Zeroes

The Redlegs produced 3 shutouts in their last 4 games...the only other time in the last 25 years that Reds pitchers produced 3 shutouts over a 4-game span was from 5/23-5/27, 1992 in games started and won by Greg Swindell (10-0 win at Phi), Chris Hammond (3-0 win at NYM) and Tim Belcher (1-0 win at NYM)...the only interruption during the shutout streak was a 8-3 victory by Jose Rijo on 5/24 at Phi (courtesy Elias Sports Bureau).

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is Game 1 of a brief 2-game series vs Dan Savage's Marlins and Game 4 (2-1) of a 5-game road trip that included a stop in Pit (2-1)...following this series the Reds return to Great American Ball Park for a 5-game homestand vs the Brewers (2g) and Cardinals (3g).

ROAD WARRIORS: The Reds have won their first 4 road series and at 9-4 have the best road record in the Major Leagues...are off to their best start on the road since 2006, when they also started their away schedule 9-4 (2-1 at Chi, 1-2 at StL, 3-1 at Mil, 3-0 at Wsh)...haven't begun a season with a 10-4 road record since 2001 (0-3 at Mil, 2-1 at Pit, 3-0 at NYM, 3-0, at SF, 2-0 at Col)...have begun a season with 4 straight road series victories for the first time since 2002 (2-1 at Pit, 2-1 at Phi, 2-1 at Chi, 2-0 at LA before losing the series finale)...haven't won 5 straight road series to begin a season since 1973 (1-0 at Atl, 2-0 at LA, 3-1 at SF, 2-1 at SD, 2-0 at NYM)...those '73 Reds won the National League West Division by finishing 99-63 overall (.611), including 49-32 on the road (.605).

QUALITY CONTROL: In the Reds' 24g the opposing pitcher has produced 17 quality starts, including 11 straight from 4/14-4/25...the Reds went 9-8 when the opposing starter produced a quality appearance...the Reds have produced 11 quality starts (Arroyo 3, Cueto 3, Harang 2, Volquez 2, Owings 1)...Cin went 10-1 in those quality starts (.909).

CENTRAL CASTING: Yesterday the Reds completed a 12-9 stretch that included an 11-7 record vs National League Central opponents (1-1 vs Pit, 2-1 at Mil, 3-1 at Hou, 2-1 at Chi, 1-2 vs Atl, 1-2 vs Hou, 2-1 at Pit).

DOT, DOT, DOT...: Thu vs Mil the Reds will play their 500th game at Great American Ball park...1B Joey Votto is the only Reds player to have played every inning of every game...the Reds' bullpen has converted all 7 save opps, all by Francisco Cordero, and for the second straight season will be the last bullpen in the Major Leagues to suffer a blown save...in 2008 Cin's pen didn't blow a save until the 41st game (5/14)...including last season Cordero has recorded each of the Reds' last 41 saves (34sv in 2008, 7sv in 2009).

AND THE WINNER IS...: RHP Edinson Volquez was the pitcher selected as the Fans' Choice Bobblehead to be given to the first 30,000 fans on Sat, 7/18 vs Mil...Volquez received 3,047 of the 7,344 votes (41.5%) cast online at reds.com...his bobblehead is part of a collectible set of 4 that also features Joey Votto (Sat, 5/9 StL), Jay Bruce (Sat, 7/4 vs StL) and Brandon Phillips (Sat, 8/15 vs Wsh).

ALL-STARS AMONG US: Major League Baseball and People magazine invite fans to nominate individuals who have gone above and beyond to serve their communities during these difficult times...30 Everyday All-Stars, one representing each team, will attend and be honored at the All-Star Game in St. Louis...one person will be featured in People magazine...to nominate an Everyday All-Star, log on to PeopleAllStars.com.

VETERAN LEADERSHIP: LHP Arthur Rhodes and RHP David Weathers, both 39 years old, this season have combined for 18 apps and 16.1 scoreless innings...opponents are hitting .148 against them (8-54)...together they have made 1,628 Major League apps for 13 teams...33-year-old RHP Francisco Cordero has converted all 7 save opps while posting a 2.70era in his 10 apps.

