Road Warriors

The Redlegs won the first 2 series on this road trip (2-1 at Mil, 3-1 at Hou)...haven't won 3 consecutive road series since they went 6-2 over 2 trips from 8/3-8/19, 2007 (2-0 at Pit, 2-1 at Chi, 2-1 at Mil)...haven't won 3 series on the same road trip since 9/21-9/30, 2004 (2-1 at Atl, 2-1 at Pit, 3-1 at Chi)...haven't won at least 6g on a single road trip since 5/29-6/7, 2006 (7-2 overall, 1-2 at Chi, 3-0 at Hou, 3-0 at StL).

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is Game 2 (0-1) of a 3-game series vs **Carl Rice's** Cubs and Game 9 (5-3) of the Reds' first and longest road trip of the season, an 11-day, 10-game jaunt that also includes visits to **Mil** (2-1) and **Hou** (3-1)...opened the season with a **2-3 homestand** vs the **Mets** (1-2) and **Pirates** (1-1, 1ppd)...beginning Friday the Redlegs return to Great American Ball Park for a 6-game homestand vs the **Braves** (3g) and **Astros** (3g).

<u>CENTRAL CASTING</u>: Tonight's game is Game 11 (6-4) in a stretch of **12 straight games**, **18-21g** and **23-28g** against **National League Central** opponents (1-1 vs Pit, 2-1 at Mil, 3-1 at Hou, **0-1 at Chi**, *3g vs Atl*, 3g vs Hou, 3g at Pit, *2g at Fla*, 2g vs Mil, 3g vs StL).

<u>DOT, DOT, DOT...</u>: Since a 1-3 start the Reds have won 6 of their last 9g...**SS** Alex Gonzalez is 3 hits shy of 1,000... RHP Aaron Harang is 2 strikeouts shy of 1,000...pitcher Micah Owings leads Reds pinch hitters with 2rbi and is tied with Darnell McDonald and Laynce Nix for the team lead with 2 pinch hits, both doubles...1B Joey Votto, 2B Brandon Phillips and 3B Edwin Encarnacion have played every inning of every game.

<u>.500</u>: At **7-5** the Reds were a season-high 2g over .500...last season were a season-best 2g over .500 at **4-2** and **6-4**... haven't been more than 2g over .500 since they were a season-high 3g over at **4-1** in **2007** and haven't been more than 2g over .500 *this late in a season* since they were 3g over .500 at **67-64** in **2006**.

<u>PLAYING FROM BEHIND</u>: The Reds have trailed in 11 of their 13g this season but won 5 of the 11g in which they trailed...5 times allowed runs in the first inning...last season the Reds went **26-69** when the opponent scored first and **48-19** when they scored first.

ABOUT THE NEW GUY: On Thursday the Reds acquired from the Astros IF Drew Sutton to complete the spring training deal that sent IF Jeff Keppinger to Hou for a player to be named later...Sutton, 25, will report to Class AAA Louisville...last season Sutton was Class AA Corpus Christi's Most Valuable Player after hitting .317 with 20hr and 69rbi...he was a Texas League mid-season and post-season All-Star and led all Astros minor leaguers in batting average, hits (165), runs (102), walks (76), doubles (39) and extra-base hits (63)...prior to the 2009 season he was rated the Astros' eighth-best prospect by Baseball America.

CIVIL RIGHTS GAME: At Great American Ball Park on Sat, 6/20 the Reds and Chicago White Sox will meet in the Civil Rights Game, the first time the contest will be played during the regular season...the weekend's festivities will include a roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's Harriet Tubman Theater (Fri, 6/19, 4:00 p.m.), a luncheon at Duke Energy Center honoring the 3 winners of Major League Baseball's Beacon Awards (Sat, 6/20, 11:30 a.m.) and a Youth Summit at Fountain Square downtown (Sat, 6/20, 4:00 p.m.)...the luncheon on Sat, 6/20 will honor Beacon of Hope winner Bill Cosby, Beacon of Life winner Hank Aaron and Beacon of Change winner Muhammad Ali...for more information, log on to www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame.

