NASCAR Night

Tonight's game ball will be delivered by **Stephen Leicht**, driver of the #29 car in the **NASCAR Nationwide Series**...honorary captain is **Erik Darnell**, driver of the #6 car...the series' **Meijer 300** presented by Ritz will be held at the **Kentucky Speedway** on **Sat, 6/13**...during the first 2 innings tonight the drivers will sign autographs in the Fan Zone.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is **Game 3** (2-0) of a 3-game series vs **Gene Dias'** Astros and **Game 9** (5-3) of a 9-game homestand that also included the **Phillies** (1-2) and **Indians** (2-1)...beginning Friday the Reds take to the road again for a 3-game weekend series at **Mil** followed by a 4-game set at **StL**.

CENTRAL CASTING: Tonight's game is **Game 3** (2-0) of 13 straight vs **National League Central Division** rivals (**2-0 vs Hou**, 3g at Mil, 4g at StL, 3g vs Chi)...following this 13-game stretch won't play within the division again until **Fourth of July** weekend (3g at StL), a drought that includes 21 consecutive games outside the **Central**.

DOT, DOT, DOT...: The Reds' current 3-game winning streak ties their season high (4th time)...the Reds have won 4 of their last 5g and 6 of their last 7g...at **12-12** have evened their record **at home** for the first time this season...regardless of tonight's outcome have produced their second straight winning homestand after losing the first 2...are **19-3** (.864) when they score first, the second-best winning percentage in the Major Leagues (SF 17-2, .895), and **6-17** when the opponent scores first.

MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUT: RHP **Carlos Fisher** is the only Reds player this season to make his Major League debut...last season 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts, including RHP **Johnny Cueto**, IF **Paul Janish**, OF **Jay Bruce**, LHP **Daniel Ray Herrera**, RHP **Daryl Thompson**, IF **Adam Rosales**, OF **Chris Dickerson**, RHP **Ramon Ramirez**, C/IF/OF **Wilkin Castillo** and RHP **Josh Roenicke**.

ALL-STAR RESOLUTION: State Senator **Gary Cates** (R-Butler County) has introduced a resolution in the Ohio Senate urging Major League Baseball to select the Reds and Great American Ball Park as hosts for the **2013 All-Star Game**...the Reds last hosted the Mid-Summer Classic in **1988** at Riverfront Stadium...the club already is hosting one of MLB's jewel events this summer, when on **6/20** the Reds and White Sox meet here in the **Gillette Civil Rights Game**.

QUALITY CONTROL: Opposing pitchers have produced **26 quality starts**, including 11 straight from **4/14-4/25**...the Reds went **13-13** (.500) when the opposing starter produced a quality appearance...the Reds produced 21 quality starts (**Cueto 6, Harang 5, Arroyo 5, Volquez 3, Owings 2**) and went **18-3** in those QS (.857).

ZEROES: The Reds and Giants lead the National League with **6 team shutouts**...the Reds produced their 6 shutouts in the first **26g**, their fastest to 6 blankings since the **1914 staff** threw its sixth shutout in the **25th** game...Cin produced 6 team shutouts all of last season.

GILLETTE CIVIL RIGHTS GAME: At Great American Ball Park on **Sat, 6/20** the Reds and Chicago White Sox will meet in the **Gillette Civil Rights Game**, the first time the contest will be played during the regular season...the weekend's festivities will include a roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's **Harriet Tubman Theater** (Fri, 6/19, 4:00 p.m.), a luncheon at **Duke Energy Center** honoring the 3 winners of Major League Baseball's **Beacon Awards** (Sat, 6/20, 11:30 a.m.) and a **Youth Summit** at **Fountain Square** downtown (Sat, 6/20, 4:00 p.m.)...the luncheon on Sat, 6/20 will honor Beacon of Hope winner **Bill Cosby**, Beacon of Life winner **Hank Aaron** and Beacon of Change winner **Muhammad Ali**...former **President Bill Clinton** will be the keynote speaker at that luncheon...for more information, log on to www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame.

VOTE REDS! Fan voting for the **2009 All-Star Game** in St. Louis kicks off in Great American Ball Park continues through **6/20**...in addition to paper ballots, fans can vote online using **laptop computers** set up near **Section 114** on Terrace Level...one online voter per game will be selected randomly to receive a **Kroger gift card**...Reds players on the ballot include **C Ramon Hernandez**, **1B Joey Votto**, **2B Brandon Phillips**, **SS Alex Gonzalez**, **3B Edwin Encarnacion**, OF **Chris Dickerson**, OF **Willy Taveras** and OF **Jay Bruce**.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (12-12, .500): The Reds went **3-4-2** in their 9 home series, including this one, and produced a winning record on 2 of their first 4 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 5-3+tonight)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **253-257-1**...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38)...**at 217-217-1** the Reds had evened their overall record at GABP for the first time since **6/26/04** (57-57)...also reached .500 at **219-219-1**.

