### Road Warriors

On their first road trip the Redlegs went 7-3 and won all 3 series (2-1 at Mil, 3-1 at Hou, 2-1 at Chi)...is their best start on the road to begin a season since **2002**, when they won their first 4 series and began 8-3 (2-1 at Pit, 2-1 at Phi, 2-1 at Chi, 2-0 at LA before losing the series finale)...the Reds most recently won 4 consecutive road series from **8/8-8/28, 2005** (3-0 at Chi, 2-1 at Mil, 2-1 at Wsh, 3-0 at Pit).

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** Is **Game 1** of a 3-game series vs **Kevin Conrad's** Pirates and **Game 1** of a 5-game road trip that also includes a brief stop in **Fla** (2g)...the Reds are coming off a 2-4 homestand vs the **Braves** (1-2) and **Astros** (1-2)...following this trip return to GABP for a 5-game homestand vs the **Brewers** (2g) and **Cardinals** (3g).

**VOLQUEZ & VANDER MEER:** RHP Edison Volquez allowed 1 hit in 5.0 innings in a 4-3 loss vs Atl last Fri and 1 hit in 8.0 innings in Wed's 3-0 win vs Hou...he is the first pitcher in the Major Leagues to record consecutive starts of at least **5.0 innings** while allowing no more than **1 hit** since Wsh's **Shawn Hill** did it on each side of a trip to the disabled list in **2007**...Volquez is the first Reds pitcher with similar consecutive starts since **Ron Villone** did it in **1999** (1 hit in 7ip on 6/24 at Hou, 1 hit in 8ip on 6/30 vs Ari) and the first Reds **righthander** to do it since **Johnny Vander Meer** threw consecutive no-hitters in **June 1938** (courtesy Elias Sports Bureau).

**CENTRAL CASTING:** Tonight's game is Game 19 in a stretch of **18-21g** and **23-28g** against **National League Central** opponents (10-8 overall, **9-6 vs NL Central**, 1-1 vs Pit, 2-1 at Mil, 3-1 at Hou, 2-1 at Chi, 1-2 vs Atl, 1-2 vs Hou, **3g at Pit**, 2g at Fla, 2g vs Mil, 3g vs StL).

**DOT, DOT, DOT...:** Today's 4.0-game deficit is the Reds' largest of the season...Wed's 3-0 home win snapped the Reds' 11-game losing streak to the Astros at Great American Ball Park...**1B Joey Votto** is the only Reds player to have played every inning of every game...in the last 13g **Reds relievers** have posted a 3.09era (35ip, 12er).

**AND THE WINNER IS...:** RHP Edinson Volquez was the pitcher selected as the **Fans' Choice Bobblehead** to be given to the first 30,000 fans on **Sat, 7/18 vs Mil**...Volquez received 3,047 of the 7,344 votes (41.5%) cast online at **reds.com**...his bobblehead is part of a collectible set of 4 that also features **Joey Votto** (Sat, 5/9 StL), **Jay Bruce** (Sat, 7/4 vs StL) and **Brandon Phillips** (Sat, 8/15 vs Wsh).

**ALL-STARS AMONG US:** Major League Baseball and *People* magazine invite fans to nominate individuals who have gone above and beyond to serve their communities during these difficult times...30 **Everyday All-Stars**, one representing each team, will attend and be honored at the **All-Star Game** in **St. Louis**...one person will be featured in *People* magazine...to nominate an **Everyday All-Star**, log on to **PeopleAllStars.com**.

**HEALTHY RECIPES:** On Tuesday the Reds disabled **3B Edwin Encarnacion** (chip fracture, left wrist) and recalled **IF Adam Rosales**...those roster moves, on the 23rd day of the season, were the first by the Reds since final cuts the day before Opening Day...was the club's longest stretch to start a season without a roster move since **1985**, when on the 37th day (5/14) the Reds recalled **Alan Knicely** and **Ron Robinson** and optioned to Class AAA Denver **Dann Bilardello** and **Carl Willis**...in 2009, the Reds began a season without a player on the disabled list for the first time since **1990**.

**VETERAN LEADERSHIP:** LHP Arthur Rhodes and RHP David Weathers, both 39 years old, this season have combined for 15 apps and 14.1 scoreless innings...opponents are hitting .170 against them (8-47)...together they have made **1,625** Major League apps for 13 teams...33-year-old **RHP Francisco Cordero** has converted all 7 save opps while posting a 3.00era in his 9 apps.

