## Kid Glove

Tonight's game is the last of this season's 4 **Kid Glove** contests...in pregame ceremonies (6:50 p.m.), **Paul Kramer**, executive secretary of the Powell Crosley Jr. Amateur Baseball Fund, will present plaques and engraved bats to 2009 Kid Glove games chairmen **Thom Brennaman** and **Jay Bruce...Kramer** also will make a presentation to **Gregg Sample**, son of the late **Glenn Sample**...for 30 years, **Glenn Sample** worked for Major League Baseball as an official scorer at Reds games and was a major contributor to youth baseball in our region.

**TONIGHT'S GAME**: Is **Game 2** (0-1) of a 3-game series vs **Kevin Gregg's** defending World Series champion Phillies and **Game 2** (0-1) of a 9-game homestand that also includes the **Indians** (3g) and **Astros** (3g)...the Reds are coming off a **3-3** road trip to **Ari** (3-0) and **SD** (0-3) that included the Reds' first 3-game sweep victory at Ari's **Chase Field** since **June 1999** and their first sweep loss in San Diego since **June 2000** at **Qualcomm Stadium**.

MEDICAL UPDATE: 1B Joey Votto has undergone a series of tests at the Scripps Clinic in San Diego and here in Cincinnati...more tests have been scheduled...after those additional tests, the club will be more prepared to discuss the cause of his dizziness...since 5/7, Votto has missed 7 starts with the flu or dizziness and twice more left games early.

<u>STREAKING</u>: The Reds' **4-game losing streak** is their longest of the season...their **4.5-game deficit** is their highest of the season...are **3-1-2** in their last 6 series (2-1 at Pit, 1-1 at Fla, 1-1 vs Mil, 2-1 vs StL, 3-0 at Ari, 0-3 at SD).

<u>FOR STARTERS...</u>: Through the first 38g the Reds used only **5 starting pitchers**, their longest such streak to begin a season since **RHP John Roper** became the staff's **sixth** different starter in the **42nd game** of the **1994 season**.

<u>BIRTHDAY BOYS</u>: IF Adam Rosales (26) and C Ramon Hernandez (33) are celebrating birthdays today...on their birthdays, **Hernandez** has gone 4-for-20 with 1hr and 3rbi in his Major League career while **Rosales** went 3-for-8 with 2rbi and 2 runs scored in the minors.

**QUALITY CONTROL**: In the Reds' 38g the opposing pitcher produced **24 quality starts**, including 11 straight from **4/14-4/25**...the Reds went **11-13** (.458) when the opposing starter produced a quality appearance...the Reds have produced 18 quality starts (**Cueto** 5, **Harang** 4, **Arroyo** 4, **Volquez** 3, **Owings** 2) and went **15-3** in those QS (.833).

<u>ZEROES</u>: Reds pitchers lead the National League with 6 team shutouts (SF 2nd w/ 5sho)...produced those 6 shutouts in their first 26g, their fastest to 6 blankings since the 1914 staff threw its sixth shutout in the 25th game...Cin produced 6 team shutouts all of last season.

MICAH IN A PINCH: This season Micah Owings as a pinch hitter is 3-for-5 with a home run (5/10 vs StL, solo off Ryan Franklin)...is tied for the club lead in pinch-hit HR (1) and RBI (3) and ranks second in pinch hits (3)...in the seventh inning of the 4-2 win on 4/19 at Hou snapped the 1-1 tie with a pinch-hit, 2-run double off Geoff Geary...was his third career game-winning RBI as a pinch hitter (2gwrbi in 2008, 1gwrbi in 2009)...over the last 5 seasons, the only other pitcher to produce a pinch-hit, game-winning RBI is Hou's Jason Jennings in the 14th inning of a 12-11 victory at Atl on 8/2/07 (RBI-single off Oscar Villarreal)...Owings has 2 career pinch-hit HR, both of which tied games...in the last 50 years, the only other pitcher to hit a pinch-hit HR that tied a game was Brooks Kieschnick of the Brewers, who did it in 2003 and 2004...notes courtesy Elias Sports Bureau.

