TONIGHT'S GAME: Is Game 2 (0-1) of a 3-game series vs Alex Boeder's Brewers and Game 2 (0-1) of a 7-game road trip that also includes an upcoming visit to StL's Busch Stadium (4g)...is Game 2 (0-1) of a stretch in which the Reds will play 13-16g on the road...following this trip return to Great American Ball Park for a brief 3-game weekend set with the Cubs before hitting the road again for **Wsh** (3g) and **KC** (3g)...the Reds are coming off a **6-3 homestand** vs the **Phillies** (1-2), **Indians** (2-1) and **Astros** (3-0) that included their first 3-game series sweep of Hou in the Queen

CENTRAL CASTING: Tonight's game is **Game 5** (3-1) of 13 straight vs **National League Central Division** rivals (3-0 vs Hou, 0-1 at Mil, 4g at StL, 3g vs Chi)...following this 13-game stretch won't play within the division again until Fourth of July weekend (3g at StL), a drought that includes 21 consecutive games outside the Central.

DOT, DOT, DOT...: The Reds' current 4-game road losing streak is a season high...have won 4 of their last 5g, 5 of their last 7g and 6 of their last 9g...the Reds are 18-3 (.857) when they score first, the second-best winning percentage in the Major Leagues (SF 19-2, .904), and 8-18 (.308) when the opponent scores first...Alex Gonzalez needs 4rbi to reach 500 in his career.

MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUT: RHP Carlos Fisher is the only Reds player this season to make his Major League debut... last season 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts, including RHP Johnny Cueto, IF Paul Janish, OF Jay Bruce, LHP Daniel Ray Herrera, RHP Daryl Thompson, IF Adam Rosales, OF Chris Dickerson, RHP Ramon Ramirez, C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo and RHP Josh Roenicke.

QUALITY CONTROL: Opposing pitchers have produced 27 quality starts, including 11 straight from 4/14-4/25... the Reds went 13-14 (.481) when the opposing starter produced a quality appearance...the Reds produced 23 quality starts (Cueto 7, Arroyo 6, Harang 5, Volquez 3, Owings 2) and went 19-4 in those QS (.826).

ZEROES: The Reds and Giants lead the National League with 6 team shutouts...the Reds produced their 6 shutouts in the first 26g, their fastest to 6 blankings since the 1914 staff threw its sixth shutout in the 25th game...Cin produced 6 team shutouts all of last season.

GILLETTE CIVIL RIGHTS GAME: At Great American Ball Park on Sat, 6/20 the Reds and Chicago White Sox will meet in the Gillette Civil Rights Game, the first time the contest will be played during the regular season...the weekend's festivities will include a roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's Harriet Tubman Theater (Fri, 6/19, 4:00 p.m.), a luncheon at **Duke Energy Center** honoring the 3 winners of Major League Baseball's Beacon Awards (Sat, 6/20, 11:30 a.m.) and a Youth Summit at Fountain Square downtown (Sat, 6/20, 4:00 p.m.)... scheduled to attend the Sat, 6/20 luncheon are Beacon of Change winner Muhammad Ali, Beacon of Hope winner Bill Cosby and Beacon of Life winner Hank Aaron...Beacon Award presenters include Sugar Ray Leonard (Ali), Hall of Fame pitcher Bob Gibson (Cosby) and Commissioner Allan H. (Bud) Selig (Aaron)...Grammy Award-winning gospel artist BeBe Winans will perform at the luncheon and at that night's game...former President Bill Clinton will be the $keynote\ speaker\ at\ the\ luncheon... for\ more\ information,\ log\ on\ to\ \underline{www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame}.$

VOTE REDS!: Through 7/2, fans can help pick the starting lineups of the 2009 All-Star Game in St. Louis by voting online at www.reds.com...fans attending games at Great American Ball Park can vote using laptop computers set up near Section 114 on Terrace Level...one online voter per game will be selected randomly to receive a Kroger gift card...in-stadium balloting ends on 6/28...Reds players on the ballot include C Ramon Hernandez, 1B Joey Votto, 2B Brandon Phillips, SS Alex Gonzalez, 3B Edwin Encarnacion, OF Chris Dickerson, OF Willy Taveras and OF Jav Bruce.

ALL-STAR RESOLUTION: State Senator Gary Cates (R-Butler County) has introduced a resolution in the Ohio Senate urging Major League Baseball to select the Reds and Great American Ball Park as hosts for the 2013 All-Star Game... the Reds last hosted the Mid-Summer Classic in 1988 at Riverfront Stadium...the club already is hosting one of MLB's jewel events this summer, when on 6/20 the Reds and White Sox meet here in the Gillette Civil Rights Game.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (13-12, .520): The Reds went 3-4-2 in their 9 home series and produced a winning record on 2 of their 4 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3)...at 13-12 their record at home is above .500 for the first time this season...in 7 seasons at GABP are 254-257-1...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38)...at 217-217-1 the Reds had evened their overall record at GABP for the first time since 6/26/04 (57-57)...also reached .500 at 219-219-1.

