**TONIGHT'S GAME:** Is **Game 1** of a 3-game series vs **Melody Yount's** Cardinals and **Game 3** (1-1) of a 5-game homestand that also included the **Brewers** (1-1)...on Tue the Reds completed a **3-2** road trip to **Pit** (2-1) and **Fla** (1-1)...following this series take to the road again for a 6-game trip to **Ari** (3g) and **SD** (off day, 3g)...tonight the Reds and **Make-A-Wish Foundation** are hosting 16-year-old **Mitchell Sayre** of Cincinnati.

**FIREWORKS!:** Tonight's fireworks are presented by **KOI Auto Parts**...popular **700 WLW Radio** personality and Senior Vice President of Player Procurement **Bill "Seg" Dennison** will serve as the official igniter of tonight's fireworks show...because of an event at nearby Sawyer Point, the fireworks show **cannot start prior to 10:00 p.m.**, regardless of when tonight's game ends.

**QUALITY CONTROL:** In the Reds' 28g the opposing pitcher has produced **20 quality starts**, including 11 straight from **4/14-4/25**...the Reds went **10-10** (.500) when the opposing starter produced a quality appearance...the Reds have produced 13 quality starts (**Arroyo** 3, **Cueto** 3, **Harang** 3, **Volquez** 3, **Owings** 1) and went **11-2** in those QS (.846).

**CENTRAL CASTING:** Tonight's game is Game 26 in a stretch of **23-28g** against **National League Central** opponents (14-11 overall, **12-8 vs NL Central**, 1-1 vs Pit, 2-1 at Mil, 3-1 at Hou, 2-1 at Chi, 1-2 vs Atl, 1-2 vs Hou, 2-1 at Pit, 1-1 at Fla, 1-1 vs Mil, **3g vs StL**).

**DOT, DOT, DOT...:** The Reds (12-0) and the Giants (12-0) are the National League's only undefeated teams when leading after 5 innings...**RHP Aaron Harang** will celebrate his 31st birthday tomorrow.

**SPELLING RELIEF:** The Reds' bullpen has converted all 8 save opps, all by **Francisco Cordero**, and for the second straight season will be the last bullpen in the Major Leagues to suffer a blown save...in 2008, Cin's pen didn't blow a save until the 41st game (5/14)...including last season, **Cordero** has recorded each of the Reds' last **42 saves** (34sv in 2008, 8sv in 2009).

**ZEROES:** Reds pitchers lead the National League with **6 team shutouts** (SF & Pit T2nd w/ 4sho)...produced those 6 shutouts in their first **26g**, their fastest to 6 blankings since the **1914 staff** threw its sixth shutout in the **25th** game...Cin produced 6 team shutouts all of last season.

**VETERAN LEADERSHIP:** **LHP Arthur Rhodes** and **RHP David Weathers**, both 39 years old, this season have combined for 22 apps and 19.2 scoreless innings...opponents are hitting .167 against them (11-66)...together they have made **1,632** Major League apps for 13 teams...33-year-old **RHP Francisco Cordero** has converted all 8 save opps while posting a 2.25era in his 12 apps.

**.500:** At **9-6** the Reds were 3g over .500 this late in a season for the first time since they were 3g over at **67-64 in 2006**...haven't been 4g over .500 since they were **67-63 in 2006**...during that **2006 season** the Redlegs reached a season-high 12g over .500 at **36-24**.

**PLAYING FROM BEHIND:** The Reds have trailed in 18 of their 28g this season...9 times allowed runs in the first inning...are **11-2** when they score first and **4-11** when the opponent scores first.

**MOTHER'S WEEKEND AT HOF:** Through Sunday, **mothers** can tour the **Reds Hall of Fame and Museum** for half the normal admission price...on **Mother's Day**, the first 200 mothers who purchase a half-price ticket to the HOF will receive a free flower, courtesy of **Jones the Florist**...normal ticket priced are \$10 for adults, \$8 for seniors and students and allow admission through December 2009.

**LUNCH WITH MICAH:** As part of the *Share the Celebration* program, this afternoon 8 young fans had lunch with Reds pitcher **Micah Owings** at the **Kenwood Cheesecake Factory**...4 of the kids who attended the lunch were **Reds Head Kids Club** members, while another child was hosted by the **Make-A-Wish Foundation**.

