Through 41g the Reds have used only **5 starting pitchers**, their longest such streak to begin a season since **RHP** John Roper became the staff's sixth different starter in the 42nd game of the 1994 season (RHP Jose Rijo, LHP John Smiley, LHP Tom Browning, RHP Erik Hanson, RHP Tim Pugh)...the current streak will end tonight, in the Reds' 42nd game, when in his season debut RHP Homer Bailey becomes the sixth pitcher to make a start.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is Game 2 (1-0) of a 3-game series vs Bart Swain's Indians and Game 5 (2-2) of a 9-game homestand that also includes the Phillies (1-2) and Astros (3g)...following this homestand the Reds take to the road again for a 3-game weekend series at Mil followed by a 4-game set at StL.

INTERLEAGUE PLAY: Last night the Reds and Indians kicked off the 13th season of interleague games...Cin also will host the White Sox during the Gillette Civil Rights Game weekend (6/19-6/21) while traveling to KC (6/12-6/14), to Tor (6/23-6/25) and to Cle (6/26-6/28)...including last night's 3-1 victory, the Reds are 78-95 (.451) all-time vs American League teams...they went 9-6 vs the AL last season (3-0 vs Cle, 1-2 vs Bos, 2-1 at NYY, 1-2 at Tor, 2-1 at Cle) to post a winning record against the AL for the first time since 2003 (7-5)...last year's 9-6 mark was the best interleague record by any National League team, along with the Mets...entering play this weekend, RHP Aaron Harang's 3.12era in interleague play was seventh-best of any pitcher...the Reds' all-time results vs American League teams can be found on page 351 of the media guide.

PHILLIPS FIELD: Brandon Phillips Field, located at Clark Montessori School at 5425 Winton Ridge Lane in Cincinnati, was dedicated this afternoon...the club's Gold Glove second baseman threw out the ceremonial first pitch before a game involving teams from the Reds Community Fund's RBI program...Phillips contributed \$32,500 to the project, including \$7,500 he received as the team's 2008 Roberto Clemente Award winner...the Reds Community Fund donated an additional \$20,000 to the development of the project as part of its field renovation program and new partnership with Cincinnati Public Schools.

MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUT: When he pitches, RHP Carlos Fisher will become the first Reds player this season to make his Major League debut...last season 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts, including RHP Johnny Cueto, IF Paul Janish, OF Jay Bruce, LHP Daniel Ray Herrera, RHP Daryl Thompson, IF Adam Rosales, OF Chris Dickerson, RHP Ramon Ramirez, C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo and RHP Josh Roenicke.

ALL-STAR RESOLUTION: State Senator Gary Cates (R-Butler County) has introduced a resolution in the Ohio Sentate urging Major League Baseball to select the Reds and Great American Ball Park as hosts for the 2013 All-Star Game...the Reds last hosted the Mid-Summer Classic in 1988 at Riverfront Stadium...the club already is hosting one of MLB's jewel events this summer, when on 6/20 the Reds and White Sox meet here in the Civil Rights Game.

MEDICAL UPDATE: 1B Joey Votto has been diagnosed with an inner ear infection, secondary to the upper respiratory infection (flu) he had last week...all other test results were normal...the Reds expect him to return to the field this weekend... since 5/7. Votto has missed 10 starts with the flu or dizziness and twice more left games early.

DOT, DOT, DOT...: Near the conclusion of tonight's National Anthem, Sam the bald eagle from the Cincinnati Zoo & Botanical Gardens will fly from the Cincinnati Bell Riverboat Deck to the pitcher's mound...will be Sam's 21st flight since Great American Ball Park opened in 2003...the Reds' are 16-2 (.889) when they score first, the best winning percentage in the Major Leagues, and 6-17 when the opponent scores first.

QUALITY CONTROL: In the Reds' 41g the opposing pitcher produced 25 quality starts, including 11 straight from 4/14-4/25...the Reds went 12-13 (.480) when the opposing starter produced a quality appearance...the Reds have produced 20 quality starts (Cueto 5, Harang 5, Arroyo 5, Volquez 3, Owings 2) and went 17-3 in those QS (.850).

ZEROES: Reds pitchers lead the National League with 6 team shutouts (SF 2nd w/ 5sho)...produced those 6 shutouts in their first 26g, their fastest to 6 blankings since the 1914 staff threw its sixth shutout in the 25th game...Cin produced 6 team shutouts all of last season.

GILLETTE CIVIL RIGHTS GAME: At Great American Ball Park on Sat, 6/20 the Reds and Chicago White Sox will meet in the Gillette Civil Rights Game, the first time the contest will be played during the regular season...the weekend's festivities will include a roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's Harriet Tubman Theater (Fri, 6/19, 4:00 p.m.), a luncheon at **Duke Energy Center** honoring the 3 winners of Major League Baseball's **Beacon Awards** (Sat, 6/20, 11:30 a.m.) and a **Youth Summit** at **Fountain Square** downtown (Sat, 6/20, 4:00 p.m.)...the luncheon on Sat, 6/20 will honor Beacon of Hope winner **Bill Cosby**, Beacon of Life winner **Hank Aaron** and Beacon of Change winner **Muhammad Ali**...former **President Bill Clinton** will be the keynote speaker at that luncheon...for more information, log on to www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (9-11, .450): The Reds went 1-4-2 in their first 7 completed home series and produced a winning record on just 1 of their first 3 completed homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2)...in 7 seasons at GABP are 250-256-1...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38).

