Tonight is Police & Fire Appreciation Night...ceremonial first pitches will be thrown by Cincinnati Police Officer Michael Glenn and Cincinnati District Fire Chief Ed Dadosky...the colors for tonight's game will be presented by the Hamilton County Police Association...Cincinnati firefighter John Winfrey will sing our National Anthem.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is Game 2 (1-0) of a 3-game series vs Gene Dias' Astros and Game 8 (4-3) of a 9-game homestand that also included the **Phillies** (1-2) and **Indians** (2-1)...beginning Friday the Reds take to the road again for a 3-game weekend series at Mil followed by a 4-game set at StL.

CENTRAL CASTING: Tonight's game is Game 2 (1-0) of 13 straight vs National League Central Division rivals (1-0) vs Hou, 3g at Mil, 4g at StL, 3g vs Chi)...following this 13-game stretch won't play within the division again until Fourth of July weekend (3g at StL), a drought that includes 21 consecutive games outside the Central.

DOT, DOT, DOT...: With a victory tonight or tomorrow the Reds will have produced their second straight winning homestand after losing the first 2...the Reds have won 3 of their last 4g and 5 of their last 6g...are 17-3 (.850) when they score first, the second-best winning percentage in the majors (SF 16-2, .889), and 6-17 when opponent scores first.

MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUT: On Sun vs Cle, RHP Carlos Fisher became the first Reds player this season to make his Major League debut...last season 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts, including RHP Johnny Cueto, IF Paul Janish, OF Jay Bruce, LHP Daniel Ray Herrera, RHP Daryl Thompson, IF Adam Rosales, OF Chris Dickerson, RHP Ramon Ramirez, C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo and RHP Josh Roenicke.

HALF-PRICE STUDENT TICKETS: Today and tomorrow, students can purchase Reds tickets for half price, courtesy of First Student...students can purchase half-price tickets for select seating sections at Great American Ball Park ticket windows or in advance at reds.com.

ALL-STAR RESOLUTION: State Senator Gary Cates (R-Butler County) has introduced a resolution in the Ohio Senate urging Major League Baseball to select the Reds and Great American Ball Park as hosts for the 2013 All-Star Game... the Reds last hosted the Mid-Summer Classic in 1988 at Riverfront Stadium...the club already is hosting one of MLB's jewel events this summer, when on 6/20 the Reds and White Sox meet here in the Civil Rights Game.

QUALITY CONTROL: Opposing pitchers have produced 26 quality starts, including 11 straight from 4/14-4/25... the Reds went **13-13** (.500) when the opposing starter produced a quality appearance...the Reds produced 21 quality starts (**Cueto** 6, **Harang** 5, **Arroyo** 5, **Volquez** 3, **Owings** 2) and went **18-3** in those QS (.857).

ZEROES: Reds pitchers lead the National League with 6 team shutouts (SF 2nd w/ 5sho)...produced those 6 shutouts in their first 26g, their fastest to 6 blankings since the 1914 staff threw its sixth shutout in the 25th game...Cin produced 6 team shutouts all of last season.

GILLETTE CIVIL RIGHTS GAME: At Great American Ball Park on Sat, 6/20 the Reds and Chicago White Sox will meet in the Gillette Civil Rights Game, the first time the contest will be played during the regular season...the weekend's festivities will include a roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's Harriet Tubman Theater (Fri, 6/19, 4:00 p.m.), a luncheon at Duke Energy Center honoring the 3 winners of Major League Baseball's Beacon Awards (Sat, 6/20, 11:30 a.m.) and a Youth Summit at Fountain Square downtown (Sat, 6/20, 4:00 p.m.)...the luncheon on Sat, 6/20 will honor Beacon of Hope winner Bill Cosby, Beacon of Life winner Hank Aaron and Beacon of Change winner Muhammad Ali...former President Bill Clinton will be the keynote speaker at that luncheon...for more information, log on to www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame.

ALL-STARS AMONG US: Major League Baseball and People magazine invite fans to nominate individuals who have gone above and beyond to serve their communities during these difficult times...30 Everyday All-Stars, one representing each team, will attend and be honored at the All-Star Game in St. Louis...one person will be featured in People magazine...to nominate an Everyday All-Star, log on to PeopleAllStars.com.

