Gillette CIVIL RIGHTS GAME

On this date in 1921, Negro Leaguer **John Beckwith** of the Chicago Giants became the first player to hit a home run out of Redland/Crosley Field when he cleared the left field wall with a 370-foot shot in a game against the Cincinnati Cuban Stars of the Negro National League...on **May 22, 1998** **Frank Robinson** became the first African-American player to have his uniform number retired by the Reds.

At Great American Ball Park on **Sat, 6/20** the Reds and Chicago White Sox will meet in the **Gillette Civil Rights Game**, the first time the contest will be played during the

regular season...the weekend's festivities will include a roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's **Harriet Tubman Theater** (Fri, 6/19, 4:00 p.m.), a luncheon at **Duke Energy Center** honoring the 3 winners of Major League Baseball's **Beacon Awards** (Sat, 6/20, 11:30 a.m.) and a **Youth Summit** at **Fountain Square** downtown (Sat, 6/20, 4:00 p.m.)...the luncheon on Sat, 6/20 will honor Beacon of Hope winner **Bill Cosby**, Beacon of Life winner **Hank Aaron** and Beacon of Change winner **Muhammad Ali**...former **President Bill Clinton** will be the keynote speaker at that luncheon...for more information, log on to www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is **Game 1** of a 3-game series vs **Bart Swain's** Indians and **Game 4** (1-2) of a 9-game homestand that also includes the **Phillies** (1-2) and **Astros** (3g)...following this homestand the Reds take to the road again for a 3-game weekend series at **Mil** followed by a 4-game set at **StL**.

INTERLEAGUE PLAY: Tonight the Reds and Indians kick off the 13th season of interleague games...Cin also will host the **White Sox** during **Civil Rights Game** weekend (6/19-6/21) while traveling to **KC** (6/12-6/14), to **Tor** (6/23-6/25) and to **Cle** (6/26-6/28)...the Reds are **77-95 (.448)** all-time vs American League teams, including **9-6 last season** (3-0 vs Cle, 1-2 vs Bos, 2-1 at NY, 1-2 at Tor, 2-1 at Cle)...at 9-6 had a winning record against the AL for the first time since 2003 (7-5) and the best interleague record by any National League team, along with the Mets...through last season, **RHP Aaron Harang's** 3.12era in interleague play is seventh-best of any pitcher...the Reds' all-time results vs American League teams can be found on page 351 of the media guide...more information is available on the press box table.

OHIO CUP: The Reds won the 2008 season series vs the Indians and along with it the coveted **Ohio Cup** trophy, presented by **The Ohio Lottery**...the Reds went **5-1 vs Cle** last season, including a 3-game sweep at Great American Ball Park in May and a 2-1 series victory in June at Progressive Field...Reds **OF Adam Dunn** received the series' **Ohio Lottery Most Outstanding Player** award after hitting .300 (6-20) and leading all players with 5hr and 10rbi.

ALL-STAR RESOLUTION: State Senator **Gary Cates** (R-Butler County) has introduced a resolution in the Ohio Sentate urging Major League Baseball to select the Reds and Great American Ball Park as hosts for the **2013 All-Star Game**...the Reds last hosted the Mid-Summer Classic in **1988** at Riverfront Stadium...the club already is hosting one of MLB's jewel events this summer, when on **6/20** the Reds and White Sox meet here in the **Gillette Civil Rights Game**.

ABOUT THE NEW GUYS: **RHP Homer Bailey** made 8 starts at Class AAA Louisville and went 3-5, 4.57 (45.1ip, 46h, 17bb, 43k, 9hr)...he posted a 3.13era in his last 6 starts there...he will start for the Reds tomorrow night...**RHP Carlos Fisher** made 13 apps for the Bats, all in relief, and went 2-0, 2.00 with 2 saves(18ip, 11h, 4bb, 21k, 0hr)...when he pitches will be making his Major League debut...in 37g at Louisville **OF Jonny Gomes** hit .282 and leads the team in HR (9), RBI (27), runs (18) and hits (37)...the non-roster invitee to spring training camp was reassigned to Louisville the day before Opening Day.

MEDICAL UPDATE: **1B Joey Votto** has been diagnosed with an **inner ear infection**, secondary to the upper respiratory infection (flu) he had last week...all other test results were normal...the Reds expect him to return to the field in the next few days...since 5/7, **Votto** has missed 9 starts with the flu or dizziness and twice more left games early.

