Gonzalez Update

SS Alex Gonzalez left last night's game after the 10th inning with a strained left oblique muscle...he is scheduled to be examined in Cincinnati tonight by Reds medical director Dr. Timothy Kremchek.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is **Game 2** (0-1) of a brief 2-game series vs **Jeremy Thompson's** Marlins and **Game 5** (2-2) of a 5-game road trip that included a stop in **Pit** (2-1)...following tonight's game the Reds return to Great American Ball Park for a 5-game homestand vs the **Brewers** (2g) and **Cardinals** (3g) that begins tomorrow.

ROAD WARRIORS: The Reds won their first 4 road series (2-1 at Mil, 3-1 at Hou, 2-1 at Chi, 2-1 at Pit)...their **9 road wins** tie the **Marlins** for the most in the Major Leagues.

QUALITY CONTROL: In the Reds' 25g the opposing pitcher has produced **18 quality starts**, including 11 straight from **4/14-4/25**...the Reds went **9-9** (.500) when the opposing starter produced a quality appearance...the Reds have produced 12 quality starts (**Arroyo** 3, **Cueto** 3, **Harang** 3, **Volquez** 2, **Owings** 1)...Cin went **10-2** in those QS (.833).

CENTRAL CASTING: On Sunday the Reds completed a **12-9** stretch that included an **11-7** record vs **National League Central** opponents (1-1 vs Pit, 2-1 at Mil, 3-1 at Hou, 2-1 at Chi, 1-2 vs *Atl*, 1-2 vs Hou, 2-1 at Pit).

DOT, DOT, DOT...: **David Weathers'** next appearance will be the **906th** of his career, tying him with **Cy Young** for 19th on that all-time list...**Thu vs Mil** the Reds will play their **500th game** at Great American Ball park...**1B Joey Votto** is the only Reds player to have played every inning of every game...the Reds' bullpen has converted all 7 save opps, all by **Francisco Cordero**, and for the second straight season will be the last bullpen in the Major Leagues to suffer a blown save...in 2008, Cin's pen didn't blow a save until the 41st game (5/14)...including last season **Cordero** has recorded each of the Reds' last **41 saves** (34sv in 2008, 7sv in 2009).

AND THE WINNER IS...: RHP **Edinson Volquez** was the pitcher selected as the **Fans' Choice Bobblehead** to be given to the first 30,000 fans on **Sat, 7/18 vs Mil**...**Volquez** received 3,047 of the 7,344 votes (41.5%) cast online at **reds.com**...his bobblehead is part of a collectible set of 4 that also features **Joey Votto** (Sat vs StL), **Jay Bruce** (Sat, 7/4 vs StL) and **Brandon Phillips** (Sat, 8/15 vs Wsh).

ALL-STARS AMONG US: Major League Baseball and *People* magazine invite fans to nominate individuals who have gone above and beyond to serve their communities during these difficult times...30 **Everyday All-Stars**, one representing each team, will attend and be honored at the **All-Star Game** in **St. Louis**...one person will be featured in *People* magazine...to nominate an **Everyday All-Star**, log on to **PeopleAllStars.com**.

VETERAN LEADERSHIP: LHP **Arthur Rhodes** and RHP **David Weathers**, both 39 years old, this season have combined for 20 apps and 18.0 scoreless innings...opponents are hitting .164 against them (10-61)...together they have made **1,630** Major League apps for 13 teams...33-year-old **RHP Francisco Cordero** has converted all 7 save opps while posting a 2.70era in his 10 apps.

.500: At **9-6** the Reds were 3g over .500 this late in a season for the first time since they were 3g over at **67-64 in 2006**...haven't been 4g over .500 since they were **67-63 in 2006**...during that **2006 season** the Redlegs reached a season-high 12g over .500 at **36-24**.

PLAYING FROM BEHIND: The Reds have trailed in 17 of their 25g this season...8 times allowed runs in the first inning...are **9-2** when they score first and **4-10** when the opponent scores first...last season the Reds went **26-69** when the opponent scored first and **48-19** when they scored first.

