### UMPS Care

Today the Reds and the umpiring crew are hosting the first of 3 groups in conjunction with **UMPS CARE Charities**...the umpires provide game tickets and give behind-the-scenes tours to local children who are waiting for adoption...the group also gives to each child a Reds cap, Cracker Jack, peanuts, Big League Chew gum and a \$10 gift card...the local partners for the program are **Hamilton County Job and Family Services** and the **Dave Thomas Foundation for Adoption**...the remaining **UMPS Care** dates are **6/7 vs Chi** and **8/2 vs Col**.

**TODAY'S GAME:** Is **Game 3** (0-2) of a 3-game series vs **Adam Liberman's** Braves and **Game 3** (0-2) of a 6-game homestand vs the **Braves** (0-2) and **Astros** (3g)...the Reds are coming off their longest road trip of the season, an 11-day, **7-3 road jaunt** to **Mil** (2-1), **Hou** (3-1) and **Chi** (2-1).

**CENTRAL CASTING:** Today's game is Game 15 in a stretch of **18-21g** and **23-28g** against **National League Central** opponents (8-6 overall, **8-4 vs NL Central**, 1-1 vs Pit, 2-1 at Mil, 3-1 at Hou, 2-1 at Chi, **0-2 vs Atl**, 3g vs Hou, 3g at Pit, **2g at Fla**, 2g vs Mil, 3g vs StL).

**DOT, DOT, DOT...** The Reds haven't lost 3 straight games all season...since a 1-3 start the Reds have won 8 of their last 13g...regardless of today's outcome will have gone **3-2-1** in their first 6 series...pitcher **Micah Owings** leads Reds pinch hitters with 2rbi and is tied with **Darnell McDonald** and **Laynce Nix** for the team lead with 2 pinch hits, both doubles...**1B Joey Votto**, **2B Brandon Phillips** and **3B Edwin Encarnacion** have played every inning of every game...**RF Jay Bruce** missed 3 starts earlier this week with a bruised right hand but in 5 apps since then is 7-for-19 (.368) with 2 homers and 4rbi.

**IN THE COMMUNITY:** At 1:00 p.m. tomorrow, Reds pitchers **Mike Lincoln**, **Nick Masset** and **Dave Weathers** will join 30 **Elder** and **Seton** high school students from the **Cincinnati Action Team** youth volunteer program in a landscaping project on the grounds at **Antioch Manor** (3710 Westmont Drive, Cincinnati)...the youth volunteer program is administered by **Volunteers of America** and the **Major League Baseball Players Trust**...**Antioch Manor** houses low-income adults with physical disabilities.

**HEALTHY RECIPES:** The Reds haven't made a roster move since final cuts the day before Opening Day...today is the 21st day of the season...last year the club made its first 25-man roster move on 4/20, the 21st day of the season, when **RHP David Weathers** went on the disabled list...haven't gone more than 20 days to start a season without a roster move since **1985**, when on the 37th day (5/14) the Reds recalled **Alan Knicely** and **Ron Robinson** and optioned to Class AAA Denver **Dann Bilardello** and **Carl Willis**...in 2009, the Reds began a season without a player on the disabled list for the first time since **1990**.

**IT STARTS WITH PITCHING:** In the last 7g **Reds pitchers** posted a 3.34era (62ip, 23er), lowering the staff's overall ERA from 5.11 to 4.38...in the last 7g **Reds starters** went 4-3, 3.82 (42.1ip, 18er)...in the last 9g **Reds relievers** have posted a 2.42era (26ip, 7er).

**VETERAN LEADERSHIP:** LHP **Arthur Rhodes** and RHP **David Weathers**, both 39 years old, this season have combined for 14 apps and 13.1 scoreless innings...opponents are hitting .182 against them (8-44)...together they have made **1,624** Major League apps for 13 teams.

**.500:** At **9-6** the Reds were 3g over .500 this late in a season for the first time since they were 3g over at **67-64 in 2006**...haven't been 4g over .500 since they were **67-63 in 2006**...during that **2006 season** the Redlegs reached a season-high 12g over .500 at **36-24**.

**PLAYING FROM BEHIND:** The Reds have trailed in 13 of their 17g this season...6 times allowed runs in the first inning...last season the Reds went **26-69** when the opponent scored first and **48-19** when they scored first.

**VOTE NOW:** Through Thursday, fans can vote online at [reds.com](http://reds.com) to decide which **Reds pitcher** will have a 2009 bobblehead...the **Fans Choice Bobblehead** will be given to the first 30,000 fans on **Sat, 7/18 vs Mil** and is part of a collectible set of 4 bobbleheads that also features **Joey Votto** (Sat, 5/9 StL), **Jay Bruce** (Sat, 7/4 vs StL) and **Brandon Phillips** (Sat, 8/15 vs Wsh).

**REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (2-5, .286):** Regardless of today's outcome will have gone 0-2-1 in their first 3 home series (1-2 vs NYM, 1-1 vs Pit, 0-2 vs Atl)...in 2008, at **43-38** the Reds established a new Great American Ball Park record for victories in a season...went **12-11-3** in their 26 home series...in 7 seasons at GABP are **243-250-1** (35-46 in 2003, 40-41 in 2004, 42-39-1 in 2005, 42-39 in 2006, 39-42 in 2007, 43-38 in 2008).

**REDS ON THE ROAD (7-3, .700):** On their first road trip the Reds went 7-3 and won all 3 series (2-1 at Mil, 3-1 at Hou, 2-1 at Chi)...through that first trip Cin's 7 road wins were the most in the Major Leagues...entering this season and dating back to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

**IN THE STANDINGS (20):** The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 0, SECOND - 2, THIRD - 7, FOURTH - 7, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...have spent 9 days above, 4 days at and 7 days below .500.

**REDS vs BRAVES:** The Reds are 1,069-963 all-time vs the Braves franchise, including 0-2 this season...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 14-11, including 0-2 this season...entered this series with a 6-game winning streak here vs Atl...**last Braves sweep:** at Cin: 7/18-7/19, 2001 (2g); 9/15-9/17, 1995 (3g); 5/31-6/3, 1984 (5g)...at Atl: 9/9-9/10, 1992 (2g); 5/2-5/4, 2008 (3g).

**REDS vs ASTROS:** The Reds are 401-380-1 all-time vs the Astros, including 3-1 this season, 6-13 the last 2 seasons and 10-24 the last 3 seasons...the Reds' 4-2 win at Minute Maid Park on 4/19/09 was their 400th victory vs Hou...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 15-30-1, including 0-6 in 2008 and 1-14 the last 2 seasons...have dropped the last 9g vs Hou at GABP...Hou's .667 winning percentage at GABP (30-15) is the best among all opponents (LAD 2nd, 13-7, .650)...**Lance Berkman's** 19 homers at GABP are the most by any Reds opponent (**Jason Bay** 2nd, 14)...**Roy Oswalt's** 7 wins there tie Chi's **Carlos Zambrano** for the most by an opposing pitcher.

**Last Pitched:** Tue at Chi, in the Reds’ first game of the season at Wrigley Field and suffered the 7-2 loss (4.2ip, 5h, 5r, 2er, 4bb, 3k, 1hr, 94 pitches, 61 strikes)...left trailing, 4-2, but was charged with another run scored off Lincoln...in the second inning allowed a leadoff HR to Micah Hoffpauir...in the fifth was charged with 3 unearned runs...start of the game was delayed 12 minutes by weather...gametime temperature was 40 degrees with a 15 mile per hour wind blowing left to right.

**Red Hots:** Is making his third start of the season...in his 3 starts the Reds went 0-2 and scored 5 runs (2.5 r/g)...in 14 apps and 10 starts since a 9-3 win for the Diamondbacks on 5/25/08 at Atl is **0-9, 8.53** (51.2ip, 49er).

**Career At GABP:** Tonight is making his first start of the season and his second career appearance at **Great American Ball Park**...made his only other appearance here while pitching for the Diamondbacks, on 7/6/07 started and suffered the 8-1 loss (4.2ip, 6h, 6er, 3bb, 4k, 3hr)...in that game allowed home runs to **Adam Dunn** (2-run), **Brandon Phillips** (solo) and **Ken Griffey Jr.** (2-run)...was **Griffey’s** 586th career homer, tying him with **Frank Robinson** for sixth on the all-time list.

**At The Plate:** Prior to his pitching debut made 2 pinch-hit apps for the Reds this season (1-2, double, strikeout)...overall as a pinch-hitter is 2-for-3 (2 2b, 2rbi), including a 2-run double in the seventh inning of the 4-2 win on 4/19 at Hou that snapped the 1-1 tie...in his career has **3 game-winning RBI** as a pinch hitter (2gwrbi in 2008, 1gwrbi in 2009)...over the last 5 seasons, the only other *pitcher* to produce a pinch-hit, game-winning RBI is Hou’s **Jason Jennings** in the 14th inning of a 12-11 victory at Atl on 8/2/07 (RBI-single off Oscar Villarreal)...courtesy Elias Sports Bureau.

**2008 Season:** Began the season with the Diamondbacks and went 6-9, 5.93 in 18 starts and 4 relief apps before he was optioned to Class AAA Tucson on 7/29...made Ari’s Opening Day roster...in his first 4 starts went 4-0, 2.42...produced 9 quality starts...was bothered late in the season by a sore right shoulder and made just 2 minor league starts...on 9/12 was acquired by the Reds to complete the 8/11 deal that sent OF Adam Dunn to the Diamondbacks...did not pitch for the Reds but in 4 pinch-hit apps produced 3rbi and 2 game-winning hits...in the 3-2 win on 9/13 at Ari made his Reds debut in the 10th inning produced an RBI-double off Tony Pena that snapped the 2-2 tie...in the 4-3 win on 9/20 vs Mil produced a 2-run single off CC Sabathia that erased the 3-2 deficit.

