In the last 11g of spring Reds pitchers posted a 2.51era (96.2ip, 27er), including a 2.08era by Reds starters (56.1ip, 13er) and a 3.12era by Reds relievers (40.1ip, 14er)...Reds pitchers allowed just 2 home runs after 3/21, including a 9-game stretch near the end of camp in which they didn't allow a homer (3/22-3/31, 79.2ip).

TODAY'S GAME: Is the Reds' spring training finale and the second of 2 exhibitions scheduled against their talented minor league Futures team...they squared off last night at Class AA Carolina's beautiful **Five County Stadium** in Zebulon, North Carolina...the minor leaguers won, 12-4...the Reds finished the **Florida** portion of their spring training schedule with a **13-20 record**.

TODAY'S TIDBITS: Reds Hall of Famer **Eric Davis** will throw out the ceremonial first pitch...the **Reds Hall of Fame** will have a traveling display at **Fifth Third Field**...gospel recording artist **Shawanda Smith** will sing the *National Anthem*... Reds President and Chief Executive Officer **Bob Castellini** will address the crowd.

IN THE COMMUNITY: During pregame ceremonies today, the **Reds Community Fund** will announce a **Reds Rookie Success League** program at **Kettering Fields** and will present a check for **\$12,500** to the **Springboro Miracle League**...the **Reds Rookie Success League** is a free, noncompetitive, coed, character-building day camp for kids ages 6-12...the club's fourth regional **RRSL** program is a partnership between the community fund and the **City of Dayton Recreation and Youth Services**...the **Springboro Miracle League** is receiving the check in recognition of the completion of its fundraising efforts...the official groundbreaking ceremony for that miracle field is **Tue, 4/14** in **Springboro**...the **Miracle League** provides a safe environment for children with disabilities to play baseball.

SUNSET: Yesterday was the Reds' final day at the **City of Sarasota Sports Complex**, their spring training home for 12 seasons...next year the organization will move its spring training site 20 miles west of Phoenix to **Goodyear, Arizona**... the Reds will share the **Goodyear Ballpark and Recreational Sports Complex** with the Indians, who moved into the facility last fall...Cin's portion of the plans includes a 40,700-square foot clubhouse, 6 full practice fields and 2 half fields... the teams will share 10,000-seat **Goodyear Ballpark**...the Reds' agreement includes a 20-year lease and two 5-year team options...next spring, 15 Major League Baseball clubs will train in Arizona and 15 will train in Florida.

REDS' SPRING TRAINING SITES: On 6/24/97, the Sarasota City Commission unanimously approved the assignment of its spring training facility from the White Sox to the Reds...the original 20-year contract expired October 1, 2008...since 1895, Reds have trained in Mobile, AL (1895, 1913), New Orleans (1896-97, 1900), Ft. Worth (1898), Columbus, GA (1899, 1912), Cincinnati (1901-02), Augusta, GA (1903), Dallas (1904), **Jacksonville** (1905), San Antonio (1906), Marlin, TX (1907), **St. Augustine** (1908), Atlanta (1909), Hot Springs, AR (1910-11), Alexandria, LA (1914-15), Shreveport, LA (1916-17), Montgomery, AL (1918), Waxahachie, TX (1919), **Miami** (1920), Cisco, TX (1921), Mineral Wells, TX (1922), **Orlando** (1923-30), **Tampa** (1931-42, 1946-87), San Juan, Puerto Rico (2/10-3/10, 1936), Bloomington, IN (1943-45), **Plant City** (1988-97) and **Sarasota** (1998-2009).

ON THE MOUND: Against Major League clubs, **RHP Homer Bailey** posted a 2.61era in his 6 apps and 4 starts...**RHP Jared Burton** in his last 7 apps posted a 1.35era (6.2ip, 1er)...**RHP Francisco Cordero** in his last 4 apps posted a 2.45era (3.2ip, 1er)...**RHP Mike Lincoln** in his last 8 apps posted a 2.25era (8ip, 2er)...**RHP Micah Owings** went 3-1, 1.52 in his 6 starts...**LHP Arthur Rhodes** didn't allow a run in his last 6g (6ip, 3h)...**RHP Josh Roenick** in his last 7 apps posted a 2.70era (6.2ip, 2er)...**RHP Edinson Volquez** didn't allow a run until his 17th inning and finished 2-0, 1.19 in his 6 apps and 5 starts...**RHP David Weathers** didn't allow a run in his last 3 apps (3ip).

AT THE PLATE: Against Major League clubs, **RF Jay Bruce** in his last 13g hit .368 (14-38, 2hr, 9rbi) and produced 6rbi in his last 5g...**IF/OF/C Wilkin Castillo** in his last 16g hit .333 (8-24)...**OF Chris Dickerson** in his last 17g hit .340 (16-47)...**3B Edwin Encarnacion** has been bothered by right shoulder soreness and after 3/21 appeared in just 4 of the Reds' final 11 spring "A" games...**SS Alex Gonzalez** hit safely in 6 of his 10 apps but didn't play in an "A" game after 3/23, when he suffered a strained right hamstring...**C Ryan Hanigan** in his 23 apps led the club in hitting (.385)...**C Ramon Hernandez** hit safely in 4 of his last 6 apps (4-13, .308)...**2B Brandon Phillips** opened the spring with a team-high 10-game hitting streak...**IF Adam Rosales** has 4 hits in his last 7ab (2 2b, 1hr, 4rbi)...**OF Willy Taveras** hit safely in 10 of his 12 apps after returning from the WBC (10-34, .294)...from 3/14-3/29 he produced a 9-game hitting streak, the second-longest by a Reds batter this spring (Phillips, 10g)...**1B Joey Votto** in his last 5 apps went 6-for-13 (.462, 2rbi).

TEAM PHOTO AUCTION: Until 5:00 p.m. on Opening Day, fans can bid online at reds.com for the opportunity to be included in the 2009 Reds team photo... the winner and a guest will pose with the team prior to the Reds' game vs the Mets on **Wednesday**...the winner also will receive a team-signed print of the photo...proceeds from the auction benefit the **Reds Community Fund**.

FOR THE SAKE OF COMPARISON: This spring against Major League clubs, Reds batters produced **28 homers** and **33 stolen bases**, compared to **23 homers** and **20 steals** in 33g a year ago.

SLAM-TASTIC!: When the Reds left Florida they led all Spring Training clubs with 5 grand slams (**Chris Valaika** on 3/9 at Phi, **Darnell McDonald** on /5 vs Pit, **Jonny Gomes** on 3/3 at Bos, **Craig Tatum** on 3/1 vs NYY, **Jerry Hairston Jr.** on 2/25 at TB)...the Mets, Rangers and Cubs each hd 3 grand slams, while the Yankees and Royals had 2 each...12 other teams had hit 1 slam.

OPENING DAY STARTER: **RHP Aaron Harang** will become the first Reds pitcher to start 4 consecutive Opening Day games since **RHP Jose Rijo** had the honors in 4 straight seasons from 1992-95...the only other Reds pitchers to make at least 3 consecutive Opening Day starts are **Pete Donohue** (5 straight, 1923-27), **Si Johnson** (3, 1932-34) and **Mario Soto** (5, 1982-86)...**Soto** holds the franchise record for most Opening Day starts (6).