GILLETTE CIVIL RIGHTS GAME: At Great American Ball Park on **Sat, 6/20** the Reds and Chicago White Sox will meet in the **Gillette Civil Rights Game**, the first time the contest will be played during the regular season...the weekend's festivities will include a roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's **Harriet Tubman Theater** (Fri, 6/19, 4:00 p.m.), a luncheon at **Duke Energy Center** honoring the 3 winners of Major League Baseball's **Beacon Awards** (Sat, 6/20, 11:30 a.m.) and a **Youth Summit** at **Fountain Square** downtown (Sat, 6/20, 4:00 p.m.)...the luncheon on Sat, 6/20 will honor Beacon of Hope winner **Bill Cosby**, Beacon of Life winner **Hank Aaron** and Beacon of Change winner **Muhammad Ali**...for more information, log on to www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (4-7, .364): On **Thu vs Mil** the Reds will play their **500th game** at Great American Ball park...went 0-3-1 in their first 4 home series (1-2 vs NYM, 1-1 vs Pit, 1-2 vs Atl, 1-2 Hou)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **245-252-1**...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38)...**at 217-217-1** the Reds had evened their overall record at GABP for the first time since **6/26/04** (57-57)...also reached .500 at **219-219-1**.

REDS ON THE ROAD (9-5, .643): At **9-5** the Reds and Marlins have the most road wins in the Major Leagues...on this road trip are 2-2...on their first trip went 7-3 and won all 3 series (2-1 at Mil, 3-1 at Hou, 2-1 at Chi)...won 3 series *on the same road trip* for the first time since **9/21-9/30, 2004** (2-1 at Atl, 2-1 at Pit, 3-1 at Chi)...won 7g on a single road trip for the first time since **5/29-6/7, 2006** (7-2 overall, 1-2 at Chi, 3-0 at Hou, 3-0 at StL)...entering this season and dating back to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

IN THE STANDINGS (29): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 0, SECOND - 6, THIRD - 10, FOURTH - 9, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...have spent **17 days** above, **5 days** at and **7 days** below .500.

REDS vs MARLINS: The Reds are 77-59 all-time vs the Marlins, including 0-1 this season and 6-2 in 2008...have won 9 of their last 12g vs Fla...**at Dolphin Stadium:** Reds are 34-32, including 0-1 this season and 14-10 the last 7 seasons...on 6/9/08 **Ken Griffey Jr.** hit his 600th HR here (2-run off Mark Hendrickson)...**last Marlins sweep:** at Cin: 5/23-5/25, 2003 (3g)...at Fla: 5/27-5/29, 1996 (2g); 8/11-8/13, 1995 (3g).

UP NEXT: REDS vs BREWERS: The Reds are 92-89-1 all-time vs the Brewers, including 2-1 this season and 12-9 the last 2 seasons...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 26-25, including 4-5 last season.

Last Pitched: Wed vs Hou, in the 3-0 victory allowed just 1 hit and no runs in a career-high 8.0 innings (1bb, 6k, 1hbp, 106 pitches, 67 strikes)...left leading, 3-0...allowed only Tejada's 2-out double in the first inning.

Volquez & Vander Meer: Allowed 1 hit in 5.0 innings in a 4-3 loss vs Atl on 4/24 and 1 hit in 8.0 innings in Wed's 3-0 win vs Hou...became the first pitcher in the Major Leagues to record consecutive starts of at least **5.0 innings** while allowing no more than **1 hit** since Wsh's **Shawn Hill** did it on each side of a trip to the disabled list in **2007**...became the first Reds pitcher with similar consecutive starts since **Ron Villone** did it in **1999** (1 hit in 7ip on 6/24 at Hou, 1 hit in 8ip on 6/30 vs Ari)...**Villone** was the first Reds pitcher to do it since **Johnny Vander Meer** threw consecutive no-hitters in **June 1938** (courtesy Elias Sports Bureau).

Red Hots: Is making his sixth start of the season...in his previous 5 starts the Reds went 3-2 and scored 24 runs (4.8 r/g)...last season didn't allow his 14th earned run until his 14th appearance...in his 5 apps produced 2 quality starts.

World Baseball Classic: Started the Dominican Republic's first game and suffered the 3-2 loss to the Netherlands (3ip, 2h, 3r, 0er, 2bb, 3k, 58 pitches)...in the first inning allowed 3 unearned runs on 2 hits, 2 errors, 1 walk and 1 wild pitch.

Spring Training: Went 2-0, 1.19 in his 5 spring training starts and 1 relief appearance...didn't allow a run until his 17th inning.

