Major League Baseball has announced that tomorrow, for the first time ever, all uniformed personnel and umpires will wear number 42 to recognize the enduring impact of **Jackie Robinson's** historical debut...tomorrow is the 62nd anniversary of his first big league game...63 **Jackie Robinson Foundation** scholarship recipients will be honored in pre-game ceremonies in the 15 ballparks...the members of each team will sign one #42 jersey to be auctioned off on MLB.com, with proceeds to benefit the **Jackie Robinson Foundation**.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is Game 2 (1-0) of a 3-game series vs **Alex Boeder's** Brewers and Game 2 (1-0) of the Reds' first and longest road trip of the season, an 11-day, 10-game jaunt to **Mil** (1-0), **Hou** (off day, 4g) and **Chi** (3g)...opened the season with a **2-3 homestand** vs the **Mets** (1-2) and **Pirates** (1-1, 1ppd)...following this road trip the Redlegs return to Great American Ball Park for a 6-game homestand vs the **Braves** (3g) and **Astros** (3g).

DOT, DOT, DOT...: With his next appearance, **RHP David Weathers** will become the 20th player in Major League history to pitch in 900 games...in last night's 7-6 victory **Brandon Phillips** and **Willy Taveras** each scored the 300th run of his career...**SS Alex Gonzalez** is 6 hits shy of **1,000**...**RHP Aaron Harang** is 8 strikeouts shy of **1,000**.

PLAYING FROM BEHIND: The Reds have trailed in 5 of their 6g this season and lost 3 of the 5g in which they trailed...3 times allowed runs in the first inning...last season the Reds went **26-69** when the opponent scored first and **48-19** when they scored first.

CIVIL RIGHTS GAME: At Great American Ball Park on **Sat, 6/20** the Reds and Chicago White Sox will meet in the **Civil Rights Game**, the first time the contest will be played during the regular season...the weekend's festivities will include a roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's **Harriet Tubman Theater** (Fri, 6/19, 4:00 p.m.), a luncheon at **Duke Energy Center** honoring the 3 winners of Major League Baseball's **Beacon Awards** (Sat, 6/20, 11:30 a.m.) and a **Youth Summit at Fountain Square** downtown (Sat, 6/20, 4:00 p.m.)...the luncheon on Sat, 6/20 will honor Beacon of Hope winner **Bill Cosby**, Beacon of Life winner **Hank Aaron** and Beacon of Change winner **Muhammad Ali**...for more information, log on to www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame.

VOTE NOW: Through 4/30, fans can vote online at reds.com to decide which **Reds** pitcher will have a 2009 bobblehead...the **Fans Choice Bobblehead** will be given to the first 30,000 fans on **Sat, 7/18 vs Mil** and is part of a collectible set of 4 bobbleheads that also features **Joey Votto** (Sat, 5/9 StL), **Jay Bruce** (Sat, 7/4 vs StL) and **Brandon Phillips** (Sat, 8/15 vs Wsh).

HONORARY BAT GIRLS: In celebration of **Mother's Day**, Major League Baseball and **Susan G. Komen for the Cure** are looking for honorary bat girls for games scheduled for **Sun, 5/10**...the Reds and Cardinals will play at 1:10 p.m. that day at Great American Ball Park...MLB.com is hosting a contest in which fans can share stories of "going to bat" against breast cancer in their daily lives...the initiative is aimed to raise additional awareness and support for the annual *Going to Bat Against Breast Cancer* program, a joint partnership between MLB and **Susan G. Komen for the Cure**...fans can submit stories and vote for their favorites on www.mlb.com/honorarybatgirl...winners will be selected **May 1**.

NON-ROSTER INVITEES: The Opening Day roster includes a pair of non-roster invitees, **OF Darnell McDonald** and **OF Laynce Nix**...the club's most recent Opening Day rosters included 5 non-roster invitees last season (**RHP Johnny Cueto**, **RHP Mike Lincoln**, **LHP Kent Mercker**, **C Paul Bako**, **OF Corey Patterson**), 1 in 2007 (**RHP Victor Santos**), 1 in 2006 (**IF Andy Abad**) and 2 in 2005 (**IF Rich Aurilia**, **1B Jacob Cruz**).