VOTE REDS!: Fan voting for the 2009 All-Star Game in St. Louis kicks off in Great American Ball Park continues through 6/20...in addition to paper ballots, fans can vote online using laptop computers set up near Section 114 on Terrace Level...one online voter per game will be selected randomly to receive a Kroger gift card...Reds players on the ballot include C Ramon Hernandez, 1B Joey Votto, 2B Brandon Phillips, SS Alex Gonzalez, 3B Edwin Encarnacion, OF Chris Dickerson, OF Willy Taveras and OF Jay Bruce.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (11-12, .478): The Reds went 2-4-2 in their first 8 completed home series and produced a winning record on just 1 of their first 3 completed homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2)...in 7 seasons at GABP are 252-257-1...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38).

REDS ON THE ROAD (13-8, .619): The Reds went 5-1-1 in their first 7 road series...produced winning records on each of their first 2 road trips (7-3, 3-2) and a .500 record on the third trip (3-3)...entering this season and dating back to 2006, the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips.

IN THE STANDINGS (50): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 8, THIRD - 19, FOURTH - 18, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...at 20-14 were a season-high 6g over .500 for the first time since the 2006 season, when they reached a season-high 12g over .500 at **36-24**...have spent **38** days above, **5** days at and **7** days below .500.

REDS vs ASTROS: The Reds are 403-382-1 all-time vs the Astros, including 5-3 this season, 8-15 the last 2 seasons and 12-26 the last 3 seasons...at Great American Ball Park: Reds are 17-32-1, including 2-2 this season, 0-6 in 2008 and 3-16 the last 3 seasons...Cin's 3-0 win on 4/29 snapped its 11-game losing streak here vs Hou...Hou's .653 winning percentage at GABP (32-17) is the best among all opponents (LAD 2nd, 13-7, .650)...**Lance Berkman's** 21 homers at GABP are the most by any Reds opponent (**Jason Bay & Albert Pujols** 2nd, 14)...**Roy Oswalt's** 7 wins here tie Chi's Carlos Zambrano for the most by an opposing pitcher... last Reds sweep: at Cin: 9/22-9/24, 2000 (3g); 5/21-5/24, 2004 (4g)...at Hou: 9/14-9/15, 1981 (2g); 6/2-6/4, 2006 (3g); 6/24-6/27, 1999 (4g).

Last Started: Thu vs Phi and suffered the 12-5 loss (3ip, 6h, 5er, 3bb, 3k, 1hr, 71 pitches, 41 strikes)...left trailing, 5-0...allowed 1 run in the first inning, 3 runs in the second and a solo HR to Dobbs in the third.

Red Hots: Is making his eighth start of the season, his second start since an emergency relief appearance on 5/16 at SD...in his previous 7 starts the Reds went 3-4 and scored 33 runs (4.71 r/g)...has 2 quality starts... with an 8-2 win on 4/26 vs Atl snapped his 9-game losing streak dating back to a 9-3 Diamondbacks victory on 5/25/08 at Atl...in 14 apps and 10 starts between victories went **0-9**, **8.53** (51.2ip, 49er).

In Relief: Made his only relief appearance of the season in the 16-inning, 6-5 loss at SD on 5/16...threw a career-high 5.2 innings in relief (3h, 1er, 3bb, 5k, 1hr, 81 pitches, 44 strikes)...entered the game in the 11th inning as the Reds' seventh and final pitcher...retired his first 10 batters until Scott Hairston singled with 1 out in the 14th inning...Nick Hundley homered to end the 5-hour, 14 minute struggle.

At The Plate: In 2007 won the National League's Silver Slugger Award (.333, 4hr, 15rbi)...has 6 career home runs, including 1 this season (5/10 vs StL, pinch-hit solo off Ryan Franklin)...his 5 career home runs prior to 2009 are listed on page 149 of the media guide...overall this season is hitting .280 (7-25, 3 2b, 1 3b, 1hr, 4rbi)...on 5/7 vs Mil produced the first triple by a Reds pitcher since Eric Milton did it on 4/13/06 at Cubs.

