Today's Transactions
RHP Nick Masset today went on the 15-day disabled list, retroactive to 5/11, with a strained left oblique muscle...he was replaced on the roster by RHP Ramon Ramirez, who was recalled from Class AAA Louisville.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is Game 1 of a 3-game series vs Kevin Gregg's defending World Series champion Phillies and Game 1 of a 9-game homestand that also includes the Indians (3g) and Astros (3g)...the Reds are coming off a 3-3 road trip to Ari (3-0) and SD (0-3) that included the Reds' first 3-game sweep victory at Ari's Chase Field since June 1999 and their first sweep loss in San Diego since June 2000 at Qualcomm Stadium.

TBA, TBA, TBA: The Reds' starting rotation after tomorrow is TBA...prior to tonight's game pitching coach Dick Pole and head athletic trainer Mark Mann will evaluate Edinson Volquez, who left Sat's start after 5.2 innings and 93 pitches with mild spasms in his mid-back, and Micah Owings, who came out of the bullpen to throw the last 5.2 innings of Sat's 16-inning, 6-5 loss at SD...Owings originally was scheduled to start tomorrow, followed by Aaron Harang on Thu and then Volquez and Bronson Arroyo on Fri and Sat, respectively, in the first 2g vs the Indians.

MEDICAL UPDATES: 1B Joey Votto became ill following Sun's game at SD...instead of flying home with the team, as a precautionary measure he was admitted for tests at Scripps Clinic at San Diego...this afternoon he will be examined in Cincinnati by internist Dr. Stephen Cleves...Votto missed 5 games last week with the flu and twice more left games with dizziness...LHP Bill Bray this morning had "Tommy John" surgery to repair the torn ulnar collateral ligament in his left elbow (Dr. Timothy Kremchek)...he is expected to miss 10-12 months...Bray has been on Class AAA Louisville's disabled list since 4/16.

STREAKING: The Reds' 3-game losing streak is their longest of the season...at 20-15 were a season-high 6g over .500 for the first time since the 2006 season, when they reached a season-high 12g over .500 at 36-24...are 3-1-2 in their last 6 series (2-1 at Pit, 1-1 at Fla, 1-1 vs Mil, 2-1 vs StL, 3-0 at Ari, 0-3 at SD).

JET LAG: On Sun at SD the Reds completed their first series of the season on the West Coast...over the last 4 seasons are 11-28 on the West Coast (0-9 at LAD, 4-6 at SD, 5-6 at SF, 1-2 at Oak, 1-2 at Sea, 0-3 at SD)...that record includes an active 9-game losing streak at Dodger Stadium, where the Reds haven't won since their final appearance of 2005 (6-1 victory by Brandon Claussen on 7/28/05)...Cin doesn't play at LAD until 7/20-7/22.

DOT, DOT, DOT...: The Redlegs are 15-2 when they score first and 5-15 when the opponent scores first...Jay Bruce leads the National League with 6 outfield assists...IF Adam Rosales (26) and C Ramon Hernandez (33) will celebrate

QUALITY CONTROL: In the Reds' 37g the opposing pitcher produced 23 quality starts, including 11 straight from 4/14-4/25...the Reds went 11-12 (.478) when the opposing starter produced a quality appearance...the Reds have produced 18 quality starts (Cueto 5, Harang 4, Arroyo 4, Volquez 3, Owings 2) and went 15-3 in those QS (.833).

ZEROES: Reds pitchers lead the National League with 6 team shutouts (SF 2nd w/ 5sho)...produced those 6 shutouts in their first 26g, their fastest to 6 blankings since the 1914 staff threw its sixth shutout in the 25th game...Cin produced 6 team shutouts all of last season.

MICAH IN A PINCH: This season Micah Owings as a pinch hitter is 3-for-5 with a home run (5/10 vs StL, solo off Ryan Franklin)...is tied for the club lead in pinch-hit HR (1) and RBI (3) and ranks second in pinch hits (3)...in the seventh inning of the 4-2 win on 4/19 at Hou snapped the 1-1 tie with a pinch-hit, 2-run double off **Geoff Geary**...was his third career game-winning RBI as a pinch hitter (2gwrbi in 2008, 1gwrbi in 2009).