LEFTHANDERS: In the **2008 season finale**, an 11-4 loss at StL, **Adam Pettyjohn** became the only lefthanded pitcher to start a game for the Reds last season...snapped a streak of 180 consecutive starts by Reds righthanders, dating back to **Phil Dumatrait's** 10-5 loss vs Mil on 9/9/07...according to Elias Sports Bureau, it was the first time since at least 1900 that the Reds went an entire season with only 1 start by a lefthander...the **2006 Diamondbacks** were the last team to finish a Major League season with fewer than 2 starts by a lefthanded pitcher...the Reds were the only team to do it in 2008.

RISING STARS: In 2008, **OF Jay Bruce**, **1B Joey Votto** and **RHP Johnny Cueto** ranked among the National League rookie leaders in almost every statistical category...**Cueto** led NL rookie pitchers in strikeouts (158), while **Votto** ranked first in hitting (.297), hits (156), HR (24), total bases (266), multi-hit games (42), on-base percentage (.368) and slugging percentage (.506)...**Votto** (24hr, 84rbi) and **Bruce** (21hr, 52rbi) became the first pair of Reds rookies ever to produce more than 13 home runs each in the same season...the Reds were the only team in the Major Leagues this season to have 2 rookies with as many as 21hr each...**Votto** hit 23 of his 24 homers as a first baseman, a new club record for HR by a rookie at that position (**Ted Kluszewski**, 12hr, 1948).

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (2-3, .400): In 2008, at **43-38** the Reds established a new Great American Ball Park record for victories in a season...went **12-11-3** in their 26 home series...in 7 seasons at GABP are **243-248-1** (35-46 in 2003, 40-41 in 2004, 42-39-1 in 2005, 42-39 in 2006, 39-42 in 2007, 43-38 in 2008)...at **217-217-1** the Reds had evened their overall record at GABP for the first time since **6/26/04** (57-57)...also reached .500 at **219-219-1**.

REDS ON THE ROAD (1-0, 1.000): Last season the Reds went **31-50** on the road and **8-16-2** in their 26 road series...produced 3 winning road trips: from **6/20-6/29** went 5-4 at NYY/Tor/Cle, from **8/12-8/14** went 2-1 at Pit and from **9/8-9/14** went 4-2 at Mil/Ari...dating back to 2006, the **Reds have produced a losing record in 23 of their last 28 road trips**.

IN THE STANDINGS (8): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 0, SECOND - 0, THIRD - 0, FOURTH - 4, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...have spent **0** days above, **0** days at and **8** days below .500.

REDS vs BREWERS: The Reds are 91-88-1 all-time vs the Brewers, including 1-0 this season and 11-8 the last 2 seasons...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 26-25, including 4-5 last season...**at Miller Park:** Reds are 38-33, including 1-0 this season and 7-3 the last 2 seasons...**last Reds sweep:** at Cin: 7/19-7/20, 2004 (2g); 5/6-5/8, 2002 (3g)...at Mil: 6/5-6/6, 2001 (2g); 7/11-7/13, 2003 (3g); 5/13-5/16, 2002 (4g)...**last Brewers sweep:** at Cin: 8/30-9/1, 2002 (3g); 8/25-8/28, 2003 (4g)...at Mil: 4/27-4/28, 2004 (2g), 7/3-7/5, 2006 (3g).

Wins Beginning 6/29

In the 14-1 loss on 6/24/08 at Tor, **Bronson Arroyo** made the shortest start of his career (1+ip, 11h, 10er) and became only the sixth starting pitcher in Major League history to allow at least 10 earned runs in a game in which he retired 3 batters or fewer...beginning with his next start, a 9-5 win at Cle on 6/29, **Arroyo** finished the 2008 season with 11 wins, second-most in the majors:

Last Pitched: Thu vs NYM, in his season debut earned the 8-6 victory (6ip, 8h, 5er, 2bb, 4k, 100 pitches, 68 strikes)...allowed 3 runs in the third inning, highlighted by Church's 2-run double, but the Reds came back with 4 runs in the bottom of that frame and then 4 more in the fifth.