GILLETTE CIVIL RIGHTS GAME: At Great American Ball Park on Sat, 6/20 the Reds and Chicago White Sox will meet in the Gillette Civil Rights Game, the first time the contest will be played during the regular season...the weekend's festivities will include a roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's Harriet Tubman Theater (Fri, 6/19, 4:00 p.m.), a luncheon at Duke Energy Center honoring the 3 winners of Major League Baseball's Beacon Awards (Sat, 6/20, 11:30 a.m.) and a Youth Summit at Fountain Square downtown (Sat, 6/20, 4:00 p.m.)...the luncheon on Sat, 6/20 will honor Beacon of Hope winner Bill Cosby, Beacon of Life winner Hank Aaron and Beacon of Change winner Muhammad Ali...former President Bill Clinton will be the keynote speaker at that luncheon...for more information, log on to <a href="https://www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame">www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame</a>.

ALL-STARS AMONG US: Major League Baseball and *People* magazine invite fans to nominate individuals who have gone above and beyond to serve their communities during these difficult times...30 Everyday All-Stars, one representing each team, will attend and be honored at the All-Star Game in St. Louis...one person will be featured in *People* magazine...to nominate an Everyday All-Star, log on to PeopleAllStars.com.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (7-10, .412): The Reds went 1-3-2 in their first 6 home series and produced a winning record on just 1 of their first 3 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2)...in 7 seasons at GABP are 248-255-1...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38).

REDS ON THE ROAD (13-8, .619): At 13-8 (.619) the Reds have the most road victories in the Major Leagues (tied w/ Phi & Mil)...went 5-1-1 in their first 7 road series...produced winning records on each of their first 2 road trips (7-3, 3-2) and a .500 record on the third trip (3-3)...entering this season and dating back to 2006, the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips.

IN THE STANDINGS (44): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 8, THIRD - 15, FOURTH - 16, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...at 20-15 were a season-high 6g over .500 for the first time since the 2006 season, when they reached a season-high 12g over .500 at 36-24...have spent 32 days above, 5 days at and 7 days below .500.

**REDS** vs **PHILLIES**: Reds are 1,043-840 all-time vs the Phillies, including 0-1 in 2009 and 3-6 the last 2 seasons... **at Great American Ball Park**: Reds are 9-14, including 0-1 this season...**last Phillies sweep**: at Cin: 4/26-4/28, 1996 (2g); 5/12-5/14, 2006 (3g)...at Phi: 4/9-4/10, 1963 (2g); 4/12-4/14, 1993 (3g); 5/13-5/15, 1975 (4g).

<u>Last Started</u>: Fri at SD, returned to his hometown and in his 200th career appearance suffered the 5-3 loss (6.1ip, 8h, 5er, 2bb, 6k, 1hr, 108 pitches, 65 strikes)...left with 2 runners on base and the score tied, 3-3, but was charged with 2 runs scored off Weathers...with 2 outs in the first inning allowed a solo HR to Gonzalez, who homered in his fifth straight game to tie the club record...retired the first 2 batters of the sixth inning but then allowed a single to Gerut and an RBI-double to Kouzmanoff...was replaced in the seventh inning after Eckstein's RBI-single tied it at 3-3.

Red Hots: Is making his ninth start of the season...originally was scheduled to start tomorrow but was pushed up after Micah Owings came out of the bullpen to throw the last 5.2 innings of Sat's 16-inning, 6-5 loss at SD...in his previous 8 starts the Reds went 3-5 and scored just 26 runs (3.25 r/g)...in his 8 starts Reds batters hit .226 (60-266)...on 4/23 at Chi recorded the 1,000th strikeout of his career (Derrek Lee)...his 3-hitter in the club's fifth game, a 2-0 win on 4/12 vs Pit, was the quickest complete game by a Reds pitcher since Pete Harnisch threw a CG in the Reds' fourth game of 1999.

