74 Years Ago Tonight....

Today marks the 74th anniversary of the first night game in Major League Baseball history...on 5/24/35, Paul Derringer and the Reds beat Joe Bowman and the Phillies, 2-1, before 20,422 fans at Crosley Field...National League President Ford Frick threw out the ceremonial first pitch...legend has it President Franklin Roosevelt pressed a button in the White House that illuminated Crosley's 632 lights...one of those Crosley Field lights had been attached to the Zach Bonkowski Power Stacks in Great American Ball Park's center field but currently is on display as part of the Reds Hall of Fame's Crosley Field exhibit...GABP has 864 field lights.

TODAY'S GAME: Is **Game 3** (1-1) of a 3-game series vs **Bart Swain's** Indians and **Game 6** (2-3) of a 9-game homestand that also includes the **Phillies** (1-2) and **Astros** (3g)...following this homestand the Reds take to the road again for a 3-game weekend series at **Mil** followed by a 4-game set at **StL**.

INTERLEAGUE PLAY: This weekend the Reds and Indians kicked off the 13th season of interleague games...Cin also will host the White Sox during the Gillette Civil Rights Game weekend (6/19-6/21) while traveling to KC (6/12-6/14), to Tor (6/23-6/25) and to Cle (6/26-6/28)...including this series' games, the Reds are 78-96 (.448) all-time vs American League teams...they went 9-6 vs the AL last season (3-0 vs Cle, 1-2 vs Bos, 2-1 at NYY, 1-2 at Tor, 2-1 at Cle) to post a winning record against the AL for the first time since 2003 (7-5)...last year's 9-6 mark was the best interleague record by any National League team, along with the Mets.

AARON'S ACES: This afternoon Aaron Harang is hosting from 30 fans in sun deck Section 143 as part of his Aaron's Aces program targeting local military families...guests receive an autographed t-shirt, in-stadium welcomes via the public address announcer and scoreboard and a \$10 concession voucher...fans with family members currently on active duty or who recently returned from active duty can sign up for the program online at www.reds.com/community, then click on ticket programs.

MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUT: When he pitches, RHP Carlos Fisher will become the first Reds player this season to make his Major League debut...last season 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts, including RHP Johnny Cueto, IF Paul Janish, OF Jay Bruce, LHP Daniel Ray Herrera, RHP Daryl Thompson, IF Adam Rosales, OF Chris Dickerson, RHP Ramon Ramirez, C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo and RHP Josh Roenicke.

ALL-STAR RESOLUTION: State Senator Gary Cates (R-Butler County) has introduced a resolution in the Ohio Senate urging Major League Baseball to select the Reds and Great American Ball Park as hosts for the 2013 All-Star Game... the Reds last hosted the Mid-Summer Classic in 1988 at Riverfront Stadium...the club already is hosting one of MLB's jewel events this summer, when on 6/20 the Reds and White Sox meet here in the Civil Rights Game.

<u>DOT, DOT.</u>: 2B Brandon Phillips left last night's game in the middle of the eighth inning after taking a bad hop off the tip of his right thumb...he will be examined again today...the Reds' are 16-3 (.842) when they score first, the second-best winning percentage in the Major Leagues (SF 15-2, .882), and 6-17 when the opponent scores first.

QUALITY CONTROL: In the Reds' 42g the opposing pitcher produced **25 quality starts**, including 11 straight from **4/14-4/25**...the Reds went **12-13** (.480) when the opposing starter produced a quality appearance...the Reds have produced 20 quality starts (**Cueto** 5, **Harang** 5, **Arroyo** 5, **Volquez** 3, **Owings** 2) and went **17-3** in those QS (.850).

ZEROES: Reds pitchers lead the National League with **6 team shutouts** (SF 2nd w/ 5sho)...produced those 6 shutouts in their first **26g**, their fastest to 6 blankings since the **1914 staff** threw its sixth shutout in the **25th** game...Cin produced 6 team shutouts all of last season.

GILLETTE CIVIL RIGHTS GAME: At Great American Ball Park on Sat, 6/20 the Reds and Chicago White Sox will meet in the Gillette Civil Rights Game, the first time the contest will be played during the regular season...the weekend's festivities will include a roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's Harriet Tubman Theater (Fri, 6/19, 4:00 p.m.), a luncheon at Duke Energy Center honoring the 3 winners of Major League Baseball's Beacon Awards (Sat, 6/20, 11:30 a.m.) and a Youth Summit at Fountain Square downtown (Sat, 6/20, 4:00 p.m.)...the luncheon on Sat, 6/20 will honor Beacon of Hope winner Bill Cosby, Beacon of Life winner Hank Aaron and Beacon of Change winner Muhammad Ali...former President Bill Clinton will be the keynote speaker at that luncheon...for more information, log on to www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (9-12, .429): The Reds went 1-4-2 in their first 7 completed home series and produced a winning record on just 1 of their first 3 completed homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2)...in 7 seasons at GABP are 250-257-1...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38).