2008 Season: Was the only member of the Reds' rotation to make every scheduled start...for the third straight season led the staff in starts (34) and for the second time in 3 years led the club in innings pitched (200.0)...for the fourth straight season recorded at least 32 starts and 200 innings...his 18 quality starts and career-high 15 wins were second on the staff to All-Star Edinson Volquez' 17 victories and 20 quality apps...3 times was the victim of blown saves...tied for the National League lead in starts (34)...in his 34 starts the Reds went 18-16 and scored 172 runs (5.06 r/g)...was 1 of only 5 Reds pitchers to participate in more winning games than losing games (Jared Burton, Francisco Cordero, Edinson Volquez, David Weathers).

Player of the Week: For the period ending 8/31 of last season was voted **National League Co-Player of the Week** along with Wsh's **Cristian Guzman**...in 2 starts that week **Arroyo** went 2-0, 1.69 with 1 CG.

Career Highlights: In each of the last 4 seasons recorded at least 32 starts and 200 innings...is 1 of only 8 Major League pitchers to record at least 200 innings in each of the last 4 seasons (Mark Buehrle, Dan Haren, Roy Oswalt, Andy Pettitte, Johan Santana, Javier Vazquez, Brandon Webb)...in each of the last 3 seasons led the Reds in starts and in 2 of the last 3 seasons led the staff in innings pitched...was National League Co-Player of the Week for 8/25-8/31, 2007...in 2006 was a National League All-Star, participated in Major League Baseball's All-Star tour of Japan in November and was voted by the Cincinnati chapter of the Baseball Writers' Association of America the winner of both the Johnny Vander Meer Award as the club's Most Outstanding Pitcher and the Joe Nuxhall Good Guy Award.

Personal: Plays guitar and sings...on 6/15/06 performed in concert with **Raquel Aurilia**, wife of then-teammate **Rich**, and Cincinnati band **Screaming Mimes** to raise \$35,000 for the Reds Community Fund...also performed at Redsfest in 2006, 2007 and 2008...in 2007, through his **Athletes for the Brave** program donated \$100 for every strikeout to **Homes For Our Troops**, an organization that provides homes at no cost to injured or disabled servicemen and servicewomen and their immediate families...his contribution totaled \$15,600...also donated to Homes For Our Troops a portion of the proceeds from a concert on 5/27/07.

Last Pitched: In a minor league game on 4/5 in Sarasota (5ip, 5h, 1er, 0bb, 2k, 73 pitches).

Red Hots: Tomorrow will make his first pitching appearance of the season...was scheduled to start Sat vs Pit but that appearance was bumped when Fri's game was postponed by rain...has made a pair of pinch-hitting apps (1-2, double, strikeout).

2008 Season: Began the season with the Diamondbacks and went 6-9, 5.93 in 18 starts and 4 relief apps before he was optioned to Class AAA Tucson on 7/29...made Ari's Opening Day roster...in his first 4 starts went 4-0, 2.42...produced 9 quality starts...was bothered late in the season by a sore right shoulder and made just 2 minor league starts...on 9/12 was acquired by the Reds to complete the 8/11 deal that sent OF Adam Dunn to the Diamondbacks...did not pitch for the Reds but in 4 pinch-hit apps produced 3rbi and 2 game-winning hits...in the 3-2 win on 9/13 at Ari made his Reds debut in the 10th inning produced an RBI-double off Tony Pena that snapped the 2-2 tie...in the 4-3 win on 9/20 vs Mil produced a 2-run single off CC Sabathia that erased the 3-2 deficit.

At The Plate: Has 5 career home runs...in 2007 won the National League's Silver Slugger Award (.333, 4hr, 15rbi)...that season led all NL pitchers in HR and RBI...his 4 homers were the most by a pitcher in a single season since KC's Jim Rooker hit 4hr in 1969.
