Road Warriors

At 5-2 the Redlegs have won the first 2 series on this road trip (2-1 at Mil, 3-1 at Hou)...haven't won 3 consecutive road series since they went 6-2 over 2 trips from **8/3-8/19**, **2007** (2-0 at Pit, 2-1 at Chi & 2-1 at Mil)...haven't won 3 series on the same road trip since **9/21-9/30**, **2004** (2-1 at Atl, 2-1 at Pit, 3-1 at Chi)...haven't won at least 6g on a single road trip since **5/29-6/7**, **2006** (7-2 overall, 1-2 at Chi, 3-0 at Hou, 3-0 at StL).

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is Game 1 of a 3-game series vs **Sinhue Mendoza's** Cubs and Game 8 (5-2) of the Reds' first and longest road trip of the season, an 11-day, 10-game jaunt that also includes visits to **Mil** (2-1) and **Hou** (3-1)...opened the season with a **2-3 homestand** vs the **Mets** (1-2) and **Pirates** (1-1, 1ppd)...following this series the Redlegs return to Great American Ball Park for a 6-game homestand vs the **Braves** (3g) and **Astros** (3g) that begins Friday.

BRUCE UPDATE: **Jay Bruce** was scratched from Sat's starting lineup with a sore right hand, which has been swollen since he was hit by a **Yovani Gallardo** pitch on 4/13 at Mil...x-rays and an MRI showed no signs of a fracture...he did not start in either of the last 3g but pinch ran Sun at Hou...he is expected to be in tonight's starting lineup.

<u>CENTRAL CASTING</u>: Tonight's game is Game 10 (6-3) in a stretch of **12 straight games**, **18-21g** and **23-28g** against **National League Central** opponents (1-1 vs Pit, 2-1 at Mil, 3-1 at Hou, **3g at Chi**, *3g vs Atl*, 3g vs Hou, 3g at Pit, *2g at Fla*, 2g vs Mil, 3g vs StL).

<u>DOT, DOT, DOT...</u>: Since a 1-3 start the Reds have won 6 of their last 8g...in the last 2g of the series at Hou, 4-2 and 4-3 Reds wins, **Reds pitchers** held Astros batters hitless in 16ab with RISP and stranded 19 baserunners...**SS Alex Gonzalez** is 4 hits shy of **1,000**...**RHP Aaron Harang** is 2 strikeouts shy of **1,000**...**Reds batters** haven't homered in 3g, their longest power drought of the young season...pitcher **Micah Owings** leads Reds pinch hitters with 2rbi and is tied for the team lead with 2 pinch hits, both doubles...**1B Joey Votto**, **2B Brandon Phillips** and **3B Edwin Encarnacion** have played every inning of every game.

<u>.500</u>: At **7-5** the Reds are a season-high 2g over .500...last season were a season-best 2g over .500 at **4-2** and **6-4**... haven't been more than 2g over .500 since they were a season-high 3g over at **4-1** in **2007** and haven't been more than 2g over .500 *this late in a season* since they were 3g over .500 at **67-64 in 2006**.

PLAYING FROM BEHIND: The Reds have trailed in 10 of their 12g this season but won 5 of the 10g in which they trailed...5 times allowed runs in the first inning...last season the Reds went **26-69** when the opponent scored first and **48-19** when they scored first.

ABOUT THE NEW GUY: On Thursday the Reds acquired from the Astros IF Drew Sutton to complete the spring training deal that sent IF Jeff Keppinger to Hou for a player to be named later...Sutton, 25, will report to Class AAA Louisville...last season Sutton was Class AA Corpus Christi's Most Valuable Player after hitting .317 with 20hr and 69rbi...he was a Texas League mid-season and post-season All-Star and led all Astros minor leaguers in batting average, hits (165), runs (102), walks (76), doubles (39) and extra-base hits (63)...prior to the 2009 season he was rated the Astros' eighth-best prospect by Baseball America.

