Zeroes

With Wed's 3-0 win vs Hou and last night's 4-0 win at Pit, the Reds have produced consecutive shutout victories for the first time since 4-0 and 1-0 wins vs the Dodgers on 8/7 and 8/8, 2007...haven't had 3 consecutive shutout wins since 6/21-6/23, 1963 vs Hou (3-0, 3-0, 4-0)...the Reds' current 19.0-inning scoreless streak is their longest since a 19.0-inning scoreless streak from 7/14-7/16, 2002...haven't thrown more than 19.0 consecutive scoreless innings since a 25.0-inning streak of zeroes from 8/11-8/14, 2000...Reds pitchers haven't thrown more than 25.0 straight scoreless innings since a 32.0-inning stretch from 6/20-6/24, 1963 that included the 3 shutouts vs the Astros.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is Game 2 (1-0) of a 3-game series vs Terry Rodgers' Pirates and Game 2 (1-0) of a 5-game road trip that also includes a brief stop in Fla (2g)...the Reds are coming off a 2-4 homestand vs the Braves (1-2) and Astros (1-2)...following this trip return to GABP for a 5-game homestand vs the Brewers (2g) and Cardinals (3g).

ROAD WARRIORS: At 8-3 the Reds are off to their best start on the road since 2002, when they won their first 4 series of the season and also began 8-3 (2-1 at Pit, 2-1 at Phi, 2-1 at Chi, 2-0 at LA before losing the series finale)...on their first road trip of this season the Redlegs went 7-3 and won all 3 series (2-1 at Mil, 3-1 at Hou, 2-1 at Chi)...most recently won 4 consecutive road series from 8/8-8/28, 2005 (3-0 at Chi, 2-1 at Mil, 2-1 at Wsh, 3-0 at Pit).

QUALITY CONTROL: In the Reds' 22g the opposing pitcher has produced 16 quality starts, including 11 straight from 4/14-4/25...the Reds went 9-7 when the opposing starter produced a quality appearance...the Reds have produced 10 quality starts (Arroyo 3, Harang 2, Cueto 2, Volquez 2, Owings 1)...Cin went 9-1 in those quality starts (.900).

BARNHILL FIELD: Earlier today the Reds Community Fund hosted a dedication ceremony for the Kevin C. Barnhill Championship Field at Testerman Park, a baseball and softball facility for the greater Hamilton Township area...the Maineville park will service the Warren County Little League and District #34 Little Miami Knothole Youth Baseball League...the field was funded in part by the RCF and Baseball Tomorrow Fund...the Little Miami High School graduate and Maineville resident was a Reds employee when he killed in August 2006...for information on the Kevin C. Barnhill Memorial Scholarship Fund, long on to www.kevinbarnhill10.org.

CENTRAL CASTING: Tonight's game is Game 20 in a stretch of 18-21g and 23-28g against National League Central opponents (11-8 overall, 10-6 vs NL Central, 1-1 vs Pit, 2-1 at Mil, 3-1 at Hou, 2-1 at Chi, 1-2 vs Atl, 1-2 vs Hou, 1-0 at Pit, 2g at Fla, 2g vs Mil, 3g vs StL).

DOT. DOT. DOT...: For the second straight day the Reds face a season-high 4.0-game deficit...1B Joey Votto is the only Reds player to have played every inning of every game...in the last 14g Reds relievers have posted a 3.00era (36ip, 12er).

AND THE WINNER IS...: RHP Edinson Volquez was the pitcher selected as the Fans' Choice Bobblehead to be given to the first 30,000 fans on Sat, 7/18 vs Mil...Volquez received 3,047 of the 7,344 votes (41.5%) cast online at reds.com...his bobblehead is part of a collectible set of 4 that also features Joey Votto (Sat, 5/9 StL), Jay Bruce (Sat, 7/4 vs StL) and Brandon Phillips (Sat, 8/15 vs Wsh).

ALL-STARS AMONG US: Major League Baseball and People magazine invite fans to nominate individuals who have gone above and beyond to serve their communities during these difficult times...30 Everyday All-Stars, one representing each team, will attend and be honored at the All-Star Game in St. Louis...one person will be featured in People magazine...to nominate an Everyday All-Star, log on to PeopleAllStars.com.

HEALTHY RECIPES: On Tuesday the Reds disabled 3B Edwin Encarnacion (chip fracture, left wrist) and recalled IF Adam Rosales...those roster moves, on the 23rd day of the season, were the first by the Reds since final cuts the day before Opening Day...was the club's longest stretch to start a season without a roster move since 1985, when on the 37th day (5/14) the Reds recalled Alan Knicely and Ron Robinson and optioned to Class AAA Denver Dann Bilardello and Carl Willis...in 2009, the Reds began a season without a player on the disabled list for the first time since 1990.

