Tonight's game is the 500th at **Great American Ball Park**...the Reds are **245-253-1** here since the ballpark opened in 2003, including **26-26** vs the Brewers.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is **Game 2** (0-1) of a 2-game series vs **John Steinmiller's** Brewers and **Game 2** (0-1) of a 5-game homestand that also includes a weekend set vs the **Cardinals** beginning tomorrow...on Tue the Reds completed a **3-2** road trip to **Pit** (2-1) and **Fla** (1-1)...following this brief homestand take to the road again for a 6-game trip to **Ari** (3g) and **SD** (off day, 3g).

LUNCH WITH MICAH: As part of the *Share the Celebration* program, 8 young fans will have lunch with Reds pitcher **Micah Owings** tomorrow from 11:00 a.m. to noon at the **Kenwood Cheesecake Factory**...4 of the kids attending the lunch will be **Reds Head Kids Club** members, while another child will be hosted by the **Make-A-Wish Foundation**.

QUALITY CONTROL: In the Reds' 27g the opposing pitcher has produced **20 quality starts**, including 11 straight from **4/14-4/25**...the Reds went **10-10** (.500) when the opposing starter produced a quality appearance...the Reds have produced 13 quality starts (**Arroyo** 3, **Cueto** 3, **Harang** 3, **Volquez** 3, **Owings** 1) and went **11-2** in those QS (.846).

<u>CENTRAL CASTING</u>: Tonight's game is Game 25 in a stretch of **23-28g** against **National League Central** opponents (13-11 overall, **11-8 vs NL Central**, 1-1 vs Pit, 2-1 at Mil, 3-1 at Hou, 2-1 at Chi, *1-2 vs Atl*, 1-2 vs Hou, 2-1 at Pit, *1-1 at Fla*, **0-1 vs Mil**, 3g vs StL).

DOT, DOT. The Reds' bullpen has converted all 7 save opps, all by **Francisco Cordero**, and for the second straight season will be the last bullpen in the Major Leagues to suffer a blown save...in 2008, Cin's pen didn't blow a save until the 41st game (5/14)...including last season, **Cordero** has recorded each of the Reds' last **41 saves** (34sv in 2008, 7sv in 2009).

ZEROES: Reds pitchers lead the National League with **6 team shutouts** (SF & Pit T2nd w/ 4sho)...produced those 6 shutouts in their first **26g**, their fastest to 6 blankings since the **1914 staff** threw its sixth shutout in the **25th** game...Cin produced 6 team shutouts all of last season.

AND THE WINNER IS...: RHP Edinson Volquez was the pitcher selected as the Fans' Choice Bobblehead to be given to the first 30,000 fans on Sat, 7/18 vs Mil...Volquez received 3,047 of the 7,344 votes (41.5%) cast online at reds.com...his bobblehead is part of a collectible set of 4 that also features Joey Votto (Sat vs StL), Jay Bruce (Sat, 7/4 vs StL) and Brandon Phillips (Sat, 8/15 vs Wsh).

<u>ALL-STARS AMONG US</u>: Major League Baseball and *People* magazine invite fans to nominate individuals who have gone above and beyond to serve their communities during these difficult times...30 **Everyday All-Stars**, one representing each team, will attend and be honored at the **All-Star Game** in **St. Louis**...one person will be featured in *People* magazine...to nominate an **Everyday All-Star**, log on to **PeopleAllStars.com**.

<u>VETERAN LEADERSHIP</u>: LHP Arthur Rhodes and RHP David Weathers, both 39 years old, this season have combined for 21 apps and 19.0 scoreless innings...opponents are hitting .172 against them (11-64)...together they have made **1,631** Major League apps for 13 teams...33-year-old RHP Francisco Cordero has converted all 7 save opps while posting a 2.45era in his 11 apps.

<u>.500</u>: At **9-6** the Reds were 3g over .500 this late in a season for the first time since they were 3g over at **67-64 in 2006**... haven't been 4g over .500 since they were **67-63 in 2006**...during that **2006 season** the Redlegs reached a season-high 12g over .500 at **36-24**.

PLAYING FROM BEHIND: The Reds have trailed in 18 of their 27g this season...9 times allowed runs in the first inning...are 10-2 when they score first and 4-11 when the opponent scores first.

<u>GILLETTE CIVIL RIGHTS GAME</u>: At Great American Ball Park on **Sat**, 6/20 the Reds and Chicago White Sox will meet in the **Gillette Civil Rights Game**, the first time the contest will be played during the regular season...the weekend's festivities will include a roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's **Harriet Tubman Theater** (Fri, 6/19, 4:00 p.m.), a luncheon at **Duke Energy Center** honoring the 3 winners of Major League Baseball's **Beacon Awards** (Sat, 6/20, 11:30 a.m.) and a **Youth Summit** at **Fountain Square** downtown (Sat, 6/20, 4:00 p.m.)... the luncheon on Sat, 6/20 will honor Beacon of Hope winner **Bill Cosby**, Beacon of Life winner **Hank Aaron** and Beacon of Change winner **Muhammad Ali**...for more information, log on to www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (4-8, .333): The Reds went 0-3-1 in their previous 4 home series (1-2 vs NYM, 1-1 vs Pit, 1-2 vs Atl, 1-2 Hou)...in 7 seasons at GABP are 245-253-1...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38).

