74 Years Ago Tonight....

Today marks the 74th anniversary of the first night game in Major League Baseball history...on **5/24/35**, **Paul Der-ringer** and the Reds beat **Joe Bowman** and the Phillies, 2-1, before 20,422 fans at **Crosley Field**...National League President **Ford Frick** threw out the ceremonial first pitch...legend has it **President Franklin Roosevelt** pressed a button in the White House that illuminated Crosley's **632 lights**...one of those Crosley Field lights had been attached to the **Zach Bonkowski Power Stacks** in Great American Ball Park's center field but currently is on display as part of the Reds Hall of Fame's **Crosley Field** exhibit...GABP has **864 field lights**.

TODAY'S GAME: Is **Game 3** (1-1) of a 3-game series vs **Bart Swain's** Indians and **Game 6** (2-3) of a 9-game homestand that also includes the **Phillies** (1-2) and **Astros** (3g)...following this homestand the Reds take to the road again for a 3-game weekend series at **Mil** followed by a 4-game set at **StL**.

INTERLEAGUE PLAY: This weekend the Reds and Indians kicked off the 13th season of interleague games...Cin also will host the **White Sox** during the **Gillette Civil Rights Game** weekend (6/19-6/21) while traveling to **KC** (6/12-6/14), to **Tor** (6/23-6/25) and to **Cle** (6/26-6/28)...including this series' games, the Reds are **78-96 (.448) all-time** vs American League teams...they went **9-6 vs the AL** last season (3-0 vs Cle, 1-2 vs Bos, 2-1 at NYY, 1-2 at Tor, 2-1 at Cle) to post a winning record against the AL for the first time since 2003 (7-5)...last year's 9-6 mark was the best interleague record by any National League team, along with the Mets.

AARON'S ACES: This afternoon **Aaron Harang** is hosting from 30 fans in sun deck Section 143 as part of his **Aaron's Aces** program targeting local **military families**...guests receive an autographed t-shirt, in-stadium welcomes via the public address announcer and scoreboard and a \$10 concession voucher...fans with family members currently on active duty or who recently returned from active duty can sign up for the program online at www.reds.com/community, then click on ticket programs.

MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUT: When he pitches, **RHP Carlos Fisher** will become the first Reds player this season to make his Major League debut...last season 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts, including **RHP Johnny Cueto**, **IF Paul Janish**, **OF Jay Bruce**, **LHP Daniel Ray Herrera**, **RHP Daryl Thompson**, **IF Adam Rosales**, **OF Chris Dickerson**, **RHP Ramon Ramirez**, **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** and **RHP Josh Roenicke**.

ALL-STAR RESOLUTION: State Senator **Gary Cates** (R-Butler County) has introduced a resolution in the Ohio Senate urging Major League Baseball to select the Reds and Great American Ball Park as hosts for the **2013 All-Star Game**...the Reds last hosted the Mid-Summer Classic in **1988** at Riverfront Stadium...the club already is hosting one of MLB's jewel events this summer, when on **6/20** the Reds and White Sox meet here in the **Civil Rights Game**.

DOT, DOT, DOT...: **2B Brandon Phillips** left last night's game in the middle of the eighth inning after taking a bad hop off the tip of his right thumb...he will be examined again today...the Reds' are **16-3** (.842) when they score first, the second-best winning percentage in the Major Leagues (SF 15-2, .882), and **6-17** when the opponent scores first.

QUALITY CONTROL: In the Reds' 42g the opposing pitcher produced **25 quality starts**, including 11 straight from **4/14-4/25**...the Reds went **12-13** (.480) when the opposing starter produced a quality appearance...the Reds have produced 20 quality starts (**Cueto** 5, **Harang** 5, **Arroyo** 5, **Volquez** 3, **Owings** 2) and went **17-3** in those QS (.850).

ZEROES: Reds pitchers lead the National League with **6 team shutouts** (SF 2nd w/ 5sho)...produced those 6 shutouts in their first **26g**, their fastest to 6 blankings since the **1914 staff** threw its sixth shutout in the **25th** game...Cin produced 6 team shutouts all of last season.

GILLETTE CIVIL RIGHTS GAME: At Great American Ball Park on **Sat, 6/20** the Reds and Chicago White Sox will meet in the **Gillette Civil Rights Game**, the first time the contest will be played during the regular season...the weekend's festivities will include a roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's **Harriet Tubman Theater** (Fri, 6/19, 4:00 p.m.), a luncheon at **Duke Energy Center** honoring the 3 winners of Major League Baseball's **Beacon Awards** (Sat, 6/20, 11:30 a.m.) and a **Youth Summit** at **Fountain Square** downtown (Sat, 6/20, 4:00 p.m.)...the luncheon on Sat, 6/20 will honor Beacon of Hope winner **Bill Cosby**, Beacon of Life winner **Hank Aaron** and Beacon of Change winner **Muhammad Ali**...former **President Bill Clinton** will be the keynote speaker at that luncheon...for more information, log on to www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (9-12, .429): The Reds went **1-4-2** in their first 7 completed home series and produced a winning record on just 1 of their first 3 completed homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **250-257-1**...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38).