CIVIL RIGHTS GAME: At Great American Ball Park on Sat, 6/20 the Reds and Chicago White Sox will meet in the Civil Rights Game, the first time the contest will be played during the regular season...the weekend's festivities will include a roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's Harriet Tubman Theater (Fri, 6/19, 4:00 p.m.), a luncheon at Duke Energy Center honoring the 3 winners of Major League Baseball's Beacon Awards (Sat, 6/20, 11:30 a.m.) and a Youth Summit at Fountain Square downtown (Sat, 6/20, 4:00 p.m.)...the luncheon on Sat, 6/20 will honor Beacon of Hope winner Bill Cosby, Beacon of Life winner Hank Aaron and Beacon of Change winner Muhammad Ali...for more information, log on to www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame.

<u>VOTE NOW</u>: Through 4/30, fans can vote online at <u>reds.com</u> to decide which **Reds pitcher** will have a 2009 bobblehead...the **Fans Choice Bobblehead** will be given to the first 30,000 fans on **Sat, 7/18 vs Mil** and is part of a collectible set of 4 bobbleheads that also features **Joey Votto** (Sat, 5/9 StL), **Jay Bruce** (Sat, 7/4 vs StL) and **Brandon Phillips** (Sat, 8/15 vs Wsh).

Komen for the Cure are looking for honorary bat girls for games scheduled for Sun, 5/10...the Reds and Cardinals will play at 1:10 p.m. that day at Great American Ball Park...MLB.com is hosting a contest in which fans can share stories of "going to bat" against breast cancer in their daily lives...the initiative is aimed to raise additional awareness and support for the annual Going to Bat Against Breast Cancer program, a joint partnership between MLB and Susan G. Komen for the Cure...fans can submit stories and vote for their favorites on www.mlb.com/honorarybatgirl...winners will be selected May 1.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (2-3, .400): Went 0-1-1 in their 2 home series...in 2008, at 43-38 the Reds established a new Great American Ball Park record for victories in a season...went 12-11-3 in their 26 home series...in 7 seasons at GABP are 243-248-1 (35-46 in 2003, 40-41 in 2004, 42-39-1 in 2005, 42-39 in 2006, 39-42 in 2007, 43-38 in 2008)...at 217-217-1 the Reds had evened their overall record at GABP for the first time since 6/26/04 (57-57)...also reached .500 at 219-219-1.

REDS ON THE ROAD (5-2, .714): Won their first 2 road series of the season (2-1 at Mil, 3-1 at Hou)...last year the Reds went 31-50 on the road and 8-16-2 in their 26 road series...in 2008 produced 3 winning road trips: from 6/20-6/29 went 5-4 at NYY/Tor/Cle, from 8/12-8/14 went 2-1 at Pit and from 9/8-9/14 went 4-2 at Mil/Ari...entering this season and dating back to 2006, the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips.

IN THE STANDINGS (15): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 0, SECOND - 0, THIRD - 6, FOURTH - 5, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...have spent 4 days above, 4 days at and 7 days below .500.

REDS vs CUBS: The Reds are 1,047-1,075 all-time vs the Cubs, including 979-1004 since 1900 and 7-8 in 2008...at Wrigley Field: Reds are 400-427 all-time, including 3-6 last season.

Last Pitched: Wed at Mil, in his Reds pitching debut suffered the 9-3 loss (5+ip, 5h, 4er, 2bb, 2k, 2hr, 89 pitches, 47 strikes)...left with the score tied, 3-3, but was charged with another run scored off Burton...the Brewers added 4 more runs off Burton in that 5-run sixth inning...Owings allowed Fielder's sacrifice fly in the first and leadoff HR to Cameron in both the second and fourth frames.

At The Plate: Prior to his pitching debut made 2 pinch-hit apps for the Reds this season (1-2, double, strikeout)...overall as a pinch-hitter is 2-for-3 (2 2b, 2rbi), including a 2-run double in the seventh inning of the 4-2 win on 4/19 at Hou that snapped the 1-1 tie...in his career has 3 game-winning RBI as a pinch hitter (2gwrbi in 2008, 1gwrbi in 2009)...over the last 5 seasons, the only other pitcher to produce a pinch-hit, game-winning RBI is Hou's Jason Jennings in the 14th inning of a 12-11 victory at Atl on 8/2/07 (RBI-single off Oscar Villarreal)...courtesy Elias Sports Bureau.