FOR STARTERS... Through 40g the Reds have used only **5 starting pitchers**, their longest such streak to begin a season since **RHP John Roper** became the staff's **sixth** different starter in the **42nd game** of the **1994 season** (**RHP Jose Rijo**, **LHP John Smiley**, **LHP Tom Browning**, **RHP Erik Hanson**, **RHP Tim Lincecum**)...the current streak should end tomorrow night, in the 42nd game, when **RHP Homer Bailey** becomes the club's sixth starter.

DOT, DOT, DOT... Tthe Reds' are **16-2** (.889) when they score first, second-best winning percentage in the Major Leagues behind the Giants' 15-1 mark (.938), and **5-17** when the opponent scores first.

ZEROES: Reds pitchers lead the National League with **6 team shutouts** (SF 2nd w/ 5sho)...produced those 6 shutouts in their first **26g**, their fastest to 6 blankings since the **1914 staff** threw its sixth shutout in the **25th** game...Cin produced 6 team shutouts all of last season.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (8-11, .421): The Reds went **1-4-2** in their first 7 home series and produced a winning record on just 1 of their first 3 completed homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **249-256-1**...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38).

REDS ON THE ROAD (13-8, .619): The Reds went **5-1-1 in their first 7 road series**...produced winning records on each of their first 2 road trips (7-3, 3-2) and a .500 record on the third trip (3-3)...entering this season and dating back to 2006, the Reds had losing records in **23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

IN THE STANDINGS (46): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 8, THIRD - 15, FOURTH - 18, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...at **20-15** were a season-high **6g over .500** for the first time since the **2006 season**, when they reached a season-high **12g over .500** at **36-24**...have spent **34** days above, **5** days at and **7** days below .500.

REDS vs INDIANS: The Reds are 27-30 all-time vs the Indians, including 5-1 in 2008...have won the last 2g vs Cle...at **Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 9-6, including 3-0 in 2008 and 5-1 the last 2 seasons...have won the last 4g here vs Cle.

Wins Beginning 6/29

In the 14-1 loss on 6/24/08 at Tor, **Bronson Arroyo** made the shortest start of his career and became only the sixth starting pitcher in Major League history to allow at least 10 earned runs in a game in which he retired 3 batters or fewer (1+ip, 11h, 10er)...beginning with his next start, a 9-5 win at Cle on 6/29/08, **Arroyo** has 16 wins, tied for second-most in the majors since then:

Since he was acquired by the Reds prior to the 2006 season, **Bronson Arroyo** ranks among the Major League leaders in games started and innings pitched:

Last Pitched: Sun at SD and suffered the 3-1 loss (7+ip, 6h, 3er, 4bb, 4k, 1hr, 119 pitches, 70 strikes)...allowed 2 runs in the first inning on consecutive 2-out, RBI-singles by Kouzmanoff and Gerut... allowed a HR to Kouzmanoff leading off the eighth.

Red Hots: Is making his ninth start of the season...in his previous 8 starts the Reds went 5-3 and scored 41 runs (5.13 r/g)...has 4 quality starts...since he was acquired by the Reds prior to the 2006 season leads all Major League pitchers with 111 starts and ranks third in the National League with 699.1ip.

Short Cuts: Made the 2 shortest starts of his career (1ip, plus 4 batters) in a 14-1 loss at Tor on 6/24/08 and a 15-3 loss on 5/6/09 vs Mil...in between those 2 starts went **15-5, 3.76**...his 15 victories in that span was second-most in the majors (**Roy Halladay**, 17-6, 2.77)...since that loss at Tor last season, still ranks tied for second in the Major Leagues with **16 victories**.

Perfect: Began the season 3-0 for the third time in his career but for the first time won his first 3 starts of a season...won his first 2 starts in 2006, when he started off 5-0...began the 2005 campaign 4-0...was the first Reds pitcher to begin the season in the rotation and win his first 3 starts since **LHP Pete Schourek** did it in 1996 and the first righthander since **Jack Armstrong** won his first 5 starts of 1990.