GILLETTE CIVIL RIGHTS GAME: At Great American Ball Park on Sat, 6/20 the Reds and Chicago White Sox will meet in the Gillette Civil Rights Game, the first time the contest will be played during the regular season...the weekend's festivities will include a roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's Harriet Tubman Theater (Fri, 6/19, 4:00 p.m.), a luncheon at **Duke Energy Center** honoring the 3 winners of Major League Baseball's **Beacon Awards** (Sat, 6/20, 11:30 a.m.) and a **Youth Summit** at **Fountain Square** downtown (Sat, 6/20, 4:00 p.m.)...the luncheon on Sat, 6/20 will honor Beacon of Hope winner Bill Cosby, Beacon of Life winner Hank Aaron and Beacon of Change winner Muhammad Ali...former President Bill Clinton will be the keynote speaker at that luncheon...for more information, log on to www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame.

ALL-STARS AMONG US: Major League Baseball and People magazine invite fans to nominate individuals who have gone above and beyond to serve their communities during these difficult times...30 Everyday All-Stars, one representing each team, will attend and be honored at the All-Star Game in St. Louis...one person will be featured in People magazine...to nominate an Everyday All-Star, log on to PeopleAllStars.com.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (7-9, .438): The Reds went 1-3-2 in their first 6 home series and produced a winning record on just 1 of their 3 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **248-254-1**...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38)...**at 217-217-1** the Reds had evened their overall record at GABP for the first time since 6/26/04 (57-57)...also reached .500 at 219-219-1.

REDS ON THE ROAD (13-8, .619): At 13-8 (.619) the Reds have the most road victories in the Major Leagues...went 5-1-1 in their first 7 road series...produced winning records on each of their first 2 road trips (7-3, 3-2) and a .500 record on the third trip (3-3)...entering this season and dating back to 2006, the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips.

IN THE STANDINGS (43): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 8, THIRD - 15, FOURTH - 15, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...have spent 31 days above, 5 days at and 7 days below .500.

REDS vs PHILLIES: Reds are 1,043-839 all-time vs the Phillies, including 3-5 in 2008...at Great American Ball Park: Reds are 9-13, including 2-2 in 2008...at Citizens Bank Park: Reds are 7-10, including 1-3 in 2008 and 2-5 the last 2 seasons...on 4/12/04 Cin earned a 4-1 victory in the first regular season game played there.

Last Pitched: Wed at Ari and earned the 10-3 victory (7ip, 4h, 3er, 2bb, 4k, 2hr, 100 pitches, 67 strikes)...in the first inning allowed a solo HR to Gerardo Parra in Parra's first career plate appearance, followed by a walk to Justin Upton...then retired 12 consecutive batters until Chad Tracy walked with 1 out in the fifth...after Parra's HR didn't allow another hit until Upton doubled with 2 outs in the sixth, followed by Stephen Drew's RBI-single... with 2 outs in the seventh inning allowed a solo HR to Ojeda, his first homer since 6/15/07 at Bal (410ab)...as a batter, led off the third inning with his second bunt single of the season to spark a 3-run rally.

Red Hots: The 23-year-old righthander is making his eighth start of the season and the 39th start of his career...with a 1.93era ranks third in the

National League...in his 7 starts the Reds went 5-2 and scored 29 runs (4.14 r/g)...in his last 5 apps produced all 5 of his quality starts, the longest stretch of quality starts by a Reds pitcher this season...last year, **Edinson Volquez** produced a string of 12 straight QS (4/22-6/20)...on 4/22 at Chi singled twice off Ted Lilly for his first career 2-hit game.

Streaking I: In his last 5 starts is 4-0, 1.25 (36ip, 5er)...the 4-game winning streak is the longest of his career...allowed 4 earned runs in his first start (6ip) and 6 earned runs in his last 6 starts (40.2ip, 0.89era).

Streaking II: In each of 4 starts from 4/22-5/8 threw at least 7.0 innings while allowing no more than 1 run, the longest streak of that kind by a Reds pitcher since Tim Belcher had a 4-game run from 5/27-6/13, 1992...(courtesy Elias Sports Bureau).

World Baseball Classic: Started the Dominican Republic's second game of the tournament and threw 4.2 scoreless innings to earn the 9-0 win vs Panama in the San Juan bracket (4.2ip, 3h, 1bb, 5k).