.500: At 9-6 the Reds were 3g over .500 this late in a season for the first time since they were 3g over at 67-64 in 2006...haven't been 4g over .500 since they were 67-63 in 2006...during that 2006 season the Redlegs reached a season-high 12g over .500 at 36-24.

PLAYING FROM BEHIND: The Reds have trailed in 16 of their 24g this season...8 times allowed runs in the first inning...are 9-2 when they score first and 4-9 when the opponent scores first...last season the Reds went 26-69 when the opponent scored first and 48-19 when they scored first.

CIVIL RIGHTS GAME: At Great American Ball Park on Sat, 6/20 the Reds and Chicago White Sox will meet in the Civil Rights Game, the first time the contest will be played during the regular season...the weekend's festivities will include a roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's Harriet Tubman Theater (Fri, 6/19, 4:00 p.m.), a luncheon at Duke Energy Center honoring the 3 winners of Major League Baseball's Beacon Awards (Sat, 6/20, 11:30 a.m.) and a Youth Summit at Fountain Square downtown (Sat, 6/20, 4:00 p.m.)...the luncheon on Sat, 6/20 will honor Beacon of Hope winner Bill Cosby, Beacon of Life winner Hank Aaron and Beacon of Change winner Muhammad Ali...for more information, log on to www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame.

VOTE REDS! Fan voting for the 2009 All-Star Game in St. Louis kicks off in Great American Ball Park continues through 6/20...in addition to paper ballots, fans can vote online using laptop computers set up near Section 114 on Terrace Level...one online voter per game will be selected randomly to receive a Kroger gift card.

REDS ON THE ROAD (9-4, .692): At 9-4 the Reds have the best road record in the Major Leagues...on this road trip are 2-1...on their first trip went 7-3 and won all 3 series (2-1 at Mil, 3-1 at Hou, 2-1 at Chi)...won 3 series on the same road trip for the first time since 9/21-9/30, 2004 (2-1 at Atl, 2-1 at Pit, 3-1 at Chi)...won 7g on a single road trip for the first time since 5/29-6/7, 2006 (7-2 overall, 1-2 at Chi, 3-0 at Hou, 3-0 at StL)...entering this season and dating back to 2006, the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips.

IN THE STANDINGS (28): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 0, SECOND - 6, THIRD - 10, FOURTH - 8, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...have spent 16 days above, 5 days at and 7 days below .500.

REDS vs MARLINS: The Reds are 77-58 all-time vs the Marlins, including 6-2 in 2008...have won 9 of their last 11g vs Fla...at Dolphin Stadium: Reds are 34-31, including 2-2 in 2008 and 14-9 the last 6 seasons...on 6/9/08 Ken Griffey Jr. hit his 600th HR here (2-run off Mark Hendrickson).

Last Started: Tue vs Hou and suffered the 8-3 loss (5ip, 6h, 6r, 5er, 1bb, 2k, 1hr, 77 pitches, 52 strikes)...left trailing, 6-1...allowed an unearned run in the first inning and a solo HR to Ivan Rodriguez in the second...allowed 4 more runs in the fifth frame.

Red Hots: Is making his sixth start of the season...in his previous 5 starts the Reds went 2-3 and scored just 13 runs (2.6 r/g)...in his first 3 starts **Reds batters** hit .146 (12-82)...in his fourth and fifth starts **Reds batters** hit .286 (20-70)...on 4/23 at Chi recorded the **1,000th strikeout** of his career (**Derrek Lee**)...his complete game in the club's fifth game, a 2-0 win on 4/12 vs Pit, was the quickest by a Reds pitcher since **Pete Harnisch** threw a CG in the Reds' fourth game of **1999**.

Astronomical: In his 2 starts vs the Astros this season, a 7-0 loss at Hou on 4/18 and an 8-3 loss at Cin on 4/28, allowed 10 earned runs in 11.0 innings...in his other 3 starts is **2-1, 0.43** (21ip, 1er).

Opening Day: In the 2-1 loss vs the Mets made his fourth straight Opening Day start, the first Reds pitcher to do so since **RHP Jose Rijo** had the honors in 4 straight seasons from 1992-95...the only other Reds pitchers to make at least 4 consecutive Opening Day starts are **Pete Donohue** (5 straight, 1923-27) and **Mario Soto** (5, 1982-86)...**Soto** holds the club record for overall Opening Day starts (6)...in 4 career Opening Day starts Harang is 1-3, 3.52 (23ip, 9er).