**MIRACLE FIELD DEDICATION:** The ribbon cutting for the **Miracle League** field, located at the Dunham Recreation Complex in Western Hills, will be held **tomorrow at 10:00 a.m.**...among those expected to attend the dedication are Reds pitcher **Aaron Harang** and his wife **Jen**, who donated \$55,000 to the project, along with Hall of Fame broadcaster **Marty Brennaman** and Cincinnati Vice Mayor **David Crowley**...the synthetic turf field will provide children with disabilities a safe and permanent home for the Miracle League operated by the Cincinnati Recreation Commission.

**VOTE REDS!:** Fan voting for the **2009 All-Star Game** in St. Louis kicks off in Great American Ball Park continues through **6/20**...in addition to paper ballots, fans can vote online using **laptop computers** set up near **Section 114** on Terrace Level...one online voter per game will be selected randomly to receive a **Kroger gift card**...Reds players on the ballot include **C Ramon Hernandez**, **1B Joey Votto**, **2B Brandon Phillips**, **SS Alex Gonzalez**, **3B Edwin Encarnacion**, **OF Chris Dickerson**, **OF Willy Taveras** and **OF Jay Bruce**.

**REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (5-8, .385):** The Reds went 0-3-2 in their previous 5 home series (1-2 vs NYM, 1-1 vs Pit, 1-2 vs Atl, 1-2 vs Hou, 1-1 vs Mil)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **246-253-1**...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38)...**at 217-217-1** the Reds had evened their overall record at GABP for the first time since **6/26/04** (57-57)...also reached .500 at **219-219-1**.

**REDS ON THE ROAD (10-5, .667):** At **10-5** the Reds have the most road wins in the Major Leagues...**went 4-0-1 in their 5 road series**...produced winning records on each of their first 2 road trips (7-3, 3-2)...entering this season and dating back to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

**IN THE STANDINGS (32):** The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 0, SECOND - 6, THIRD - 11, FOURTH - 11, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...have spent **20** days above, **5** days at and **7** days below .500.

**REDS vs CARDINALS:** The Reds are 928-1,052 all-time vs the Cardinals, including 5-10 in 2008...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 24-23, including 4-5 last season...**Albert Pujols'** 13 homers here trail only **Lance Berkman's** 20 and **Jason Bay's** 14.

**Last Pitched:** Sun at Pit, in the 5-0 victory threw 8.0 shutout innings in the best start of his young career (4h, 1bb, 9k, 109 pitches, 68 strikes)...the 8.0 innings are a career high...allowed only 4 singles.

**Red Hots:** The 23-year-old righthander is making his sixth start of the season and the 37th start of his career...**in his last 4 starts is 2-0, 0.68 (26.2ip, 2er)**...in his 5 starts the Reds went 3-2 and scored 13 runs (2.60 r/g)...in his last 3 apps produced all 3 of his quality starts...on 4/22 at Chi singled twice off Ted Lilly for his first career 2-hit game.

**World Baseball Classic:** Started the Dominican Republic's second game of the tournament and threw 4.2 scoreless innings to earn the 9-0 win vs Panama in the San Juan bracket (4.2ip, 3h, 1bb, 5k).

**Cueto's Most Recent Starts:** **4/11 vs Pit**, in his season debut suffered the 10-2 loss (6ip, 8h, 4er, 1bb, 9k, 1hr, 109 pitches, 67 strikes)...left trailing, 4-0...allowed McLouth's 2-run HR in the first inning...in the fourth allowed Wilson's RBI-double and Morgan's RBI-triple...**4/17 at Hou**, in his second start of the season received no decision in the dramatic 2-1 victory (4.1ip, 2h, 1er, 6bb, 3k, 88 pitches, 46 strikes)...left trailing, 1-0...allowed only 1 hit through 4.2 scoreless innings - an infield single by Tejada leading off the fourth - but with 2 outs in the fifth walked Oswalt and Bourn, allowed a single to Tejada and then walked Berkman to force in the game's first run...Lincoln then came in to induce Lee to ground out and end the inning...Cueto, Lincoln, Herrera, Masset and Cordero held Astros hitters to 4 singles...the Reds took the lead in the ninth on Hernandez' 1-out, 2-run HR off Valverde...including the no-decision, in 29 career apps vs the Reds Oswalt is 23-1, 2.39...**4/22 at Chi**, in one of the best starts of his career threw 7.0 shutout innings to earn the 3-0 victory (4h, 0bb, 3k, 108 pitches, 68 strikes)...left leading, 1-0...the Reds added insurance runs in the eighth and ninth innings...singled twice off Lilly, his first career 2-hit game...**4/27 vs Hou** and received no decision in the 4-1 loss (7ip, 7h, 1er, 1bb, 5k, 1hr, 98 pitches, 64 strikes)...Left with the score tied, 1-1...allowed only a solo HR to Berkman leading off the sixth inning, snapping his scoreless streak at career-high 12 innings...was Berkman's 20th career homer at Great American Ball Park, the most by any opposing player...the Astros scored 3 runs in the ninth off Cordero.