REDS ON THE ROAD (13-8, .619): The Reds went 5-1-1 in their first 7 road series...produced winning records on each of their first 2 road trips (7-3, 3-2) and a .500 record on the third trip (3-3)...entering this season and dating back to 2006, the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips.

IN THE STANDINGS (48): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 8, THIRD - 17, FOURTH - 18, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...at 20-15 were a season-high 6g over .500 for the first time since the 2006 season, when they reached a season-high 12g over .500 at 36-24...have spent 36 days above, 5 days at and 7 days below .500.

<u>REDS vs INDIANS</u>: The Reds are 28-31 all-time vs the Indians, including 1-1 in 2009 and 6-2 the last 2 seasons... have won 3 of the last 4g vs Cle...the **Most Outstanding Player** of the series will receive the coveted **Ohio Cup** trophy, presented by **The Ohio Lottery**...Reds **OF Adam Dunn** won the MOP last year (.300, 5hr, 10rbi).

<u>UP NEXT: REDS vs ASTROS</u>: The Reds are 402-382-1 all-time vs the Astros, including 4-3 this season, 7-15 the last 2 seasons and 11-26 the last 3 seasons...<u>at Great American Ball Park</u>: Reds are 16-32-1, including 1-2 this season, 0-6 in 2008 and 2-16 the last 3 seasons...Cin's 3-0 win on 4/29 snapped its 11-game losing streak here vs Hou...Hou's .667 winning percentage at GABP (32-16) is the best among all opponents (LAD 2nd, 13-7, .650)...**Lance Berkman's** 20 homers at GABP are the most by any Reds opponent (**Jason Bay & Albert Pujols** 2nd, 14)...**Roy Oswalt's** 7 wins here tie Chi's **Carlos Zambrano** for the most by an opposing pitcher.

Last Pitched: Tue vs Phi and suffered the 4-3 loss (7ip, 7h, 4er, 0bb, 4k, 1hr, 112 pitches, 68 strikes)...in the second inning allowed a solo HR to Howard...allowed 3 runs in the fifth on Rollins' RBI-double, Utley's RBI-single and a sac fly by Ibanez.

Red Hots: The 23-year-old righthander is making his ninth start of the season and the 40th start of his career...with a 2.35era ranks fourth in the National League...in his 8 starts the Reds went 5-3 and scored 32 runs (4 r/g)...in his last 6 apps produced all 5 of his quality starts...his string of 5 consecutive QS from 4/22-5/13 was the longest stretch of quality starts by a Reds pitcher this season...last year, Edinson Volquez produced a string of 12 straight QS (4/22-6/20)...on 4/22 at Chi singled twice off Ted Lilly for his first career 2-hit game.

<u>Streaking I</u>: In 5 starts from 4/22-5/13 went **4-0, 1.25** (36ip, 5er)...the 4-game winning streak was the longest of his career...allowed 4 earned runs in his first start of the season (6ip) and 10 earned runs in his last 7 starts (47.2ip, 1.89era).

Streaking II: In each of 4 starts from 4/22-5/8 threw at least 7.0 innings while allowing no more than 1 run, the longest streak of that kind by a Reds pitcher since **Tim Belcher** had a 4-game run from **5/27-6/13**, **1992** (courtesy Elias Sports Bureau).

<u>World Baseball Classic</u>: Started the Dominican Republic's second game of the tournament and threw 4.2 scoreless innings to earn the 9-0 win vs Panama in the San Juan bracket (4.2ip, 3h, 1bb, 5k).

<u>Career Highs</u>: Innings: 8.0, 5/3/09 at Pit (longest) & 1.2 (shortest), 4/29/08 at StL; **Hits**: 9 (2x), 5/27/08 vs Pit & 8/8/08 vs Hou; **Runs**: 7, 4/29/08 at StL; **Earned Runs**: 6 (4x), last on 7/17/08 vs NYM; **Walks**: 8, 6/11/08 vs StL; **Strikeouts**: 10 (2x), 4/3/08 vs Ari (ML debut) & 7/22/08 vs SD; **HR allowed**: 3, 5/16/08 vs Cle (Blake & Hafner, Peralta).