REDS ON THE ROAD (13-8, .619): The Reds went 5-1-1 in their first 7 road series...produced winning records on each of their first 2 road trips (7-3, 3-2) and a .500 record on the third trip (3-3)...entering this season and dating back to 2006, the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips.

IN THE STANDINGS (47): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 8, THIRD - 16, FOURTH - 18, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...at 20-15 were a season-high 6g over .500 for the first time since the 2006 season.

REDS vs INDIANS: The Reds are 28-30 all-time vs the Indians, including 1-0 in 2009 and 6-1 the last 2 seasons... have won the last 3g vs Cle...the Most Outstanding Player of the series will receive the coveted Ohio Cup trophy, presented by The Ohio Lottery...Reds OF Adam Dunn won the MOP last year (.300, 5hr, 10rbi)...at Great American Ball Park: Reds are 10-6, including 1-0 in 2009, 4-0 the last 2 seasons and 6-1 the last 2 years...have won the last 5g here vs Cle... last Reds sweep: at Cin: 5/16-5/18, 2008...at Cle: never.

<u>Last Pitched</u>: For Louisville on Mon at Norfolk, threw a 6-inning complete game in the 2-0 loss (6h, 2er, 2bb, 6k, 90 pitches, 62 strikes)...was his second complete game of the season, both in his last 4 starts.

2009 Season: Tonight is making his season debut...began the year at Class AAA Louisville, where he went 3-5, 4.57 with 2 complete games and a shutout in 8 starts...in his last 6 starts for the Bats posted a 3.13era...is only the sixth different pitcher to start a game for the Reds, in the club's 42nd game...is the longest such streak to begin a season since RHP John Roper became the staff's sixth different starter in the 42nd game of the 1994 campaign.

IL Pitcher of the Week: For the week ending 4/26 was named the International League's Pitcher of the Week...in 2 starts that week went 2-0, 2.92 with 18 strikeouts in 12.1 innings (10h, 6bb), including a 3-2 win at Columbus and a 10-3 victory at Toledo...in that win over the Mud Hens, over 6.1 innings he struck out a career-high 15 batters to tie the Louisville single-game record...between the third and sixth innings he retired 9 consecutive batters by strikeout.

Major League Debut: On 6/8/07, made his Major League debut against the Indians and earned the 4-3 victory (5ip, 5h, 2er, 4bb, 3k, 114 pitches)...left leading, 3-2...struck out his first batter, **Grady Sizemore**...in his final inning struck out **Dave Dellucci** with 2 outs and the bases loaded to preserve his 3-2 lead...crowd of 38,696 was just shy of a sellout.

2008 Season: Spent most of the season at Class AAA Louisville (19gs, 4-7, 4.77)...made 8 starts during 2 stints with the Reds (0-6, 7.93)...from 6/5-6/17 filled in for injured starter **Josh Fogg** and from 7/13-8/9 took the spot vacated by the disabled **Aaron Harang**...from 8/24-9/2 was on Louisville's disabled list with a sprained medial collateral ligament in his right knee, an injury that prevented a September promotion...between a 4-3 victory for Louisville on 4/30 vs Toledo and a 19-3 win on 9/4 vs Durham in Game 2 of the International League playoffs made 21 starts without a victory (13gs for Louisville, 8gs at Cin)...in his 8 starts the Reds went 0-8, scored 14 runs (1.75 r/g) and twice were shut out...produced 2 quality starts...twice was the victim of blown saves.

Tomorrow's Pitcher: RHP Johnny Cueto

<u>Last Pitched</u>: Tue vs Phi and suffered the 4-3 loss (7ip, 7h, 4er, 0bb, 4k, 1hr, 112 pitches, 68 strikes)...in the second inning allowed a solo HR to Howard...allowed 3 runs in the fifth on Rollins' RBI-double, Utley's RBI-single and a sac fly by Ibanez.

Red Hots: Tomorrow the 23-year-old righthander will make his ninth start of the season, the 40th start of his career and his fourth start vs an American League team...with a 2.35era ranks fifth in the National League...in his 8 starts the Reds went 5-3 and scored 32 runs (4 r/g)...in his last 6 apps produced all 5 of his quality starts.

<u>Streaking I</u>: In 5 starts from 4/22-5/13 went **4-0**, **1.25** (36ip, 5er)... the 4-game winning streak was the longest of his career...allowed 4 earned runs in his first start of the season (6ip) and 10 earned runs in his last 7 starts (47.2ip, 1.89era).

Streaking II: In each of 4 starts from 4/22-5/8 threw at least 7.0 innings while allowing no more than 1 run, the longest streak of that kind by a Reds pitcher since **Tim Belcher** had a 4-game run from **5/27-6/13, 1992** (courtesy Elias Sports Bureau).

World Baseball Classic: Started the Dominican Republic's second game of the tournament and threw 4.2 scoreless innings to earn the 9-0 win vs Panama in the San Juan bracket (4.2ip, 3h, 1bb, 5k).
