See You In September..

The Reds are expected to move into their new spring training facility in nearby Goodyear in time for instructional league play this fall...they will share the Goodyear Ballpark and Recreational Sports Complex with the Indians, who moved into their new facility here last year...Cin's portion of the plans includes a 40,700-square foot clubhouse, 6 full practice fields and 2 half fields...the Ohio teams will share 10,000-seat **Goodyear Ballpark**...the Reds' agreement includes a 20-year lease and two 5-year team options...next spring, 15 Major League Baseball clubs will train in Arizona and 15 will train in Florida...April 3 was the Reds' final day at the **City of Sarasota Sports Complex**, their spring training home in Florida for 12 seasons.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is Game 2 (1-0) of a 3-game series vs Lauren Hopper's Diamondbacks and Game 2 (1-0) of a 6-game road trip that also includes an off day Thursday before a weekend series at SD (3g)...the Reds are coming off a 3-2 homestand vs Mil (1-1) and StL (2-1)...following this trip return to Great American Ball Park for a 9-game homestand vs Phi (3g), Cle (3g) and Hou (3g).

.500: At 18-14 the Reds are a season-high 4g over .500 for the second time (17-13)...haven't been 5g over .500 since they were 67-62 in 2006...during that 2006 season the Redlegs reached a season-high 12g over .500 at 36-24.

DOT, DOT, DOT...: Last night's 13-5 win at Ari was Dusty Baker's 1,254th as a manager, 32nd-most all-time and 1 more than Billy Martin...last night Reds batters produced 13 runs on 18 hits and 8 extra-base hits, including 6 doubles, all season highs...the Red went 2-0-2 in their previous 4 series (2-1 at Pit, 1-1 at Fla, 1-1 vs Mil, 2-1 vs StL)... are 14-2 when they score first and 4-12 when the opponent scores first...Adam Rosales homered in each of the last 2g, his first career home runs...in each of the last 2g Reds batters produced season highs in total bases (28tb on Sun vs StL, 30tb last night at Ari)...Jay Bruce leads the National League with 6 outfield assists, followed by Willy Taveras and 4 others with 4 OF assists.

JET LAG: With 3g at SD scheduled for this weekend, the current road trip includes the Reds' first visit to the West Coast this year...over the last 3 seasons, the Reds are 11-25 on the West Coast (0-9 at LAD, 4-6 at SD, 5-6 at SF, 1-2 at Oak, 1-2 at Sea)...that record includes an active 9-game losing streak at Dodger Stadium, where the Reds haven't won since their final appearance of 2005 (6-1 victory by Brandon Claussen on 7/28/05)...Cin doesn't play at LAD until 7/20-7/22.

CENTRAL CASTING: On Sunday the Reds completed a 28-game stretch that included 2 off days and 23 matchups with National League Central Division opponents...went 16-12 overall and 14-9 vs the Central (1-1 vs Pit, 2-1 at Mil, 3-1 at Hou, 2-1 at Chi, 1-2 vs Atl, 1-2 vs Hou, 2-1 at Pit, 1-1 at Fla, 1-1 vs Mil, 2-1 vs StL).

QUALITY CONTROL: In the Reds' 32g the opposing pitcher has produced 20 quality starts, including 11 straight from 4/14-4/25...the Reds went 10-10 (.500) when the opposing starter produced a quality appearance...the Reds have produced 15 quality starts (Cueto 4, Harang 4, Arroyo 3, Volquez 3, Owings 1) and went 13-2 in those QS (.867).

SPELLING RELIEF: The Reds' bullpen has converted all 9 save opps, all by Francisco Cordero, and for the second straight season will be the last bullpen in the Major Leagues to suffer a blown save...in 2008, Cin's pen didn't blow a save until the 41st game (5/14)...including last season, Cordero has recorded each of the Reds' last 43 saves (34sv in 2008, 9sv in 2009).

ZEROES: Reds pitchers lead the National League with 6 team shutouts (SF & Pit T2nd w/ 4sho)...produced those 6 shutouts in their first 26g, their fastest to 6 blankings since the 1914 staff threw its sixth shutout in the 25th game...Cin produced 6 team shutouts all of last season.

GILLETTE CIVIL RIGHTS GAME: At Great American Ball Park on Sat, 6/20 the Reds and Chicago White Sox will meet in the Gillette Civil Rights Game, the first time the contest will be played during the regular season...the weekend's festivities will include a roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's Harriet Tubman Theater (Fri, 6/19, 4:00 p.m.), a luncheon at Duke Energy Center honoring the 3 winners of Major League Baseball's Beacon Awards (Sat, 6/20, 11:30 a.m.) and a Youth Summit at Fountain Square downtown (Sat, 6/20, 4:00 p.m.)... the luncheon on Sat, 6/20 will honor Beacon of Hope winner Bill Cosby, Beacon of Life winner Hank Aaron and Beacon of Change winner ${\bf Muhammad~Ali}$... for more information, log on to ${\underline {\it www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame}}$.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (7-9, .438): The Reds went 1-3-2 in their first 6 home series and produced a winning record on just 1 of their 3 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2)...in 7 seasons at GABP are 248-254-1...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38).

