The **Beacon Award** presenters at the **Gillette Civil Rights Game** luncheon on **Sat, 6/21** will include **Sugar Ray Leonard** for Beacon of Change winner **Muhammad Ali**, Hall of Fame pitcher **Bob Gibson** for Beacon of Hope winner **Bill Cosby** and **Commissioner Allan H. (Bud) Selig** for Beacon of Life winner **Hank Aaron**...Grammy Award-winning gospel artist **BeBe Winans** will perform at the luncheon and at that night's game...former **President Bill Clinton** will be the keynote speaker at the luncheon.

At Great American Ball Park on **Sat, 6/20** the Reds and Chicago White Sox will meet in the **Gillette Civil Rights Game**, the first time the contest will be played during the regular season...the weekend's festivities will include a roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's **Harriet Tubman Theater** (Fri, 6/19, 4:00 p.m.), a luncheon at **Duke Energy Center** honoring the 3 winners of Major League Baseball's **Beacon Awards** (Sat, 6/20, 11:30 a.m.) and a **Youth Summit** at **Fountain Square** downtown (Sat, 6/20, 4:00 p.m.)...for more information, log on to www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame.

Homer, Homer, Triple

In Wed's 6-1 victory vs Hou, **RF Jay Bruce** produced a pair of home runs, a triple and 4rbi...he became only the third Reds player in the last 40 years to produce 2 homers and 1 triple in the same game (**Barry Larkin** in 1995, **Cesar Cedeno** in 1982)...**Bruce's** 11 total bases tied Mil's **Ryan Braun** for the most by a National League player in a game this season...courtesy Elias Sports Bureau.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is **Game 1** of a 3-game series vs **Allison McClain's** Brewers and **Game 1** of a 7-game road trip that also includes an upcoming visit to StL's **Busch Stadium** (4g)...is **Game 1** of a stretch in which the Reds will play 13-16g on the road...following this trip return to **Great American Ball Park** for a brief 3-game weekend set with the Cubs before hitting the road again for **Wsh** (3g) and **KC** (3g)...the Reds are coming off a **6-3 homestand** vs the **Phillies** (1-2), **Indians** (2-1) and **Astros** (3-0) that included their first 3-game series sweep of Hou in the Queen City since **September 1990**.

CENTRAL CASTING: Tonight's game is **Game 4** (3-0) of 13 straight vs **National League Central Division** rivals (3-0 vs Hou, **3g at Mil**, 4g at StL, 3g vs Chi)...following this 13-game stretch won't play within the division again until **Fourth of July** weekend (3g at StL), a drought that includes 21 consecutive games outside the **Central**.

DOT, DOT, DOT...: The Reds' current 4-game winning streak is a season high...have won 5 of their last 6g and 8 of their last 8g...at **26-20** are a season-high **6g over .500** for the second time (20-14)...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g over .500** at **36-24**...the Reds are **18-3** (.857) when they score first, the second-best winning percentage in the Major Leagues (SF 18-2, .900), and **8-17** when the opponent scores first...**Alex Gonzalez** needs 4rbi to reach **500** in his career...**Reds pitchers as batters** have a 3-game hitting streak (4-8, .500, 1 2b, 1rbi).

MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUT: RHP **Carlos Fisher** is the only Reds player this season to make his Major League debut...last season 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts, including **RHP Johnny Cueto**, **IF Paul Janish**, **OF Jay Bruce**, **LHP Daniel Ray Herrera**, **RHP Daryl Thompson**, **IF Adam Rosales**, **OF Chris Dickerson**, **RHP Ramon Ramirez**, **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** and **RHP Josh Roenicke**.

ALL-STAR RESOLUTION: State Senator **Gary Cates** (R-Butler County) has introduced a resolution in the Ohio Senate urging Major League Baseball to select the Reds and Great American Ball Park as hosts for the **2013 All-Star Game**...the Reds last hosted the Mid-Summer Classic in **1988** at Riverfront Stadium...the club already is hosting one of MLB's jewel events this summer, when on **6/20** the Reds and White Sox meet here in the **Gillette Civil Rights Game**.

QUALITY CONTROL: Opposing pitchers have produced **26 quality starts**, including 11 straight from **4/14-4/25**...the Reds went **13-13** (.500) when the opposing starter produced a quality appearance...the Reds produced 22 quality starts (**Cueto** 6, **Arroyo** 6, **Harang** 5, **Volquez** 3, **Owings** 2) and went **19-3** in those QS (.864).

ZEROES: The Reds and Giants lead the National League with **6 team shutouts**...the Reds produced their 6 shutouts in the first **26g**, their fastest to 6 blankings since the **1914 staff** threw its sixth shutout in the **25th** game...Cin produced 6 team shutouts all of last season.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (13-12, .520): The Reds went **3-4-2** in their 9 home series and produced a winning record on 2 of their 4 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3)...at **13-12** their record at home is above .500 for the first time this season...in 7 seasons at GABP are **254-257-1**...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38)...at **217-217-1** the Reds had evened their overall record at GABP for the first time since **6/26/04** (57-57)...also reached .500 at **219-219-1**.

