Gillette CIVIL RIGHTS GAME

On today's date in 1884 **Moses Fleetwood Walker**, one of the first African Americans to appear in the Major Leagues, made his first appearance in Cincinnati as the starting catcher for the **Toledo Blue Stockings**.

At Great American Ball Park on **Sat, 6/20** the Reds and Chicago White Sox will meet in the **Gillette Civil Rights Game**, the first time the contest will be played during the regular season...the weekend's festivities will include a roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's **Harriet Tubman Theater** (Fri, 6/19, 4:00

p.m.), a luncheon at **Duke Energy Center** honoring the 3 winners of Major League Baseball's **Beacon Awards** (Sat, 6/20, 11:30 a.m.) and a **Youth Summit at Fountain Square** downtown (Sat, 6/20, 4:00 p.m.)...the luncheon on Sat, 6/20 will honor Beacon of Hope winner **Bill Cosby**, Beacon of Life winner **Hank Aaron** and Beacon of Change winner **Muhammad Ali**...for more information, log on to www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is **Game 2** (1-0) of a 3-game series vs **Melody Yount's** Cardinals and **Game 4** (2-1) of a 5-game homestand that also included the **Brewers** (1-1)...following this series take to the road again for a 6-game trip to **Ari** (3g) and **SD** (off day, 3g).

HAIRSTON'S HEROES: Tonight **Jerry Hairston Jr.** is hosting from **St. Peter Claver Latin School For Boys** 30 fans in moon deck Section 143 as part of his **Hairston's Heroes** program targeting underprivileged children...the kids will receive an autographed t-shirt, while the entire group will enjoy \$10 in concession vouchers and in-stadium welcomes via the public address announcer and scoreboard.

.500: At **16-13** the Reds are a season-high 3g over .500 for the second time (**9-6**)...are 3g over .500 this late in a season for the first time since they were 3g over at **67-64 in 2006**...haven't been 4g over .500 since they were **67-63 in 2006**...during that **2006 season** the Redlegs reached a season-high 12g over .500 at **36-24**.

CENTRAL CASTING: Tonight's game is Game 27 in a stretch of **23-28g** against **National League Central** opponents (15-11 overall, **13-8 vs NL Central**, 1-1 vs Pit, 2-1 at Mil, 3-1 at Hou, 2-1 at Chi, *1-2 vs Atl*, 1-2 vs Hou, 2-1 at Pit, *1-1 at Fla*, 1-1 vs Mil, **1-0 vs StL**).

QUALITY CONTROL: In the Reds' 29g the opposing pitcher has produced **20 quality starts**, including 11 straight from **4/14-4/25**...the Reds went **10-10** (.500) when the opposing starter produced a quality appearance...the Reds have produced 14 quality starts (**Cueto 4, Arroyo 3, Harang 3, Volquez 3, Owings 1**) and went **12-2** in those QS (.857).

DOT, DOT, DOT...: **Dusty Baker** has **1,252** career victories as a manager, just 1 shy of **Billy Martin** for 32nd on the all-time list...the Reds (13-0) and the Giants (12-0) are the National League's only undefeated teams when leading after 5 innings...**RHP Aaron Harang** today is celebrating his 31st birthday.

SPELLING RELIEF: The Reds' bullpen has converted all 9 save opps, all by **Francisco Cordero**, and for the second straight season will be the last bullpen in the Major Leagues to suffer a blown save...in 2008, Cin's pen didn't blow a save until the 41st game (5/14)...including last season, **Cordero** has recorded each of the Reds' last **43 saves** (34sv in 2008, 9sv in 2009).

ZEROES: Reds pitchers lead the National League with **6 team shutouts** (SF & Pit T2nd w/ 4sho)...produced those 6 shutouts in their first **26g**, their fastest to 6 blankings since the **1914 staff** threw its sixth shutout in the **25th** game...Cin produced 6 team shutouts all of last season.

PLAYING FROM BEHIND: The Reds have trailed in 18 of their 29g this season...9 times allowed runs in the first inning...are **12-2** when they score first and **4-11** when the opponent scores first.

