RHP Micah Owings vs RHP Yovani Gallardo (4-2, 3.83, +today vs StL)

The first 10,000 fans will receive a copy of *Stars & Stripes Magazine*...today's ceremonial first pitch will be thrown out by Clermont County native **Staff Sergeant Chad Keirns**, a 7-year Army veteran who has served 2 combat tours in Iraq...tomorrow he returnes to active duty at Fort Campbell...today's honorary game captain is Hillsboro native **Staff Sergeant Ralph "Frankie" Steward**, who was wounded in Iraq in the fall of 2008 while on his third tour of duty...he has spent more than 18 years in the Army and has been awarded the **Bronze Star** and **Purple Heart**...singing *God Bless America* will be **Staff Sergeant Felita Rowe** of the Air Force Band of Flight...at 3:00 p.m., every Major League game will stop for a **National Moment of Remembrance**.

TODAY'S GAME: Is **Game 1** of a 3-game series vs **Sally Gunter's** Astros and **Game 7** (3-3) of a 9-game homestand that also included the **Phillies** (1-2) and **Indians** (2-1)...beginning Friday the Reds take to the road again for a 3-game weekend series at **Mil** followed by a 4-game set at **StL**.

<u>CENTRAL CASTING</u>: Today's game is **Game 1** of 13 straight vs **National League Central Division** rivals (**3g vs Hou**, 3g at Mil, 4g at StL, 3g vs Chi)...following this 13-game stretch won't play within the division again until **Fourth of July** weekend (3g at StL), a drought that includes 21 consecutive games outside the **Central**.

<u>DOT, DOT, DOT...</u>: Starting pitchers **Aaron Harang** and **Wandy Rodriguez** are facing each other for the third time this season...with yesterday's 11-inning, 4-3 win vs the Indians **RHP Carlos Fisher** became the first Reds reliever to win in his Major League debut since **RHP Hector Carrasco** on **4/4/94 vs StL** (5-4 win)...the Reds' are **17-3** (.850) when they score first, the second-best winning percentage in the Major Leagues (SF 15-2, .882), and **6-17** when the opponent scores first

MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUT: Yesterday vs Cle, RHP Carlos Fisher will became the first Reds player this season to make his Major League debut...<u>last season</u> 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts, including RHP Johnny Cueto, IF Paul Janish, OF Jay Bruce, LHP Daniel Ray Herrera, RHP Daryl Thompson, IF Adam Rosales, OF Chris Dickerson, RHP Ramon Ramirez, C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo and RHP Josh Roenicke.

HALF-PRICE STUDENT TICKETS: For all 3g of this series, students can purchase Reds tickets for half price, courtesy of **First Student**...students can purchase half-price tickets for select seating sections at Great American Ball Park ticket windows or in advance at reds.com.

ALL-STAR RESOLUTION: State Senator Gary Cates (R-Butler County) has introduced a resolution in the Ohio Senate urging Major League Baseball to select the Reds and Great American Ball Park as hosts for the 2013 All-Star Game... the Reds last hosted the Mid-Summer Classic in 1988 at Riverfront Stadium...the club already is hosting one of MLB's jewel events this summer, when on 6/20 the Reds and White Sox meet here in the Civil Rights Game.

QUALITY CONTROL: Opposing pitchers have produced **26 quality starts**, including 11 straight from **4/14-4/25**... the Reds went **13-13** (.500) when the opposing starter produced a quality appearance...the Reds produced 21 quality starts (**Cueto** 6, **Harang** 5, **Arroyo** 5, **Volquez** 3, **Owings** 2) and went **18-3** in those QS (.857).

<u>ZEROES</u>: Reds pitchers lead the National League with **6 team shutouts** (SF 2nd w/ 5sho)...produced those 6 shutouts in their first **26g**, their fastest to 6 blankings since the **1914 staff** threw its sixth shutout in the **25th** game...Cin produced 6 team shutouts all of last season.