Career Highs: **Innings:** 9.0 (longest, 5x), last on 8/26/08 for Cin at Hou & 1+4bf (shortest, 2x), 6/24/08 for Cin at Tor & 5/6/09 for Cin vs Mil; **Hits:** 13, 9/26/08 for Cin at StL; **Runs:** 10 (2x), 6/23/00 for Pit at NYM & 6/24/08 for Cin at Tor; **Earned Runs:** 10, 6/24/08 for Cin at Tor; **Walks:** 5 (4x), last on 8/20/08 at Chi; **Strikeouts:** 12, 7/19/04 for Bos at Sea; **HR allowed:** 4, 4/7/08 vs Phi (Rollins leadoff, Burrell 2, Jenkins); **Complete Games:** 6, last on 8/26/08 for Cin at Hou (2-1 win); **Shutouts:** 1, 9/5/06 for Cin vs SF (3-0 win).

Arroyo's Most Recent Starts: **4/9 vs NYM**, in his season debut earned the 8-6 victory (6ip, 8h, 5er, 2bb, 4k, 100 pitches, 68 strikes)...allowed 3 runs in the third inning, highlighted by Church's 2-run double...**4/14 at Mil** and earned the 6-1 victory (6.1ip, 4h, 1er, 4bb, 3k, 1hr, 105 pitches, 57 strikes)...left leading, 3-1, and the Reds added 3 runs in the ninth inning...allowed only Hardy's solo HR in the second inning...**4/20 at Hou** and in his 100th career road start earned the 4-3 victory (7ip, 9h, 3er, 0bb, 2k, 2hr, 81 pitches, 53 strikes)...left leading, 4-3...allowed run-scoring groundout to Rodriguez in the second inning...allowed back-to-back HR to Berkman and Lee with 2 outs in the sixth...**4/25 vs Atl** and suffered the 10-2 loss (5.2ip, 9h, 9er, 3bb, 5k, 1hbp, 2hr, 102 pitches, 60 strikes)...left trailing, 9-2...gave up 2 runs in the first inning, 3 in the second (CJones 3-run HR) and three in the sixth (Escobar 2-run HR)...**5/1 at Pit** and threw 8.0 shutout innings to earn the 4-0 win (4h, 3bb, 4k, 113 pitches, 71 strikes)...left leading, 2-0...**5/6 vs Mil** and suffered the 15-3 loss (1ip+4bf, 7h, 9er, 3bb, 0k, 2hr, 46 pitches, 24 strikes)...tied for the shortest start of his career...left trailing, 9-0...in the first inning allowed 5 runs on 2 walks and 4 hits, including a 3-run HR by Hardy...in the second allowed Braun's grand slam...**5/11 at Ari**, in his 200th career start earned the 13-5 victory (7ip, 10h, 5er, 0bb, 5k, 3hr, 123 pitches, 81 strikes)...allowed 4 of the 5 runs on homers to Upton (2-run), Lopez (solo) and Reynolds (solo)...Reds batters scored 13 runs on 18 hits and 8 extra-base hits, including 6 doubles, all season highs.

Tomorrow's Starter: RHP Homer Bailey

Last Pitched: For Louisville on Mon at Norfolk, threw a 6-inning complete game in the 2-0 loss (6h, 2er, 2bb, 6k, 90 pitches, 62 strikes)...was his second complete game of the season.

2009 Season: Tomorrow will make his season debut...began the year at Class AAA Louisville, where he went 3-5, 4.57 with 2 complete games and a shutout in 8 starts...in his last 6 starts for the Bats posted a 3.13era...tomorrow vs Cle will become only the sixth different pitcher to start a game for the Reds, in the club's 42nd game...is the longest such streak to begin a season since **RHP John Roper** became the staff's **sixth** different starter in the **42nd game** of the **1994** campaign.

IL Pitcher of the Week: For the week ending 4/26 was named the International League's **Pitcher of the Week**...in 2 starts that week went 2-0, 2.92 with 18 strikeouts in 12.1 innings (10h, 6bb), including a 3-2 win at Columbus and a 10-3 victory at Toledo...in that win over the Mud Hens, over 6.1 innings he struck out a career-high 15 batters to tie the Louisville single-game record...between the third and sixth innings he retired 9 consecutive batters by strikeout.

2008 Season: Spent most of the season at Class AAA Louisville (19gs, 4-7, 4.77)...made 8 starts during 2 stints with the Reds (0-6, 7.93)...from 6/5-6/17 filled in for injured starter **Josh Fogg** and from 7/13-8/9 took the spot vacated by the disabled **Aaron Harang**...from 8/24-9/2 was on Louisville's disabled list with a sprained medial collateral ligament in his right knee, an injury that prevented a September promotion...in his 8 starts the Reds went 0-8, scored 14 runs (1.75 r/g) and twice were shut out...produced 2 quality starts...twice was the victim of blown saves.
