Interleague Play Begins Tomorrow

This weekend the Reds will host the Indians to kick off the 13th season of interleague games...Cin also will host the White Sox during Civil Rights Game weekend (6/19-6/21) while traveling to KC (6/12-6/14), to Tor (6/23-6/25) and to Cle (6/26-6/28)...the Reds are 77-95 (.448) all-time vs American League teams, including 9-6 last season (3-0 vs Cle, 1-2 vs Bos, 2-1 at NYY, 1-2 at Tor, 2-1 at Cle)...at 9-6 had a winning record against the AL for the first time since 2003 (7-5) and the best interleague record by any National League team, along with the Mets...RHP Aaron Harang's 3.12era in interleague play is seventh-best of any pitcher...the Reds' all-time results vs American League teams can be found on page 351 of the media guide...interleague play information is available on the press box table.

TODAY'S GAME: Is **Game 3** (1-1) of a 3-game series vs **Kevin Gregg's** defending World Series champion Phillies and **Game 3** (1-1) of a 9-game homestand that also includes the **Indians** (3g) and **Astros** (3g)...following this homestand the Reds take to the road again for a 3-game series at **Mil** followed by a 4-game set at **StL**.

FRIENDS OF REDS BASEBALL: This afternoon Alex Gonzalez and Ramon Hernandez are hosting from the Academy of Multilingual Immersion Studies 100 fans in sun deck Section 143 as part of their Los Amigos del Beisbol de Los Rojos ticket program targeting local hispanic families...today's guests received transportation to and from the game, a custom Reds cap, a \$10 concession voucher and in-stadium welcomes via the public address announcer and scoreboard.

MEDIA ADVISORY: The official dedication for Brandon Phillips Field, located at Clark Montessori School at 5425 Winton Ridge Lane in Cincinnati, is scheduled for noon Saturday...the club's Gold Glove second baseman will throw out the ceremonial first pitch before a game involving teams from the Reds Community Fund's RBI program...Phillips contributed \$32,000 to the project, including \$7,000 he received as the team's 2008 Roberto Clemente Award winner... the Reds Community Fund donated an additional \$20,000 to the development of the project as part of its field renovation program and new partnership with Cincinnati Public Schools...Sat's ceremony is not open to the public.

<u>FOR STARTERS...</u>: Through the first 39g the Reds used only **5 starting pitchers**, their longest such streak to begin a season since **RHP John Roper** became the staff's **sixth** different starter in the **42nd game** of the **1994 season**.

DOT, DOT. DOT...: Today's ceremonial first pitch will be tossed by **Joe Rief**, a senior at Campbell County High School who earlier this month threw a 45-pitch, 5-inning perfect game in a 14-0 defeat of Calvary Christian...**2B Brandon Phillips** tripled in each of the last 2g...he is the only player in the 7-year history of Great American Ball Park to triple in consecutive games, and he's now done it twice (8/6 vs Mil & 8/7 vs Hou of last season)...the Reds' are **3-1-2** in their last 6 completed series (2-1 at Pit, 1-1 at Fla, 1-1 vs Mil, 2-1 vs StL, 3-0 at Ari, 0-3 at SD)...are **16-2** (.889) when they score first, second-best winning percentage in the Major Leagues behind the Giants' 15-1 mark (.938), and **5-16** when the opponent scores first...**Jay Bruce** and LA's **Matt Kemp** share the National League lead with **6 outfield assists**... today **Bruce** reached 1.000 year of service time.

QUALITY CONTROL: In the Reds' 39g the opposing pitcher produced **25 quality starts**, including 11 straight from **4/14-4/25**...the Reds went **12-13** (.480) when the opposing starter produced a quality appearance...the Reds have produced 19 quality starts (**Cueto** 5, **Harang** 5, **Arroyo** 4, **Volquez** 3, **Owings** 2) and went **16-3** in those QS (.842).

<u>ZEROES</u>: Reds pitchers lead the National League with 6 team shutouts (SF 2nd w/ 5sho)...produced those 6 shutouts in their first 26g, their fastest to 6 blankings since the 1914 staff threw its sixth shutout in the 25th game...Cin produced 6 team shutouts all of last season.

