(Bud) Selig for Beacon of Life winner Hank Aaron...Grammy Award-winning gospel artist BeBe Winans will perform at the luncheon and at that night's game...former President Bill Clinton will be the keynote speaker at the luncheon

At Great American Ball Park on **Sat**, **6/20** the Reds and Chicago White Sox will meet in the **Gillette Civil Rights Game**, the first time the contest will be played during the regular season...the weekend's festivities will include a roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's **Harriet Tubman Theater** (Fri, 6/19, 4:00 p.m.), a luncheon at **Duke Energy Center** honoring the 3 winners of Major League Baseball's **Beacon Awards** (Sat, 6/20, 11:30 a.m.) and a **Youth Summit** at **Fountain Square** downtown (Sat, 6/20, 4:00 p.m.)...for more information, log on to <u>www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame</u>.

Homer, Homer, Triple

In Wed's 6-1 victory vs Hou, **RF Jay Bruce** produced a pair of home runs, a triple and 4rbi...he became only the third Reds player in the last 40 years to produce 2 homers and 1 triple in the same game (**Barry Larkin** in 1995, **Cesar Cedeno** in 1982)...**Bruce's** 11 total bases tied Mil's **Ryan Braun** for the most by a National League player in a game this season...courtesy Elias Sports Bureau.

<u>TONIGHT'S GAME</u>: Is Game 1 of a 3-game series vs Allison McClain's Brewers and Game 1 of a 7-game road trip that also includes an upcoming visit to StL's **Busch Stadium** (4g)...is **Game 1** of a stretch in which the Reds will play 13-16g on the road...following this trip return to **Great American Ball Park** for a brief 3-game weekend set with the Cubs before hitting the road again for **Wsh** (3g) and **KC** (3g)...the Reds are coming off a **6-3 homestand** vs the **Phillies** (1-2), **Indians** (2-1) and **Astros** (3-0) that included their first 3-game series sweep of Hou in the Queen City since **September 1990**.

<u>CENTRAL CASTING</u>: Tonight's game is **Game 4** (3-0) of 13 straight vs **National League Central Division** rivals (3-0 vs Hou, **3g at Mil**, 4g at StL, 3g vs Chi)...following this 13-game stretch won't play within the division again until **Fourth of July** weekend (3g at StL), a drought that includes 21 consecutive games outside the **Central**.

DOT, DOT. The Reds' current 4-game winning streak is a season high...have won 5 of their last 6g and 8 of their last 8g...at **26-20** are a season-high **6g over .500** for the second time (20-14)...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g** over .500 at **36-24**...the Reds are **18-3** (.857) when they score first, the second-best winning percentage in the Major Leagues (SF 18-2, .900), and **8-17** when the opponent scores first...**Alex Gonzalez** needs 4rbi to reach **500** in his career...**Reds pitchers as batters** have a 3-game hitting streak (4-8, .500, 1 2b, 1rbi).

MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUT: RHP Carlos Fisher is the only Reds player this season to make his Major League debut... last season 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts, including RHP Johnny Cueto, IF Paul Janish, OF Jay Bruce, LHP Daniel Ray Herrera, RHP Daryl Thompson, IF Adam Rosales, OF Chris Dickerson, RHP Ramon Ramirez, C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo and RHP Josh Roenicke.

ALL-STAR RESOLUTION: State Senator Gary Cates (R-Butler County) has introduced a resolution in the Ohio Senate urging Major League Baseball to select the Reds and Great American Ball Park as hosts for the 2013 All-Star Game... the Reds last hosted the Mid-Summer Classic in 1988 at Riverfront Stadium...the club already is hosting one of MLB's jewel events this summer, when on 6/20 the Reds and White Sox meet here in the Gillette Civil Rights Game.

QUALITY CONTROL: Opposing pitchers have produced **26 quality starts**, including 11 straight from **4/14-4/25**... the Reds went **13-13** (.500) when the opposing starter produced a quality appearance...the Reds produced 22 quality starts (**Cueto** 6, **Arroyo** 6, **Harang** 5, **Volquez** 3, **Owings** 2) and went **19-3** in those QS (.864).