Komen for the Cure are looking for honorary bat girls for games scheduled for Sun, 5/10...the Reds and Cardinals will play at 1:10 p.m. that day at Great American Ball Park...MLB.com is hosting a contest in which fans can share stories of "going to bat" against breast cancer in their daily lives...the initiative is aimed to raise additional awareness and support for the annual Going to Bat Against Breast Cancer program, a joint partnership between MLB and Susan G. Komen for the Cure...fans can submit stories and vote for their favorites on www.mlb.com/honorarybatgirl...winners will be selected May 1.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (2-3, .400): Went 0-1-1 in their 2 home series...in 2008, at 43-38 the Reds established a new Great American Ball Park record for victories in a season...went 12-11-3 in their 26 home series...in 7 seasons at GABP are 243-248-1 (35-46 in 2003, 40-41 in 2004, 42-39-1 in 2005, 42-39 in 2006, 39-42 in 2007, 43-38 in 2008)...at 217-217-1 the Reds had evened their overall record at GABP for the first time since 6/26/04 (57-57)...also reached .500 at 219-219-1.

REDS ON THE ROAD (5-3, .625): Won their first 2 road series of the season (2-1 at Mil, 3-1 at Hou)...last year the Reds went 31-50 on the road and 8-16-2 in their 26 road series...in 2008 produced 3 winning road trips: from 6/20-6/29 went 5-4 at NYY/Tor/Cle, from 8/12-8/14 went 2-1 at Pit and from 9/8-9/14 went 4-2 at Mil/Ari...entering this season and dating back to 2006, the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips.

<u>IN THE STANDINGS (16)</u>: The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 0, SECOND - 0, THIRD - 6, FOURTH - 6, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...have spent 5 days above, 4 days at and 7 days below .500.

REDS vs CUBS: The Reds are 1,047-1,076 all-time vs the Cubs, including 979-1005 since 1900 and 0-1 this season... against the Cubs in September/October, the Reds are 21-19 over the last 7 seasons and 35-33 over the last 12 years... at Great American Ball Park: Reds are 24-24, including 4-2 in 2008 and 8-7 the last 2 seasons...Aramis Ramirez and Derrek Lee rank in the Top 5 in home runs by an opponent at GABP (Lance Berkman 19, Jason Bay 14, Albert Pujols 13, Ramirez 12, Lee 12)...Carlos Zambrano's 7 wins here tie Hou's Roy Oswalt for the most by an opposing pitcher...at Wrigley Field: Reds are 400-428 all-time, including 0-1 this season and 3-7 the last 2 seasons...last Reds sweep: at Cin: 4/25-4/26, 1994 (2g); 9/24-9/26, 2002 (3g); 4/8-4/11, 1983 (4g)...at Chi: 5/14-5/15, 1966 (2g); 8/8-8/10, 2005 (3g); 8/16-8/18, 1968 (4g)...last Cubs sweep: at Cin: 4/26-4/27, 1995 (2g); 5/28-5/30, 2001 (3g)...at Chi: 7/21-7/22, 2004 (2g); 5/22-5/24, 2001 (3g).

Last Pitched: Fri at Hou, in his second start of the season received no decision in the dramatic 2-1 victory (4.1ip, 2h, 1er, 6bb, 3k, 88 pitches, 46 strikes)...left trailing, 1-0...allowed only 1 hit through 4.2 scoreless innings - an infield single by Tejada leading off the fourth - but with 2 outs in the fifth walked Oswalt and Bourn, allowed a single to Tejada and then walked Berkman to force in the game's first run...Lincoln then came in to induce Lee to ground out and end the inning...Cueto, Lincoln, Herrera, Masset and Cordero held Astros hitters to 4 singles...the Reds took the lead in the ninth on Hernandez' 1-out, 2-run HR off Valverde...with the no-decision, in 29 career apps vs the Reds Oswalt is 23-1, 2.39.

Red Hots: The 23-year-old righthander is making his third start of the season and the 34th start of his career...in his 2 starts the Reds went 1-1 and scored 4 runs (2 r/g).

World Baseball Classic: Started the Dominican Republic's second game of the tournament and threw 4.2 scoreless innings to earn the 9-0 victory vs Panama in the San Juan bracket (4.2ip, 3h, 1bb, 5k).

Rookie Season: In 2008 became the first Reds rookie to make 30 starts since **Tom Browning** in 1988 (38gs) and the first Reds rookie *righthander* to make 30 starts since **Gary Nolan** in 1967 (32gs).