GILLETTE CIVIL RIGHTS GAME: At Great American Ball Park on Sat, 6/20 the Reds and Chicago White Sox will meet in the Gillette Civil Rights Game, the first time the contest will be played during the regular season...the weekend's festivities will include a roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's Harriet Tubman Theater (Fri, 6/19, 4:00 p.m.), a luncheon at Duke Energy Center honoring the 3 winners of Major League Baseball's Beacon Awards (Sat, 6/20, 11:30 a.m.) and a Youth Summit at Fountain Square downtown (Sat, 6/20, 4:00 p.m.)...the luncheon on Sat, 6/20 will honor Beacon of Hope winner Bill Cosby, Beacon of Life winner Hank Aaron and Beacon of Change winner Muhammad Ali...former President Bill Clinton will be the keynote speaker at that luncheon...for more information, log on to www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (8-10, .444): The Reds went 1-3-2 in their first 6 completed home series and produced a winning record on just 1 of their first 3 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2)...in 7 seasons at GABP are 249-255-1...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38)...at 217-217-1 the Reds had evened their overall record at GABP for the first time since 6/26/04 (57-57)...also reached .500 at 219-219-1.

REDS ON THE ROAD (13-8, .619): At 13-8 (.619) the Reds have the most road victories in the Major Leagues (tied w/ Phi & Mil)...went 5-1-1 in their first 7 road series...produced winning records on each of their first 2 road trips (7-3, 3-2) and a .500 record on the third trip (3-3)...entering this season and dating back to 2006, the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips.

IN THE STANDINGS (45): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 8, THIRD - 15, FOURTH - 17, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...at 20-15 were a season-high 6g over .500 for the first time since the 2006 season, when they reached a season-high 12g over .500 at 36-24...have spent 33 days above, 5 days at and 7 days below .500.

REDS vs PHILLIES: Reds are 1,044-840 all-time vs the Phillies, including 1-1 in 2009 and 3-6 the last 2 seasons...<u>at Great American Ball Park</u>: Reds are 10-14, including 1-1 this season...<u>at Citizens Bank Park</u>: Reds are 7-10, including 1-3 in 2008 and 2-5 the last 2 seasons.

<u>UP NEXT: REDS vs INDIANS</u>: The Reds are 27-30 all-time vs the Indians, including 5-1 in 2008 to win the coveted **Ohio Cup** trophy, presented by **The Ohio Lottery**...the Reds recorded a 3-game sweep at Great American Ball Park in May and a 2-1 series victory in June at Progressive Field...Reds **OF Adam Dunn** received the series' **Ohio Lottery Most Outstanding Player** award after hitting .300 (6-20) and leading all players with 5hr and 10rbi.

Last Pitched: Sat at SD, threw a career-high 5.2 innings in relief and suffered the 16-inning, 6-5 loss (3h, 1er, 3bb, 5k, 1hr, 81 pitches, 44 strikes)...entered the game in the 11th inning as the Reds' seventh and final pitcher...retired his first 10 batters until Scott Hairston singled with 1 out in the 14th inning...Nick Hundley homered to end the 5-hour, 14 minute struggle.

<u>Last Started</u>: On 5/12 at Ari, in his first career appearance vs his former team earned the 3-1 victory (7+ip, 4h, 1er, 2bb, 4k, 1hbp, 90 pitches, 53 strikes)...took a 4-hit shutout into the eighth inning but then hit with a pitch leadoff batter Ryan Roberts...was charged with that run, which scored on Felipe Lopez' RBI-double off Arthur Rhodes.

Red Hots: Is making his seventh start of the season...in his 6 starts the Reds went 3-3 and scored 28 runs (4.67 r/g)...has 2 quality starts...with an 8-2 win on 4/26 vs Atl snapped his 9-game losing streak dating back to a 9-3 Diamondbacks victory on 5/25/08 at Atl...in 14 apps and 10 starts between victories went **0-9**, **8.53** (51.2ip, 49er).

At The Plate: In 2007 won the National League's Silver Slugger Award (.333, 4hr, 15rbi)...has 6 career home runs, including 1 this season (5/10 vs StL, pinch-hit solo off Ryan Franklin)...his 5 career home runs prior to 2009 are listed on page 149 of the media guide...overall this season is hitting .273 (6-22, 3 2b, 1 3b, 1hr, 4rbi)...on 5/7 vs Mil produced the first triple by a Reds pitcher since Eric Milton did it on 4/13/06 at Cubs.

