On today's date in 1947, **Jackie Robinson** of the Brooklyn Dodgers, the first African-American player to appear in the Major Leagues in the 20th century, made his first appearance in Cincinnati.

At Great American Ball Park on Sat, 6/20 the Reds and Chicago White Sox will meet in the Gillette Civil Rights Game, the first time the contest will be played during the regular season...the weekend's festivities will include a roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's Harriet Tubman Theater (Fri, 6/19, 4:00

p.m.), a luncheon at **Duke Energy Center** honoring the 3 winners of Major League Baseball's **Beacon Awards** (Sat, 6/20, 11:30 a.m.) and a **Youth Summit** at **Fountain Square** downtown (Sat, 6/20, 4:00 p.m.)...the luncheon on Sat, 6/20 will honor Beacon of Hope winner **Bill Cosby**, Beacon of Life winner **Hank Aaron** and Beacon of Change winner **Muhammad Ali**...for more information, log on to www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is **Game 3** (2-0) of a 3-game series vs **Glenn Sherlock's** Diamondbacks and **Game 3** (2-0) of a 6-game road trip that also includes an off day tomorrow before a weekend series at **SD** (3g)...following this trip the Reds return to **Great American Ball Park** for a 9-game homestand vs **Phi** (3g), **Cle** (3g) and **Hou** (3g).

.500: At 19-14 the Redlegs are a season-high 5g over .500...is their best record since the 2006 season, when they reached a season-high 12g over .500 at 36-24.

DOT, DOT. The Redlegs have won 5 of their last 6g...are **6-2** in Game 3 of a series and **5-2** on travel days...are **0-2** in games in which they could have recorded a series sweep...haven't swept a series in the **Pacific time zone** since a 3-game sweep at SD from **7/29-7/31**, **2005**...regardless of tonight's outcome the Reds are **3-0-2** in their last 5 series (2-1 at Pit, 1-1 at Fla, 1-1 vs Mil, 2-1 vs StL, **2-0 at Ari**)...their current 3-game road winning streak ties their longest of the season...are **15-2** when they score first and **4-12** when the opponent scores first.

<u>JET LAG</u>: With **3g** at **SD** scheduled for this weekend, the current road trip includes the Reds' first visit to the **West Coast** this year...over the last 3 seasons, the Reds are **11-25** on the **West Coast** (0-9 at LAD, 4-6 at SD, 5-6 at SF, 1-2 at Oak, 1-2 at Sea)...that record includes an active **9-game losing streak** at **Dodger Stadium**, where the Reds haven't won since their final appearance of **2005** (6-1 victory by **Brandon Claussen** on 7/28/05).

<u>STREAKING</u>: Willy Taveras' active 13-game hitting streak is the longest of the season by a Reds batter and sixth-longest in the National League...while playing for the Astros from 7/27-8/27, 2006 he produced a career-best 30-game hitting streak, a franchise record and second-longest in the NL that season behind Chase Utley's 35-game streak... Edwin Encarnacion's 14-game hitting streak was the longest by a Reds batter last season (4/10-4/24).

<u>CENTRAL CASTING</u>: On Sunday the Reds completed a 28-game stretch that included 2 off days and 23 matchups with **National League Central Division** opponents...went **16-12** overall and **14-9** vs the Central (1-1 vs Pit, 2-1 at Mil, 3-1 at Hou, 2-1 at Chi, 1-2 vs Atl, 1-2 vs Hou, 2-1 at Pit, 1-1 at Fla, 1-1 vs Mil, 2-1 vs StL).

QUALITY CONTROL: In the Reds' 33g the opposing pitcher has produced **21 quality starts**, including 11 straight from **4/14-4/25**...the Reds went **11-10** (.524) when the opposing starter produced a quality appearance...the Reds have produced 16 quality starts (**Cueto 4**, **Harang 4**, **Arroyo 3**, **Volquez 3**, **Owings 2**) and went **14-2** in those QS (.875).

SPELLING RELIEF: The Reds' bullpen has converted all 10 save opps, all by **Francisco Cordero**, and for the second straight season will be the last bullpen in the Major Leagues to suffer a blown save...in 2008, Cin's pen didn't blow a save until the **41st game** (5/14)...including last season, **Cordero** has recorded each of the Reds' last **44 saves**.

ZEROES: Reds pitchers lead the National League with **6 team shutouts** (SF & Pit T2nd w/ 4sho)...produced those 6 shutouts in their first **26g**, their fastest to 6 blankings since the **1914 staff** threw its sixth shutout in the **25th** game...Cin produced 6 team shutouts all of last season.