**.500:** At **9-6** the Reds were 3g over .500 this late in a season for the first time since they were 3g over at **67-64 in 2006**...haven't been 4g over .500 since they were **67-63 in 2006**...during that **2006 season** the Redlegs reached a season-high 12g over .500 at **36-24**.

**PLAYING FROM BEHIND:** The Reds have trailed in 15 of their 21g this season...7 times allowed runs in the first inning...last season the Reds went **26-69** when the opponent scored first and **48-19** when they scored first.

**CIVIL RIGHTS GAME:** At Great American Ball Park on **Sat, 6/20** the Reds and Chicago White Sox will meet in the **Civil Rights Game**, the first time the contest will be played during the regular season...the weekend's festivities will include a roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's **Harriet Tubman Theater** (Fri, 6/19, 4:00 p.m.), a luncheon at **Duke Energy Center** honoring the 3 winners of Major League Baseball's **Beacon Awards** (Sat, 6/20, 11:30 a.m.) and a **Youth Summit** at **Fountain Square** downtown (Sat, 6/20, 4:00 p.m.)...the luncheon on Sat, 6/20 will honor Beacon of Hope winner **Bill Cosby**, Beacon of Life winner **Hank Aaron** and Beacon of Change winner **Muhammad Ali**...for more information, log on to [www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame](http://www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame).

**REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (4-7, .364):** On **Thu vs Mil** the Reds will play their **500th game** at Great American Ball park...went 0-3-1 in their first 4 home series (1-2 vs NYM, 1-1 vs Pit, 1-2 vs Atl, 1-2 Hou)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **245-252-1**.

**REDS ON THE ROAD (7-3, .700):** On their first road trip the Reds went 7-3 and won all 3 series (2-1 at Mil, 3-1 at Hou, 2-1 at Chi)...through that first trip Cin's 7 road wins were the most in the Major Leagues...won 3 consecutive road series for the first time since they went 6-2 over 2 trips from **8/3-8/19, 2007** (2-0 at Pit, 2-1 at Chi & 2-1 at Mil)...won 3 series *on the same road trip* for the first time since **9/21-9/30, 2004** (2-1 at Atl, 2-1 at Pit, 3-1 at Chi)...won 7g on a single road trip for the first time since **5/29-6/7, 2006** (7-2 overall, 1-2 at Chi, 3-0 at Hou, 3-0 at StL)...entering this season and dating back to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

**IN THE STANDINGS (25):** The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 0, SECOND - 3, THIRD - 10, FOURTH - 8, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...have spent **13** days above, **5** days at and **7** days below .500.

**REDS vs PIRATES:** The Reds are **970-1,016 all-time** vs the Pirates, including 1-1 this season...**at GABP:** Reds are 26-29 all-time, including 1-1 this season...**at PNC Park:** Reds are 31-30 all-time, including 2-4 last season.

Wins Beginning 6/29

In the 14-1 loss on 6/24/08 at Tor, **Bronson Arroyo** made the shortest start of his career and became only the sixth starting pitcher in Major League history to allow at least 10 earned runs in a game in which he retired 3 batters or fewer (1+ip, 11h, 10er)...beginning with his next start, a 9-5 win at Cle on 6/29/08, **Arroyo** has compiled 14 wins, second-most in the majors since then:

**Last Pitched:** Sat vs Atl and suffered the 10-2 loss (5.2ip, 9h, 9er, 3bb, 5k, 1hbp, 2hr, 102 pitches, 60 strikes)...left trailing, 9-2...gave up 2 runs in the first inning, 3 in the second (CJones 3-run HR) and three in the sixth (Escobar 2-run HR).

**Red Hots:** Is making his fifth start of the season...in his previous 4 starts the Reds went 3-1 and scored 20 runs (5 r/g)...since he was acquired by the Reds prior to the 2006 season leads all Major League pitchers with 107 starts and ranks third in the National League with 676.1 innings pitched.

**Perfect:** Began the season 3-0 for the third time in his career but for the first time won his first 3 starts of a season... won his first 2 starts in 2006, when he started off 5-0...began the 2005 campaign 4-0...was the first Reds pitcher to begin the season in the rotation and win his first 3 starts since **LHP Pete Schourek** did it in 1996 and the first righthander since **Jack Armstrong** won his first 5 starts of 1990.