REDS ON THE ROAD (13-8, .619): The Reds went **5-1-1 in their first 7 road series**...produced winning records on each of their first 2 road trips (7-3, 3-2) and a .500 record on the third trip (3-3)...entering this season and dating back to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

IN THE STANDINGS (48): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 8, THIRD - 17, FOURTH - 18, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...at **20-15** were a season-high **6g over .500** for the first time since the **2006 season**, when they reached a season-high **12g** over .500 at **36-24**...have spent **36** days above, **5** days at and **7** days below .500.

REDS vs INDIANS: The Reds are 28-31 all-time vs the Indians, including 1-1 in 2009 and 6-2 the last 2 seasons...have won 3 of the last 4g vs Cle...the **Most Outstanding Player** of the series will receive the coveted **Ohio Cup** trophy, presented by **The Ohio Lottery**...Reds **OF Adam Dunn** won the MOP last year (.300, 5hr, 10rbi).

UP NEXT: REDS vs ASTROS: The Reds are 402-382-1 all-time vs the Astros, including 4-3 this season, 7-15 the last 2 seasons and 11-26 the last 3 seasons...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 16-32-1, including 1-2 this season, 0-6 in 2008 and 2-16 the last 3 seasons...Cin's 3-0 win on 4/29 snapped its 11-game losing streak here vs Hou...Hou's .667 winning percentage at GABP (32-16) is the best among all opponents (LAD 2nd, 13-7, .650)...**Lance Berkman's** 20 homers at GABP are the most by any Reds opponent (**Jason Bay** & **Albert Pujols** 2nd, 14)...**Roy Oswalt's** 7 wins here tie Chi's **Carlos Zambrano** for the most by an opposing pitcher.

IF Paul Janish pitched in the ninth inning of the 15-3 loss vs Mil on 5/6 (1ip, 5h, 5er, 0bb, 2k, Fielder 2-run HR)...he became the first Reds position player to pitch since Lenny Harris on 6/1/98 at SF.				

Reds Pitchers: Rank seventh in the National League with a 4.08 team ERA...**on the homestand are 2-3, 5.00 (45ip, 25er)**...have 6 team shutouts...had 6 shutouts all last season...with a 7-0 win on 5/5 at Fla reached 6 shutouts in their 26th game, their fastest to 6 shutouts since the 1914 Reds threw their sixth shutout in their 25th game.

Reds Starters: Rank seventh in the National League with 4.22 rotation ERA...**on the homestand are 2-2, 5.22 (29.1ip 17er)**...through the first 41g of the season used just 5 starting pitchers, their longest such streak to begin a year since **RHP John Roper** became the staff's **sixth** different starter in the **42nd game** of the **1994 campaign**...on 5/23 vs Cle, in the club's 42nd game, **RHP Homer Bailey** became the Reds' sixth starting pitcher...in 42g have produced 20 quality starts (**Cueto 5, Harang 5, Arroyo 5, Volquez 3, Owings 2**)...the Reds went 17-3 in those quality starts (.850)...**Aaron Harang** threw a 3-hitter in the 2-0 win vs Pit in the club's fifth game of the season...was the earliest complete game by a Reds pitcher since **Pete Harnisch** beat the Cardinals, 3-0 in Busch Stadium, in the **fourth** contest of the **1999** campaign...last season, **Bronson Arroyo** threw the staff's first CG in a 2-1 win at Hou in the 132nd game...4 times in the previous 7 years the Reds tied the franchise record for fewest complete games in a season (2cg, 2001, 2002, 2005, 2008).

Reds Relievers: Rank fourth in the National League with a 3.78 bullpen ERA...**on the homstand are 0-1-1, 4.60 (15.2ip, 8er)**...in the last 34g have posted a 2.93era (98.1ip, 32er) and in the last 22g have posted a 2.52era (64.1ip, 18er)...none of the previous notes include the pitching performance by IF Paul Janish in the ninth inning of the 15-3 loss on 5/6 vs Mil (1ip, 5er)...didn't blow a save until the club's 36th game, a 6-5 loss in 16 innings on 5/16 at SD...for the second straight season the Reds' bullpen was the last in the Major Leagues to suffer a blown save...in 2008 didn't blow a save until the 41st game (5/14)...over the last 2 seasons **Francisco Cordero** has recorded all **45** of the bullpen's saves (34sv in 2008, 10sv in 2009).

Ranks T2nd in the National League lead in saves (11), 1 behind 2 players tied with 12...was the only available Reds reliever who didn't pitch in last Sun's 16-inning loss at SD...in his last 10 apps has posted a 0.90era (10ip, 1er)...with 222 career saves is tied with Sparky Lyle for 30th on that all-time list...Ugeth Urbina is 29th with 237 saves...including last season has recorded the bullpen's last 45 saves (34sv in 2008, 11sv in 2009)...dating back to last season has converted 25 consecutive save chances, including all 11 save opps this year...**suffered his last blown save on 7/21/08 vs SD**...in the 3-0 victory on 4/22 at Chi recorded his 100th save in the National League to become only the 11th pitcher in history with at least 100 saves in each league (see box below).