MICAH IN A PINCH: This season Micah Owings as a pinch hitter is 3-for-5 with a home run (5/10 vs StL, solo off Ryan Franklin)...is tied for the club lead in pinch-hit HR (1) and RBI (3) and ranks second in pinch hits (3)...in the seventh inning of the 4-2 win on 4/19 at Hou snapped the 1-1 tie with a pinch-hit, 2-run double off Geoff Geary...was his third career game-winning RBI as a pinch hitter (2gwrbi in 2008, 1gwrbi in 2009)...over the last 5 seasons, the only other pitcher to produce a pinch-hit, game-winning RBI is Hou's Jason Jennings in the 14th inning of a 12-11 victory at Atl on 8/2/07 (RBI-single off Oscar Villarreal)...Owings has 2 career pinch-hit HR, both of which tied games...in the last 50 years, the only other pitcher to hit a pinch-hit HR that tied a game was Brooks Kieschnick of the Brewers, who did it in 2003 and 2004...notes courtesy Elias Sports Bureau.

REDS ON THE ROAD (12-5, .706): At 12-5 the Reds have the most road victories and best road winning percentage in the Major Leagues (.706)...regardless of tonight's outcome have gone 5-0-1 in their first 6 road series...produced winning records on each of their first 2 road trips (7-3, 3-2)...entering this season and dating back to 2006, the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips.

IN THE STANDINGS (37): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 0, SECOND - 8, THIRD - 14, FOURTH - 11, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...have spent 25 days above, 5 days at and 7 days below .500.

REDS vs **DIAMONDBACKS**: The Reds are 40-38 all-time vs the Diamondbacks, including 2-0 this season and 6-2 the last 2 years... at Chase Field: Reds are 21-18, including 2-0 in 2009 and 4-1 the last 2 seasons... are 18-9 with the roof closed and 3-9 with the roof open... last Reds sweep: at Cin: 7/6-7/8, 2007 (3g)... at Ari: 6/21-6/23, 1999 (3g).

<u>UP NEXT: REDS vs PADRES</u>: The Reds are 309-250 all-time vs the Padres, including 4-3 in 2008...<u>at PETCO Park</u>: Reds are 8-8, including 2-2 in 2008 and 4-6 the last 3 seasons.

<u>Last Pitched</u>: Fri vs StL and earned the 6-4 victory (7ip, 5h, 1er, 2bb, 3k, 98 pitches, 67 strikes)...left leading, 6-1...allowed only a run-scoring GIDP by Thurston in the seventh inning, snapping his career-high scoreless streak at 15 innings.

Red Hots: The 23-year-old righthander is making his seventh start of the season and the 38th start of his career...in his 6 starts the Reds went 4-2 and scored 19 runs (3.17 r/g)...in his last 4 apps produced all 4 of his quality starts...on 4/22 at Chi singled twice off Ted Lilly for his first career 2-hit game.

<u>Streaking I</u>: In his last 4 starts is 3-0, 0.62 (29ip, 2er)...the 3-game winning streak ties his longest of last season (5/27-6/6)...allowed 4 earned runs in his first start (6ip) and 3 earned runs in his last 5 starts (33.2ip).

Streaking II: In each of his last 4 starts threw at least 7.0 innings while allowing no more than 1 run, the longest streak of that kind by a Reds pitcher since **Tim Belcher** had a 4-game run from **5/27-6/13**, **1992**...no Reds pitcher has made 5 consecutive starts of at least 7ip while allowing no more than 1er since **Tom Browning** produced 5 straight such starts from **5/17-6/8**, **1990** (courtesy Elias Sports Bureau).

World Baseball Classic: Started the Dominican Republic's second game of the tournament and threw 4.2 scoreless innings to earn the 9-0 win vs Panama in the San Juan bracket (4.2ip, 3h, 1bb, 5k).