Volquez' Most Recent Starts: **4/8 vs NYM**, in the Reds' second game of the season suffered the 9-7 loss (4.1ip, 6h, 5r, 4er, 4bb, 4k, 1hr, 107 pitches, 60 strikes)...left trailing, 5-4...allowed Delgado's 2-run HR in the second inning and 3 runs on 3 hits and an error in the fifth...**4/13 at Mil**, in the Reds' first road game of the season and earned the 7-6 victory (5ip, 7h, 6er, 4bb, 4k, 1hbp, 2hr)...left leading, 7-6...in the first inning allowed Fielder's run-scoring groundout...in the second allowed 4 runs on 3 hits and a walk, capped by Hart's 3-run HR, and in the third allowed Hart's leadoff HR...benefitted from the Reds' 6-run third...**4/19 at Hou** and earned the 4-2 victory (6ip, 4h, 1er, 5bb, 7k, 104 pitches, 62 strikes)...left trailing, 1-0, but benefited from the Reds' 3-run seventh inning highlighted by pinch-hitter Micah Owings' 2-run double...allowed only Miguel Tejada's RBI-single with 1 out in the third inning...**4/24 vs Atl**, issued a career-high 7 walks and suffered the 4-3 loss (5ip, 1h, 3er, 7bb, 7k, 1hr, 1hbp, 97 pitches, 53 strikes)...left trailing, 3-2...allowed just 1 hit, a solo HR by Jeff Francoeur with 2 outs in the fifth inning...threw 40 pitches in the fourth frame, in which he walked 5 batters to force in 2 runs...became the first pitcher in the Major Leagues to walk 5 batters in an inning since Wsh's Jason Bergmann walked 5 in the top of the third inning on 8/13/08 vs NYM and the first Reds pitcher to do it since Ryan Dempster walked 6 batters in the bottom of the second inning on 4/30/03 at Col.

Tomorrow vs Brewers: Bronson Arroyo

Last Pitched: Fri at Pit and threw 8.0 shutout innings to earn the 4-0 win (4h, 3bb, 4k, 113 pitches, 71 strikes)...left leading, 2-0.

Red Hots: Tomorrow vs Mil will make his sixth start of the season...in his previous 5 starts the Reds went 4-1 and scored 24 runs (4.80 r/g)...since he was acquired by the Reds prior to the 2006 season leads all Major League pitchers with 108 starts and ranks third in the National League with 684.1 innings pitched.

Streaking: Suffered his only loss in a 10-2 defeat to Atl in which he allowed a season-high 9 earned runs in a season-low 5.2 innings...in his other 4 starts went **4-0, 2.96** (27.1ip, 9er).

Perfect: Began the season 3-0 for the third time in his career but for the first time won his first 3 starts of a season...won his first 2 starts in 2006, when he started off 5-0...began the 2005 campaign 4-0...was the first Reds pitcher to begin the season in the rotation and win his first 3 starts since **LHP Pete Schourek** did it in 1996 and the first righthander since **Jack Armstrong** won his first 5 starts of 1990.

Arroyo's Most Recent Starts: **4/9 vs NYM**, in his season debut earned the 8-6 victory (6ip, 8h, 5er, 2bb, 4k, 100 pitches, 68 strikes)...allowed 3 runs in the third inning, highlighted by Church's 2-run double, but the Reds came back with 4 runs in the bottom of that frame and then 4 more in the fifth...**4/14 at Mil** and earned the 6-1 victory (6.1ip, 4h, 1er, 4bb, 3k, 1hr, 105 pitches, 57 strikes)...left leading, 3-1, and the Reds added 3 runs in the ninth inning...allowed only Hardy's solo HR in the second inning...**4/20 at Hou** and in his 100th career road start earned the 4-3 victory (7ip, 9h, 3er, 0bb, 2k, 2hr, 81 pitches, 53 strikes)...left leading, 4-3...allowed run-scoring groundout to Rodriguez in the second inning...allowed back-to-back HR to Berkman and Lee with 2 outs in the sixth...**4/25 vs Atl** and suffered the 10-2 loss (5.2ip, 9h, 9er, 3bb, 5k, 1hbp, 2hr, 102 pitches, 60 strikes)...left trailing, 9-2...gave up 2 runs in the first inning, 3 in the second (CJones 3-run HR) and three in the sixth (Escobar 2-run HR).
