans car pool.

<u>DANDY DOMINICAN</u>: Reds prospect **3B Juan Francisco** established a Dominican Winter League regular season record for home runs by a lefthanded batter with 12...he shattered the mark held by Rafael Batista, who hit 8 homers during the 1974-75 DWL regular season...including the playoffs, in 62 apps and 246 at bats for Gigantes del Cibao **Francisco** hit .350 with 14 doubles, 2 triples, 18 HR, 55rbi and 52 runs scored.

<u>SUNSET SEASON</u>: In 2009 the **City of Sarasota Sports Complex** is hosting the Reds' spring training activities for the 12th and final season...next year the organization will move its spring training site 20 miles west of Phoenix to **Goodyear**, **Arizona**...the Reds will share the **Goodyear Ballpark and Recreational Sports Complex** with the Indians, who moved into the facility last fall...Cin's portion of the plans includes a 40,700-square foot clubhouse, 6 full practice fields and 2 half fields...the teams will share the 10,000-seat ballpark...the Reds' agreement includes a 20-year lease and two 5-year team options...next spring, 15 Major League Baseball clubs will train in Arizona and 15 will train in Florida.
