TONIGHT'S GAME: Is **Game 3** (0-2) of a 3-game series vs **Sally Gunter's** Astros and **Game 6** (1-4) of a 6-game homestand that also included the **Braves** (1-2)...on tomorrow's off day the Reds will travel to **Pit**, where on Fri they will begin a 5-game road trip that includes 3g vs the **Pirates** and a brief 2-game series at **Fla**.

<u>VOTE NOW</u>: Through tomorrow, fans can vote online at <u>reds.com</u> to decide which **Reds pitcher** will have a 2009 bobblehead...the **Fans Choice Bobblehead** will be given to the first 30,000 fans on **Sat, 7/18 vs Mil** and is part of a collectible set of 4 bobbleheads that also features **Joey Votto** (Sat, 5/9 StL), **Jay Bruce** (Sat, 7/4 vs StL) and **Brandon Phillips** (Sat, 8/15 vs Wsh).

JACKIE ROBINSON SCHOLAR: During pre-game ceremonies tonight the Reds will recognize Jackie Robinson Foundation scholar Brittany Jones, a computer engineering major at the University of Cincinnati...Brittany is among the 279 current Jackie Robinson Foundation scholarship recipients...her scholarship is funded by the Reds Community Fund...since 1973 the Jackie Robinson Foundation has provided more than 1,300 college scholarships... the remarkable 97 percent graduate rate is the highest of any peer scholarship program in the nation.

<u>CENTRAL CASTING</u>: Tonight's game is Game 18 in a stretch of **18-21g** and **23-28g** against **National League Central** opponents (9-8 overall, **8-6 vs NL Central**, 1-1 vs Pit, 2-1 at Mil, 3-1 at Hou, 2-1 at Chi, *1-2 vs Atl*, **0-2 vs Hou**, 3g at Pit, *2g at Fla*, 2g vs Mil, 3g vs StL).

DOT, DOT.: The Astros have won 11 straight games vs the Reds at Great American Ball Park and over the last 3 seasons are 16-1 here...**1B Joey Votto** and **2B Brandon Phillips** have played every inning of every game...in the last 12g **Reds relievers** have posted a 3.18era (34ip, 12er).

<u>YESTERDAY'S TRANSACTIONS</u>: 3B Edwin Encarnacion went on the 15-day disabled list with a chip fracture in his left wrist suffered on a swing during his final plate appearance on Mon...he will be in a cast for 1 week, after which time the cast will be removed and he will be re-evaluated...**IF Adam Rosales** (#23) was recalled from Class AAA Louisville to replace Encarnacion on the roster.

<u>HEALTHY RECIPES:</u> Yesterday's roster moves, on the 23rd day of the season, were the first by the Reds since final cuts the day before Opening Day...was the club's longest stretch to start a season without a roster move since **1985**, when on the 37th day (5/14) the Reds recalled **Alan Knicely** and **Ron Robinson** and optioned to Class AAA Denver **Dann Bilardello** and **Carl Willis**...in 2009, the Reds began a season without a player on the disabled list for the first time since **1990**.

<u>VETERAN LEADERSHIP</u>: LHP Arthur Rhodes and RHP David Weathers, both 39 years old, this season have combined for 15 apps and 14.1 scoreless innings...opponents are hitting .170 against them (8-47)...together they have made **1,625** Major League apps for 13 teams...33-year-old RHP Francisco Cordero has converted all 6 save opps while posting a 3.38era in his 8 apps.

<u>.500</u>: At **9-6** the Reds were 3g over .500 this late in a season for the first time since they were 3g over at **67-64 in 2006**... haven't been 4g over .500 since they were **67-63 in 2006**...during that **2006 season** the Redlegs reached a season-high 12g over .500 at **36-24**.

PLAYING FROM BEHIND: The Reds have trailed in 15 of their 20g this season...7 times allowed runs in the first inning...last season the Reds went **26-69** when the opponent scored first and **48-19** when they scored first.