<u>ZEROES</u>: The Reds and Giants lead the National League with 6 team shutouts...the Reds produced their 6 shutouts in the first 26g, their fastest to 6 blankings since the 1914 staff threw its sixth shutout in the 25th game...Cin produced 6 team shutouts all of last season.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (13-12, .520): The Reds went 3-4-2 in their 9 home series and produced a winning record on 2 of their 4 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3)...at 13-12 their record at home is above .500 for the first time this season...in 7 seasons at GABP are 254-257-1...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38)...at 217-217-1 the Reds had evened their overall record at GABP for the first time since 6/26/04 (57-57)...also reached .500 at 219-219-1.

<u>REDS ON THE ROAD (13-8, .619)</u>: The Reds went **5-1-1 in their first 7 road series...**produced winning records on each of their first 2 road trips (7-3, 3-2) and a .500 record on the third trip (3-3)...entering this season and dating back to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

IN THE STANDINGS (53): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 8, THIRD - 22, FOURTH - 18, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...at 26-20 are a season-high 6g over .500 for the second time (20-14)...prior to this season hadn't been 6g over .500 since 2006, when they reached a season-high 12g over .500 at 36-24...have spent 41 days above, 5 days at and 7 days below .500.

REDS vs BREWERS: The Reds are 93-90-1 all-time vs the Brewers, including 3-2 this season and 13-10 the last 2 seasons...<u>at Great American Ball Park</u>: Reds are 27-26, including 1-1 this season...<u>at Miller Park</u>: Reds are 39-34, including 2-1 this season and 8-3 the last 2 seasons...<u>last Reds sweep</u>: at Cin: 7/19-7/20, 2004 (2g); 5/6-5/8, 2002 (3g)...at Mil: 6/5-6/6, 2001 (2g); 7/11-7/13, 2003 (3g); 5/13-5/16, 2002 (4g)...<u>last Brewers sweep</u>: at Cin: 8/30-9/1, 2002 (3g); 8/25-8/28, 2003 (4g)...at Mil: 4/27-4/28, 2004 (2g), 7/3-7/5, 2006 (3g).

Last Pitched: Sun vs Cle and received no decision in the 11-inning, 4-3 victory (7ip, 6h, 3r, 2er, 3bb, 7k, 2hhp, 1wp, 111 pitches, 67 strikeouts)... left with the score tied, 3-3...allowed all 3 runs with 2 outs...in the fourth inning gave up a run-scoring double to Luis Valbuena...in the seventh allowed an RBI-triple to Grady Sizemore, who then scored on the play after obstruction was called on 3B Adam Rosales.

Red Hots: The 23-year-old righthander is making his 10th start of the season and the 41st start of his career...with a 2.37era ranks fourth in the National League...in his 9 starts the Reds went 6-3 and scored 36 runs (4 r/g)...in his last 7 apps produced all 6 of his quality starts...his string of 5 consecutive QS from 4/22-5/13 was the longest stretch of quality starts by a Reds pitcher this season...last year, Edinson Volquez produced a string of 12 straight QS (4/22-6/20)...on 4/22 at Chi singled twice off Ted Lilly for his first career 2-hit game.

<u>Streaking I</u>: In 5 starts from 4/22-5/13 went **4-0, 1.25** (36ip, 5er)...the 4-game winning streak was the longest of his career...allowed 4 earned runs in his first start of the season (6ip) and 12 earned runs in his last 8 starts (54.2ip, 1.98era).

<u>Streaking II</u>: In each of 4 starts from 4/22-5/8 threw at least 7.0 innings while allowing no more than 1 run, the longest streak of that kind by a Reds pitcher since **Tim Belcher** had a 4-game run from **5/27-6/13**, **1992** (courtesy Elias Sports Bureau).

<u>World Baseball Classic</u>: Started the Dominican Republic's second game of the tournament and threw 4.2 scoreless innings to earn the 9-0 win vs Panama in the San Juan bracket (4.2ip, 3h, 1bb, 5k).

