Class AAA Louisville **RHP Homer Bailey** was named the International League's **Pitcher of the Week**...in 2 starts last week **Bailey** went 2-0, 2.92 with 18 strikeouts in 12.1 innings (10h, 6bb), including a 3-2 win at Columbus and yesterday's 10-3 victory at Toledo...in yesterday's start, over 6.1 innings he struck out a career-high 15 batters to tie the Louisville single-game record...between the third and sixth innings he retired 9 consecutive batters by strikeout.

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** Is **Game 1** of a 3-game series vs **Sally Gunter's** Astros and **Game 4** (1-2) of a 6-game homestand that also included the **Braves** (1-2)...on Thu's off day the Reds will travel to **Pit**, where the next night they will begin a 5-game road trip that includes a 3-game series vs the **Pirates** and a brief 2-game series at **Fla**.

**VOTE REDS!** Fan voting for the **2009 All-Star Game** in St. Louis kicks off in Great American Ball Park tonight and will continue through **6/20**...in addition to paper ballots, fans can vote online using **laptop computers** set up near **Section 114** on Terrace Level...one online voter per game will be selected randomly to receive a **Kroger gift card**...Reds players on the ballot include **C Ramon Hernandez**, **1B Joey Votto**, **2B Brandon Phillips**, **SS Alex Gonzalez**, **3B Edwin Encarnacion**, **OF Chris Dickerson**, **OF Willy Taveras** and **OF Jay Bruce**.

**IN THE COMMUNITY:** This afternoon, Reds pitchers **Mike Lincoln**, **Nick Masset** and **Dave Weathers** joined 30 **Elder** and **Seton** high school students from the **Cincinnati Action Team** youth volunteer program in a landscaping project on the grounds at **Antioch Manor** (3710 Westmont Drive, Cincinnati)...the youth volunteer program is administered by **Volunteers of America** and the **Major League Baseball Players Trust**...**Antioch Manor** houses low-income adults with physical disabilities.

**CENTRAL CASTING:** Tonight's game is Game 16 in a stretch of **18-21g** and **23-28g** against **National League Central** opponents (9-6 overall, **8-4 vs NL Central**, 1-1 vs Pit, 2-1 at Mil, 3-1 at Hou, 2-1 at Chi, 1-2 vs *Atl*, 3g vs Hou, 3g at Pit, 2g at *Fla*, 2g vs Mil, 3g vs StL).

**DOT, DOT, DOT...** Since a 1-3 start the Reds have won 9 of their last 14g...the Reds went **3-2-1** in their first 6 series...pitcher **Micah Owings** leads Reds pinch hitters with 2rbi and is tied with **Darnell McDonald** and **Laynece Nix** for the team lead with 2 pinch hits, both doubles...**1B Joey Votto**, **2B Brandon Phillips** and **3B Edwin Encarnacion** have played every inning of every game...**RF Jay Bruce** missed 3 starts earlier this week with a bruised right hand but in 6 apps since then is 10-for-22 (.455) with 4 homers and 8rbi...**Bruce's** active 6-game hitting streak (10-22, .455, 4hr, 8rbi) ties **Votto** for the longest by a Reds batter this season.

**HEALTHY RECIPES:** The Reds haven't made a roster move since final cuts the day before Opening Day...today is the 22nd day of the season...haven't gone more than 21 days to start a season without a roster move since **1985**, when on the 37th day (5/14) the Reds recalled **Alan Knicely** and **Ron Robinson** and optioned to Class AAA Denver **Dann Bilardello** and **Carl Willis**...in 2009, Cin began a season without a player on the DL for the first time since **1990**.

**IT STARTS WITH PITCHING:** In the last 8g **Reds pitchers** posted a 3.16era (71ip, 25er), lowering the staff's overall ERA from 5.11 to 4.25...in the last 8g **Reds starters** went 5-3, 3.46 (49.1ip, 19er)...in the last 10g **Reds relievers** have posted a 2.57era (28ip, 8er).

**VETERAN LEADERSHIP:** LHP **Arthur Rhodes** and RHP **David Weathers**, both 39 years old, this season have combined for 14 apps and 13.1 scoreless innings...opponents are hitting .182 against them (8-44)...together they have made **1,624** Major League apps for 13 teams...33-year-old **RHP Francisco Cordero** has converted all 6 save opps while posting a 1.29era in his 7 apps.