<u>Cueto's Most Recent Starts</u>: 4/17 at Hou, in his second start of the season received no decision in the dramatic 2-1 victory (4.1ip, 2h, 1er, 6bb, 3k, 88 pitches, 46 strikes)...left trailing, 1-0...allowed only 1 hit through 4.2 scoreless innings - an infield single by Tejada leading off the fourth - but with 2 outs in the fifth walked Oswalt and Bourn, allowed a single to Tejada

<u>Cueto vs Indians</u>: Is making his third career appearance vs the Indians...in his 4-3 win on 5/16/08 at Great American Ball Park took a no-hitter and a 3-0 lead into the sixth inning but then allowed leadoff back-to-back HR to Blake and pinch-hitter Hafner and another solo homer to Peralta 1 out later.

and then walked Berkman to force in the game's first run...Lincoln then came in to induce Lee to ground out and end the inning...Cueto, Lincoln, Herrera, Masset and Cordero held Astros hitters to 4 singles...4/22 at Chi, in one of the best starts of his career threw 7.0 shutout innings to earn the 3-0 victory (4h, 0bb, 3k, 108 pitches, 68 strikes)...left leading, 1-0...4/27 vs Hou and received no decision in the 4-1 loss (7ip, 7h, 1er, 1bb, 5k, 1hr, 98 pitches, 64 strikes)...left with the score tied, 1-1... allowed only a solo HR to Berkman leading off the sixth inning, snapping his scoreless streak at career-high 12 innings...was Berkman's 20th career homer at Great American Ball Park, the most by any opposing player...the Astros scored 3 runs in the ninth off Cordero...5/3 at Pit, in the 5-0 victory threw 8.0 shutout innings in the best start of his young career (4h, 1bb, 9k, 109 pitches, 68 strikes)...the 8.0 innings are a career high...allowed only 4 singles...5/8 vs StL and earned the 6-4 victory (7ip, 5h, 1er, 2bb, 3k, 98 pitches, 67 strikes)...left leading, 6-1...allowed only a run-scoring GIDP by Thurston in the seventh inning, snapping his career-high scoreless streak at 15 innings...5/13 at Ari and earned the 10-3 victory (7ip, 4h, 3er, 2bb, 4k, 2hr, 100 pitches, 67 strikes)...in the first inning allowed a solo HR to Gerardo Parra in Parra's first career plate appearance, followed by a walk to Justin Upton...then retired 12 consecutive batters until Chad Tracy walked with 1 out in the fifth...after Parra's HR didn't allow another hit until Upton doubled with 2 outs in the sixth, followed by Stephen Drew's RBI-single...with 2 outs in the seventh inning allowed a solo HR to Ojeda, his first homer since 6/15/07 at Bal (410ab)...as a batter, led off the third inning with his second bunt single of the season to spark a 3-run rally.

Tomorrow vs Astros: RHP Aaron Harang

<u>Last Started</u>: Wed vs SD and earned the 5-1 victory (7ip, 4h, 1er, 2bb, 9k, 1hr, 109 pitches, 72 strikes)...left leading, 3-1...allowed only a leadoff HR to Ibanez in the fourth inning.

Red Hots: Tomorrow vs Hou will make his 10th start of the season... in his previous 9 starts the Reds went 4-5 and scored just 31 runs (3.44 r/g)...in his 9 starts Reds batters hit .242 (72-298)...on 4/23 at Chi recorded the 1,000th strikeout of his career (Derrek Lee)... his 3-hitter in the club's fifth game, a 2-0 win on 4/12 vs Pit, was the quickest complete game by a Reds pitcher since Pete Harnisch threw a CG in the Reds' fourth game of 1999.

Astronomical: In his 2 starts vs the Astros this season, a 7-0 loss at Hou on 4/18 and an 8-3 loss at Cin on 4/28, allowed 10 earned runs in 11.0 innings...in his other 7 starts went 4-2, 2.05 (48.1ip, 11er).

<u>Home Cookin'</u>: Is **3-2, 2.45** (33ip, 9er) in 5 starts at Great American Ball Park and **1-2, 4.10** (26.1ip, 12er) in 4 starts on the road.

Staff Ace: Since he was acquired from the Athletics at the 2003 trading deadline is the Reds' leader in most statistical pitching categories, including starts (176), wins (67), innings pitched (1128.1) and strikeouts (953)...since the beginning of the 2006 season leads the National League in innings pitched (709.2)...in 2005 and 2007 won the BBWAA's Johnny Vander Meer Award as the club's Most Outstanding Pitcher.
