**TODAY'S GAME:** Is **Game 3** (1-1) of a 3-game series vs **Bob Peter's** Pirates and **Game 2** (1-1) of a 5-game road trip that also includes a brief stop in **Fla** (2g)...the Reds are coming off a 2-4 homestand vs the **Braves** (1-2) and **Astros** (1-2)...following this trip return to GABP for a 5-game homestand vs the **Brewers** (2g) and **Cardinals** (3g).

**ROAD WARRIORS:** At **8-4** the Reds are off to their best start on the road since **2006**, when they started their away schedule **8-4** (2-1 at Chi, 1-2 at StL, 3-1 at Mil, 2-0 at Wsh)...won their first 3 road series of this season...haven't won their first 4 series of any season since **2002** (2-1 at Pit, 2-1 at Phi, 2-1 at Chi, 2-0 at LA before losing the series finale)...haven't won 4 consecutive road series since **8/8-8/28, 2005** (3-0 at Chi, 2-1 at Mil, 2-1 at Wsh, 3-0 at Pit).

**QUALITY CONTROL:** In the Reds' 23g the opposing pitcher has produced **17 quality starts**, including 11 straight from **4/14-4/25**...the Reds went **9-8** when the opposing starter produced a quality appearance...the Reds have produced 10 quality starts (**Arroyo 3, Harang 2, Cueto 2, Volquez 2, Owings 1**)...Cin went **9-1** in those quality starts (.900).

**CENTRAL CASTING:** Today's game is Game 21 in a stretch of **18-21g** and **23-28g** against **National League Central** opponents (11-9 overall, **10-7 vs NL Central**, 1-1 vs Pit, 2-1 at Mil, 3-1 at Hou, 2-1 at Chi, 1-2 vs Atl, 1-2 vs Hou, **1-1 at Pit, 2g at Fla, 2g vs Mil, 3g vs StL**).

**DOT, DOT, DOT...:** The Pirates scored a run in the first inning last night to snap a streak of **19.0 consecutive scoreless innings** by Reds pitchers, their longest since an identical streak from **7/14-7/16, 2002**...the Reds are the only team in the Major Leagues without a blown save...for the third straight day the Reds face a season-high 4.0-game deficit...**1B Joey Votto** is the only Reds player to have played every inning of every game...in the last 15g have posted a 3.29era (38.1ip, 14er).

**AND THE WINNER IS...:** RHP **Edinson Volquez** was the pitcher selected as the **Fans' Choice Bobblehead** to be given to the first 30,000 fans on **Sat, 7/18 vs Mil...Volquez** received 3,047 of the 7,344 votes (41.5%) cast online at **reds.com**...his bobblehead is part of a collectible set of 4 that also features **Joey Votto** (Sat, 5/9 StL), **Jay Bruce** (Sat, 7/4 vs StL) and **Brandon Phillips** (Sat, 8/15 vs Wsh).

**ALL-STARS AMONG US:** Major League Baseball and *People* magazine invite fans to nominate individuals who have gone above and beyond to serve their communities during these difficult times...30 **Everyday All-Stars**, one representing each team, will attend and be honored at the **All-Star Game** in **St. Louis**...one person will be featured in *People* magazine...to nominate an **Everyday All-Star**, log on to **PeopleAllStars.com**.

**HEALTHY RECIPES:** On Tuesday the Reds disabled **3B Edwin Encarnacion** (chip fracture, left wrist) and recalled **IF Adam Rosales**...those roster moves, on the 23rd day of the season, were the first by the Reds since final cuts the day before Opening Day...was the club's longest stretch to start a season without a roster move since **1985**, when on the 37th day (5/14) the Reds recalled **Alan Knicely** and **Ron Robinson** and optioned to Class AAA Denver **Dann Bilardello** and **Carl Willis**...in 2009, the Reds began a season without a player on the disabled list for the first time since **1990**.

**VETERAN LEADERSHIP:** LHP **Arthur Rhodes** and RHP **David Weathers**, both 39 years old, this season have combined for 17 apps and 15.1 scoreless innings...opponents are hitting .157 against them (8-51)...together they have made **1,627** Major League apps for 13 teams...33-year-old **RHP Francisco Cordero** has converted all 7 save opps while posting a 2.70era in his 10 apps.

**.500:** At **9-6** the Reds were 3g over .500 this late in a season for the first time since they were 3g over at **67-64 in 2006**...haven't been 4g over .500 since they were **67-63 in 2006**...during that **2006 season** the Redlegs reached a season-high 12g over .500 at **36-24**.