**.500:** At **9-6** the Reds were 3g over .500 this late in a season for the first time since they were 3g over at **67-64 in 2006**...haven't been 4g over .500 since they were **67-63 in 2006**...during that **2006 season** the Redlegs reached a season-high 12g over .500 at **36-24**.

**PLAYING FROM BEHIND:** The Reds have trailed in 13 of their 18g this season...6 times allowed runs in the first inning...last season the Reds went **26-69** when the opponent scored first and **48-19** when they scored first.

**VOTE NOW:** Through Thursday, fans can vote online at [reds.com](http://reds.com) to decide which **Reds pitcher** will have a 2009 bobblehead...the **Fans Choice Bobblehead** will be given to the first 30,000 fans on **Sat, 7/18 vs Mil** and is part of a collectible set of 4 bobbleheads that also features **Joey Votto** (Sat, 5/9 StL), **Jay Bruce** (Sat, 7/4 vs StL) and **Brandon Phillips** (Sat, 8/15 vs Wsh).

**REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (3-5, .375):** Went gone 0-2-1 in their first 3 home series (1-2 vs NYM, 1-1 vs Pit, 1-2 vs Atl)...in 2008, at **43-38** the Reds established a new Great American Ball Park record for victories in a season and went **12-11-3** in their 26 home series...in 7 seasons at GABP are **244-250-1** (35-46 in 2003, 40-41 in 2004, 42-39-1 in 2005, 42-39 in 2006, 39-42 in 2007, 43-38 in 2008)...at **217-217-1** the Reds had evened their overall record at GABP for the first time since **6/26/04** (57-57)...also reached .500 at **219-219-1**.

**REDS ON THE ROAD (7-3, .700):** On their first road trip the Reds went 7-3 and won all 3 series (2-1 at Mil, 3-1 at Hou, 2-1 at Chi)...through that first trip Cin's 7 road wins were the most in the Major Leagues...entering this season and dating back to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

**IN THE STANDINGS (21):** The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 0, SECOND - 2, THIRD - 8, FOURTH - 7, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...have spent **10** days above, **4** days at and **7** days below .500.

**REDS vs ASTROS:** The Reds are 401-380-1 all-time vs the Astros, including 3-1 this season, 6-13 the last 2 seasons and 10-24 the last 3 seasons...the Reds' 4-2 win at Minute Maid Park on 4/19/09 was their 400th victory vs Hou...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 15-30-1, including 0-6 in 2008 and 1-14 the last 2 seasons...have dropped the last 9g vs Hou at GABP...Hou's .667 winning percentage at GABP (30-15) is the best among all opponents (LAD 2nd, 13-7, .650)...**Lance Berkman's** 19 homers at GABP are the most by any Reds opponent (**Jason Bay** 2nd, 14)...**Roy Oswalt's** 7 wins there tie Chi's **Carlos Zambrano** for the most by an opposing pitcher.

**Last Pitched:** Wed at Chi, in one of the best starts of his career threw 7.0 shutout innings to earn the 3-0 victory (4h, 0bb, 3k, 108 pitches, 68 strikes)...left leading, 1-0...the Reds added insurance runs in the eighth and ninth innings...singled twice off Lilly, his first career 2-hit game.

**Red Hots:** The 23-year-old righthander is making his fourth start of the season and the 35th start of his career...in his last 2 starts is 1-0, 0.77 (11.2ip, 1er)...in his 3 starts the Reds went 2-1 and scored 7 runs (2.3 r/g)...produced 1 quality start.

**World Baseball Classic:** Started the Dominican Republic's second game of the tournament and threw 4.2 scoreless innings to earn the 9-0 victory vs Panama in the San Juan bracket (4.2ip, 3h, 1bb, 5k).

**Rookie Season:** In 2008 became the first Reds rookie to make 30 starts since **Tom Browning** in 1988 (38gs) and the first Reds rookie *righthander* to make 30 starts since **Gary Nolan** in 1967 (32gs).

**Rookie Leader:** In 2008 led all National League rookie pitchers in strikeouts (158) and ranked among the NL rookie leaders in ERA (8th), starts (31, T1st), wins (9, T2nd), innings pitched (174.0, 4th) and opponents' BA (.264, 6th)...averaged 8.2 strikeouts per 9 innings to rank eighth among all NL pitchers.

