Yesterday's Off Day News & Notes
Yesterday the Reds acquired from the Astros IF Drew Sutton to complete the 3/31 trade that sent IF Jeff Keppinger to Houston for a player to be named later...**Sutton** will report to Class AAA Louisville...to make room on the 40-man roster, the Reds outrighted to Louisville **IF Danny Richar**...on the minor league front yesterday, Louisville **LHP Bill** Bray was examined in Cincinnati by Reds medical director Dr. Timothy Kremchek and was diagnosed with a strained left elbow...he will be evaluated again in 10 days.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is Game 1 of a 4-game series vs Russ Luna's Astros and Game 4 (2-1) of the Reds' first and longest road trip of the season, an 11-day, 10-game jaunt that also includes visits to Mil (2-1) and Chi (3g, Tue-Thu)... opened the season with a 2-3 homestand vs the Mets (1-2) and Pirates (1-1, 1ppd)...following this road trip the Redlegs return to Great American Ball Park for a 6-game homestand vs the Braves (3g) and Astros (3g).

CENTRAL CASTING: Tonight's game is Game 6 (3-2) in a stretch of 12 straight games, 18-21g and 23-28g against National League Central Division opponents (1-1 vs Pit, 2-1 at Mil, 4g at Hou, 3g at Chi, 3g vs Atl, 3g vs Hou, 3g at Pit, 2g at Fla, 2g vs Mil, 3g vs StL).

DOT, DOT., DOT...: At 4-3 the Reds were a season-high 1g over .500...last season were a season-best 2g over .500 at 4-2 and 6-4...on Tue at Mil, RHP David Weathers became the 20th player in Major League history to pitch in 900 games...SS Alex Gonzalez is 5 hits shy of 1,000...RHP Aaron Harang is 8 strikeouts shy of 1,000...Ramon Hernandez is 2 at bats shy of 4,000.

PLAYING FROM BEHIND: The Reds have trailed in 6 of their 8g this season and lost 4 of the 6g in which they trailed...4 times allowed runs in the first inning...last season the Reds went 26-69 when the opponent scored first and 48-19 when they scored first.

ABOUT THE NEW GUY: Yesterday the Reds acquired from the Astros IF Drew Sutton to complete the spring training deal that sent IF Jeff Keppinger to Hou for a player to be named later...Sutton, 25, will report to Class AAA Louisville... last season Sutton was Class AA Corpus Christi's Most Valuable Player after hitting .317 with 20hr and 69rbi...he was a Texas League mid-season and post-season All-Star and led all Astros minor leaguers in batting average, hits (165), runs (102), walks (76), doubles (39) and extra-base hits (63)...prior to the 2009 season he was rated the Astros' eighthbest prospect by Baseball America.

CIVIL RIGHTS GAME: At Great American Ball Park on Sat, 6/20 the Reds and Chicago White Sox will meet in the Civil Rights Game, the first time the contest will be played during the regular season...the weekend's festivities will include a roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's Harriet Tubman Theater (Fri, 6/19, 4:00 p.m.), a luncheon at **Duke Energy Center** honoring the 3 winners of Major League Baseball's **Beacon Awards** (Sat, 6/20, 11:30 a.m.) and a Youth Summit at Fountain Square downtown (Sat, 6/20, 4:00 p.m.)...the luncheon on Sat, 6/20 will honor Beacon of Hope winner Bill Cosby, Beacon of Life winner Hank Aaron and Beacon of Change winner Muhammad Ali...for more information, log on to www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame

VOTE NOW: Through 4/30, fans can vote online at reds.com to decide which Reds pitcher will have a 2009 bobblehead...the Fans Choice Bobblehead will be given to the first 30,000 fans on Sat, 7/18 vs Mil and is part of a collectible set of 4 bobbleheads that also features Joey Votto (Sat, 5/9 StL), Jay Bruce (Sat, 7/4 vs StL) and Brandon Phillips (Sat, 8/15 vs Wsh).

HONORARY BAT GIRLS: In celebration of Mother's Day, Major League Baseball and Susan G. Komen for the Cure are looking for honorary bat girls for games scheduled for Sun, 5/10...the Reds and Cardinals will play at 1:10 p.m. that day at Great American Ball Park...MLB.com is hosting a contest in which fans can share stories of "going to bat" against breast cancer in their daily lives...the initiative is aimed to raise additional awareness and support for the annual Going to Bat Against Breast Cancer program, a joint partnership between MLB and Susan G. Komen for the Cure...fans can submit stories and vote for their favorites on www.mlb.com/honorarybatgirl...winners will be selected May 1.

NON-ROSTER INVITEES: The Opening Day roster includes a pair of non-roster invitees, OF Darnell McDonald and OF Laynce Nix...the club's most recent Opening Day rosters included 5 non-roster invitees last season (RHP Johnny Cueto, RHP Mike Lincoln, LHP Kent Mercker, C Paul Bako, OF Corey Patterson), 1 in 2007 (RHP Victor Santos), 1 in 2006 (IF Andy Abad) and 2 in 2005 (IF Rich Aurilia, 1B Jacob Cruz).

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (2-3, .400): Went 0-1-1 in their 2 home series...in 2008, at 43-38 the Reds established a new Great American Ball Park record for victories in a season...went **12-11-3** in their 26 home series...in 7 seasons at GABP are **243-248-1** (35-46 in 2003, 40-41 in 2004, 42-39-1 in 2005, 42-39 in 2006, 39-42 in 2007, 43-38 in 2008)...at 217-217-1 the Reds had evened their overall record at GABP for the first time since 6/26/04 (57-57)...also reached .500 at 219-219-1.