**2008 Season:** Was the only member of the Reds’ rotation to make every scheduled start...for the third straight season led the staff in starts (34) and for the second time in 3 years led the club in innings pitched (200.0)...for the fourth straight season recorded at least 32 starts and 200 innings...his 18 quality starts and career-high 15 wins were second on the staff to All-Star Edinson Volquez’ 17 victories and 20 quality apps...3 times was the victim of blown saves...tied for the National League lead in starts (34)...in his 34 starts the Reds went 18-16 and scored 172 runs (5.06 r/g)...was 1 of only 5 Reds pitchers to participate in more winning games than losing games (Jared Burton, Francisco Cordero, Edinson Volquez, David Weathers).

**Player of the Week:** For the period ending 8/31 of last season was voted **National League Co-Player of the Week** along with Wsh’s **Cristian Guzman**...in 2 starts that week **Arroyo** went 2-0, 1.69 with 1 CG.

**Arroyo’s Most Recent Starts:** **4/9 vs NYM**, in his season debut earned the 8-6 victory (6ip, 8h, 5er, 2bb, 4k, 100 pitches, 68 strikes)...allowed 3 runs in the third inning, highlighted by Church’s 2-run double, but the Reds came back with 4 runs in the bottom of that frame and then 4 more in the fifth...**4/14 at Mil** and earned the 6-1 victory (6.1ip, 4h, 1er, 4bb, 3k, 1hr, 105 pitches, 57 strikes)...left leading, 3-1, and the Reds added 3 runs in the ninth inning...allowed only Hardy’s solo HR in the second inning...**4/20 at Hou** and in his 100th career road start earned the 4-3 victory (7ip, 9h, 3er, 0bb, 2k, 2hr, 81 pitches, 53 strikes)...left leading, 4-3...allowed run-scoring groundout to Rodriguez in the second inning...allowed back-to-back HR to Berkman and Lee with 2 outs in the sixth.

## Tomorrow’s Pitcher: RHP Micah Owings

**Last Pitched:** Sun vs Atl and earned the 8-2 victory (7ip, 6h, 1er, 3bb, 6k, 1hr, 102 pitches, 60 strikes)...left leading, 8-1...allowed only a solo HR to David Ross with 1 out in the seventh inning...his first victory since May 2008 snapped a personal 9-game losing streak.

**Red Hots:** Tomorrow will make his fourth start of the season...in his 3 starts the Reds went 1-2 and scored 13 runs (3.25 r/g)...has 1 quality start...with an 8-2 win on 4/26 vs Atl snapped his 9-game losing streak dating back to a 9-3 Diamondbacks victory on 5/25/08 at Atl...in 14 apps and 10 starts between wins went **0-9, 8.53**.

**At The Plate:** Overall this season is hitting .364 (4-11, 3 2b, 2rbi), including 2-for-4 with 2rbi as a pinch hitter...ranks second on the club in pinch hits and T1st in pinch-hit RBI...in the seventh inning of the 4-2 win on 4/19 at Hou snapped the 1-1 tie with a pinch-hit, 2-run double off **Geoff Geary**...in his career has **3 game-winning RBI** as a pinch hitter (2gwrbi in 2008, 1gwrbi in 2009)...over the last 5 seasons, the only other *pitcher* to produce a pinch-hit, game-winning RBI is Hou’s **Jason Jennings** in the 14th inning of a 12-11 victory at Atl on 8/2/07 (RBI-single off Oscar Villarreal).

**Owings’ Most Recent Starts:** **4/15 at Mil**, in his Reds pitching debut suffered the 9-3 loss (5+ip, 5h, 4er, 2bb, 2k, 2hr, 89 pitches, 47 strikes)...left with the score tied, 3-3, but was charged with another run scored off Burton...the Brewers added 4 more runs off Burton in that 5-run sixth inning...Owings allowed Fielder’s sac fly in the first and leadoff HR to Cameron in both the second and fourth frames...**4/21 at Chi**, in the Reds’ first game of the season at Wrigley Field and suffered the 7-2 loss (4.2ip, 5h, 5r, 2er, 4bb, 3k, 1hr, 94 pitches, 61 strikes)...left trailing, 4-2, but was charged with another run scored off Lincoln...in the second inning allowed a leadoff HR to Micah Hoffpauir...in the fifth was charged with 3 unearned runs...start of the game was delayed 12 minutes by weather...gametime temperature was 40 degrees.