Staff Ace: In 2008 received the Joe Nuxhall Good Guy Award from the local chapter of the Baseball Writers' Association of America...in 2005 and 2007 won the BBWAA's Johnny Vander Meer Award as the club's Most Outstanding Pitcher...since he was acquired from the Athletics at the 2003 trading deadline is the Reds' leader in most statistical pitching categories, including starts (172), wins (65), innings pitched (1101.0) and strikeouts (922).

Community Affairs: Is one of the club's more active members of the local community...for the third consecutive season, as part of his **Aaron's Aces** ticket program is hosting at all Sunday home games children of military personnel serving in the **War On Terrorism**...in 2008 he donated \$55,000 to the **Miracle League of Greater Cincinnati** and **Northern Kentucky**...for his community service has been the club's nominee for the **Robert Clemente Award** (2007), **Branch Rickey Award** (2007) and **Marvin Miller Man of the Year Award** (2007, 2008).

Harang's Most Recent Starts: **4/6 vs NYM**, in his fourth straight Opening Day start suffered the 2-1 loss (5ip, 7h, 1er, 3bb, 2k, 1hr, 114 pitches)...left trailing, 1-0...allowed only a solo HR to Daniel Murphy in the fifth...**4/12 vs Pit** and threw a 3-hitter in the 2-0 victory (0bb, 9k, 1hbp, 108 pitches, 80 strikes)...was his 12th career complete game and sixth career shutout...was the first CG in the majors this season...allowed only a leadoff double to Morgan and singles to Moss and Morgan...**4/18 at Hou** and suffered the 7-0 loss (6+ip, 10h, 5er, 1bb, 6k, 93 pitches, 62 strikes)...left trailing, 3-0, but was charged with 2 more runs scored off Burton...while on the mound allowed all 3 runs with 2 outs...in the first inning allowed 2 runs on 4 hits, including consecutive RBI-singles to Pence and Blum...in the fifth allowed Lee's RBI-double...Reds batters produced 2 singles off Rodriguez (7ip, 10k), Sampson and Fulchino...**4/23 at Chi** and earned the 7-1 victory (7+ip, 7h, 1r, 0er, 1bb, 2k, 105 pitches, 66 strikes)...left leading, 4-1...allowed only an unearned run in the sixth inning...in the sixth inning recorded his 1,000th career strikeout (Derrek Lee).

Tomorrow's Pitcher: Edinson Volquez

Last Pitched: Wed vs Hou, in the 3-0 victory allowed just 1 hit and no runs in a career-high 8.0 innings (1bb, 6k, 1hbp, 106 pitches, 67 strikes)...left leading, 3-0...allowed only Tejada's 2-out double in the first inning.

Volquez & Vander Meer: Allowed 1 hit in 5.0 innings in a 4-3 loss vs Atl on 4/24 and 1 hit in 8.0 innings in Wed's 3-0 win vs Hou...became the first pitcher in the Major Leagues to record consecutive starts of at least **5.0 innings** while allowing no more than **1 hit** since Wsh's **Shawn Hill** did it on each side of a trip to the disabled list in **2007**...became the first Reds pitcher with similar consecutive starts since **Ron Villone** did it in **1999** (1 hit in 7ip on 6/24 at Hou, 1 hit in 8ip on 6/30 vs Ari) and the first Reds **righthander** to do it since **Johnny Vlied Meer** threw consecutive no-hitters in **June 1938** (courtesy Elias Sports Bureau).

Red Hots: Tomorrow will make his sixth start of the season...in his previous 5 starts the Reds went 3-2 and scored 24 runs (4.8 r/g)...last season didn't allow his 14th earned run until his 14th appearance...in his 5 apps produced 2 quality starts.

World Baseball Classic: Started the Dominican Republic's first game and suffered the 3-2 loss to the Netherlands (3ip, 2h, 3r, 0er, 2bb, 3k, 58 pitches)...in the first inning allowed 3 unearned runs on 2 hits, 2 errors, 1 walk and 1 wild pitch.