REDS ON THE ROAD (13-9, .591): The Reds went 5-1-1 in their first 7 completed road series...produced winning records on each of their first 2 road trips (7-3, 3-2) and a .500 record on the third trip (3-3)...entering this season and dating back to 2006, the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips.

IN THE STANDINGS (54): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 8, THIRD - 23, FOURTH - 18, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...at 20-14 and again at 26-20 were a season-high 6g over .500...prior to this season hadn't been 6g over .500 since 2006, when they reached a season-high 12g over .500 at 36-24...have spent 42 days above, 5 days at and 7 days below .500.

REDS vs BREWERS: The Reds are 93-91-1 all-time vs the Brewers, including 3-3 this season and 13-11 the last 2 seasons...at Great American Ball Park: Reds are 27-26, including 1-1 this season...at Miller Park: Reds are 39-35, including 2-2 this season and 8-4 the last 2 seasons... last Reds sweep: at Cin: 7/19-7/20, 2004 (2g); 5/6-5/8, 2002 (3g)...at Mil: 6/5-6/6, 2001 (2g); 7/11-7/13, 2003 (3g); 5/13-5/16, 2002 (4g)...last Brewers sweep: at Cin: 8/30-9/1, 2002 (3g); 8/25-8/28, 2003 (4g)...at Mil: 4/27-4/28, 2004 (2g), 7/3-7/5, 2006 (3g).

UP NEXT: REDS at CARDINALS: The Reds are 930-1,053 all-time vs the Cardinals, including 2-1 this season...<u>at</u> Great American Ball Park: Reds are 26-24, including 2-1 this season...Albert Pujols' 14 homers there trail only Lance Berkman's 20 (Jason Bay 14)...at Busch Stadium: Reds are 8-16, including 1-5 in 2008 and 3-12 there the last 2 years...lost 8 of the last 9g there, including each of the last 5g...at Old Busch went 119-139...last Reds sweep: at StL: 6/26-6/27, 2001 (2g); 6/5-6/7, 2006 (3g); 5/4-5/7, 1990 (4g)...last Cardinals sweep: at StL: 6/28-6/29, 2005 (2g); 9/26-9/28, 2008 (3g); 8/13-8/16, 2001 (4g).

Phillips Update

Brandon Phillips hasn't made a start since last Saturday, when he suffered a hairline fracture on the tip of his right thumb...he will be evaluated again before tonight's game...when injured he led the Major Leagues with 27rbi in May and ranked among this month's leaders in hitting (.350), HR (5) and slugging (.638)... no Reds batter has produced more than 27rbi in a calendar month since Adam Dunn had 31rbi in June 2005.

Last Started: Mon vs Hou and earned the 8-5 victory (5ip, 10h, 3er, 1bb, 4k, 1hr, 93 pitches, 60 strikes)...left leading, 6-3...returned after a 2-hour, 3-minute rain delay with 2 outs in the top of the fifth inning, allowed a single to Pence but then struck out Quintero to become eligible for the win...in the first allowed a 2-run HR to Berkman, his 21st career homer at GABP (most by any visiting player), but the Reds battled back with 5 runs in the bottom of the inning...in the third allowed an RBI-single to Quintero...as a batter produced his third career 2-hit game, including an RBI-single that capped Cin's 5-run first inning.

Red Hots: Is making his 11th start of the season and 199th start of his career...in his previous 10 starts the Reds went 5-5 and scored 39 runs (3.9 r/g)...in his 10 starts **Reds batters** hit .254 (85-335)...on 4/23 at Chi recorded the 1,000th strikeout of his career (Derrek Lee)...his 3-hitter in the club's fifth game, a 2-0 win on 4/12 vs Pit, was the quickest complete game by a Reds pitcher since Pete Harnisch threw a CG in the Reds' fourth game of 1999.

Astronomical: In his 3 starts vs the Astros this season allowed 13 earned runs in 16.0 innings (7.31era)...in his other 7 starts went 4-2, 2.05 (48.1ip,

Home Cookin': Is 4-2, 2.84 (38ip, 12er) in 6 starts at Great American Ball Park and **1-2, 4.10** (26.1ip, 12er) in 4 starts on the road.

Opening Day: In the 2-1 loss vs the Mets made his fourth straight Opening Day start, the first Reds pitcher to do so since RHP Jose Rijo had the honors in 4 straight seasons from 1992-95...the only other Reds pitchers to make at least 4 consecutive Opening Day starts are Pete Donohue (5 straight, 1923-27) and **Mario Soto** (5, 1982-86)...**Soto** holds the club record for overall Opening Day starts (6)...in 4 career Opening Day starts Harang is 1-3, 3.52 (23ip, 9er).