Cueto's Most Recent Starts: 4/22 at Chi, in one of the best starts of his career threw 7.0 shutout innings to earn the 3-0 victory (4h, 0bb, 3k, 108 pitches, 68 strikes)... left leading, 1-0...the Reds added insurance runs in the eighth and ninth innings...4/27 vs Hou and received no decision in the 4-1 loss (7ip, 7h, 1er, 1bb, 5k, 1hr, 98 pitches, 64 strikes)...left with the score tied, 1-1...allowed only a solo HR to Berkman leading off the sixth inning, snapping his scoreless streak at career-high 12 innings...was Berkman's 20th career homer at Great American Ball Park, the most by any opposing player...the Astros scored 3 runs in the ninth off Cordero...5/3 at Pit, in the 5-0 victory threw 8.0 shutout innings in the best start of his young career (4h, 1bb, 9k, 109 pitches, 68 strikes)...the 8.0 innings are a career high...allowed only 4 singles...5/8 vs StL and earned the 6-4 victory (7ip, 5h, 1er, 2bb, 3k, 98 pitches, 67 strikes)...left leading, 6-1...allowed only a run-scoring GIDP by Thurston in the seventh inning, snapping his career-high scoreless streak at 15 innings...5/13 at Ari and earned the 10-3 victory (7ip, 4h, 3er, 2bb, 4k, 2hr, 100 pitches, 67 strikes)...in the first inning allowed a solo HR to Gerardo Parra in Parra's first career plate appearance, followed by a walk to Justin Upton...then retired 12 consecutive batters until Chad Tracy walked with 1 out in the fifth...after Parra's HR didn't allow another hit until Upton doubled with 2 outs in the sixth, followed by Stephen Drew's RBI-single...with 2 outs in the seventh inning allowed a solo HR to Ojeda, his first homer since 6/15/07 at Bal (410ab)...as a batter, led off the third inning with his second bunt single of the season to spark a 3-run rally...5/19 vs Phi and suffered the 4-3 loss (7ip, 7h, 4er, 0bb, 4k, 1hr, 112 pitches, 68 strikes)...in the second inning allowed a solo HR to Howard...allowed 3 runs in the fifth on Rollins' RBI-double, Utley's RBI-single and a sac fly by Ibanez.

Tomorrow's Pitcher: RHP Aaron Harang

Last Started: Mon vs Hou and earned the 8-5 victory (5ip, 10h, 3er, 1bb, 4k, 1hr, 93 pitches, 60 strikes)...left leading, 6-3...returned after a 2-hour, 3-minute rain delay with 2 outs in the top of the fifth inning, allowed a single to Pence but then struck out Quintero to become eligible for the win...in the first allowed a 2-run HR to Berkman, his 21st career homer at GABP (most by any visiting player), but the Reds battled back with 5 runs in the bottom of the inning...in the third allowed an RBI-single to Quintero...as a batter produced his third career 2-hit game, including an RBI-single that capped Cin's 5-run first inning.

Red Hots: Tomorrow vs Mil will make his 11th start of the season and 199th start of his career...in his previous 10 starts the Reds went 5-5 and scored 39 runs (3.9 r/g)...in his 10 starts Reds batters hit .254 (85-335)...on 4/23 at Chi recorded the 1,000th strikeout of his career (Derrek Lee)...his 3-hitter in the club's fifth game, a 2-0 win on 4/12 vs Pit, was the quickest complete game by a Reds pitcher since Pete Harnisch threw a CG in the Reds' fourth game of 1999.

<u>Astronomical</u>: In his 3 starts vs the Astros this season allowed 13 earned runs in 16.0 innings (7.31era)...in his other 7 starts went **4-2**, **2.05** (48.1ip, 11er).

<u>Home Cookin'</u>: Is **4-2, 2.84** (38ip, 12er) in 6 starts at Great American Ball Park and **1-2, 4.10** (26.1ip, 12er) in 4 starts on the road.

<u>Staff Ace</u>: Since he was acquired from the Athletics at the **2003** trading deadline is the Reds' leader in most statistical pitching categories, including starts (177), wins (68), innings pitched (1133.1) and strikeouts (957)...since the beginning of the **2006 season** ranks second in the National League in innings pitched (714.2; Arroyo 1st, 716.1).