Cueto's Most Recent Starts: 4/11 vs Pit, in his season debut suffered the 10-2 loss (6ip, 8h, 4er, 1bb, 9k, 1hr, 109 pitches, 67 strikes)...left trailing, 4-0...allowed McLouth's 2-run HR in the first inning...in the fourth allowed Wilson's RBI-double and Morgan's RBI-triple...4/17 at Hou, in his second start of the season received no decision in the dramatic 2-1 victory (4.1ip, 2h, 1er, 6bb, 3k, 88 pitches, 46 strikes)...left trailing, 1-0...allowed only 1 hit through 4.2 scoreless innings - an infield single by Tejada leading off the fourth - but with 2 outs in the fifth walked Oswalt and Bourn, allowed a single to Tejada and then walked Berkman to force in the game's first run...Lincoln then came in to induce Lee to ground out and end the inning...Cueto, Lincoln, Herrera, Masset and Cordero held Astros hitters to 4 singles...the Reds took the lead in the ninth on Hernandez' 1-out, 2-run HR off Valverde...including the no-decision, in 29 career apps vs the Reds Oswalt is 23-1, 2.39...4/22 at Chi, in one of the best starts of his career threw 7.0 shutout innings to earn the 3-0 victory (4h, 0bb, 3k, 108 pitches, 68 strikes)...left leading, 1-0...the Reds added insurance runs in the eighth and ninth innings...singled twice off Lilly, his first career 2-hit game...4/27 vs Hou and received no decision in the 4-1 loss (7ip, 7h, 1er, 1bb, 5k, 1hr, 98 pitches, 64 strikes)...left with the score tied, 1-1...allowed only a solo HR to Berkman leading off the sixth inning, snapping his scoreless streak at career-high 12 innings...was Berkman's 20th career homer at Great American Ball Park, the most by any opposing player...the Astros scored 3 runs in the ninth off Cordero...5/3 at Pit, in the 5-0 victory threw 8.0 shutout innings in the best start of his young career (4h, 1bb, 9k, 109 pitches, 68 strikes)...the 8.0 innings are a career high...allowed only 4 singles...5/8 vs StL and earned the 6-4 victory (7ip, 5h, 1er, 2bb, 3k, 98 pitches, 67 strikes)...left leading, 6-1...allowed only a run-scoring GIDP by Thurston in t

Tomorrow's Pitcher: RHP Aaron Harang

<u>Last Started</u>: Fri at SD, returned to his hometown and in his 200th career appearance suffered the 5-3 loss (6.1ip, 8h, 5er, 2bb, 6k, 1hr, 108 pitches, 65 strikes)...left with 2 runners on base and the score tied, 3-3, but was charged with 2 runs scored off Weathers... with 2 outs in the first inning allowed a solo HR to Gonzalez, who homered in his fifth straight game to tie the club record...retired the first 2 batters of the sixth inning but then allowed a single to Gerut and an RBI-double to Kouzmanoff...was replaced in the seventh inning after Eckstein's RBI-single tied it at 3-3.

Red Hots: Tomorrow will make his ninth start of the season... originally was scheduled to start on Thu but was pushed up a day after Micah Owings came out of the bullpen to throw the last 5.2 innings of Sat's 16-inning, 6-5 loss at SD...in his previous 8 starts the Reds went 3-5 and scored just 26 runs (3.25 r/g)...in his 8 starts Reds batters hit .226 (60-266)...on 4/23 at Chi recorded the 1,000th strikeout of his career (Derrek Lee)...his 3-hitter in the club's fifth game, a 2-0 win on 4/12 vs Pit, was the quickest complete game by a Reds pitcher since Pete Harnisch threw a CG in the Reds' fourth game of 1999.

Astronomical: In his 2 starts vs the Astros this season, a 7-0 loss at Hou on 4/18 and an 8-3 loss at Cin on 4/28, allowed 10 earned runs in 11.0 innings...in his other 6 starts went **3-2, 2.18** (41.1ip, 10er).

<u>Staff Ace</u>: Since he was acquired from the Athletics at the **2003** trading deadline is the Reds' leader in most statistical pitching categories, including starts (175), wins (66), innings pitched (1121.1) and strikeouts (944)...since the beginning of the **2006 season** leads the National League in innings pitched (**702.2**)...in 2005 and 2007 won the BBWAA's Johnny Vander Meer Award as the club's Most Outstanding Pitcher.