Staff Ace: Since he was acquired from the Athletics at the 2003 trading deadline is the Reds' leader in most statistical pitching categories, including starts (177), wins (68), innings pitched (1133.1) and strikeouts (957)...since the beginning of the 2006 season ranks second in the National League in innings pitched (714.2; Arroyo 1st, 716.1)...in 2005 and 2007 won the BBWAA's Johnny Vander Meer Award as the club's Most Outstanding Pitcher.

Career Highs: Innings: 10.0 (longest), 7/23/07 vs Mil & 1.0 (shortest, 2x), 9/5/03 at StL & 7/28/07 vs Chi; Hits: 14, 9/28/05 at Mil; Runs: 9, 4/3/06 vs Chi; Earned runs: 8 (2x), 8/10/08 vs Hou & 8/16/08 vs StL; Walks: 7, 7/8/08 for Cin at Chi; Strikeouts: 13, 9/29/07 vs Chi; HR allowed: 4 (3x), last on 8/19/07 at Mil (Braun solo, Hall 2-run, Fielder 2-run, Hardy solo); Complete Games: 12, last on 4/12/09 for Cin vs Pit (2-0 win); Shutouts: 6, last on 4/12/09 for Cin vs Pit (2-0 win).

Harang's Most Recent Starts: 4/28 vs Hou and suffered the 8-3 loss (5ip, 6h, 6r, 5er, 1bb, 2k, 1hr, 77 pitches, 52 strikes)...left trailing, 6-1...allowed an unearned run in the first inning and a solo HR to Ivan Rodriguez in the second...allowed 4 more runs in the fifth frame...5/4 at Fla and received no decision in the 14-inning, 3-2 loss (7ip, 7h, 2er, 3bb, 9k, 1hr, 116 pitches, 70 strikes)...left with the score tied, 2-2...allowed both runs with 2 outs, on a solo HR by Ramirez in the first inning and an RBI-single by Hermida in the sixth...the Marlins won on an unearned run in the bottom of the 14th inning...**5/9 vs StL** and celebrated his 31st birthday with an 8-3 victory (7ip, 7h, 3r, 2er, 1bb, 7k, 1hr, 107 pitches, 69 strikes)...left leading, 8-3...allowed only a 2-out, 2-run HR to Ludwick in the third inning and an unearned run in the seventh following 2 Reds errors...while batting with the bases loaded and 2 outs in the sixth inning produced his first hit and RBI of the season, a 2-run single off Kyle Lohse that increased Cin's lead to 6-2...5/15 at SD, returned to his hometown and in his 200th career appearance suffered the 5-3 loss (6.1ip, 8h, 5er, 2bb, 6k, 1hr, 108 pitches, 65 strikes)...left with 2 runners on base and the score tied, 3-3, but was charged with 2 runs scored off Weathers...with 2 outs in the first inning allowed a solo HR to Gonzalez, who homered in his fifth straight game to tie the club record...retired the first 2 batters of the sixth inning but then allowed a single to Gerut and an RBI-double to Kouzmanoff...was replaced in the seventh inning after Eckstein's RBI-single tied it at 3-3...5/20 vs Phi and earned the 5-1 victory (7ip, 4h, 1er, 2bb, 9k, 1hr, 109 pitches, 72 strikes)...left leading, 3-1...allowed only a leadoff HR to Ibanez in the fourth inning

Last Started: Tue vs Hou and received no decision in the 6-4 victory (5ip, 6h, 3er, 4bb, 3k, 99 pitches, 62 strikes)...allowed all 3 runs in the fourth inning on a 2-run double by Rodriguez and a run-scoring single by Maysonet.

Red Hots: Tomorrow will make his ninth start of the season, his third start since an emergency relief appearance on 5/16 at SD...in his previous 8 starts the Reds went 4-4 and scored 39 runs (4.88 r/g)...has 2 quality starts...with an 8-2 win on 4/26 vs Atl snapped his 9-game losing streak dating back to a 9-3 Diamondbacks victory on 5/25/08 at Atl...in 14 apps and 10 starts between victories went 0-9, 8.53 (51.2ip, 49er).

In Relief: Made his only relief appearance of the season in the 16-inning, 6-5 loss at SD on 5/16...threw a career-high 5.2 innings in relief (3h, 1er, 3bb, 5k, 1hr, 81 pitches, 44 strikes)...entered the game in the 11th inning as the Reds' seventh and final pitcher...retired his first 10 batters until Scott Hairston singled with 1 out in the 14th inning...Nick Hundley homered to end the 5-hour, 14 minute struggle... in 2 starts since then is 0-1, 9.00 (8ip, 8er).