VETERAN LEADERSHIP: LHP Arthur Rhodes and RHP David Weathers, both 39 years old, this season have combined for 15 apps and 14.1 scoreless innings...opponents are hitting .170 against them (8-47)...together they have made 1,625 Major League apps for 13 teams...33-year-old RHP Francisco Cordero has converted all 7 save opps while posting a 2.70era in his 10 apps.

.500: At 9-6 the Reds were 3g over .500 this late in a season for the first time since they were 3g over at 67-64 in 2006...haven't been 4g over .500 since they were 67-63 in 2006...during that 2006 season the Redlegs reached a season-high 12g over .500 at 36-24.

PLAYING FROM BEHIND: The Reds have trailed in 15 of their 22g this season...7 times allowed runs in the first inning...last season the Reds went 26-69 when the opponent scored first and 48-19 when they scored first.

REDS ON THE ROAD (8-3, .737): On their first road trip the Reds went 7-3 and won all 3 series (2-1 at Mil, 3-1 at Hou, 2-1 at Chi)...through that first trip Cin's 7 road wins were the most in the Major Leagues...won 3 consecutive road series for the first time since they went 6-2 over 2 trips from 8/3-8/19, 2007 (2-0 at Pit, 2-1 at Chi & 2-1 at Mil)...won 3 series on the same road trip for the first time since 9/21-9/30, 2004 (2-1 at Atl, 2-1 at Pit, 3-1 at Chi)...won 7g on a single road trip for the first time since 5/29-6/7, 2006 (7-2 overall, 1-2 at Chi, 3-0 at Hou, 3-0 at StL)...entering this season and dating back to 2006, the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips.

IN THE STANDINGS (26): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 0, SECOND - 4, THIRD - 10, FOURTH - 8, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...have spent 14 days above, 5 days at and 7 days below .500.

REDS vs PIRATES: The Reds are 971-1,016 all-time vs the Pirates, including 2-1 this season...at Great American Ball Park: Reds are 26-29 all-time, including 1-1 this season...at PNC Park: Reds are 32-30 all-time, including 1-0 this season...last Reds sweep: at Pit: 8/3-8/4, 2007 (2g); 8/26-8/28, 2005 (3g); 7/2-7/5, 1992 (4g).

Last Pitched: Sun vs Atl and earned the 8-2 victory (7ip, 6h, 1er, 3bb, 6k, 1hr, 102 pitches, 60 strikes)...left leading, 8-1...allowed only a solo HR to David Ross with 1 out in the seventh inning...his first victory since May 2008 snapped a personal 9-game losing streak.

Red Hots: Is making his fourth start of the season...in his 3 starts the Reds went 1-2 and scored 13 runs (3.25 r/g)...has 1 quality start...with an 8-2 win on 4/26 vs Atl snapped his 9-game losing streak dating back to a 9-3 Diamondbacks victory on 5/25/08 at Atl...in 14 apps and 10 starts between wins went **0-9, 8.53** (51.2ip, 49er).

At The Plate: Overall this season is hitting .364 (4-11, 3 2b, 2rbi), including 2-for-3 with 2rbi as a pinch hitter...is tied for the club lead in pinch-hit RBI and ranks second in pinch hits...in the seventh inning of the 4-2 win on 4/19 at Hou snapped the 1-1 tie with a pinch-hit, 2-run double off **Geoff Geary**...in his career has **3 game-winning RBI** as a pinch hitter (2gwrbi in 2008, 1gwrbi in 2009)...over the last 5 seasons, the only other *pitcher* to produce a pinch-hit, game-winning RBI is Hou's **Jason Jennings** in the 14th inning of a 12-11 victory at Atl on 8/2/07 (RBI-single off Oscar Villarreal)...courtesy Elias Sports Bureau.

2008 Season: Began the season with the Diamondbacks and went 6-9, 5.93 in 18 starts and 4 relief apps before he was optioned to Class AAA Tucson on 7/29...made Ari's Opening Day roster...in his first 4 starts went 4-0, 2.42...produced 9 quality starts...was bothered late in the season by a sore right shoulder and made just 2 minor league starts...on 9/12 was acquired by the Reds to complete the 8/11 deal that sent OF Adam Dunn to the Diamondbacks...did not pitch for the Reds but in 4 pinch-hit apps produced 3rbi and 2 game-winning hits...in the 3-2 win on 9/13 at Ari made his Reds debut in the 10th inning produced an RBI-double off Tony Pena that snapped the 2-2 tie...in the 4-3 win on 9/20 vs Mil produced a 2-run single off CC Sabathia that erased the 3-2 deficit.