<u>Cueto vs Cubs</u>: Is making his fifth career appearance and his first appearance of the season vs Chi...in his last 3 starts vs Chi is 0-3, 4.74 (19ip, 10er).

Rookie Leader: In 2008 led all National League rookie pitchers in strikeouts (158) and ranked among the NL rookie leaders in ERA (8th), starts (31, T1st), wins (9, T2nd), innings pitched (174.0, 4th) and opponents' BA (.264, 6th)...averaged 8.2 strikeouts per 9 innings to rank eighth among all NL pitchers.

Major League Debut: On 4/3/08 vs Ari made his Major League debut at 22 years, 48 days old and earned the 3-2 victory (7ip, 1h, 1er, 0bb, 10k, Upton HR, 92 pitches, 68 strikes)...became the first pitcher in modern Major League history to debut with 10 strikeouts and 0 walks, the first Reds pitcher since 1900 to record 10 strikeouts in his ML debut and only the third pitcher to win his ML debut while allowing 1 hit and recording at least 10 strikeouts (Steve Woodard 1997, Juan Marichal 1960)...retired his first 15 batters and allowed only 1 baserunner overall, Justin Upton homered leading off the sixth.

Control Freak: According to Elias Sports Bureau, in 2008 became the only pitcher since 1900 to record as many as 18 strikeouts without a walk in his first 2 career starts...threw 16.0 innings and recorded 22 strikeouts before issuing his first career walk, to Pit's Nate McLouth on 4/13/08 in his third start.

<u>Cueto's Most Recent Starts</u>: 4/11 vs Pit, in his season debut suffered the 10-2 loss (6ip, 8h, 4er, 1bb, 9k, 1hr, 109 pitches, 67 strikes)...left trailing, 4-0...allowed McLouth's 2-run HR in the first inning...in the fourth allowed Wilson's RBI-double and Morgan's RBI-triple.

Tomorrow's Pitcher: RHP Aaron Harang

Last Started: Sat at Hou and suffered the 7-0 loss (6+ip, 10h, 5er, 1bb, 6k, 93 pitches, 62 strikes)...left trailing, 3-0, but was charged with 2 more runs scored off Burton...while on the mound allowed all 3 runs with 2 outs...in the first inning allowed 2 runs on 4 hits, including consecutive RBI-singles to Pence and Blum...in the fifth allowed Lee's RBI-double...Reds batters produced 2 singles off Rodriguez (7ip, 10k), Sampson and Fulchino.

Red Hots: Tomorrow will make his fourth start of the season and his seventh career start vs Zambrano...in his previous 3 starts the Reds went 1-2 and scored 3 runs (1 r/g)...is approaching 1,000 career strikeouts (998)...in his 3 previous starts Reds batters hit .146 (12-82)...his complete game in the club's fifth game, a 2-0 win on 4/12 vs Pit, was the quickest by a Reds pitcher since Pete Harnisch threw a CG in the Reds' fourth game of 1999.

Opening Day: In the 2-1 loss vs the Mets made his fourth straight Opening Day start, the first Reds pitcher to do so since RHP Jose Rijo had the honors in 4 straight seasons from 1992-95...the only other Reds pitchers to make at least 4 consecutive Opening Day starts are Pete Donohue (5 straight, 1923-27) and Mario Soto (5, 1982-86)...Soto holds the club record for overall Opening Day starts (6)...in 4 career Opening Day starts Harang is 1-3, 3.52.

Staff Ace: In 2008 received the Joe Nuxhall Good Guy Award from the local chapter of the Baseball Writers' Association of America... in 2005 and 2007 won the BBWAA's Johnny Vander Meer Award as the club's Most Outstanding Pitcher...since he was acquired from the Athletics at the 2003 trading deadline is the Reds' leader in most statistical pitching categories, including starts (170), wins (64), innings pitched (1089.0) and strikeouts (918).

Harang's Most Recent Starts: 4/6 vs NYM, in his fourth straight Opening Day start suffered the 2-1 loss (5ip, 7h, 1er, 3bb, 2k, 1hr, 114 pitches)...left trailing, 1-0...allowed only a solo HR to Daniel Murphy in the fifth...4/12 vs Pit and threw a 3-hitter in the 2-0 victory (0bb, 9k, 1hbp, 108 pitches, 80 strikes)...was his 12th career complete game and sixth career shutout...allowed only a leadoff double to Morgan and singles to Moss and Morgan.