**Major League Debut:** On 4/3/08 vs Ari made his Major League debut at 22 years, 48 days old and earned the 3-2 victory (7ip, 1h, 1er, 0bb, 10k, Upton HR, 92 pitches, 68 strikes)...became the first pitcher in modern Major League history to debut with 10 strikeouts and 0 walks, the first Reds pitcher since 1900 to record 10 strikeouts in his ML debut and only the third pitcher to win his ML debut while allowing 1 hit and recording at least 10 strikeouts (Steve Woodard 1997, Juan Marichal 1960)...retired his first 15 batters and allowed only 1 baserunner overall, Justin Upton homered leading off the sixth.

**Control Freak:** According to Elias Sports Bureau, in 2008 became the only pitcher since 1900 to record as many as 18 strikeouts without a walk in his first 2 career starts...threw 16.0 innings and recorded 22 strikeouts before issuing his first career walk, to Pit's Nate McLouth on 4/13/08 in his third start.

**Cueto's Most Recent Starts:** **4/11 vs Pit**, in his season debut suffered the 10-2 loss (6ip, 8h, 4er, 1bb, 9k, 1hr, 109 pitches, 67 strikes)...left trailing, 4-0...allowed McLouth's 2-run HR in the first inning...in the fourth allowed Wilson's RBI-double and Morgan's RBI-triple.

**Cueto vs Astros:** Is making his second appearance of the season vs Hou...in his first start, a 2-1 victory on 4/19 at Minute Maid Park, received no decision in his second appearance of the season...left trailing, 1-0...allowed only 1 hit through 4.2 scoreless innings - an infield single by Tejada leading off the fourth - but with 2 outs in the fifth walked Oswalt and Bourn, allowed a single to Tejada and then walked Berkman to force in the game's first run...Lincoln then came in to induce Lee to ground out and end the inning...Cueto, Lincoln, Herrera, Masset and Cordero held Astros hitters to 4 singles...the Reds took the lead in the ninth on Hernandez' 1-out, 2-run HR off Valverde...including the no-decision, in 29 career apps vs the Reds Oswalt is 23-1, 2.39.

Tomorrow's Pitcher: RHP Aaron Harang

**Last Started:** Thu at Chi and earned the 7-1 victory (7+ip, 7h, 1r, 0er, 1bb, 2k, 105 pitches, 66 strikes)...left leading, 4-1...allowed only an unearned run in the sixth inning...in the sixth inning recorded his 1,000th career strikeout (Derrek Lee).

**Red Hots:** Tomorrow will make his fifth start of the season...in his previous 4 starts the Reds went 2-2 and scored 10 runs (2.5 r/g)...in his first 3 starts **Reds batters** hit .146 (12-82)...in Thu's start at Wrigley Field **Reds batters** went 13-for-38 (.342)...his complete game in the club's fifth game, a 2-0 win on 4/12 vs Pit, was the quickest by a Reds pitcher since **Pete Harnisch** threw a CG in the Reds' fourth game of **1999**.

**Astronomical:** In his third start of the season, a 7-0 loss at Hou on 4/18, allowed 5 earned runs in 6+ innings...in his other 3 starts is **2-1, 0.43** (21ip, 1er).

**Opening Day:** In the 2-1 loss vs the Mets made his fourth straight Opening Day start, the first Reds pitcher to do so since **RHP Jose Rijo** had the honors in 4 straight seasons from 1992-95...the only other Reds pitchers to make at least 4 consecutive Opening Day starts are **Pete Donohue** (5 straight, 1923-27) and **Mario Soto** (5, 1982-86)...**Soto** holds the club record for overall Opening Day starts (6)...in 4 career Opening Day starts Harang is 1-3, 3.52 (23ip, 9er).

**Staff Ace:** In 2008 received the Joe Nuxhall Good Guy Award from the local chapter of the Baseball Writers' Association of America...in 2005 and 2007 won the BBWAA's Johnny Vander Meer Award as the club's Most Outstanding Pitcher...since he was acquired from the Athletics at the 2003 trading deadline is the Reds' leader in most statistical pitching categories, including starts (171), wins (65), innings pitched (1096.0) and strikeouts (920).