REDS ON THE ROAD (11-5, .688): At 11-5 the Reds have the best road winning percentage in the Major League (.688)...the Marlins (11-8), Blue Jays (11-8) and Braves (11-7) also have 11 road victories...went 4-0-1 in their first 5 road series...produced winning records on each of their first 2 road trips (7-3, 3-2)...entering this season and dating back to 2006, the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips.

IN THE STANDINGS (36): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 0, SECOND - 7, THIRD - 14, FOURTH - 11, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...have spent 24 days above, 5 days at and 7 days below .500.

REDS vs DIAMONDBACKS: The Reds are 39-38 all-time vs the Diamondbacks, including 1-0 this season and 5-2 the last 2 years...the last 9 seasons are 21-31 vs Ari, including a 16-game losing streak from 5/8/01-8/13/03...at Chase Field: Reds are 20-18, including 1-0 in 2009 and 3-1 the last 2 seasons...are 18-9 with the roof closed and 2-9 with the roof open...won their first 7g at Bank One Ballpark until a 9-6 loss on 7/1/00...Cin was the last visiting team to lose a game in Phoenix...last Reds sweep: at Cin: 7/6-7/8, 2007 (3g)...at Ari: 6/21-6/23, 1999 (3g).

Last Pitched: Thu vs Mil and earned the 6-5 victory (6ip, 7h, 5r, 4er, 1bb, 4k, 100 pitches, 67 strikes)...left leading, 6-5...allowed 3 runs in the fourth inning and 2 runs in the sixth...his RBI-triple in the bottom of the fourth off Braden Looper gave the Reds a 4-3 lead they would not relinquish.

Red Hots: Is making his sixth start of the season...in his 5 starts the Reds went 2-3 and scored 25 runs (5 r/g)...has 1 quality start...with an 8-2 win on 4/26 vs Atl snapped his 9-game losing streak dating back to a 9-3 Diamondbacks victory on 5/25/08 at Atl...in 14 apps and 10 starts between victories went 0-9, 8.53 (51.2ip, 49er).

was traded to the Reds to complete the 8/11/08 trade that sent OF Adam Dunn and At The Plate: In 2007 won the National League's Silver Slugger Award cash to the D'Backs in exchange for RHP Dallas Buck and 2 PTBNL (IF/OF/C Wilkin Castillo, 8/14/08).

As A Pinch Hitter: This season as a pinch hitter is 3-for-5 with a home run (5/10 vs StL, solo off Ryan Franklin)...is tied for the club lead in pinch-hit RBI (3) and ranks second in pinch hits (3)...in the seventh inning of the 4-2 win on 4/19 at Hou snapped the 1-1 tie with a pinch-hit, 2-run double off Geoff Geary...was his third career game-winning RBI as a pinch hitter (2gwrbi in 2008, 1gwrbi in 2009)...over the last 5 seasons, the only other pitcher to produce a pinch-hit, game-winning RBI is Hou's Jason Jennings in the 14th inning of a 12-11 victory at Atl on 8/2/07 (RBI-single off Oscar Villarreal)...has 2 career pinch-hit HR, both of which tied games...in the last 50 years, the only other pitcher to hit a pinch-hit HR that tied a game was Brooks Kieschnick of the Brewers, who did it in 2003 and 2004...notes courtesy Elias Sports Bureau.

Owings' Most Recent Starts: 4/15 at Mil, in his Reds pitching debut suffered the 9-3 loss (5+ip, 5h, 4er, 2bb, 2k, 2hr, 89 pitches, 47 strikes)...left with the score tied, 3-3, but was charged with another run scored off Burton...the Brewers added 4 more runs off Burton in that 5-run sixth inning...Owings allowed Fielder's sac fly in the first and leadoff HR to Cameron in both the second and fourth frames...4/21 at Chi, in the Reds' first game of the season at Wrigley Field and suffered the 7-2 loss (4.2ip, 5h, 5r, 2er, 4bb, 3k, 1hr, 94 pitches, 61 strikes)...left trailing, 4-2, but was charged with another run scored off Lincoln...in the second inning allowed a leadoff HR to Micah Hoffpauir...in the fifth was charged with 3 unearned runs...start of the game was delayed 12 minutes by weather...gametime temperature was 40 degrees with a 15 mile per hour wind blowing left to right...4/26 vs Atl and earned the 8-2 victory (7ip, 6h, 1er, 3bb, 6k, 1hr, 102 pitches, 60 strikes)...left leading, 8-1...allowed only a solo HR to David Ross with 1 out in the seventh inning...his first victory since May 2008 snapped a personal 9-game losing streak...5/2 at Pit and suffered the 8-6 loss (5.2ip, 9h, 5er, 2bb, 0k, 99 pitches, 64 strikes)...left trailing, 5-3...in the first inning allowed 4 runs on 4 hits, 1 walk and 1 hit batter.

