SUNSET: Tomorrow is the Reds' final day at the **City of Sarasota Sports Complex**, their spring training home for 12 seasons...next year the organization will move its spring training site 20 miles west of Phoenix to **Goodyear, Arizona**...the Reds will share the **Goodyear Ballpark and Recreational Sports Complex** with the Indians, who moved into the facility last fall...Cin's portion of the plans includes a 40,700-square foot clubhouse, 6 full practice fields and 2 half fields...the teams will share 10,000-seat **Goodyear Ballpark**...the Reds' agreement includes a 20-year lease and two 5-year team options...next spring, 15 Major League Baseball clubs will train in Arizona and 15 will train in Florida.

REDS' SPRING TRAINING SITES: On 6/24/97, the Sarasota City Commission unanimously approved the assignment of its spring training facility from the White Sox to the Reds...the original 20-year contract expired October 1, 2008...since 1895, Reds have trained in Mobile, AL (1895, 1913), New Orleans (1896-97, 1900), Ft. Worth (1898), Columbus, GA (1899, 1912), Cincinnati (1901-02), Augusta, GA (1903), Dallas (1904), **Jacksonville** (1905), San Antonio (1906), Marlin, TX (1907), **St. Augustine** (1908), Atlanta (1909), Hot Springs, AR (1910-11), Alexandria, LA (1914-15), Shreveport, LA (1916-17), Montgomery, AL (1918), Waxahachie, TX (1919), **Miami** (1920), Cisco, TX (1921), Mineral Wells, TX (1922), **Orlando** (1923-30), **Tampa** (1931-42, 1946-87), San Juan, Puerto Rico (2/10-3/10, 1936), Bloomington, IN (1943-45), **Plant City** (1988-97) and **Sarasota** (1998-2009).

TODAY'S GAME: Is the sixth of 6 exhibitions vs the **Pirates** and the Reds' **final game** at Sarasota's **Ed Smith Stadium**...Pit leads this spring's series, 3-2, including a split in the pair of games already played here (10-6 Reds win in 10 innings on 3/5, 6-5 Pirates win on 3/21)...the Reds will finish this spring's schedule with a pair of games against their talented **Futures** team, tomorrow night (6:05) at their Class AA Carolina affiliate's **Five County Stadium** and Sat afternoon (3:05) at their Class A Dayton affiliate's **Fifth Third Field**.

LINEUP CARD: Today's extra players are **OF Drew T. Anderson** (#36), **C Chris McMurray** (#56), **C Chris Denove** (#90), **IF Michael Griffin** (#39), **RHP James Avery** (#86), **RHP Daniel Guerrero** (#78) and **RHP Derrik Lutz** (#49).

ON THE MOUND: **RHP Jared Burton** in his last 7 apps has posted a 1.35era (6.2ip, 1er)...**RHP Francisco Cordero** in his last 4 apps has posted a 2.45era (3.2ip, 1er)...**RHP Mike Lincoln** in his last 8 apps has posted a 2.25era (8ip, 2er)...**RHP Nick Masset** in his last 3 apps has posted a 1.50era (6ip, 1er)...**RHP Edinson Volquez** didn't allow a run until his 17th inning and overall has allowed just 1 run in 5g/4gs (19ip, 17h, 9bb, 15k).

AT THE PLATE: **RF Jay Bruce** in his last 12g is hitting .371 (13-35, 2hr, 8rbi)...**IF/OF/C Wilkin Castillo** in his last 15g is hitting .364 (8-22)...**OF Chris Dickerson** in his last 16g is hitting .311 (14-45)...**3B Edwin Encarnacion** has been bothered by right shoulder soreness and since 3/21 has made just 3 apps (Sat at TB, Tue vs NYY, yesterday at Hou)...**SS Alex Gonzalez** has hit safely in 6 of his 10 apps but hasn't played in an "A" game since 3/23, when he suffered a strained right hamstring...he is scheduled to play 9 innings in a minor league game today...**C Ryan Hanigan** is hitting .361 in his 22 apps...**C Ramon Hernandez** has hit safely in 4 of his last 5 apps (4-11, .363)...**2B Brandon Phillips** opened the spring with a team-high 10-game hitting streak...**OF Willy Taveras** has hit safely in 9 of his 11 apps since returning from the WBC (9-33, .273)...from 3/14-3/29 he produced a 9-game hitting streak, the second-longest by a Reds batter this spring (Phillips, 10g)...**IF Chris Valaika** has hit safely in 6 of his last 9 apps (6-15, .400).

FOR THE SAKE OF COMPARISON: This spring Reds batters have produced **28 homers** and **32 stolen bases**, compared to **22 homers** and **20 steals** through 32g a year ago.

SLAM-TASTIC!: The Reds lead all Spring Training clubs with 5 grand slams (**Chris Valaika** on 3/9 at Phi, **Darnell McDonald** on /5 vs Pit, **Jonny Gomes** on 3/3 at Bos, **Craig Tatum** on 3/1 vs NYY, **Jerry Hairston Jr.** on 2/25 at TB)...the Mets, Rangers and Cubs each have 3 grand slams, while the Yankees and Royals have 2 each...12 other teams have hit 1 slam this spring.

OPENING DAY STARTER: If **RHP Aaron Harang** makes the start on Opening Day (vs NYM, 1:10pm), he would become the first Reds pitcher to start 4 consecutive Opening Day games since **RHP Jose Rijo** had the honors in 4 straight seasons from 1992-95...the only other Reds pitchers to make at least 3 consecutive Opening Day starts are **Pete Donohue** (5 straight, 1923-27), **Si Johnson** (3, 1932-34) and **Mario Soto** (5, 1982-86)...**Soto** holds the franchise record for most Opening Day starts (6).

OUT OF OPTIONS: The following players on the 40-man roster do not have options: **RHP Bronson Arroyo**, **RHP Francisco Cordero**, **RHP Mike Lincoln**, **RHP Nick Masset**, **2B Brandon Phillips**, **LHP Arthur Rhodes** and **RHP David Weathers**.