REDS ON THE ROAD (13-8, .619): The Reds went **5-1-1 in their first 7 road series**...produced winning records on each of their first 2 road trips (7-3, 3-2) and a .500 record on the third trip (3-3)...entering this season and dating back to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

IN THE STANDINGS (51): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 8, THIRD - 20, FOURTH - 18, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...at **20-14** were a season-high **6g over .500** for the first time since the **2006 season**, when they reached a season-high **12g** over .500 at **36-24**...have spent **39** days above, **5** days at and **7** days below .500.

REDS vs ASTROS: The Reds are 404-382-1 all-time vs the Astros, including 6-3 this season, 9-15 the last 2 seasons and 13-26 the last 3 seasons...the Reds' 4-2 win at Minute Maid Park on 4/19/09 was their 400th victory vs Hou...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 18-32-1, including 3-2 this season, 0-6 in 2008 and 4-16 the last 3 seasons...Cin's 3-0 win on 4/29 snapped its 11-game losing streak here vs Hou...Hou's .640 winning percentage at GABP (32-18) ranks second-best among all opponents (LAD 1st, 13-7, .650)...**Lance Berkman's** 21 homers at GABP are the most by any Reds opponent (**Jason Bay** & **Albert Pujols** 2nd, 14)...**Roy Oswalt's** 7 wins here tie Chi's **Carlos Zambrano** for the most by an opposing pitcher...**last Reds sweep:** at Cin: 9/22, 1992 (2g, DH); 9/22-9/24, 2000 (3g); 5/21-5/24, 2004 (4g)...at Hou: 9/14-9/15, 1981 (2g); 6/2-6/4, 2006 (3g); 6/24-6/27, 1999 (4g).

UP NEXT: REDS at BREWERS: The Reds are 93-90-1 all-time vs the Brewers, including 3-2 this season and 13-10 the last 2 seasons...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 27-26, including 1-1 this season...**at Miller Park:** Reds are 39-34, including 2-1 this season and 8-3 the last 2 seasons.

Wins Beginning 6/29

In the 14-1 loss on 6/24/08 at Tor, **Bronson Arroyo** made the shortest start of his career and became only the sixth starting pitcher in Major League history to allow at least 10 earned runs in a game in which he retired 3 batters or fewer (1+ip, 11h, 10er)...beginning with his next start, a 9-5 win at Cle on 6/29/08, **Arroyo** has 17 wins, second-most in the majors since then:

Iron Man

Since he was acquired by the Reds prior to the 2006 season, **Bronson Arroyo** ranks among the Major League leaders in games started and innings pitched:

Last Pitched: Fri vs Cle and earned the 3-1 victory (8ip, 5h, 1er, 2bb, 2k, 1hr, 105 pitches, 61 strikes)...left leading, 3-1... allowed only a solo HR to Sizemore in the first inning.

Red Hots: Is making his 10th start of the season...in his previous 9 starts the Reds went 6-3 and scored 44 runs (4.89 r/g)...has 5 quality starts...since he was acquired by the Reds prior to the 2006 season leads all Major League pitchers with 112 starts and ranks second in the National League with 707.1 innings pitched (**Aaron Harang** 1st, 714.2).

Short Cuts: Made the 2 shortest starts of his career (1ip, plus 4 batters) in a 14-1 loss at Tor on 6/24/08 and a 15-3 loss on 5/6/09 vs Mil...in between those 2 starts went **15-5, 3.76**...his 15 victories in that span were the second-most in the Major Leagues (**Roy Halladay**, 17-6, 2.77)...since that loss at Tor last season, still ranks second in the majors with **17 victories**.

Perfect: Began the season 3-0 for the third time in his career but for the first time won his first 3 starts of a season...won his first 2 starts in 2006, when he started off 5-0...began the 2005 campaign 4-0...was the first Reds pitcher to begin the season in the rotation and win his first 3 starts since **LHP Pete Schourek** did it in 1996 and the first righthander since **Jack Armstrong** won his first 5 starts of 1990.

Career Highs: **Innings:** 9.0 (longest, 5x), last on 8/26/08 for Cin at Hou & 1+4bf (shortest, 2x), 6/24/08 for Cin at Tor & 5/6/09 for Cin vs Mil; **Hits:** 13, 9/26/08 for Cin at StL; **Runs:** 10 (2x), 6/23/00 for Pit at NYM & 6/24/08 for Cin at Tor; **Earned Runs:** 10, 6/24/08 for Cin at Tor; **Walks:** 5 (4x), last on 8/20/08 at Chi; **Strikeouts:** 12, 7/19/04 for Bos at Sea; **HR allowed:** 4, 4/7/08 vs Phi (Rollins leadoff, Burrell 2, Jenkins); **Complete Games:** 6, last on 8/26/08 for Cin at Hou (2-1 win); **Shutouts:** 1, 9/5/06 for Cin vs SF (3-0 win).