REDS ON THE ROAD (2-1, .667): Won their first road series (2-1 at Mil)..last season the Reds went 31-50 on the road and 8-16-2 in their 26 road series...produced 3 winning road trips: from 6/20-6/29 went 5-4 at NYY/Tor/Cle, from 8/12-8/14 went 2-1 at Pit and from 9/8-9/14 went 4-2 at Mil/Ari...entering this season and dating back to 2006, the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips.

IN THE STANDINGS (11): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 0, SECOND - 0, THIRD - 3, FOURTH - 4, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...have spent 1 day above, 3 days at and 7 days below .500.

REDS vs ASTROS: The Reds are 398-379-1 all-time vs the Astros, including 3-12 in 2008 and 7-23 the last 2 seasons... **at Great American Ball Park**: Reds are 15-30-1, including 0-6 in 2008 and 1-14 the last 2 seasons...have dropped the last 9g vs Hou at GABP...Hou's .667 winning percentage at GABP (30-15) is the best among all opponents (LAD 2nd, 13-7, .650)...**Lance Berkman's** 19 homers at GABP are the most by any Reds opponent (**Jason Bay** 2nd, 14)...**Roy** Oswalt's 7 wins there tie Chi's Carlos Zambrano for the most by an opposing pitcher...at Minute Maid Park: Reds are 27-46, including 3-6 last season... last Reds sweep: at Hou: 9/14-9/15, 1981 (2g); 6/2-6/4, 2006 (3g); 6/24-6/27, 1999 (4g)...last Astros sweep: at Hou: 9/7-9/8, 1998 (2g); 8/30-9/1, 2005 (3g); 7/7-7/10, 2003 (4g).

Last Pitched: Sat vs Pit, in his season debut suffered the 10-2 loss (6ip, 8h, 4er, 1bb, 9k, 1hr, 109 pitches, 67 strikes)...left trailing, 4-0...allowed McLouth's 2-run HR in the first inning...in the fourth allowed Wilson's RBI-double and Morgan's RBI-triple.

<u>Red Hots</u>: The 23-year-old righthander is making his second start of the season and the 33rd start of his career.

World Baseball Classic: Started the Dominican Republic's second game of the tournament and threw 4.2 scoreless innings to earn the 9-0 victory vs Panama in the San Juan bracket (4.2ip, 3h, 1bb, 5k).

<u>Rookie Season</u>: In 2008 became the first Reds rookie to make 30 starts since **Tom Browning** in 1988 (38gs) and the first Reds rookie *righthander* to make 30 starts since **Gary Nolan** in 1967 (32gs).

Rookie Leader: In 2008 led all National League rookie pitchers in strikeouts (158) and ranked among the NL rookie leaders in ERA (8th), starts (31, T1st), wins (9, T2nd), innings pitched (174.0, 4th) and opponents' BA (.264, 6th)...averaged 8.2 strikeouts per 9 innings to rank eighth among all NL pitchers.

Major League Debut: On 4/3/08 vs Ari made his Major League debut at 22 years, 48 days old and earned the 3-2 victory (7ip, 1h, 1er, 0bb, 10k, Upton HR, 92 pitches, 68 strikes)...became the first pitcher in modern Major League history to debut with 10 strikeouts and 0 walks, the first Reds pitcher since 1900 to record 10 strikeouts in his ML debut and only the third pitcher to win his ML debut while allowing 1 hit and recording at least 10 strikeouts

(Steve Woodard 1997, Juan Marichal 1960)...retired his first 15 batters and allowed only 1 baserunner overall, Justin Upton homered leading off the sixth.

Tomorrow's Pitcher: RHP Aaron Harang

<u>Last Started</u>: Sun vs Pit and threw a 3-hitter in the 2-0 victory (0bb, 9k, 1hbp, 108 pitches, 80 strikes)...was his 12th career complete game and sixth career shutout...was the first CG in the majors this season...allowed only a leadoff double to Morgan and singles to Moss and Morgan.

2008 Red Hots: Tomorrow will make his third start of the season...in his previous 2 starts the Reds went 1-1 and scored 3 runs (1.5 r/g)... is approaching 1,000 career strikeouts (992)...his complete game in Sun's 2-0 win vs Pit was the quickest by a Reds pitcher since Pete Harnisch threw a CG in the Reds' fourth game of 1999.

Opening Day: In the 2-1 loss vs the Mets made his fourth straight Opening Day start, the first Reds pitcher to do so since RHP Jose Rijo had the honors in 4 straight seasons from 1992-95...the only other Reds pitchers to make at least 4 consecutive Opening Day starts are Pete Donohue (5 straight, 1923-27) and Mario Soto (5, 1982-86)...Soto holds the club record for overall Opening Day starts (6)...in 4 career Opening Day starts Harang is (1-3, 3.52, 23ip, 9er).

Staff Ace: In 2008 received the Joe Nuxhall Good Guy Award from the local chapter of the Baseball Writers' Association of America... in 2005 and 2007 won the BBWAA's Johnny Vander Meer Award as the club's Most Outstanding Pitcher...since he was acquired from the Athletics at the 2003 trading deadline is the Reds' leader in most statistical pitching categories, including starts (169), wins (64), innings pitched (1083.0) and strikeouts (912).

Community Affairs: Is one of the club's more active members of the local community...for the third consecutive season, as part of his Aaron's Aces ticket program is hosting at all Sunday home games children of military personnel serving in the War On Terrorism... in 2008 he donated \$55,000 to the Miracle League of Greater Cincinnati and Northern Kentucky...for his community service has been the club's nominee for the Robert Clemente Award (2007), Branch Rickey Award (2007) and Marvin Miller Man of the Year Award (2007, 2008).