ALL-STARS AMONG US: Major League Baseball and *People* magazine invite fans to nominate individuals who have gone above and beyond to serve their communities during these difficult times...**30 Everyday All-Stars**, one representing each team, will attend and be honored at the **All-Star Game** in **St. Louis**...one person will be featured in *People* magazine...to nominate an **Everyday All-Star**, log on to **PeopleAllStars.com**.

MOTHER'S WEEKEND AT HOF: Through Sunday, **mothers** can tour the **Reds Hall of Fame and Museum** for half the normal admission price...on **Mother's Day**, the first 200 mothers who purchase a half-price ticket to the HOF will receive a free flower, courtesy of **Jones the Florist**...normal ticket priced are \$10 for adults, \$8 for seniors and students and allow admission through December 2009.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (6-8, .429): The Reds went 0-3-2 in their previous 5 home series (1-2 vs NYM, 1-1 vs Pit, 1-2 vs Atl, 1-2 vs Hou, 1-1 vs Mil)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **247-253-1**...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38).

REDS ON THE ROAD (10-5, .667): At **10-5** the Reds and Marlins (10-7) have the most road wins in the Major Leagues...**went 4-0-1 in their 5 road series**...produced winning records on each of their first 2 road trips (7-3, 3-2)...entering this season and dating back to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

IN THE STANDINGS (33): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 0, SECOND - 6, THIRD - 12, FOURTH - 11, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...have spent **21** days above, **5** days at and **7** days below .500.

REDS vs CARDINALS: The Reds are 929-1,052 all-time vs the Cardinals, including 1-0 this season...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 25-23, including 1-0 this season...**Albert Pujols'** 13 homers here trail only **Lance Berkman's 20** and **Jason Bay's 14**...**last Reds sweep:** at Cin: 5/1-5/2, 2006 (2g); 9/11-9/13, 2007 (3g); 5/5-5/8, 2003 (4g)...at StL: 6/26-6/27, 2001 (2g); 6/5-6/7, 2006 (3g); 5/4-5/7, 1990 (4g).

Last Started: Mon at Fla and received no decision in the 14-inning, 3-2 loss (7ip, 7h, 2er, 3bb, 9k, 1hr, 116 pitches, 70 strikes)...left with the score tied, 2-2...allowed both runs with 2 outs, on a solo HR by Ramirez in the first inning and an RBI-single by Hermida in the sixth...the Marlins won on an unearned run in the bottom of the 14th inning.

Miracle Field Dedication: This morning attended the formal ribbon cutting for the **Miracle League** field at the **Dunham Recreation Complex** in Western Hills...**Harang** and his wife **Jen** donated \$55,000 to the project...Reds President of Baseball Operations **Walt Jocketty**, Hall of Fame broadcaster **Marty Brennaman** and Cincinnati Vice Mayor **David Crowley** also attended the dedication...the synthetic turf field will provide children with disabilities a safe and permanent home for the Miracle League operated by the Cincinnati Recreation Commission.

Red Hots: Today is celebrating his 31st birthday...is making his seventh start of the season...in his previous 6 starts the Reds went 2-4 and scored just 15 runs (2.5 r/g)...in his 6 starts **Reds batters** hit .213 (43-202)...on 4/23 at Chi recorded the **1,000th strikeout** of his career (**Derrek Lee**)...his complete game in the club's fifth game, a 2-0 win on 4/12 vs Pit, was the quickest by a Reds pitcher since **Pete Harnisch** threw a CG in the Reds' fourth game of **1999**.

Astronomical: In his 2 starts vs the Astros this season, a 7-0 loss at Hou on 4/18 and an 8-3 loss at Cin on 4/28, allowed 10 earned runs in 11.0 innings...in his other 4 starts is **2-1, 0.96** (28ip, 3er).