Arroyo's Most Recent Starts: 4/9 vs NYM, in his season debut earned the 8-6 victory (6ip, 8h, 5er, 2bb, 4k, 100 pitches, 68 strikes)...allowed 3 runs in the third inning, highlighted by Church's 2-run double, but the Reds came back with 4 runs in the bottom of that frame and then 4 more in the fifth...**4/14 at Mil** and earned the 6-1 victory (6.1ip, 4h, 1er, 4bb, 3k, 1hr, 105 pitches, 57 strikes)...left leading, 3-1, and the Reds added 3 runs in the ninth inning...allowed only Hardy's solo HR in the second inning...**4/20 at Hou** and in his 100th career road start earned the 4-3 victory (7ip, 9h, 3er, 0bb, 2k, 2hr, 81 pitches, 53 strikes)...left leading, 4-3...allowed run-scoring groundout to Rodriguez in the second inning...allowed back-to-back HR to Berkman and Lee with 2 outs in the sixth...**4/25 vs Atl** and suffered the 10-2 loss (5.2ip, 9h, 9er, 3bb, 5k, 1hbp, 2hr, 102 pitches, 60 strikes)...left trailing, 9-2...gave up 2 runs in the first inning, 3 in the second (CJones 3-run HR) and three in the sixth (Escobar 2-run HR)...**5/1 at Pit** and threw 8.0 shutout innings to earn the 4-0 win (4h, 3bb, 4k, 113 pitches, 71 strikes)...left leading, 2-0...**5/6 vs Mil** and suffered the 15-3 loss (1ip+4bf, 7h, 9er, 3bb, 0k, 2hr, 46 pitches, 24 strikes)...tied for the shortest start of his career...left trailing, 9-0...in the first inning allowed 5 runs on 2 walks and 4 hits, including a 3-run HR by Hardy...in the second allowed Braun's grand slam...**5/11 at Ari**, in his 200th career start earned the 13-5 victory (7ip, 10h, 5er, 0bb, 5k, 3hr, 123 pitches, 81 strikes)...allowed 4 of the 5 runs on homers to Upton (2-run), Lopez (solo) and Reynolds (solo)...Reds batters scored 13 runs on 18 hits and 8 extra-base hits, including 6 doubles, all season highs...**5/17 at SD** and suffered the 3-1 loss (7+ip, 6h, 3er, 4bb, 4k, 1hr, 119 pitches, 70 strikes)...allowed 2 runs in the first inning on consecutive 2-out, RBI-singles by Kouzmanoff and Gerut...allowed a HR to Kouzmanoff leading off the eighth.

Friday at Brewers: RHP Johnny Cueto

Last Pitched: Sun vs Cle and received no decision in the 11-inning, 4-3 victory (7ip, 6h, 3r, 2er, 3bb, 7k, 2hbp, 1wp, 111 pitches, 67 strikeouts)...left with the score tied, 3-3...allowed all 3 runs with 2 outs...in the fourth inning gave up a run-scoring double to Luis Valbuena...in the seventh allowed an RBI-triple to Grady Sizemore, who then scored on the play after obstruction was called on 3B Adam Rosales.

Red Hots: On Fri at Mil the 23-year-old righthander will make his 10th start of the season, the 41st start of his career and his first appearance of the year vs Mil...with a 2.37era ranks fourth in the National League...in his 9 starts the Reds went 6-3 and scored 36 runs (4 r/g)...in his last 7 apps produced all 6 of his quality starts.

Streaking I: In 5 starts from 4/22-5/13 went **4-0, 1.25** (36ip, 5er)...the 4-game winning streak was the longest of his career...allowed 4 earned runs in his first start of the season (6ip) and 12 earned runs in his last 8 starts (54.2ip, 1.98era).

Streaking II: In each of 4 starts from 4/22-5/8 threw at least 7.0 innings while allowing no more than 1 run, the longest streak of that kind by a Reds pitcher since **Tim Belcher** had a 4-game run from **5/27-6/13, 1992** (courtesy Elias Sports Bureau).

World Baseball Classic: Started the Dominican Republic's second game of the tournament and threw 4.2 scoreless innings to earn the 9-0 win vs Panama in the San Juan bracket (4.2ip, 3h, 1bb, 5k).
