TONIGHT'S GAME: Is Game 4 (2-1) of a 4-game series vs **MJ Trahan's** Astros and Game 7 (4-2) of the Reds' first and longest road trip of the season, an 11-day, 10-game jaunt that also includes visits to **Mil** (2-1) and **Chi** (3g, Tue-Thu)...opened the season with a **2-3 homestand** vs the **Mets** (1-2) and **Pirates** (1-1, 1ppd)...following this road trip the Redlegs return to Great American Ball Park for a 6-game homestand vs the **Braves** (3g) and **Astros** (3g).

BRUCE UPDATE: **Jay Bruce** was scratched from Sat's starting lineup with a sore right hand, which has been swollen since he was hit by a **Yovani Gallardo** pitch a week ago at Mil...x-rays and an MRI showed no signs of a fracture...he did not start in either of the last 2g but pinch ran yesterday...he will be examined again prior to tonight's game.

<u>CENTRAL CASTING</u>: Tonight's game is Game 9 (5-3) in a stretch of **12 straight games**, **18-21g** and **23-28g** against **National League Central** opponents (1-1 vs Pit, 2-1 at Mil, **2-1 at Hou**, 3g at Chi, 3g vs Atl, 3g vs Hou, 3g at Pit, 2g at Fla, 2g vs Mil, 3g vs StL).

<u>DOT, DOT, DOT...</u>: Yesterday's 4-2 victory was the Reds' **400th** win vs the Astros (400-380-1)...**SS Alex Gonzalez** is 4 hits shy of **1,000**...**RHP Aaron Harang** is 2 strikeouts shy of **1,000**...**Reds batters** haven't homered in 2g, their longest power drought of the young season...pitcher **Micah Owings** leads Reds pinch hitters with 2rbi and ranks second on the club with 2 pinch hits, both doubles...**Darnell McDonald** leads the club with 3 pinch hits.

.500: At 6-5 the Reds are a season-high 1g over .500 for the third time (4-3, 5-4)...last season were a season-best 2g over .500 at 4-2 and 6-4...haven't been more than 2g over .500 since they were a season-high 3g over at 4-1 in 2007 and haven't been more than 2g over .500 this late in a season since they were 3g over .500 at 67-64 in 2006.

PLAYING FROM BEHIND: The Reds have trailed in 9 of their 11g this season and lost 5 of the 9g in which they trailed...5 times allowed runs in the first inning...last season the Reds went **26-69** when the opponent scored first and **48-19** when they scored first.

ABOUT THE NEW GUY: On Thursday the Reds acquired from the Astros IF Drew Sutton to complete the spring training deal that sent IF Jeff Keppinger to Hou for a player to be named later...Sutton, 25, will report to Class AAA Louisville...last season Sutton was Class AA Corpus Christi's Most Valuable Player after hitting .317 with 20hr and 69rbi...he was a Texas League mid-season and post-season All-Star and led all Astros minor leaguers in batting average, hits (165), runs (102), walks (76), doubles (39) and extra-base hits (63)...prior to the 2009 season he was rated the Astros' eighth-best prospect by Baseball America.

CIVIL RIGHTS GAME: At Great American Ball Park on Sat, 6/20 the Reds and Chicago White Sox will meet in the Civil Rights Game, the first time the contest will be played during the regular season...the weekend's festivities will include a roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's Harriet Tubman Theater (Fri, 6/19, 4:00 p.m.), a luncheon at Duke Energy Center honoring the 3 winners of Major League Baseball's Beacon Awards (Sat, 6/20, 11:30 a.m.) and a Youth Summit at Fountain Square downtown (Sat, 6/20, 4:00 p.m.)...the luncheon on Sat, 6/20 will honor Beacon of Hope winner Bill Cosby, Beacon of Life winner Hank Aaron and Beacon of Change winner Muhammad Ali...for more information, log on to www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame.