<u>CIVIL RIGHTS GAME</u>: At Great American Ball Park on **Sat**, 6/20 the Reds and Chicago White Sox will meet in the **Civil Rights Game**, the first time the contest will be played during the regular season...the weekend's festivities will include a roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's **Harriet Tubman Theater** (Fri, 6/19, 4:00 p.m.), a luncheon at **Duke Energy Center** honoring the 3 winners of Major League Baseball's **Beacon Awards** (Sat, 6/20, 11:30 a.m.) and a **Youth Summit** at **Fountain Square** downtown (Sat, 6/20, 4:00 p.m.)...the luncheon on Sat, 6/20 will honor Beacon of Hope winner **Bill Cosby**, Beacon of Life winner **Hank Aaron** and Beacon of Change winner **Muhammad Ali...**for more information, log on to www.mlb.com/civilrightsqame.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (3-7, .300): Regardless of tonight's outcome the Reds went 0-3-1 in their first 4 home series (1-2 vs NYM, 1-1 vs Pit, 1-2 vs Atl, 0-2 Hou)...in 7 seasons at GABP are 244-252-1...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38)...at 217-217-1 the Reds had evened their overall record at GABP for the first time since 6/26/04 (57-57)...also reached .500 at 219-219-1.

REDS ON THE ROAD (7-3, .700): On their first road trip the Reds went 7-3 and won all 3 series (2-1 at Mil, 3-1 at Hou, 2-1 at Chi)...through that first trip Cin's 7 road wins were the most in the Major Leagues...won 3 consecutive road series for the first time since they went 6-2 over 2 trips from 8/3-8/19, 2007 (2-0 at Pit, 2-1 at Chi & 2-1 at Mil)...won 3 series on the same road trip for the first time since 9/21-9/30, 2004 (2-1 at Atl, 2-1 at Pit, 3-1 at Chi)...won 7g on a single road trip for the first time since 5/29-6/7, 2006 (7-2 overall, 1-2 at Chi, 3-0 at Hou, 3-0 at StL)...entering this season and dating back to 2006, the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips.

IN THE STANDINGS (23): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 0, SECOND - 2, THIRD - 9, FOURTH - 8, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...have spent 11 days above, 5 days at and 7 days below .500.

REDS vs ASTROS: The Reds are 401-382-1 all-time vs the Astros, including 3-3 this season, 6-15 the last 2 seasons and 10-26 the last 3 seasons...the Reds' 4-2 win at Minute Maid Park on 4/19/09 was their 400th victory vs Hou...<u>at</u>

Great American Ball Park: Reds are 15-32-1, including 0-2 this season, 0-6 in 2008 and 1-16 the last 3 seasons...have lost the last 11g vs Hou at GABP...Hou's .681 winning percentage at GABP (32-15) is the best among all opponents (LAD 2nd, 13-7, .650)...Lance Berkman's 20 homers at GABP are the most by any Reds opponent (Jason Bay 2nd, 14)...Roy Oswalt's 7 wins here tie Chi's Carlos Zambrano for the most by an opposing pitcher..

<u>UP NEXT: REDS at PIRATES</u>: The Reds are **970-1,016** all-time vs the Pirates, including 1-1 this season...<u>at PNC Park</u>: Reds are 31-30 all-time, including 2-4 last season.

Last Pitched: Fri vs Atl, issued a career-high 7 walks and suffered the 4-3 loss (5ip, 1h, 3er, 7bb, 7k, 1hr, 1hbp, 97 pitches, 53 strikes)...left trailing, 3-2...allowed just 1 hit, a solo HR by Jeff Francoeur with 2 outs in the fifth inning...threw 40 pitches in the fourth frame, in which he walked 5 batters to force in 2 runs...became the first pitcher in the Major Leagues to walk 5 batters in an inning since Wsh's Jason Bergmann walked 5 in the top of the third inning on 8/13/08 vs NYM and the first Reds pitcher to do it since Ryan Dempster walked 6 batters in the bottom of the second inning on 4/30/03 at Col.

Red Hots: Is making his fifth start of the season...in his previous 4 starts the Reds went 2-2 and scored 21 runs (5.3 r/g)...last season didn't allow his 14th earned run until his 14th appearance...in his 4 apps produced 1 quality start.

World Baseball Classic: Started the Dominican Republic's first game and suffered the 3-2 loss to the Netherlands (3ip, 2h, 3r, 0er, 2bb, 3k, 58 pitches)...in the first inning allowed 3 unearned runs on 2 hits, 2 errors, 1 walk and 1 wild pitch.

2008 Awards: In his first full season in the Major Leagues was the Reds' lone **All-Star** and won the **Johnny Vander Meer Award** as the staff's **Most Outstanding Pitcher**.

<u>League Leader</u>: For most of the first half of last season led the Major Leagues in ERA and finished the season ranked among the NL leaders in that category (8th) plus wins (17, T3rd), strikeouts (206, T2nd), walks (93,

4th), opponents' BA (.232, 5th), winning percentage (.739, T3rd), strikeouts per 9 innings (9.5, 2nd), ERA on the road (2.43, 2nd) and ERA in the day (2.21, 4th)... despite his ranking among the NL leaders in most pitching categories didn't receive a single **Cy Young Award** vote.