Opening Day: In the 2-1 loss vs the Mets made his fourth straight Opening Day start, the first Reds pitcher to do so since **RHP Jose Rijo** had the honors in 4 straight seasons from 1992-95...the only other Reds pitchers to make at least 4 consecutive Opening Day starts are **Pete Donohue** (5 straight, 1923-27) and **Mario Soto** (5, 1982-86)...**Soto** holds the club record for overall Opening Day starts (6)...in 4 career Opening Day starts **Harang** is 1-3, 3.52 (23ip, 9er).

Staff Ace: Since he was acquired from the Athletics at the **2003 trading deadline** is the Reds' leader in most statistical pitching categories, including starts (173), wins (65), innings pitched (1108.0) and strikeouts (931)...since the beginning of the **2006 season** ranks second in the National League in innings pitched (**689.1**, Brandon Webb 1st w/ 702.0)...in 2005 and 2007 won the BBWAA's Johnny Vander Meer Award as the club's Most Outstanding Pitcher.

Community Affairs: Is one of the club's more active members of the local community...for the third consecutive season, as part of his **Aaron's Aces** ticket program is hosting at all Sunday home games children of military personnel serving in the **War On Terrorism**...in 2008 he donated \$55,000 to the **Miracle League of Greater Cincinnati** and **Northern Kentucky**...for his community service has been the club's nominee for the **Robert Clemente Award** (2007), **Branch Rickey Award** (2007) and **Marvin Miller Man of the Year Award** (2007, 2008).

Career Highs: **Innings:** 10.0 (longest), 7/23/07 vs Mil & 1.0 (shortest, 2x), 9/5/03 at StL & 7/28/07 vs Chi; **Hits:** 14, 9/28/05 at Mil; **Runs:** 9, 4/3/06 vs Chi; **Earned runs:** 8 (2x), 8/10/08 vs Hou & 8/16/08 vs StL; **Walks:** 7, 7/8/08 for Cin at Chi; **Strikeouts:** 13, 9/29/07 vs Chi; **HR allowed:** 4 (3x), last on 8/19/07 at Mil (Braun solo, Hall 2-run, Fielder 2-run, Hardy solo); **Complete Games:** 12, last on 4/12/09 for Cin vs Pit (2-0 win); **Shutouts:** 6, last on 4/12/09 for Cin vs Pit (2-0 win).

Tomorrow's Pitcher: Edinson Volquez

Last Pitched: Tue at Fla and in the 7-0 victory threw a career-high 8.0 shutout innings for the second consecutive start (3h, 4bb, 7k, 1hbp, 1wp, 110 pitches, 62 strikes)...allowed only a double to Hermida and 3 singles...stranded 5 baserunners.

Red Hots: Tomorrow will make his seventh start of the season...in his previous 6 starts the Reds went 4-2 and scored 31 runs (5.17 r/g)...last season didn't allow his 14th earned run until his 14th appearance...in his 6 apps produced 3 quality starts, all in his last 4 starts...in each of his last 2 starts threw a career-high 8.0 innings and didn't allow a run in either.

Zeroes: Hasn't allowed a run in 16 innings, the longest scoreless streak of his career and the longest by a Reds pitcher so far this season...is the longest scoreless streak by a Reds starter since **Bronson Arroyo** threw 16.0 consecutive scoreless frames from **4/21-5/1, 2006**...reliever **Mike Lincoln** threw 19.0 straight scoreless innings last season.

Volquez To Vander Meer: Allowed 1 hit in 5.0 innings in a 4-3 loss vs Atl on 4/24 and 1 hit in 8.0 innings in a 3-0 win on 4/29 vs Hou...became the first pitcher in the Major Leagues to record consecutive starts of at least **5.0 innings** while allowing no more than **1 hit** since Wsh's **Shawn Hill** did it on each side of a trip to the disabled list in **2007**...became the first Reds pitcher with similar consecutive starts since **Ron Villone** did it in **1999** (1 hit in 7ip on 6/24 at Hou, 1 hit in 8ip on 6/30 vs Ari)...**Villone** was the first Reds pitcher to do it since **Johnny Vander Meer** threw consecutive no-hitters in **June 1938** (courtesy Elias Sports Bureau).