Tomorrow's Pitcher: RHP Johnny Cueto

Last Pitched: Fri vs StL and earned the 6-4 victory (7ip, 5h, 1er, 2bb, 3k, 98 pitches, 67 strikes)...left leading, 6-1...allowed only a run-scoring GIDP by Thurston in the seventh inning, snapping his career-high scoreless streak at 15 innings.

Red Hots: The 23-year-old righthander tomorrow will make his seventh start of the season and the 38th start of his career...in his 6 starts the Reds went 4-2 and scored 19 runs (3.17 r/g)...in his last 4 apps produced all 4 of his quality starts...on 4/22 at Chi singled twice off Ted Lilly for his first career 2-hit game.

Streaking I: In his last 4 starts is 3-0, 0.62 (29ip, 2er)...the 3-game winning streak ties his longest of last season (5/27-6/6)...allowed 4 earned runs in his first start (6ip) and 3 earned runs in his last 5 starts (33.2ip).

Streaking II: In each of his last 4 starts threw at least 7.0 innings while allowing no more than 1 run, the longest streak of that kind by a Reds pitcher since Tim Belcher had a 4-game run from 5/27-6/13, 1992... no Reds pitcher has made 5 consecutive starts of at least 7ip while allowing no more than 1er since Tom Browning produced 5 straight such starts from 5/17-6/8, 1990 (courtesy Elias Sports Bureau).

World Baseball Classic: Started the Dominican Republic's second game of the tournament and threw 4.2 scoreless innings to earn the 9-0 win vs Panama in the San Juan bracket (4.2ip, 3h, 1bb, 5k).

Cueto's Most Recent Starts: 4/11 vs Pit, in his season debut suffered the 10-2 loss (6ip, 8h, 4er, 1bb, 9k, 1hr, 109 pitches, 67 strikes)...left trailing, 4-0...allowed McLouth's 2-run HR in the first inning...in the fourth allowed Wilson's RBI-double and Morgan's RBI-triple...4/17 at Hou, in his second start of the season received no decision in the dramatic 2-1 victory (4.1ip, 2h, 1er, 6bb, 3k, 88 pitches, 46 strikes)...left trailing, 1-0...allowed only 1 hit through 4.2 scoreless innings - an infield single by Tejada leading off the fourth but with 2 outs in the fifth walked Oswalt and Bourn, allowed a single to Tejada and then walked Berkman to force in the game's first run...Lincoln then came in to induce Lee to ground out and end the inning...Cueto, Lincoln, Herrera, Masset and Cordero held Astros hitters to 4 singles...the Reds took the lead in the ninth on Hernandez' 1-out, 2-run HR off Valverde...including the no-decision, in 29 career apps vs the Reds Oswalt is 23-1, 2.39...4/22 at Chi, in one of the

<u>Cueto vs Diamondbacks</u>: Tomorrow will make his third career appearance vs Ari... on 4/3/08 at Great American Ball Park made his Major League debut and earned the 3-2 victory...in that start became the first pitcher in modern Major League history to debut with 10 strikeouts and 0 walks, the first Reds pitcher since 1900 to record 10 strikeouts in his ML debut and only the third pitcher to win his ML debut while allowing 1 hit and recording at least 10 strikeouts...retired his first 15 batters and allowed only 1 baserunner overall, Justin Upton homered leading off the sixth...made his other start vs Ari on 9/14/08 at Chase Field and received no decision in the 10-inning, 2-1 victory...in that game, between solo HR by Bruce in the fourth inning and Patterson in the 10th Diamondbacks pitchers retired 19 consecutive Reds batters...out of 115 pitches Cueto threw 56 balls, tied for the most by a pitcher in a Major League game in 2008 and the highest total of balls thrown in a game by a Reds pitcher since Ron Villone had 59 on 9/29/00 at StL...Diamondbacks batters went 0-for-13 with RISP and stranded 17 baserunners

best starts of his career threw 7.0 shutout innings to earn the 3-0 victory (4h, 0bb, 3k, 108 pitches, 68 strikes)...left leading, 1-0...the Reds added insurance runs in the eighth and ninth innings...singled twice off Lilly, his first career 2-hit game...4/27 vs Hou and received no decision in the 4-1 loss (7ip, 7h, 1er, 1bb, 5k, 1hr, 98 pitches, 64 strikes)...left with the score tied, 1-1...allowed only a solo HR to Berkman leading off the sixth inning, snapping his scoreless streak at career-high 12 innings...was Berkman's 20th career homer at Great American Ball Park, the most by any opposing player...the Astros scored 3 runs in the ninth off Cordero...5/3 at Pit, in the 5-0 victory threw 8.0 shutout innings in the best start of his young career (4h, 1bb, 9k, 109 pitches, 68 strikes)...the 8.0 innings are a career high...allowed only 4 singles.