**PLAYING FROM BEHIND:** The Reds have trailed in 16 of their 23g this season...8 times allowed runs in the first inning...last season the Reds went **26-69** when the opponent scored first and **48-19** when they scored first.

**REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (4-7, .364):** On **Thu vs Mil** the Reds will play their **500th game** at Great American Ball park...went 0-3-1 in their first 4 home series (1-2 vs NYM, 1-1 vs Pit, 1-2 vs Atl, 1-2 Hou)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **245-252-1**...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38)...**at 217-217-1** the Reds had evened their overall record at GABP for the first time since **6/26/04** (57-57)...also reached .500 at **219-219-1**.

**REDS ON THE ROAD (8-4, .667):** On their first road trip the Reds went 7-3 and won all 3 series (2-1 at Mil, 3-1 at Hou, 2-1 at Chi)...through that first trip Cin's 7 road wins were the most in the Major Leagues...won 3 consecutive road series for the first time since they went 6-2 over 2 trips from **8/3-8/19, 2007** (2-0 at Pit, 2-1 at Chi & 2-1 at Mil)...won 3 series *on the same road trip* for the first time since **9/21-9/30, 2004** (2-1 at Atl, 2-1 at Pit, 3-1 at Chi)...won 7g on a single road trip for the first time since **5/29-6/7, 2006** (7-2 overall, 1-2 at Chi, 3-0 at Hou, 3-0 at StL)...entering this season and dating back to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

**IN THE STANDINGS (27):** The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: **FIRST** - 0, **SECOND** - 5, **THIRD** - 10, **FOURTH** - 8, **FIFTH** - 3, **SIXTH** - 1...have spent **15** days above, **5** days at and **7** days below .500.

**REDS vs PIRATES:** The Reds are **971-1,017 all-time** vs the Pirates, including 2-2 this season...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 26-29 all-time, including 1-1 this season...**at PNC Park:** Reds are 32-31 all-time, including 1-1 this season...**last Reds sweep:** at Cin: 6/10-6/11, 1997 (2g); 9/25-9/27, 1998 (3g); 8/14-8/17, 1975 (4g)...at Pit: 8/3-8/4, 2007 (2g); 8/26-8/28, 2005 (3g); 7/2-7/5, 1992 (4g)...**last Pirates sweep:** at Cin: 7/23-7/24, 2003 (2g); 3/31-4/3, 2003 (3g); 7/11-7/14, 1991 (4g)...at Pit: 8/20-8/21, 1998 (2g); **4/11-4/13, 2008 (3g)**; 8/22-8/24, 1969 (4g).

**REDS vs MARLINS:** The Reds are 77-58 all-time vs the Marlins, including 6-2 in 2008...have won 9 of their last 11g vs Fla...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 11-8, including 4-0 in 2008 and 7-0 the last 2 seasons...have won the last 8g there...**at Dolphin Stadium:** Reds are 34-31, including 2-2 in 2008 and 14-9 the last 6 seasons...on 6/9/08 **Ken Griffey Jr.** hit his 600th HR here (2-run off Mark Hendrickson).

**Last Pitched:** Mon vs Hou and received no decision in the 4-1 loss (7ip, 7h, 1er, 1bb, 5k, 1hr, 98 pitches, 64 strikes)...left with the score tied, 1-1...allowed only a solo HR to Berkman leading off the sixth inning, snapping his scoreless streak at career-high 12 innings...was Berkman's 20th career homer at Great American Ball Park, the most by any opposing player...the Astros scored 3 runs in the ninth off Cordero.

**Red Hots:** The 23-year-old righthander is making his fifth start of the season and the 36th start of his career...in his last 3 starts is 1-0, 0.96 (18.2ip, 2er)...in his 4 starts the Reds went 2-2 and scored 8 runs (2 r/g)...in his last 2 apps produced both of his quality starts...on 4/22 at Chi singled twice off Ted Lilly for his first career 2-hit game.

**World Baseball Classic:** Started the Dominican Republic's second game of the tournament and threw 4.2 scoreless innings to earn the 9-0 victory vs Panama in the San Juan bracket (4.2ip, 3h, 1bb, 5k).

**Rookie Season:** In 2008 became the first Reds rookie to make 30 starts since **Tom Browning** in 1988 (38gs) and the first Reds rookie *righthander* to make 30 starts since **Gary Nolan** in 1967 (32gs).

**Rookie Leader:** In 2008 led all National League rookie pitchers in strikeouts (158) and ranked among the NL rookie leaders in ERA (8th), starts (31, T1st), wins (9, T2nd), innings pitched (174.0, 4th) and opponents' BA (.264, 6th).