2008 Season: Began the season with the Diamondbacks and went 6-9, 5.93 in 18 starts and 4 relief apps before he was optioned to Class AAA Tucson on 7/29...made Ari's Opening Day roster...in his first 4 starts went 4-0, 2.42...produced 9 quality starts...was bothered late in the season by a sore right shoulder and made just 2 minor league starts...on 9/12 was acquired by the Reds to complete the 8/11 deal that sent OF Adam Dunn

<u>Owings vs Cubs</u>: Is making his fifth career appearance and his third career start vs Chi...in his 2 career starts vs Cubs is **0-1**, **4.50** (10ip, 5er).

to the Diamondbacks...did not pitch for the Reds but in 4 pinch-hit apps produced 3rbi and 2 game-winning hits...in the 3-2 win on 9/13 at Ari made his Reds debut in the 10th inning produced an RBI-double off Tony Pena that snapped the 2-2 tie...in the 4-3 win on 9/20 vs Mil produced a 2-run single off CC Sabathia that erased the 3-2 deficit.

At The Plate: Has 5 career home runs...in 2007 won the National League's Silver Slugger Award (.333, 4hr, 15rbi)...that season led all NL pitchers in HR and RBI... his 4 homers were the most by a pitcher in a single season since KC's Jim Rooker hit 4hr in 1969...last season, with Ari and Cin combined to hit .304 (1hr, 6rbi), including .294 as a pinch hitter (5-17, 1hr, 5rbi)...on 4/30 vs Hou tied the game with a pinch-hit, 2-run HR off Dave Borkowski...became the first pitcher to produce a pinch-hit HR since Mil's Brooks Kieschnick did it on 4/22/04 vs Ari.

<u>Career Highlights</u>: In 2006 was the Diamondback organization's Pitcher of the Year...as a senior at Gainesville (GA) High School was the Georgia Player of the Year and a *Baseball America* and *Collegiate Baseball* first-team All-America selection.

Tomorrow's Pitcher: RHP Johnny Cueto

Last Pitched: Fri at Hou, in his second start of the season received no decision in the dramatic 2-1 victory (4.1ip, 2h, 1er, 6bb, 3k, 88 pitches, 46 strikes)...left trailing, 1-0...allowed only 1 hit through 4.2 scoreless innings - an infield single by Tejada leading off the fourth - but with 2 outs in the fifth walked Oswalt and Bourn, allowed a single to Tejada and then walked Berkman to force in the game's first run...Lincoln then came in to induce Lee to ground out and end the inning...Cueto, Lincoln, Herrera, Masset and Cordero held Astros hitters to 4 singles...the Reds took the lead in the ninth on Hernandez' 1-out, 2-run HR off Valverde...with the no-decision, in 29 career apps vs the Reds Oswalt is 23-1, 2.39.

Red Hots: The 23-year-old righthander tomorrow will make his third start of the season and the 34th start of his career...in his 2 starts the Reds went 1-1 and scored 4 runs (2 r/g).

World Baseball Classic: Started the Dominican Republic's second game of the tournament and threw 4.2 scoreless innings to earn the 9-0 win vs Panama in the San Juan bracket (4.2ip, 3h, 1bb, 5k).

Rookie Season: In 2008 became the first Reds rookie to make 30 starts since **Tom Browning** in 1988 (38gs) and the first Reds rookie *righthander* to make 30 starts since **Gary Nolan** in 1967 (32gs).

Rookie Leader: In 2008 led all National League rookie pitchers in strikeouts (158) and ranked among the NL rookie leaders in ERA (8th), starts (31, T1st), wins (9, T2nd), innings pitched (174.0, 4th) and opponents' BA (.264, 6th)...averaged 8.2 strikeouts per 9 innings to rank eighth among all NL pitchers.