Silver Slugger: Has 5 career home runs...in 2007 won the National League's Silver Slugger Award (.333, 4hr, 15rbi)...that season led all NL pitchers in HR and RBI...his 4 homers were the most by a pitcher in a single season since KC's Jim Rooker hit 4hr in 1969...last season, with Ari and Cin combined to hit .304 (1hr, 6rbi), including .294 as a pinch hitter (5-17, 1hr, 5rbi)...on 4/30 vs Hou tied the game with a pinch-hit, 2-run HR off Dave Borkowski...became the first pitcher to produce a pinch-hit HR since Mil's Brooks Kieschnick did it on 4/22/04 vs Ari.

Owings' Most Recent Starts: **4/15 at Mil**, in his Reds pitching debut suffered the 9-3 loss (5+ip, 5h, 4er, 2bb, 2k, 2hr, 89 pitches, 47 strikes)...left with the score tied, 3-3, but was charged with another run scored off Burton...the Brewers added 4 more runs off Burton in that 5-run sixth inning...Owings allowed Fielder's sac fly in the first and leadoff HR to Cameron in both the second and fourth frames...**4/21 at Chi**, in the Reds' first game of the season at Wrigley Field and suffered the 7-2 loss (4.2ip, 5h, 5r, 2er, 4bb, 3k, 1hr, 94 pitches, 61 strikes)...left trailing, 4-2, but was charged with another run scored off Lincoln...in the second inning allowed a leadoff HR to Micah Hoffpauir...in the fifth was charged with 3 unearned runs...start of the game was delayed 12 minutes by weather...gametime temperature was 40 degrees with a 15 mile per hour wind blowing left to right.

Tomorrow's Pitcher: RHP Johnny Cueto

Last Pitched: Mon vs Hou and received no decision in the 4-1 loss (7ip, 7h, 1er, 1bb, 5k, 1hr, 98 pitches, 64 strikes)...left with the score tied, 1-1...allowed only a solo HR to Berkman leading off the sixth inning, snapping his scoreless streak at career-high 12 innings... was Berkman's 20th career homer at Great American Ball Park, the most by any opposing player...the Astros scored 3 runs in the ninth off Cordero.

Red Hots: The 23-year-old righthander tomorrow will make his fifth start of the season and the 36th start of his career...in his last 3 starts is 1-0, 0.96 (18.2ip, 2er)...in his 4 starts the Reds went 2-2 and scored 8 runs (2 r/g)...in his last 2 apps produced both of his quality starts...on 4/22 at Chi singled twice off Ted Lilly for his first career 2-hit game.

World Baseball Classic: Started the Dominican Republic's second game of the tournament and threw 4.2 scoreless innings to earn the 9-0 win vs Panama in the San Juan bracket (4.2ip, 3h, 1bb, 5k).

Cueto's Most Recent Starts: **4/11 vs Pit**, in his season debut suffered the 10-2 loss (6ip, 8h, 4er, 1bb, 9k, 1hr, 109 pitches, 67 strikes)...left trailing, 4-0...allowed McLouth's 2-run HR in the first inning...in the fourth allowed Wilson's RBI-double and Morgan's RBI-triple...**4/17 at Hou**, in his second start of the season received no decision in the dramatic 2-1 victory (4.1ip, 2h, 1er, 6bb, 3k, 88 pitches, 46 strikes)...left trailing, 1-0...allowed only 1 hit through 4.2 scoreless innings - an infield single by Tejada leading off the fourth - but with 2 outs in the fifth walked Oswalt and Bourn, allowed a single to Tejada and then walked Berkman to force in the game's first run...Lincoln then came in to induce Lee to ground out and end the inning...Cueto, Lincoln, Herrera, Masset and Cordero held Astros hitters to 4 singles...the Reds took the lead in the ninth on Hernandez' 1-out, 2-run HR off Valverde...including the no-decision, in 29 career apps vs the Reds Oswalt is 23-1, 2.39...**4/22 at Chi**, in one of the best starts of his career threw 7.0 shutout innings to earn the 3-0 victory (4h, 0bb, 3k, 108 pitches, 68 strikes)...left leading, 1-0...the Reds added insurance runs in the eighth and ninth innings...singled twice off Lilly, his first career 2-hit game.