GILLETTE CIVIL RIGHTS GAME: At Great American Ball Park on Sat, 6/20 the Reds and Chicago White Sox will meet in the Gillette Civil Rights Game, the first time the contest will be played during the regular season...the weekend's festivities will include a roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's Harriet Tubman Theater (Fri, 6/19, 4:00 p.m.), a luncheon at Duke Energy Center honoring the 3 winners of Major League Baseball's Beacon Awards (Sat, 6/20, 11:30 a.m.) and a Youth Summit at Fountain Square downtown (Sat, 6/20, 4:00 p.m.)...the luncheon on Sat, 6/20 will honor Beacon of Hope winner Bill Cosby, Beacon of Life winner Hank Aaron and Beacon of Change winner Muhammad Ali...former President Bill Clinton will be the keynote speaker at that luncheon...for more information, log on to www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame.

<u>ALL-STARS AMONG US</u>: Major League Baseball and *People* magazine invite fans to nominate individuals who have gone above and beyond to serve their communities during these difficult times...30 **Everyday All-Stars**, one representing each team, will attend and be honored at the **All-Star Game** in **St. Louis**...one person will be featured in *People* magazine...to nominate an **Everyday All-Star**, log on to **PeopleAllStars.com**.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (10-12, .455): The Reds went **2-4-2** in their first 8 home series and produced a winning record on just 1 of their first 3 completed homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **251-257-1**...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38).

REDS ON THE ROAD (13-8, .619): The Reds went 5-1-1 in their first 7 road series...produced winning records on each of their first 2 road trips (7-3, 3-2) and a .500 record on the third trip (3-3)...entering this season and dating back to 2006, the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips.

IN THE STANDINGS (49): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 8, THIRD - 18, FOURTH - 18, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...at 20-15 were a season-high 6g over .500 for the first time since the 2006 season, when they reached a season-high 12g over .500 at 36-24...have spent 37 days above, 5 days at and 7 days below .500.

REDS vs ASTROS: The Reds are 402-382-1 all-time vs the Astros, including 4-3 this season, 7-15 the last 2 seasons and 11-26 the last 3 seasons...the Reds' 4-2 win at Minute Maid Park on 4/19/09 was their 400th victory vs Hou...<u>at Great American Ball Park</u>: Reds are 16-32-1, including 1-2 this season, 0-6 in 2008 and 2-16 the last 3 seasons... Cin's 3-0 win on 4/29 snapped its 11-game losing streak here vs Hou...Hou's .667 winning percentage at GABP (32-16) is the best among all opponents (LAD 2nd, 13-7, .650)...**Lance Berkman's** 20 homers at GABP are the most by any Reds opponent (**Jason Bay & Albert Pujols** T2nd, 14)...**Roy Oswalt's** 7 wins here tie Chi's **Carlos Zambrano** for the most by an opposing pitcher.

<u>Last Started</u>: Wed vs SD and earned the 5-1 victory (7ip, 4h, 1er, 2bb, 9k, 1hr, 109 pitches, 72 strikes)...left leading, 3-1...allowed only a leadoff HR to Ibanez in the fourth inning.

Red Hots: Is making his 10th start of the season and his third start opposing Wandy Rodriguez...in his previous 9 starts the Reds went 4-5 and scored just 31 runs (3.44 r/g)...in his 9 starts Reds batters hit .242 (72-298)...on 4/23 at Chi recorded the 1,000th strikeout of his career (Derrek Lee)...his 3-hitter in the club's fifth game, a 2-0 win on 4/12 vs Pit, was the quickest complete game by a Reds pitcher since Pete Harnisch threw a CG in the Reds' fourth game of 1999.

Astronomical: In his 2 starts vs the Astros this season, a 7-0 loss at Hou on 4/18 and an 8-3 loss at Cin on 4/28, allowed 10 earned runs in 11.0 innings...in his other 7 starts went **4-2**, **2.05** (48.1ip, 11er).

<u>Home Cookin'</u>: Is **3-2**, **2.45** (33ip, 9er) in 5 starts at Great American Ball Park and **1-2**, **4.10** (26.1ip, 12er) in 4 starts on the road.

Opening Day: In the 2-1 loss vs the Mets made his fourth straight Opening Day start, the first Reds pitcher to do so since **RHP Jose Rijo** had the honors in 4 straight seasons from 1992-95...the only other Reds pitchers to make at least 4 consecutive Opening Day starts are **Pete Donohue** (5 straight, 1923-27) and **Mario Soto** (5, 1982-86)...**Soto** holds the club record for overall Opening Day starts (6).