REDS ON THE ROAD (13-8, .619): The Reds went **5-1-1 in their first 7 road series**...produced winning records on each of their first 2 road trips (7-3, 3-2) and a .500 record on the third trip (3-3)...entering this season and dating back to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

IN THE STANDINGS (53): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: **FIRST** - 1, **SECOND** - 8, **THIRD** - 22, **FOURTH** - 18, **FIFTH** - 3, **SIXTH** - 1...at **26-20** are a season-high **6g over .500** for the second time (20-14)...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g over .500** at **36-24**...have spent **41** days above, **5** days at and **7** days below .500.

REDS vs BREWERS: The Reds are 93-90-1 all-time vs the Brewers, including 3-2 this season and 13-10 the last 2 seasons...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 27-26, including 1-1 this season...**at Miller Park:** Reds are 39-34, including 2-1 this season and 8-3 the last 2 seasons...**last Reds sweep:** at Cin: 7/19-7/20, 2004 (2g); 5/6-5/8, 2002 (3g)...at Mil: 6/5-6/6, 2001 (2g); 7/11-7/13, 2003 (3g); 5/13-5/16, 2002 (4g)...**last Brewers sweep:** at Cin: 8/30-9/1, 2002 (3g); 8/25-8/28, 2003 (4g)...at Mil: 4/27-4/28, 2004 (2g), 7/3-7/5, 2006 (3g).

IF Paul Janish pitched in the ninth inning of the 15-3 loss vs Mil on 5/6 (1ip, 5h, 5er, 0bb, 2k, Fielder 2-run HR)...he became the first Reds position player to pitch since Lenny Harris on 6/1/98 at SF.				

Reds Pitchers: Rank fifth in the National League with a 3.97 team ERA...**on the homestand went 6-3, 4.01 (83ip, 37er)**...have 6 team shutouts...had 6 shutouts all last season...with a 7-0 win on 5/5 at Fla reached 6 shutouts in their 26th game, their fastest to 6 shutouts since the 1914 Reds threw their sixth shutout in their 25th game.

Reds Starters: Rank sixth in the National League with 4.12 rotation ERA...**on the homestand went 4-2, 4.23 (55.1ip 26er)**...through the first 41g of the season used just 5 starting pitchers, their longest such streak to begin a year since **RHP John Roper** became the staff's **sixth** different starter in the **42nd game** of the **1994 campaign**...on 5/23 vs Cle, in the club's 42nd game, **RHP Homer Bailey** became the Reds' sixth starting pitcher...in 46g have produced 22 quality starts (**Cueto** 6, **Arroyo** 6, **Harang** 5, **Volquez** 3, **Owings** 2)...the Reds went 19-3 in those quality starts (.864)...**Bronson Arroyo** on Wed threw a 5-hitter in the 6-1 win vs Hou, the team's second complete game of the season...**Aaron Harang** threw a 3-hitter in the 2-0 win vs Pit in the club's fifth game of the season...was the earliest complete game by a Reds pitcher since **Pete Harnisch** beat the Cardinals, 3-0 in Busch Stadium, in the **fourth** contest of the **1999** campaign...last season, **Arroyo** threw the staff's first CG in a 2-1 win at Hou in the 132nd game...4 times in the previous 7 years the Reds tied the franchise record for fewest complete games in a season (2cg, 2001, 2002, 2005, 2008).

Reds Relievers: Rank fourth in the National League with a 3.65 bullpen ERA...**on the homstand went 2-1-3, 3.58 (27.2ip, 11er)**...in their last 37g have posted a 2.69era (110.1ip, 33er) and in their last 25g have posted a 2.48era (76.1ip, 21er)...**none of the previous notes include the pitching performance by IF Paul Janish in the ninth inning of the 15-3 loss on 5/6 vs Mil (1ip, 5er)**...didn't blow a save until the club's 36th game, a 6-5 loss in 16 innings on 5/16 at SD...for the second straight season the Reds' bullpen was the last in the Major Leagues to suffer a blown save...in 2008 didn't blow a save until the 41st game (5/14)...over the last 2 seasons **Francisco Cordero** has recorded all **47** of the bullpen's saves (34sv in 2008, 13sv in 2009).

Ranks T2nd in the National League leaders in saves...leads the staff in apps (21)...has not allowed a run in his last 7 apps (7ip, 4h, 1bb, 6k)...in his last 13 apps has posted a 0.69era (13ip, 1er)...with 224 career saves ranks 30th on that all-time list...Ugeth Urbina is 29th with 237 saves...including last season has recorded the bullpen's last 47 saves (34sv in 2008, 13sv in 2009)...dating back to last season has converted 27 consecutive save chances, including all 13 save opps this year...**suffered his last blown save on 7/21/08 vs SD**...in the 3-0 victory on 4/22 at Chi recorded his 100th save in the National League to become only the 11th pitcher in history with at least 100 saves in each league (see box below).