**Astronomical**: In his 2 starts vs the Astros this season, a 7-0 loss at Hou on 4/18 and an 8-3 loss at Cin on 4/28, allowed 10 earned runs in 11.0 innings...in his other 6 starts went **3-2**, **2.18** (41.1ip, 10er).

Opening Day: In the 2-1 loss vs the Mets made his fourth straight Opening Day start, the first Reds pitcher to do so since RHP Jose Rijo had the honors in 4 straight seasons from 1992-95...the only other Reds pitchers to make at least 4 consecutive Opening Day starts are Pete Donohue (5 straight, 1923-27) and Mario Soto (5, 1982-86)...Soto holds the club record for overall Opening Day starts (6)...in 4 career Opening Day starts Harang is 1-3, 3.52 (23ip, 9er).

Staff Ace: Since he was acquired from the Athletics at the 2003 trading deadline is the Reds' leader in most statistical pitching categories, including starts (175), wins (66), innings pitched (1121.1) and strikeouts (944)...since the beginning of the 2006 season leads the National League in innings pitched (702.2)...in 2005 and 2007 won the BBWAA's Johnny Vander Meer Award as the club's Most Outstanding Pitcher.

Harang vs Phillies: Is making his eighth career start and his ninth career appearance vs Phi...made his only relief appearance vs Phi on 8/11/06 at Citizens Bank Park...in that 14-inning, 6-5 loss threw a scoreless 13th inning as the eighth of Cin's 9 pitchers... that relief appearance snapped his streak of consecutive starts at 100.

Community Affairs: Is one of the club's more active members of the local community...for the third straight season, as part of his Aaron's Aces ticket program is hosting at all Sunday home games children of military personnel serving in the War On Terrorism...along with wife Jen donated \$55,000 to the Miracle League of Greater Cincinnati and Northern Kentucky and on 5/9 attended the dedication of that field at the Durham Recreation Complex in Western Hills...for his community service has been the club's nominee for the Robert Clemente Award (2007), Branch Rickey Award (2007) and Marvin Miller Man of the Year Award (2007, 2008).

## **Tomorrow's Pitcher: RHP Micah Owings**

<u>Last Pitched</u>: Sat at SD, threw a career-high 5.2 innings in relief and suffered the 16-inning, 6-5 loss (3h, 1er, 3bb, 5k, 1hr, 81 pitches, 44 strikes)...entered the game in the 11th inning as the Reds' seventh and final pitcher...retired his first 10 batters until Scott Hairston singled with 1 out in the 14th inning...Nick Hundley homered to end the 5-hour, 14 minute struggle.

<u>Last Started</u>: On 5/12 at Ari, in his first career appearance vs his former team earned the 3-1 victory (7+ip, 4h, 1er, 2bb, 4k, 1hbp, 90 pitches, 53 strikes)...took a 4-hit shutout into the eighth inning but then hit with a pitch leadoff batter Ryan Roberts...was charged with that run, which scored on Felipe Lopez' RBI-double off Arthur Rhodes.

Red Hots: Tomorrow will make his seventh start of the season...in his 6 starts the Reds went 3-3 and scored 28 runs (4.67 r/g)...has 2 quality starts...with an 8-2 win on 4/26 vs Atl snapped his 9-game losing streak dating back to a 9-3 Diamondbacks victory on 5/25/08 at Atl...in 14 apps and 10 starts between victories went **0-9**, **8.53** (51.2ip, 49er).

At The Plate: In 2007 won the National League's Silver Slugger Award (.333, 4hr, 15rbi)...has 6 career home runs, including 1 this season (5/10 vs StL, pinch-hit solo off Ryan Franklin)...his 5 career home runs prior to 2009 are listed on page 149 of the media guide... overall this season is hitting .273 (6-22, 3 2b, 1 3b, 1hr, 4rbi)... on 5/7 vs Mil produced the first triple by a Reds pitcher since Eric Milton did it on 4/13/06 at Cubs.