Staff Ace: Since he was acquired from the Athletics at the 2003 trading deadline is the Reds' leader in most statistical pitching categories, including starts (176), wins (67), innings pitched (1128.1) and strikeouts (953)...since the beginning of the 2006 season leads the National League in innings pitched (709.2; Arroyo 2nd, 707.1)...in 2005 and '07 won the BBWAA's Johnny Vander Meer Award as Cin's Most Outstanding Pitcher.

Community Affairs: Is one of the club's more active members of the local community...for the third straight season, as part of his Aaron's Aces ticket program is hosting at all Sunday home games children of military personnel serving in the War On Terrorism...along with wife Jen donated \$55,000 to the Miracle League of Greater Cincinnati and Northern Kentucky and on 5/9 attended the dedication of that field at the Durham Recreation Complex in Western Hills...for his community service has been the club's nominee for the Robert Clemente Award (2007), Branch Rickey Award (2007) and Marvin Miller Man of the Year Award (2007, 2008).

<u>Harang vs Astros</u>: Is making his 22nd career appearance vs Hou, his third of the season...is opposing Wandy Rodriguez for the third time this year...in his last 4 starts vs the Astros is 0-4, 8.59 (22ip, 32h, 21er, 7hr).

Harang's Most Recent Starts: 4/18 at Hou and suffered the 7-0 loss (6+ip, 10h, 5er, 1bb, 6k, 93 pitches, 62 strikes)...left trailing, 3-0, but was charged with 2 more runs scored off Burton...Reds batters produced 2 singles off Rodriguez (7ip, 10k), Sampson and Fulchino...4/28 vs Hou and suffered the 8-3 loss (5ip, 6h, 6r, 5er, 1bb, 2k, 1hr, 77 pitches, 52 strikes)...left trailing, 6-1...allowed an unearned run in the first inning and a solo HR to Ivan Rodriguez in the second...allowed 4 more runs in the fifth frame...5/9 vs StL and celebrated his 31st birthday with an 8-3 victory (7ip, 7h, 3r, 2er, 1bb, 7k, 1hr, 107 pitches, 69 strikes)...left leading, 8-3...allowed only a 2-out, 2-run HR to Ludwick in the third inning and an unearned run in the seventh following 2 Reds errors...while batting with the bases loaded and 2 outs in the sixth inning produced his first hit and RBI of the season, a 2-run single off Kyle Lohse that increased Cin's lead to 6-2...5/15 at SD, returned to his hometown and in his 200th career appearance suffered the 5-3 loss (6.1ip, 8h, 5er, 2bb, 6k, 1hr, 108 pitches, 65 strikes)...left with 2 runners on base and the score tied, 3-3, but was charged with 2 runs scored off Weathers...with 2 outs in the first inning allowed a solo HR to Gonzalez, who homered in his fifth straight game to tie the club record...retired the first 2 batters of the sixth inning but then allowed a single to Gerut and an RBI-double to Kouzmanoff...was replaced in the seventh inning after Eckstein's RBI-single tied it at 3-3.

Tomorrow's Pitcher: RHP Micah Owings

<u>Last Started</u>: Thu vs Phi and suffered the 12-5 loss (3ip, 6h, 5er, 3bb, 3k, 1hr, 71 pitches, 41 strikes)...left trailing, 5-0...allowed 1 run in the first inning, 3 runs in the second and a solo HR to Dobbs in the third.

Red Hots: Tomorrow will make his eighth start of the season and his second start since an emergency relief appearance on 5/16 at SD... in his previous 7 starts the Reds went 3-4 and scored 33 runs (4.71 r/g)...has 2 quality starts...with an 8-2 win on 4/26 vs Atl snapped his 9-game losing streak dating back to a 9-3 Diamondbacks victory on 5/25/08 at Atl...in 14 apps and 10 starts between victories went 0-9, 8.53 (51.2ip, 49er).

In Relief: Made his only relief appearance of the season in the 16-inning, 6-5 loss at SD on 5/16...threw a career-high 5.2 innings in relief (3h, 1er, 3bb, 5k, 1hr, 81 pitches, 44 strikes)...entered the game in the 11th inning as the Reds' seventh and final pitcher... retired his first 10 batters until Scott Hairston singled with 1 out in the 14th inning...Nick Hundley homered to end the 5-hour, 14 minute struggle.