Berkman

Stingy: Last season, in 20 of his 32 starts allowed 2 earned runs or fewer and in 24 of his 32 starts allowed 3 earned runs or fewer...didn't allow more than 1 earned run in any of his first 8 starts, tying the Major League record for most starts to begin a season without allowing more than 1 earned run...his ERA didn't rise above 2.00 until his 17th appearance (2.08) and didn't rise above 3.00 until his 28th appearance (3.04)...in his 32 starts the Reds (74-88, .457) went 21-11 (.645)...in 2 of the 11 losses he started Reds batters were shut out, in 2 more they scored 1 run and in 3 others they lost in extra innings.

17 Wins: Last season went 10-2, 1.71 in his first 16 apps and 7-4, 4.63 in his last 17 apps...3 times was the victim of blown saves...his 17 victories were the most by a Reds pitcher since **LHP Pete Schourek** in 1995 (18-7), the most by a Reds righthander since **Mario Soto** in 1984 (18-7), the most by a pitcher in his first season with the Reds since **Danny Jackson** in 1988 (23 wins) and the most by a righthander in his first season with the Reds since **Joey Jay** in 1961 (21 wins).

KKKKKKKKK</u>: Six times last season recorded at least 10 strikeouts, the most 10k apps in a season by a Reds pitcher since Mario Soto had six 10-strikeout games in 1983...in 3 other starts finished with 9 strikeouts.

<u>Tool Box</u>: In Baseball America's Best Tools issue at the end of last season ranked third in the National League in the categories of **Best Fastball** (Tim Lincecum 1st, Ben Sheets 2nd) and **Best Changeup** (Johan Santana 1st, Cole Hamels 2nd).

Volquez' Most Recent Starts: 4/8 vs NYM, in the Reds' second game of the season suffered the 9-7 loss (4.1ip, 6h, 5r, 4er, 4bb, 4k, 1hr, 107 pitches, 60 strikes)... left trailing, 5-4...allowed Delgado's 2-run HR in the second inning and 3 runs on 3 hits and an error in the fifth...4/13 at Mil, in the Reds' first road game of the season and earned the 7-6 victory (5ip, 7h, 6er, 4bb, 4k, 1hbp, 2hr)...left leading, 7-6...in the first inning allowed Fielder's run-scoring groundout...in the second allowed 4 runs on 3 hits and a walk, capped by Hart's 3-run HR, and in the third allowed Hart's leadoff HR...benefitted from the Reds' 6-run third...4/19 at Hou and earned the 4-2 victory (6ip, 4h, 1er, 5bb, 7k, 104 pitches, 62 strikes)...left trailing, 1-0, but benefited from the Reds' 3-run seventh inning highlighted by pinch-hitter Micah Owings' 2-run double...allowed only Miguel Tejada's RBI-single with 1 out in the third inning.

Friday at Pirates: Bronson Arroyo

<u>Last Pitched</u>: Sat vs Atl and suffered the 10-2 loss (5.2ip, 9h, 9er, 3bb, 5k, 1hbp, 2hr, 102 pitches, 60 strikes)...left trailing, 9-2...gave up 2 runs in the first inning, 3 in the second (CJones 3-run HR) and three in the sixth (Escobar 2-run HR).

Red Hots: Friday at Pit will make his fifth start of the season... in his previous 4 starts the Reds went 3-1 and scored 20 runs (5 r/g)...since he was acquired by the Reds prior to the 2006 season leads all Major League pitchers with 107 starts and ranks third in the National League with 676.1 innings pitched.

Perfect: Began the season 3-0 for the third time in his career but for the first time won his first 3 starts of a season...won his first 2 starts in 2006, when he started off 5-0...began the 2005 campaign 4-0...was the first Reds pitcher to begin the season in the rotation and win his first 3 starts since **LHP Pete Schourek** did it in 1996 and the first righthander since **Jack Armstrong** won his first 5 starts of 1990.

<u>Career Highlights</u>: In each of the previous 4 seasons recorded at least 32 starts and 200 innings...is 1 of only 8 Major League pitchers to record at least 200 innings in each of the previous 4 seasons (Mark Buehrle, Dan Haren, Roy Oswalt, Andy Pettitte, Johan Santana, Javier Vazquez, Brandon Webb)...in each of the previous 3 seasons led the Reds in starts and in 2 of the last 3 seasons led the staff in innings pitched.
