### To Serve & Protect

Tonight is Police & Fire Appreciation Night...ceremonial first pitches will be thrown by Cincinnati Police Officer **Michael Glenn** and Cincinnati District Fire Chief **Ed Dadosky**...the colors for tonight's game will be presented by the **Hamilton County Police Association**...Cincinnati firefighter **John Winfrey** will sing our *National Anthem*.

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** Is **Game 2** (1-0) of a 3-game series vs **Gene Dias'** Astros and **Game 8** (4-3) of a 9-game homestand that also included the **Phillies** (1-2) and **Indians** (2-1)...beginning Friday the Reds take to the road again for a 3-game weekend series at **Mil** followed by a 4-game set at **StL**.

**CENTRAL CASTING:** Tonight's game is **Game 2** (1-0) of 13 straight vs **National League Central Division** rivals (**1-0 vs Hou**, 3g at Mil, 4g at StL, 3g vs Chi)...following this 13-game stretch won't play within the division again until **Fourth of July** weekend (3g at StL), a drought that includes 21 consecutive games outside the **Central**.

**DOT, DOT, DOT...:** With a victory tonight or tomorrow the Reds will have produced their second straight winning homestand after losing the first 2...the Reds have won 3 of their last 4g and 5 of their last 6g...are **17-3** (.850) when they score first, the second-best winning percentage in the majors (SF 16-2, .889), and **6-17** when opponent scores first.

**MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUT:** On Sun vs Cle, **RHP Carlos Fisher** became the first Reds player this season to make his Major League debut...last season 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts, including **RHP Johnny Cueto**, **IF Paul Janish**, **OF Jay Bruce**, **LHP Daniel Ray Herrera**, **RHP Daryl Thompson**, **IF Adam Rosales**, **OF Chris Dickerson**, **RHP Ramon Ramirez**, **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** and **RHP Josh Roenicke**.

**HALF-PRICE STUDENT TICKETS:** Today and tomorrow, students can purchase Reds tickets for half price, courtesy of **First Student**...students can purchase half-price tickets for select seating sections at Great American Ball Park ticket windows or in advance at [reds.com](http://reds.com).

**ALL-STAR RESOLUTION:** State Senator **Gary Cates** (R-Butler County) has introduced a resolution in the Ohio Senate urging Major League Baseball to select the Reds and Great American Ball Park as hosts for the **2013 All-Star Game**...the Reds last hosted the Mid-Summer Classic in **1988** at Riverfront Stadium...the club already is hosting one of MLB's jewel events this summer, when on **6/20** the Reds and White Sox meet here in the **Civil Rights Game**.

**QUALITY CONTROL:** Opposing pitchers have produced **26 quality starts**, including 11 straight from **4/14-4/25**...the Reds went **13-13** (.500) when the opposing starter produced a quality appearance...the Reds produced 21 quality starts (**Cueto 6**, **Harang 5**, **Arroyo 5**, **Volquez 3**, **Owings 2**) and went **18-3** in those QS (.857).

**ZEROES:** Reds pitchers lead the National League with **6 team shutouts** (SF 2nd w/ 5sho)...produced those 6 shutouts in their first **26g**, their fastest to 6 blankings since the **1914 staff** threw its sixth shutout in the **25th** game...Cin produced 6 team shutouts all of last season.

**GILLETTE CIVIL RIGHTS GAME:** At Great American Ball Park on **Sat, 6/20** the Reds and Chicago White Sox will meet in the **Gillette Civil Rights Game**, the first time the contest will be played during the regular season...the weekend's festivities will include a roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's **Harriet Tubman Theater** (Fri, 6/19, 4:00 p.m.), a luncheon at **Duke Energy Center** honoring the 3 winners of Major League Baseball's **Beacon Awards** (Sat, 6/20, 11:30 a.m.) and a **Youth Summit** at **Fountain Square** downtown (Sat, 6/20, 4:00 p.m.)...the luncheon on Sat, 6/20 will honor Beacon of Hope winner **Bill Cosby**, Beacon of Life winner **Hank Aaron** and Beacon of Change winner **Muhammad Ali**...former **President Bill Clinton** will be the keynote speaker at that luncheon...for more information, log on to [www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame](http://www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame).

**ALL-STARS AMONG US:** Major League Baseball and *People* magazine invite fans to nominate individuals who have gone above and beyond to serve their communities during these difficult times...**30 Everyday All-Stars**, one representing each team, will attend and be honored at the **All-Star Game** in **St. Louis**...one person will be featured in *People* magazine...to nominate an **Everyday All-Star**, log on to [PeopleAllStars.com](http://PeopleAllStars.com).

**VOTE REDS!** Fan voting for the **2009 All-Star Game** in St. Louis kicks off in Great American Ball Park continues through **6/20**...in addition to paper ballots, fans can vote online using **laptop computers** set up near **Section 114** on Terrace Level...one online voter per game will be selected randomly to receive a **Kroger gift card**...Reds players on the ballot include **C Ramon Hernandez**, **1B Joey Votto**, **2B Brandon Phillips**, **SS Alex Gonzalez**, **3B Edwin Encarnacion**, **OF Chris Dickerson**, **OF Willy Taveras** and **OF Jay Bruce**.

**REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (11-12, .478):** The Reds went **2-4-2** in their first 8 completed home series and produced a winning record on just 1 of their first 3 completed homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **252-257-1**...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38).

**REDS ON THE ROAD (13-8, .619):** The Reds went **5-1-1 in their first 7 road series**...produced winning records on each of their first 2 road trips (7-3, 3-2) and a .500 record on the third trip (3-3)...entering this season and dating back to 2006, the Reds had losing records in **23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

**IN THE STANDINGS (50):** The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 8, THIRD - 19, FOURTH - 18, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...at **20-14** were a season-high **6g over .500** for the first time since the **2006 season**, when they reached a season-high **12g over .500** at **36-24**...have spent **38** days above, **5** days at and **7** days below .500.

**REDS vs ASTROS:** The Reds are 403-382-1 all-time vs the Astros, including 5-3 this season, 8-15 the last 2 seasons and 12-26 the last 3 seasons...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 17-32-1, including 2-2 this season, 0-6 in 2008 and 3-16 the last 3 seasons...Cin's 3-0 win on 4/29 snapped its 11-game losing streak here vs Hou...Hou's .653 winning percentage at GABP (32-17) is the best among all opponents (LAD 2nd, 13-7, .650)...**Lance Berkman's** 21 homers at GABP are the most by any Reds opponent (**Jason Bay** & **Albert Pujols** 2nd, 14)...**Roy Oswalt's** 7 wins here tie Chi's **Carlos Zambrano** for the most by an opposing pitcher...**last Reds sweep:** at Cin: 9/22-9/24, 2000 (3g); 5/21-5/24, 2004 (4g)...at Hou: 9/14-9/15, 1981 (2g); 6/2-6/4, 2006 (3g); 6/24-6/27, 1999 (4g).

IF Paul Janish pitched in the ninth inning of the 15-3 loss vs Mil on 5/6 (1ip, 5h, 5er, 0bb, 2k, Fielder 2-run HR)...he became the first Reds position player to pitch since Lenny Harris on 6/1/98 at SF.				

**Reds Pitchers:** Rank sixth in the National League with a 4.03 team ERA...**on the homestand are 4-3, 4.43 (65ip, 32er)**...have 6 team shutouts...had 6 shutouts all last season...with a 7-0 win on 5/5 at Fla reached 6 shutouts in their 26th game, their fastest to 6 shutouts since the 1914 Reds threw their sixth shutout in their 25th game.

**Reds Starters:** Rank seventh in the National League with 4.20 rotation ERA...**on the homestand are 3-2, 4.79 (41.1ip 22er)**...through the first 41g of the season used just 5 starting pitchers, their longest such streak to begin a year since **RHP John Roper** became the staff's **sixth** different starter in the **42nd game** of the **1994 campaign**...on 5/23 vs Cle, in the club's 42nd game, **RHP Homer Bailey** became the Reds' sixth starting pitcher...in 44g have produced 21 quality starts (**Cueto 6, Harang 5, Arroyo 5, Volquez 3, Owings 2**)...the Reds went 18-3 in those quality starts (.857)...**Aaron Harang** threw a 3-hitter in the 2-0 win vs Pit in the club's fifth game of the season...was the earliest complete game by a Reds pitcher since **Pete Harnisch** beat the Cardinals, 3-0 in Busch Stadium, in the **fourth** contest of the **1999** campaign...last season, **Bronson Arroyo** threw the staff's first CG in a 2-1 win at Hou in the 132nd game...4 times in the previous 7 years the Reds tied the franchise record for fewest complete games in a season (2cg, 2001, 2002, 2005, 2008).

**Reds Relievers:** Rank third in the National League with a 3.69 bullpen ERA...**on the homstand are 1-1-2, 3.80 (23.2ip, 10er)**...in the last 36g have posted a 2.88era (106.1ip, 34er) and in the last 24g have posted a 2.49era (72.1ip, 20er)...none of the previous notes include the pitching performance by IF Paul Janish in the ninth inning of the 15-3 loss on 5/6 vs Mil (1ip, 5er)...didn't blow a save until the club's 36th game, a 6-5 loss in 16 innings on 5/16 at SD...for the second straight season the Reds' bullpen was the last in the Major Leagues to suffer a blown save...in 2008 didn't blow a save until the 41st game (5/14)...over the last 2 seasons **Francisco Cordero** has recorded all **46** of the bullpen's saves (34sv in 2008, 12sv in 2009).

Ranks third in the National League in saves (12)...in his last 12 apps has posted a 0.75era (12ip, 1er)...with 223 career saves ranks 30th on that all-time list...Ugeth Urbina is 29th with 237 saves...including last season has recorded the bullpen's last 46 saves (34sv in 2008, 12sv in 2009)...dating back to last season has converted 26 consecutive save chances, including all 12 save opps this year...**suffered his last blown save on 7/21/08 vs SD**...in the 3-0 victory on 4/22 at Chi recorded his 100th save in the National League to become only the 11th pitcher in history with at least 100 saves in each league (see box below).