## Tomorrow's Pitcher: RHP Aaron Harang

**Last Started:** Mon at Fla and received no decision in the 14-inning, 3-2 loss (7ip, 7h, 2er, 3bb, 9k, 1hr, 116 pitches, 70 strikes)...left with the score tied, 2-2...allowed both runs with 2 outs, on a solo HR by Ramirez in the first inning and an RBI-single by Hermida in the sixth...the Marlins won on an unearned run in the bottom of the 14th inning.

**Red Hots:** Tomorrow will celebrate his 31st birthday...will make his seventh start of the season...in his previous 6 starts the Reds went 2-4 and scored just 15 runs (2.5 r/g)...in his 6 starts **Reds batters** hit .213 (43-202)...on 4/23 at Chi recorded the **1,000th strikeout** of his career (**Derrek Lee**)...his complete game in the club's fifth game, a 2-0 win on 4/12 vs Pit, was the quickest by a Reds pitcher since **Pete Harnisch** threw a CG in the Reds' fourth game of **1999**.

**Astronomical:** In his 2 starts vs the Astros this season, a 7-0 loss at Hou on 4/18 and an 8-3 loss at Cin on 4/28, allowed 10 earned runs in 11.0 innings...in his other 4 starts is **2-1, 0.96** (28ip, 3er).

**Staff Ace:** Since he was acquired from the Athletics at the **2003 trading deadline** is the Reds' leader in most statistical pitching categories, including starts (173), wins (65), innings pitched (1108.0) and strikeouts (931)...since the beginning of the **2006 season** ranks second in the National League in innings pitched (**689.1**, Brandon Webb 1st w/ 702.0, Bronson Arroyo 3rd w/ 685.1ip)...in 2005 and 2007 won the BBWAA's Johnny Vander Meer Award as the club's Most Outstanding Pitcher.

**Harang's Most Recent Starts:** **4/6 vs NYM**, in his fourth straight Opening Day start suffered the 2-1 loss (5ip, 7h, 1er, 3bb, 2k, 1hr, 114 pitches)...left trailing, 1-0...allowed only a solo HR to Daniel Murphy in the fifth...**4/12 vs Pit** and threw a 3-hitter in the 2-0 victory (0bb, 9k, 1hbp, 108 pitches, 80 strikes)...was his 12th career complete game and sixth career shutout...**4/18 at Hou** and suffered the 7-0 loss (6+ip, 10h, 5er, 1bb, 6k, 93 pitches, 62 strikes)...left trailing, 3-0, but was charged with 2 more runs scored off Burton...while on the mound allowed all 3 runs with 2 outs...in the first inning allowed 2 runs on 4 hits, including consecutive RBI-singles to Pence and Blum...in the fifth allowed Lee's RBI-double...Reds batters produced 2 singles off Rodriguez (7ip, 10k), Sampson and Fulchino...**4/23 at Chi** and earned the 7-1 victory (7+ip, 7h, 1r, 0er, 1bb, 2k, 105 pitches, 66 strikes)...left leading, 4-1...allowed only an unearned run in the sixth inning...in the sixth inning recorded his 1,000th career strikeout (Derrek Lee)...**4/28 vs Hou** and suffered the 8-3 loss (5ip, 6h, 6r, 5er, 1bb, 2k, 1hr, 77 pitches, 52 strikes)...left trailing, 6-1...allowed an unearned run in the first inning and a solo HR to Ivan Rodriguez in the second...allowed 4 more runs in the fifth frame.