**Silver Slugger:** Has 5 career home runs...in 2007 won the National League’s Silver Slugger Award (.333, 4hr, 15rbi)...that season led all NL pitchers in HR and RBI...his 4 homers were the most by a pitcher in a single season since KC’s Jim Rooker hit 4hr in 1969...last season, with Ari and Cin combined to hit .304 (1hr, 6rbi), including .294 as a pinch hitter (5-17, 1hr, 5rbi)...on 4/30 vs Hou tied the game with a pinch-hit, 2-run HR off Dave Borkowski...became the first pitcher to produce a pinch-hit HR since Mil’s Brooks Kieschnick did it on 4/22/04 vs Ari.

**2009 Highs:** **Innings:** 5+, 4/15 at Mil; **Hits:** 5 (2x), 4/15 at Mil & 4/21 at Chi; **Runs:** 5, 4/21 at Chi; **Earned Runs:** 4, 4/15 at Mil; **Walks:** 4, 4/21 at Chi; **Strikeouts:** 3, 4/21 at Hou; **HR allowed:** 2, 4/15 at Mil (Cameron, 2 solo).

**Career Highs:** **Innings :** 9.0 (2x), 5/24/07 vs Hou & 9/18/07 vs SF; **Hits:** 10, vs 5/2/08 vs NYM; **Runs:** 8, 7/28/08 at SD; **Earned Runs:** 8, 7/28/08 at SD; **Walks:** 5, 7/9/08 at Wsh; **Strikeouts:** 10, 5/20/08 at Fla; **HR allowed:** 4, 9/3/07 vs SD.

**Owings’ Most Recent Starts:** **4/15 at Mil**, in his Reds pitching debut suffered the 9-3 loss (5+ip, 5h, 4er, 2bb, 2k, 2hr, 89 pitches, 47 strikes)...left with the score tied, 3-3, but was charged with another run scored off Burton...the Brewers added 4 more runs off Burton in that 5-run sixth inning...Owings allowed Fielder’s sac fly in the first and leadoff HR to Cameron in both the second and fourth frames.

**Owings vs Braves:** Is making his third career appearance vs Atl and his first vs the Braves for the Reds.

Tomorrow vs Astros: RHP Johnny Cueto

**Last Pitched:** Wed at Chi, in one of the best starts of his career threw 7.0 shutout innings to earn the 3-0 victory (4h, 0bb, 3k, 108 pitches, 68 strikes)...left leading, 1-0...the Reds added insurance runs in the eighth and ninth innings...singled twice off Lilly, his first career 2-hit game.

**Red Hots:** Tomorrow vs Hou, the 23-year-old righthander will make his fourth start of the season and the 35th start of his career...in his last 2 starts is 1-0, 0.77 (11.2ip, 1er)...in his 3 starts the Reds went 2-1 and scored 7 runs (2.3 r/g)...produced 1 quality start.

**World Baseball Classic:** Started the Dominican Republic’s second game of the tournament and threw 4.2 scoreless innings to earn the 9-0 win vs Panama in the San Juan bracket (4.2ip, 3h, 1bb, 5k).

**Rookie Season:** In 2008 became the first Reds rookie to make 30 starts since **Tom Browning** in 1988 (38gs) and the first Reds rookie *righthander* to make 30 starts since **Gary Nolan** in 1967 (32gs).

**Rookie Leader:** In 2008 led all National League rookie pitchers in strikeouts (158) and ranked among the NL rookie leaders in ERA (8th), starts (31, T1st), wins (9, T2nd), innings pitched (174.0, 4th) and opponents’ BA (.264, 6th)...averaged 8.2 strikeouts per 9 innings to rank eighth among all NL pitchers.

**Cueto’s Most Recent Starts:** **4/11 vs Pit**, in his season debut suffered the 10-2 loss (6ip, 8h, 4er, 1bb, 9k, 1hr, 109 pitches, 67 strikes)...left trailing, 4-0...allowed McLouth’s 2-run HR in the first inning...in the fourth allowed Wilson’s RBI-double and Morgan’s RBI-triple.

**Cueto vs Astros:** Tomorrow will make his second appearance of the season vs Hou...in his first start, a 2-1 victory on 4/19 at Minute Maid Park, received no decision in his second appearance of the season...left trailing, 1-0...allowed only 1 hit through 4.2 scoreless innings - an infield single by Tejada leading off the fourth - but with 2 outs in the fifth walked Oswalt and Bourn, allowed a single to Tejada and then walked Berkman to force in the game’s first run...Lincoln then came in to induce Lee to ground out and end the inning...Cueto, Lincoln, Herrera, Masset and Cordero held Astros hitters to 4 singles...the Reds took the lead in the ninth on Hernandez’ 1-out, 2-run HR off Valverde...including the no-decision, in 29 career apps vs the Reds Oswalt is 23-1, 2.39.