REDS ON THE ROAD (10-5, .667): At 10-5 the Reds have the most road wins in the Major Leagues...went 4-0-1 in their 5 road series...produced winning records on each of their first 2 road trips (7-3, 3-2)...entering this season and dating back to 2006, the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips.

<u>IN THE STANDINGS (31)</u>: The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 0, SECOND - 6, THIRD - 11, FOURTH - 10, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...have spent 19 days above, 5 days at and 7 days below .500.

REDS vs **BREWERS**: The Reds are 92-90-1 all-time vs the Brewers, including 2-2 this season and 12-10 the last 2 seasons...**at Great American Ball Park**: Reds are 26-26, including 0-1 this season...**last Brewers sweep**: at Cin: 8/30-9/1, 2002 (3g); 8/25-8/28, 2003 (4g)...at Mil: 4/27-4/28, 2004 (2g), 7/3-7/5, 2006 (3g).

<u>Last Pitched</u>: Sat at Pit and suffered the 8-6 loss (5.2ip, 9h, 5er, 2bb, 0k, 99 pitches, 64 strikes)...left trailing, 5-3...in the first inning allowed 4 runs on 4 hits, 1 walk and 1 hit batter.

Red Hots: Is making his fifth start of the season...in his 4 starts the Reds went 1-3 and scored 19 runs (4.75 r/g)...has 1 quality start...with an 8-2 win on 4/26 vs Atl snapped his 9-game losing streak dating back to a 9-3 Diamondbacks victory on 5/25/08 at Atl...in 14 apps and 10 starts between wins went **0-9**, **8.53** (51.2ip, 49er).

At The Plate: Has 5 career home runs...in 2007 won the National League's Silver Slugger Award (.333, 4hr, 15rbi)...overall this season is hitting .286 (4-14, 3 2b, 2rbi), including 2-for-4 as a pinch hitter...ranks second on the club in pinch-hit RBI (2) and ranks T2nd in pinch hits (2)...in the seventh inning of the 4-2 win on 4/19 at Hou snapped the 1-1 tie with a pinch-hit, 2-run double off Geoff Geary...in his career has 3 game-winning RBI as a pinch hitter (2gwrbi in 2008, 1gwrbi in 2009)...over the last 5 seasons, the only other pitcher to produce a pinch-hit, game-winning RBI is Hou's Jason Jennings in the 14th inning of a 12-11 victory at Atl on 8/2/07 (RBI-single off Oscar Villarreal)...courtesy Elias Sports Bureau.

<u>Last Pitched</u>: Sun at Pit, in the 5-0 victory threw 8.0 shutout innings in the best start of his young career (4h, 1bb, 9k, 109 pitches, 68 strikes)...the 8.0 innings are a career high...allowed only 4 singles.

Red Hots: Tomorrow vs the Cardinals the 23-year-old righthander will make his sixth start of the season and the 37th start of his career...in his last 4 starts is 2-0, 0.68 (26.2ip, 2er)...in his 5 starts the Reds went 3-2 and scored 13 runs (2.60 r/g)...in his last 3 apps produced all 3 of his quality starts...on 4/22 at Chi singled twice off Ted Lilly for his first career 2-hit game.

World Baseball Classic: Started the Dominican Republic's second game of the tournament and threw 4.2 scoreless innings to earn the 9-0 win vs Panama in the San Juan bracket (4.2ip, 3h, 1bb, 5k).

<u>Cueto's Most Recent Starts</u>: 4/11 vs Pit, in his season debut suffered the 10-2 loss (6ip, 8h, 4er, 1bb, 9k, 1hr, 109 pitches, 67 strikes)...left trailing, 4-0...allowed McLouth's 2-run HR in the first inning...in the fourth allowed Wilson's RBI-double and Morgan's RBI-triple...4/17 at Hou, in his second start of the season received no decision in the dramatic 2-1 victory (4.1ip, 2h, 1er, 6bb, 3k, 88 pitches, 46 strikes)...left trailing, 1-0...allowed only 1 hit through 4.2 scoreless innings - an infield single by Tejada leading off the fourth - but with 2 outs in the fifth walked Oswalt and Bourn, allowed a single to Tejada and then walked Berkman to force in the game's first run...Lincoln then came in to induce Lee to ground out and end the inning...Cueto, Lincoln, Herrera, Masset and Cordero held Astros hitters to 4 singles... the Reds took the lead in the ninth on Hernandez' 1-out, 2-run HR