**Major League Debut:** On 4/3/08 vs Ari made his Major League debut at 22 years, 48 days old and earned the 3-2 victory (7ip, 1h, 1er, 0bb, 10k, Upton HR, 92 pitches, 68 strikes)...became the first pitcher in modern Major League history to debut with 10 strikeouts and 0 walks, the first Reds pitcher since 1900 to record 10 strikeouts in his ML debut and only the third pitcher to win his ML debut while allowing 1 hit and recording at least 10 strikeouts (Steve Woodard 1997, Juan Marichal 1960)...retired his first 15 batters and allowed only 1 baserunner overall, Justin Upton homered leading off the sixth.

**Control Freak:** According to Elias Sports Bureau, in 2008 became the only pitcher since 1900 to record as many as 18 strikeouts without a walk in his first 2 career starts...threw 16.0 innings and recorded 22 strikeouts before issuing his first career walk, to Pit's Nate McLouth on 4/13/08 in his third start.

**Cueto's Most Recent Starts:** **4/11 vs Pit**, in his season debut suffered the 10-2 loss (6ip, 8h, 4er, 1bb, 9k, 1hr, 109 pitches, 67 strikes)...left trailing, 4-0...allowed McLouth's 2-run HR in the first inning...in the fourth allowed Wilson's RBI-double and Morgan's RBI-triple...**4/17 at Hou**, in his second start of the season received no decision in the dramatic 2-1 victory (4.1ip, 2h, 1er, 6bb, 3k, 88 pitches, 46 strikes)...left trailing, 1-0...allowed only 1 hit through 4.2 scoreless innings - an infield single by Tejada leading off the fourth - but with 2 outs in the fifth walked Oswalt and Bourn, allowed a single to Tejada and then walked Berkman to force in the game's first run...Lincoln then came in to induce Lee to ground out and end the inning...Cueto, Lincoln, Herrera, Masset and Cordero held Astros hitters to 4 singles...the Reds took the lead in the ninth on Hernandez' 1-out, 2-run HR off Valverde...including the no-decision, in 29 career apps vs the Reds Oswalt is 23-1, 2.39...**4/22 at Chi**, in one of the best starts of his career threw 7.0 shutout innings to earn the 3-0 victory (4h, 0bb, 3k, 108 pitches, 68 strikes)...left leading, 1-0...the Reds added insurance runs in the eighth and ninth innings...singled twice off Lilly, his first career 2-hit game.

## Tomorrow at Marlins: RHP Aaron Harang

**Last Started:** Tue vs Hou and suffered the 8-3 loss (5ip, 6h, 6r, 5er, 1bb, 2k, 1hr, 77 pitches, 52 strikes)...left trailing, 6-1...allowed an unearned run in the first inning and a solo HR to Ivan Rodriguez in the second...allowed 4 more runs in the fifth frame.

**Red Hots:** Tomorrow at Fla will make his sixth start of the season...in his previous 5 starts the Reds went 2-3 and scored just 13 runs (2.6 r/g)...in his first 3 starts **Reds batters** hit .146 (12-82)...in his fourth and fifth starts **Reds batters** hit .286 (20-70)...on 4/23 at Chi recorded the **1,000th** **strikeout** of his career (**Derrek Lee**)...his complete game in the club's fifth game, a 2-0 win on 4/12 vs Pit, was the quickest by a Reds pitcher since **Pete Harnisch** threw a CG in the Reds' fourth game of **1999**.

**Astronomical:** In his 2 starts vs the Astros this season, a 7-0 loss at Hou on 4/18 and an 8-3 loss at Cin on 4/28, allowed 10 earned runs in 11.0 innings...in his other 3 starts is **2-1, 0.43** (21ip, 1er).

**Opening Day:** In the 2-1 loss vs the Mets made his fourth straight Opening Day start, the first Reds pitcher to do so since **RHP Jose Rijo** had the honors in 4 straight seasons from 1992-95...the only other Reds pitchers to make at least 4 consecutive Opening Day starts are **Pete Donohue** (5 straight, 1923-27) and **Mario Soto** (5, 1982-86)...**Soto** holds the club record for overall Opening Day starts (6).

**Staff Ace:** In 2008 received the Joe Nuxhall Good Guy Award from the local chapter of the Baseball Writers' Association of America...in 2005 and 2007 won the BBWAA's Johnny Vander Meer Award as the club's Most Outstanding Pitcher...since he was acquired from the Athletics at the 2003 trading deadline is the Reds' leader in most statistical pitching categories, including starts (172), wins (65), innings pitched (1101.0) and strikeouts (922).