<u>Owings vs Phillies</u>: Is making his fifth career appearance and fourth career start vs Phi.

<u>Career Highs</u>: Innings: 9.0 (2x), 5/24/07 vs Hou & 9/18/07 vs SF; **Hits**: 10, vs 5/2/08 vs NYM; **Runs**: 8, 7/28/08 at SD; **Earned Runs**: 8, 7/28/08 at SD; **Walks**: 5, 7/9/08 at Wsh; **Strikeouts**: 10, 5/20/08 at Fla; **HR allowed**: 4, 9/3/07 vs SD.

Owings' Most Recent Starts: 4/15 at Mil, in his Reds pitching debut suffered the 9-3 loss (5+ip, 5h, 4er, 2bb, 2k, 2hr, 89 pitches, 47 strikes)...left with the score tied, 3-3, but was charged with another run scored off Burton...the Brewers added 4 more runs off Burton in that 5-run sixth inning...Owings allowed Fielder's sac fly in the first and leadoff HR to Cameron in both the second and fourth frames...4/21 at Chi, in the Reds' first game of the season at Wrigley Field and suffered the 7-2 loss (4.2ip, 5h, 5r, 2er, 4bb, 3k, 1hr, 94 pitches, 61 strikes)...left trailing, 4-2, but was charged with another run scored off Lincoln...in the second inning allowed a leadoff HR to Micah Hoffpauir...in the fifth was charged with 3 unearned runs...start of the game was delayed 12 minutes by weather...gametime temperature was 40 degrees with a 15 mile per hour wind blowing left to right...4/26 vs Atl and earned the 8-2 victory (7ip, 6h, 1er, 3bb, 6k, 1hr, 102 pitches, 60 strikes)...left leading, 8-1...allowed only a solo HR to David Ross with 1 out in the seventh inning...his first victory since May 2008 snapped a personal 9-game losing streak...5/2 at Pit and suffered the 8-6 loss (5.2ip, 9h, 5er, 2bb, 0k, 99 pitches, 64 strikes)...left trailing, 5-3...in the first inning allowed 4 runs on 4 hits, 1 walk and 1 hit batter...5/7 vs Mil and earned the 6-5 victory (6ip, 7h, 5r, 4er, 1bb, 4k, 100 pitches, 67 strikes)...left leading, 6-5...allowed 3 runs in the fourth inning and 2 runs in the sixth...his RBI-triple in the bottom of the fourth off Braden Looper gave the Reds a 4-3 lead they would not relinquish.

Tomorrow vs Indians: Bronson Arroyo

Last Pitched: Sun at SD and suffered the 3-1 loss (7+ip, 6h, 3er, 4bb, 4k, 1hr, 119 pitches, 70 strikes)...allowed 2 runs in the first inning on consecutive 2-out, RBI-singles by Kouzmanoff and Gerut... allowed a HR to Kouzmanoff leading off the eighth.

Red Hots: Tomorrow vs Cle will make his ninth start of the season... in his previous 8 starts the Reds went 5-3 and scored 41 runs (5.13 r/g)...has 4 quality starts...since he was acquired by the Reds prior to the 2006 season leads all Major League pitchers with 111 starts and ranks third in the National League with 699.1 innings pitched.

<u>Short Cuts</u>: Made the 2 shortest starts of his career (1ip, plus 4 batters) in a 14-1 loss at Tor on 6/24/08 and a 15-3 loss on 5/6/09 vs Mil...in between those 2 starts went **15-5**, **3.76**...his 15 victories in that span was second-most in the Major Leagues (**Roy Halladay**, 17-6, 2.77)...since that loss at Tor last season, still ranks T2nd in the majors with **16 wins**.

Perfect: Began the season 3-0 for the third time in his career but for the first time won his first 3 starts of a season...won his first 2 starts in 2006, when he started off 5-0...began the 2005 campaign 4-0...was the first Reds pitcher to begin the season in the rotation and win his first 3 starts since **LHP Pete Schourek** did it in 1996 and the first righthander since **Jack Armstrong** won his first 5 starts of 1990.
