TONIGHT'S GAME: Is **Game 2** (0-1) of a 3-game series vs **Sally Gunter's** Astros and **Game 5** (1-3) of a 6-game homestand that also included the **Braves** (1-2)...on Thu's off day the Reds will travel to **Pit**, where the next night they will begin a 5-game road trip that includes a 3-game series vs the **Pirates** and a brief 2-game series at **Fla**.

CENTRAL CASTING: Tonight's game is Game 17 in a stretch of **18-21g** and **23-28g** against **National League Central** opponents (9-7 overall, **8-5 vs NL Central**, 1-1 vs Pit, 2-1 at Mil, 3-1 at Hou, 2-1 at Chi, 1-2 vs Atl, **0-1 vs Hou**, 3g at Pit, 2g at Fla, 2g vs Mil, 3g vs StL).

DOT, DOT, DOT...: The Astros have won 10 straight games vs the Reds at Great American Ball Park...**1B Joey Votto**, **2B Brandon Phillips** and **3B Edwin Encarnacion** have played every inning of every game...**RF Jay Bruce** missed 3 starts last week with a bruised right hand but in 7 apps since then is 10-for-25 (.400) with 4 homers and 8rbi...**Gonzalez'** active 6-game hitting streak (7-21, .333, 1 2b, 1hr, 5rbi) ties streaks by **Votto** and **Bruce** for the longest by a Reds batter this season.

HEALTHY RECIPES: The Reds haven't made a roster move since final cuts the day before Opening Day...today is the 23rd day of the season...haven't gone more than 22 days to start a season without a roster move since **1985**, when on the 37th day (5/14) the Reds recalled **Alan Knicely** and **Ron Robinson** and optioned to Class AAA Denver **Dann Bilardello** and **Carl Willis**...in 2009, the Reds began a season without a player on the disabled list for the first time since **1990**.

IT STARTS WITH PITCHING: In the last 9g **Reds pitchers** posted a 3.15era (80ip, 28er), lowering the staff's overall ERA from 5.11 to 4.18...in the last 9g **Reds starters** went 5-3, 3.20 (56.1ip, 20er)...in the last 11g **Reds relievers** have posted a 3.00era (30ip, 10er).

VETERAN LEADERSHIP: **LHP Arthur Rhodes** and **RHP David Weathers**, both 39 years old, this season have combined for 15 apps and 14.1 scoreless innings...opponents are hitting .170 against them (8-47)...together they have made **1,625** Major League apps for 13 teams...33-year-old **RHP Francisco Cordero** has converted all 6 save opps while posting a 3.38era in his 8 apps.

.500: At **9-6** the Reds were 3g over .500 this late in a season for the first time since they were 3g over at **67-64 in 2006**...haven't been 4g over .500 since they were **67-63 in 2006**...during that **2006 season** the Redlegs reached a season-high 12g over .500 at **36-24**.

PLAYING FROM BEHIND: The Reds have trailed in 14 of their 19g this season...6 times allowed runs in the first inning...last season the Reds went **26-69** when the opponent scored first and **48-19** when they scored first.

VOTE NOW: Through Thursday, fans can vote online at reds.com to decide which **Reds pitcher** will have a 2009 bobblehead...the **Fans Choice Bobblehead** will be given to the first 30,000 fans on **Sat, 7/18 vs Mil** and is part of a collectible set of 4 bobbleheads that also features **Joey Votto** (Sat, 5/9 StL), **Jay Bruce** (Sat, 7/4 vs StL) and **Brandon Phillips** (Sat, 8/15 vs Wsh).

CIVIL RIGHTS GAME: At Great American Ball Park on **Sat, 6/20** the Reds and Chicago White Sox will meet in the **Civil Rights Game**, the first time the contest will be played during the regular season...the weekend's festivities will include a roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's **Harriet Tubman Theater** (Fri, 6/19, 4:00 p.m.), a luncheon at **Duke Energy Center** honoring the 3 winners of Major League Baseball's **Beacon Awards** (Sat, 6/20, 11:30 a.m.) and a **Youth Summit at Fountain Square** downtown (Sat, 6/20, 4:00 p.m.)...the luncheon on Sat, 6/20 will honor Beacon of Hope winner **Bill Cosby**, Beacon of Life winner **Hank Aaron** and Beacon of Change winner **Muhammad Ali**...for more information, log on to www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame.