Owings' Most Recent Starts: 4/15 at Mil, in his Reds pitching debut suffered the 9-3 loss (5+ip, 5h, 4er, 2bb, 2k, 2hr, 89 pitches, 47 strikes)...left with the score tied, 3-3, but was charged with another run scored off Burton...the Brewers added 4 more runs off Burton in that 5-run sixth inning...Owings allowed Fielder's sac fly in the first and leadoff HR to Cameron in both the second and fourth frames...4/21 at Chi, in the Reds' first game of the season at Wrigley Field and suffered the 7-2 loss (4.2ip, 5h, 5r, 2er, 4bb, 3k, 1hr, 94 pitches, 61 strikes)...left trailing, 4-2, but was charged with another run scored off Lincoln...in the second inning allowed a leadoff HR to Micah Hoffpauir...in the fifth was charged with 3 unearned runs...start of the game was delayed 12 minutes by weather...gametime temperature was 40 degrees with a 15 mile per hour wind blowing left to right...4/26 vs Atl and earned the 8-2 victory (7ip, 6h, 1er, 3bb, 6k, 1hr, 102 pitches, 60 strikes)...left leading, 8-1...allowed only a solo HR to David Ross with 1 out in the seventh inning...his first victory since May 2008 snapped a personal 9-game losing streak...5/2 at Pit and suffered the 8-6 loss (5.2ip, 9h, 5er, 2bb, 0k, 99 pitches, 64 strikes)...left trailing, 5-3...in the first inning allowed 4 runs on 4 hits, 1 walk and 1 hit batter...5/7 vs Mil and earned the 6-5 victory (6ip, 7h, 5r, 4er, 1bb, 4k, 100 pitches, 67 strikes)...left leading, 6-5...allowed 3 runs in the fourth inning and 2 runs in the sixth...his RBI-triple in the bottom of the fourth off Braden Looper gave the Reds a 4-3 lead they would not relinquish...5/12 at Ari, in his first career appearance vs his former team earned the 3-1 victory (7+ip, 4h, 1er, 2bb, 4k, 1hbp, 90 pitches, 53 strikes)...took a 4-hit shutout into the eighth inning but then hit with a pitch leadoff batter Ryan Roberts... was charged with that run, which scored on Felipe Lopez' RBI-double off Arthur Rhodes.

<u>Tomorrow's Pitcher</u>: Bronson Arroyo

<u>Last Pitched</u>: Fri vs Cle and earned the 3-1 victory (8ip, 5h, 1er, 2bb, 2k, 1hr, 105 pitches, 61 strikes)...left leading, 3-1...allowed only a solo HR to Sizemore in the first inning.

Red Hots: Tomorrow will make his 10th start of the season, his second against the Astros...in his previous 9 starts the Reds went 6-3 and scored 44 runs (4.89 r/g)...has 5 quality starts...since he was acquired by the Reds prior to the 2006 season leads all Major League pitchers with 112 starts and ranks second in the National League with 707.1 innings pitched (Aaron Harang 1st, 714.2).

Arroyo vs Astros: On 4/20 at Hou, in his 100th career road start earned the 4-3 victory (7ip, 9h, 3er, 0bb, 2k, 2hr, 81 pitches, 53 strikes)...left leading, 4-3...allowed run-scoring groundout to Rodriguez in the second inning...allowed back-to-back HR to Berkman and Lee with 2 outs in the sixth.

Short Cuts: Made the 2 shortest starts of his career (1ip, plus 4 batters) in a 14-1 loss at Tor on 6/24/08 and a 15-3 loss on 5/6/09 vs Mil...in between those 2 starts went 15-5, 3.76...his 15 victories in that span was second-most in the Major Leagues (Roy Halladay, 17-6, 2.77)...since that loss at Tor last season, still ranks second in the majors with 17 wins.

<u>Perfect</u>: Began the season 3-0 for the third time in his career but for the first time won his first 3 starts of a season...won his first 2 starts in 2006, when he started off 5-0...began the 2005 campaign 4-0...was the first Reds pitcher to begin the season in the rotation and win his first 3 starts since **LHP Pete Schourek** did it in 1996 and the first righthander since **Jack Armstrong** won his first 5 starts of 1990.