Cueto vs Diamondbacks: Is making his third career appearance vs Ari...on 4/3/08 at Great American Ball Park made his Major League debut and earned the 3-2 victory... in that start became the first pitcher in modern Major League history to debut with 10 strikeouts and 0 walks, the first Reds pitcher since 1900 to record 10 strikeouts in his ML debut and only the third pitcher to win his ML debut while allowing 1 hit and recording at least 10 strikeouts...retired his first 15 batters and allowed only 1 baserunner overall, Justin Upton homered leading off the sixth...made his other start vs Ari on 9/14/08 at Chase Field and received no decision in the 10-inning, 2-1 victory...in that game, between solo HR by Bruce in the fourth inning and Patterson in the 10th Diamondbacks pitchers retired 19 consecutive Reds batters...out of 115 pitches Cueto threw 56 balls, tied for the most by a pitcher in a Major League game in 2008 and the highest total of balls thrown in a game by a Reds pitcher since Ron Villone had 59 on 9/29/00 at StL... Diamondbacks batters went 0-for-13 with RISP and stranded 17 baserunners.

Cueto's Most Recent Starts: 4/11 vs Pit, in his season debut suffered the 10-2 loss (6ip, 8h, 4er, 1bb, 9k, 1hr, 109 pitches, 67 strikes)...left trailing, 4-0...allowed McLouth's 2-run HR in the first inning...in the fourth allowed Wilson's RBI-double and Morgan's RBI-triple...4/17 at Hou, in his second start of the season received no decision in the dramatic 2-1 victory (4.1ip, 2h, 1er, 6bb, 3k, 88 pitches, 46 strikes)...left trailing, 1-0...allowed only 1 hit through 4.2 scoreless innings - an infield single by Tejada leading off the fourth - but with 2 outs in the fifth walked Oswalt and Bourn, allowed a single to Tejada and then walked Berkman to force in the game's first run...Lincoln then came in to induce Lee to ground out and end the inning...Cueto, Lincoln, Herrera, Masset and Cordero held Astros hitters to 4 singles...the Reds took the lead in the ninth on Hernandez' 1-out, 2-run HR off Valverde...including the no-decision, in 29 career apps vs the Reds Oswalt is 23-1, 2.39...4/22 at Chi, in one of the best starts of his career threw 7.0 shutout innings to earn the 3-0 victory (4h, 0bb, 3k, 108 pitches, 68 strikes)...left leading, 1-0...the Reds added insurance runs in the eighth and ninth innings...singled twice off Lilly, his first career 2-hit game...4/27 vs Hou and received no decision in the 4-1 loss (7ip, 7h, 1er, 1bb, 5k, 1hr, 98 pitches, 64 strikes)...left with the score tied, 1-1...allowed only a solo HR to Berkman leading off the sixth inning, snapping his scoreless streak at career-high 12 innings...was Berkman's 20th career homer at Great American Ball Park, the most by any opposing player...the Astros scored 3 runs in the ninth off Cordero...5/3 at Pit, in the 5-0 victory threw 8.0 shutout innings in the best start of his young career (4h, 1bb, 9k, 109 pitches, 68 strikes)...the 8.0 innings are a career high...allowed only 4 singles.

Friday at Padres: RHP Aaron Harang

Last Started: Sat vs StL and celebrated his 31st birthday with an 8-3 victory (7ip, 7h, 3r, 2er, 1bb, 7k, 1hr, 107 pitches, 69 strikes)... left leading, 8-3...allowed only a 2-out, 2-run HR to Ludwick in the third inning and an unearned run in the seventh following 2 Reds errors...while batting with the bases loaded and 2 outs in the sixth inning produced his first hit and RBI of the season, a 2-run single off Kyle Lohse that increased Cin's lead to 6-2.

Red Hots: On Fri at SD will make his eighth start of the season and the 200th appearance of his career...in his previous 7 starts the Reds went 3-4 and scored just 23 runs (3.29 r/g)...in his 7 starts Reds batters hit .231 (54-234)...on 4/23 at Chi recorded the 1,000th strikeout of his career (Derrek Lee)...his 3-hitter in the club's fifth game, a 2-0 win on 4/12 vs Pit, was the quickest complete game by a Reds pitcher since Pete Harnisch threw a CG in the Reds' fourth game of 1999.

Harang vs Padres: On Fri will make his ninth career appearance and his eighth career start vs his hometown team...was born in San Diego and still resides there...in 1996 graduated from Patrick Henry High School and then attended San Diego State University, where he majored in graphic design...in his most recent appearance, on 5/25/08 at PETCO Park, pitched in relief for the first time since 8/11/06 and threw 4.0 scoreless innings in the 18-inning, 12-9 loss (2h, 1bb, 9k, 63 pitches)...his 9 strikeouts were a season high and his 4.0 innings tied for the longest relief appearance of his career... was the ninth of the Reds' 10 pitchers and threw innings 13-16... fellow starter Edinson Volquez pitched the 17th and 18th innings...