HONORARY BAT GIRLS: In celebration of **Mother's Day**, Major League Baseball and **Susan G. Komen for the Cure** are looking for honorary bat girls for games scheduled for **Sun, 5/10**...the Reds and Cardinals will play at 1:10 p.m. that day at Great American Ball Park...MLB.com is hosting a contest in which fans can share stories of "going to bat" against breast cancer in their daily lives...the initiative is aimed to raise additional awareness and support for the annual *Going to Bat Against Breast Cancer* program, a joint partnership between MLB and **Susan G. Komen for the Cure**...fans can submit stories and vote for their favorites on www.mlb.com/honorarybatgirl...winners will be selected **Friday**.

VOTE REDS!: Fan voting for the **2009 All-Star Game** in St. Louis kicks off in Great American Ball Park continues through **6/20**...in addition to paper ballots, fans can vote online using **laptop computers** set up near **Section 114** on Terrace Level...one online voter per game will be selected randomly to receive a **Kroger gift card**...Reds players on the ballot include **C Ramon Hernandez**, **1B Joey Votto**, **2B Brandon Phillips**, **SS Alex Gonzalez**, **3B Edwin Encarnacion**, **OF Chris Dickerson**, **OF Willy Taveras** and **OF Jay Bruce**.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (3-6, .333): Went 0-2-1 in their first 3 completed home series (1-2 vs NYM, 1-1 vs Pit, 1-2 vs Atl)...in 2008, at **43-38** the Reds established a new Great American Ball Park record for victories in a season and went **12-11-3** in their 26 home series...in 7 seasons at GABP are **244-251-1**.

REDS ON THE ROAD (7-3, .700): On their first road trip the Reds went 7-3 and won all 3 series (2-1 at Mil, 3-1 at Hou, 2-1 at Chi)...through that first trip Cin's 7 road wins were the most in the Major Leagues...entering this season and dating back to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

IN THE STANDINGS (22): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 0, SECOND - 2, THIRD - 9, FOURTH - 7, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1.

REDS vs ASTROS: The Reds are 401-381-1 all-time vs the Astros, including 3-2 this season, 6-14 the last 2 seasons and 10-25 the last 3 seasons...the Reds' 4-2 win at Minute Maid Park on 4/19/09 was their 400th victory vs Hou...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 15-31-1, including 0-1 this season, 0-6 in 2008 and 1-15 the last 3 seasons...have lost the last 10g vs Hou at GABP...Hou's .674 winning percentage at GABP (31-15) is the best among all opponents (LAD 2nd, 13-7, .650)...**Lance Berkman's** 20 homers at GABP are the most by any Reds opponent (**Jason Bay** 2nd, 14)...**Roy Oswalt's** 7 wins there tie Chi's **Carlos Zambrano** for the most by an opposing pitcher.

Last Started: Thu at Chi and earned the 7-1 victory (7+ip, 7h, 1r, 0er, 1bb, 2k, 105 pitches, 66 strikes)...left leading, 4-1...allowed only an unearned run in the sixth inning...also in the sixth inning recorded his 1,000th career strikeout (Derrek Lee).

Red Hots: Is making his fifth start of the season...in his previous 4 starts the Reds went 2-2 and scored 10 runs (2.5 r/g)...in his first 3 starts **Reds batters** hit .146 (12-82)...in Thu's start at Wrigley Field **Reds batters** went 13-for-38 (.342)...his complete game in the club's fifth game, a 2-0 win on 4/12 vs Pit, was the quickest by a Reds pitcher since **Pete Harnisch** threw a CG in the Reds' fourth game of **1999**.

Astronomical: In his third start of the season, a 7-0 loss at Hou on 4/18, allowed 5 earned runs in 6+ innings...in his other 3 starts is **2-1, 0.43** (21ip, 1er).

Opening Day: In the 2-1 loss vs the Mets made his fourth straight Opening Day start, the first Reds pitcher to do so since **RHP Jose Rijo** had the honors in 4 straight seasons from 1992-95...the only other Reds pitchers to make at least 4 consecutive Opening Day starts are **Pete Donohue** (5 straight, 1923-27) and **Mario Soto** (5, 1982-86)...**Soto** holds the club record for overall Opening Day starts (6)...in 4 career Opening Day starts Harang is 1-3, 3.52 (23ip, 9er).

Staff Ace: In 2008 received the Joe Nuxhall Good Guy Award from the local chapter of the Baseball Writers' Association of America...in 2005 and 2007 won the BBWAA's Johnny Vander Meer Award as the club's Most Outstanding Pitcher...since he was acquired from the Athletics at the 2003 trading deadline is the Reds' leader in most statistical pitching categories, including starts (171), wins (65), innings pitched (1096.0) and strikeouts (920).