<u>VOTE NOW</u>: Through 4/30, fans can vote online at <u>reds.com</u> to decide which **Reds pitcher** will have a 2009 bobblehead...the **Fans Choice Bobblehead** will be given to the first 30,000 fans on **Sat, 7/18 vs Mil** and is part of a collectible set of 4 bobbleheads that also features **Joey Votto** (Sat, 5/9 StL), **Jay Bruce** (Sat, 7/4 vs StL) and **Brandon Phillips** (Sat, 8/15 vs Wsh).

NON-ROSTER INVITEES: The Opening Day roster includes a pair of non-roster invitees, OF Darnell McDonald and OF Laynce Nix...the club's most recent Opening Day rosters included 5 non-roster invitees last season (RHP Johnny Cueto, RHP Mike Lincoln, LHP Kent Mercker, C Paul Bako, OF Corey Patterson), 1 in 2007 (RHP Victor Santos), 1 in 2006 (IF Andy Abad) and 2 in 2005 (IF Rich Aurilia, 1B Jacob Cruz).

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (2-3, .400): Went 0-1-1 in their 2 home series...in 2008, at 43-38 the Reds established a new Great American Ball Park record for victories in a season...went 12-11-3 in their 26 home series...in 7 seasons at GABP are 243-248-1 (35-46 in 2003, 40-41 in 2004, 42-39-1 in 2005, 42-39 in 2006, 39-42 in 2007, 43-38 in 2008)...at 217-217-1 the Reds had evened their overall record at GABP for the first time since 6/26/04 (57-57)...also reached .500 at 219-219-1.

REDS ON THE ROAD (4-2, .667): Won their first road series of the season (2-1 at Mil)...last year the Reds went 31-50 on the road and 8-16-2 in their 26 road series...in 2008 produced 3 winning road trips: from 6/20-6/29 went 5-4 at NYY/ Tor/Cle, from 8/12-8/14 went 2-1 at Pit and from 9/8-9/14 went 4-2 at Mil/Ari...entering this season and dating back to 2006, the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips.

IN THE STANDINGS (14): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 0, SECOND - 0, THIRD - 5, FOURTH - 5, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...have spent 3 days above, 4 days at and 7 days below .500.

REDS vs ASTROS: The Reds are 400-380-1 all-time vs the Astros, including 2-1 this season, 5-13 the last 2 seasons and 9-24 the last 3 seasons...the Reds' 4-2 win at Minute Maid Park on 4/19 was their 400th victory vs Hou...at Great American Ball Park: Reds are 15-30-1, including 0-6 in 2008 and 1-14 the last 2 seasons...have dropped the last 9g vs Hou at GABP...Hou's .667 winning percentage at GABP (30-15) is the best among all opponents (LAD 2nd, 13-7, .650)...Lance Berkman's 19 homers at GABP are the most by any Reds opponent (Jason Bay 2nd, 14)...Roy Oswalt's 7 wins there tie Chi's Carlos Zambrano for the most by an opposing pitcher...at Minute Maid Park: Reds are 29-47, including 2-1 this season and 3-6 in 2008...last Reds sweep: at Cin: 9/22, 1992 (2g, DH); 9/22-9/24, 2000 (3g); 5/21-5/24, 2004 (4g)...at Hou: 9/14-9/15, 1981 (2g); 6/2-6/4, 2006 (3g); 6/24-6/27, 1999 (4g)...last Astros sweep: at Cin: 4/23-4/24, 2008 (2g); 9/25-9/27, 2007 (3g); 8/7-8/10 2008 (4g)...at Hou: 9/7-9/8, 1998 (2g); 8/30-9/1, 2005 (3g); 7/7-7/10, 2003 (4g).

Last Pitched: Tue at Mil and earned the 6-1 victory (6.1ip, 4h, 1er, 4bb, 3k, 1hr, 105 pitches, 57 strikes)...left leading, 3-1, and the Reds added 3 runs in the ninth inning...allowed only Hardy's solo HR in the second inning.

Red Hots: Is making his third start of the season and his 100th career start on the road...in his previous 2 starts the Reds went 2-0 and scored 14 runs (7 r/g)...since he was acquired by the Reds prior to the 2006 season leads all Major League pitchers with 105 starts and ranks third in the National League with 663.2 innings pitched.

2008 Season: Was the only member of the Reds' rotation to make every scheduled start...for the third straight season led the staff in starts (34) and for the second time in 3 years led the club in innings pitched (200.0)...for the fourth straight season recorded at least 32 starts and 200 innings...his 18 quality starts and career-high 15 wins were second on the

staff to All-Star Edinson Volquez' 17 victories and 20 quality apps...3 times was the victim of blown saves...tied for the National League lead in starts (34)...in his 34 starts the Reds went 18-16 and scored 172 runs (5.06 r/g)...was 1 of only 5 Reds pitchers to participate in more winning games than losing games (Jared Burton, Francisco Cordero, Edinson Volquez, David Weathers).

<u>Player of the Week</u>: For the period ending 8/31 of last season was voted **National League Co-Player of the Week** along with Wsh's **Cristian Guzman**...in 2 starts that week **Arroyo** went 2-0, 1.69 with 1 CG.

<u>Career Highlights</u>: In each of the previous 4 seasons recorded at least 32 starts and 200 innings...is 1 of only 8 Major League pitchers to record at least 200 innings in each of the previous 4 seasons (Mark Buehrle, Dan Haren, Roy Oswalt, Andy Pettitte, Johan Santana, Javier Vazquez, Brandon Webb)...in each of the previous 3 seasons led the Reds in starts

Arroyo vs Astros: Is making his 21st career appearance and 15th start vs Hou...in his most recent appearance vs the Astros, a 2-1 win on 8/26/08 at Minute Maid Park, threw a 5-hitter for his sixth career complete game...was the Reds' first CG of the 2008 season in their 132nd game.

and in 2 of the last 3 seasons led the staff in innings pitched...was National League Co-Player of the Week for 8/25-8/31, 2008...in 2006 was a National League All-Star, participated in Major League Baseball's All-Star tour of Japan in November and was voted by the Cincinnati chapter of the Baseball Writers' Association of America the winner of both the Johnny Vander Meer Award as the club's Most Outstanding Pitcher and the Joe Nuxhall Good Guy Award.

Last Pitched: Wed at Mil, in his Reds pitching debut suffered the 9-3 loss (5+ip, 5h, 4er, 2bb, 2k, 2hr, 89 pitches, 47 strikes)...left with the score tied, 3-3, but was charged with another run scored off Burton...the Brewers added 4 more runs off Burton in that 5-run sixth inning...Owings allowed Fielder's sac fly in the first and leadoff HR to Cameron in both the second and fourth frames.

Red Hots: Tomorrow at Chi will make his second start of the season...prior to his pitching debut made 2 pinch-hit apps (1-2, double, strikeout)...overall as a pinch-hitter is 2-for-3 (2 2b, 2rbi), including a 2-run double in the seventh inning of Sun's 4-2 win at Hou that snapped the 1-1 tie.

2008 Season: Began the season with the Diamondbacks and went 6-9, 5.93 in 18 starts and 4 relief apps before he was optioned to Class AAA Tucson on 7/29...made Ari's Opening Day roster...in his first 4 starts went 4-0, 2.42...produced 9 quality starts...was bothered late in the season by a sore right shoulder and made just 2 minor league starts...on 9/12 was acquired by the Reds to complete the 8/11 deal that sent OF Adam Dunn to the Diamondbacks...did not pitch for the Reds but in 4 pinch-hit apps produced 3rbi and 2 gamewinning hits...in the 3-2 win on 9/13 at Ari made his Reds debut in the 10th inning produced an RBI-double off Tony Pena that snapped the 2-2 tie...in the 4-3 win on 9/20 vs Mil produced a 2-run single off CC Sabathia that erased the 3-2 deficit.