Community Affairs: Is one of the club's more active members of the local community...for the third consecutive season, as part of his **Aaron's Aces** ticket program is hosting at all Sunday home games children of military personnel serving in the **War On Terrorism**...in 2008 he donated \$55,000 to the **Miracle League of Greater Cincinnati and Northern Kentucky**...for his community service has been the club's nominee for the **Robert Clemente Award** (2007), **Branch Rickey Award** (2007) and **Marvin Miller Man of the Year Award** (2007, 2008).

Career Highs: **Innings:** 10.0 (longest), 7/23/07 vs Mil & 1.0 (shortest, 2x), 9/5/03 at StL & 7/28/07 vs Chi; **Hits:** 14, 9/28/05 at Mil; **Runs:** 9, 4/3/06 vs Chi; **Earned runs:** 8 (2x), 8/10/08 vs Hou & 8/16/08 vs StL; **Walks:** 7, 7/8/08 for Cin at Chi; **Strikeouts:** 13, 9/29/07 vs Chi; **HR allowed:** 4 (3x), last on 8/19/07 at Mil (Braun solo, Hall 2-run, Fielder 2-run, Hardy solo); **Complete Games:** 12, last on 4/12/09 for Cin vs Pit (2-0 win); **Shutouts:** 6, last on 4/12/09 for Cin vs Pit (2-0 win).

Harang's Most Recent Starts: **4/6 vs NYM**, in his fourth straight Opening Day start suffered the 2-1 loss (5ip, 7h, 1er, 3bb, 2k, 1hr, 114 pitches)...left trailing, 1-0...allowed only a solo HR to Daniel Murphy in the fifth...**4/12 vs Pit** and threw a 3-hitter in the 2-0 victory (0bb, 9k, 1hbp, 108 pitches, 80 strikes)...was his 12th career complete game and sixth career shutout...was the first CG in the majors this season...allowed only a leadoff double to Morgan and singles to Moss and Morgan...**4/18 at Hou** and suffered the 7-0 loss (6+ip, 10h, 5er, 1bb, 6k, 93 pitches, 62 strikes)...left trailing, 3-0, but was charged with 2 more runs scored off Burton...while on the mound allowed all 3 runs with 2 outs...in the first inning allowed 2 runs on 4 hits, including consecutive RBI-singles to Pence and Blum...in the fifth allowed Lee's RBI-double...Reds batters produced 2 singles off Rodriguez (7ip, 10k), Sampson and Fulchino.

Tomorrow's Pitcher: Edinson Volquez

Last Pitched: Fri vs Atl, issued a career-high 7 walks and suffered the 4-3 loss (5ip, 1h, 3er, 7bb, 7k, 1hr, 1hbp, 97 pitches, 53 strikes)...left trailing, 3-2...allowed just 1 hit, a solo HR by Jeff Francoeur with 2 outs in the fifth inning...threw 40 pitches in the fourth frame, in which he walked 5 batters to force in 2 runs...became the first pitcher in the Major Leagues to walk 5 batters in an inning since Wsh's Jason Bergmann walked 5 in the top of the third inning on 8/13/08 vs NYM and the first Reds pitcher to do it since Ryan Dempster walked 6 batters in the bottom of the second inning on 4/30/03 at Col.

Red Hots: Tomorrow will make his fifth start of the season...in his previous 4 starts the Reds went 2-2 and scored 21 runs (5.3 r/g)...last season didn't allow his 14th earned run until his 14th appearance...in his 4 apps produced 1 quality start.

World Baseball Classic: Started the Dominican Republic's first game and suffered the 3-2 loss to the Netherlands (3ip, 2h, 3r, 0er, 2bb, 3k, 58 pitches)...in the first inning allowed 3 unearned runs on 2 hits, 2 errors, 1 walk and 1 wild pitch.

2008 Awards: In his first full season in the Major Leagues was the Reds' lone **All-Star** and won the **Johnny Vander Meer Award** as the staff's **Most Outstanding Pitcher**.

Team Leader: Last season led the Reds' staff in victories (17), ERA (3.21) and strikeouts (206) and with 196.0 innings pitched finished second on the club to **Bronson Arroyo's** 200ip...his 206 strikeouts tied for the most by a pitcher in his first season with the Reds (**Gary Nolan**, 1967)...also led the pitching staff with 20 quality starts.
