Transactions

Today the Reds are expected to reinstate from the 15-day disabled list **RHP Edinson Volquez** (back spasms)...a corresponding roster move will be announced prior to gametime.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is **Game 4** (0-3) of a 3-game series vs **Jeff Risch's** Cardinals and **Game 4** (0-3) of a 7-game road trip that also included a winless visit to Mil (0-3)...is **Game 4** (0-3) of a stretch in which the Reds will play 13-16g on the road...following this series the Reds return to **Great American Ball Park** for a brief 3-game weekend set with the Cubs before hitting the road again for **Wsh** (3g) and **KC** (3g).

CENTRAL CASTING: Tonight's game is **Game 7** (3-3) of 13 straight vs **National League Central Division** rivals (3-0 vs Hou, 0-3 at Mil, **4g at StL**, 3g vs Chi)...following this 13-game stretch won't play within the division again until **Fourth of July** weekend (3g at StL), a drought that includes 21 consecutive games outside the **Central**.

DOT, DOT, DOT...: The Reds' current **6-game road losing streak** is a season high and matches the longest road losing streak of last year (6g, 4/29-5/10)...haven't lost more than 6 consecutive road games since an 8-game road skid from **5/31-6/15, 2005**...**Reds relievers** on this road trip have posted a 1.29era (7ip, 1er)...**Alex Gonzalez** needs 4rbi to reach **500** in his career...in the first inning of each of the last 4g Reds pitchers allowed at least 1 run (8r).

PLAYER OF THE WEEK: Class AA Carolina's **OF Chris Heisey** (pronounced HI-zee) has been named **Southern League Hitter of the Week** after hitting safely in all 7 apps (15-27, .555, 2hr, 9rbi, 7r)...in 49g overall for the Mudcats, **Heisey** is hitting .378 with 16 doubles, 2 triples, 8hr, 28rbi and 10 stolen bases...he currently has a 9-game hitting streak (20-35, .571, 3hr, 12rbi, 12r), including 3 hits in each of his last 3g...**Heisey** leads the SL in batting average (.378), hits (70), extra-base hits (26), slugging percentage (.616) and runs scored (40) and ranks among the leaders in doubles (16, T4th) and on-base percentage (.458, 2nd).

MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUT: RHP **Carlos Fisher** is the only Reds player this season to make his Major League debut...last season 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts, including **RHP Johnny Cueto**, **IF Paul Janish**, **OF Jay Bruce**, **LHP Daniel Ray Herrera**, **RHP Daryl Thompson**, **IF Adam Rosales**, **OF Chris Dickerson**, **RHP Ramon Ramirez**, **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** and **RHP Josh Roenicke**.

QUALITY CONTROL: Opposing pitchers have produced **27 quality starts**, including 11 straight from **4/14-4/25**...the Reds went **13-14** (.481) when the opposing starter produced a quality appearance...the Reds produced 23 quality starts (**Cueto** 7, **Arroyo** 6, **Harang** 5, **Volquez** 3, **Owings** 2) and went **19-4** in those QS (.826).

ZEROES: The Reds and Giants lead the National League with **6 team shutouts**...the Reds produced their 6 shutouts in the first **26g**, their fastest to 6 blankings since the **1914 staff** threw its sixth shutout in the **25th** game...Cin produced 6 team shutouts all of last season.

GILLETTE CIVIL RIGHTS GAME: At Great American Ball Park on **Sat, 6/20** the Reds and Chicago White Sox will meet in the **Gillette Civil Rights Game**, the first time the contest will be played during the regular season...the weekend's festivities will include a roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's **Harriet Tubman Theater** (Fri, 6/19, 4:00 p.m.), a luncheon at **Duke Energy Center** honoring the 3 winners of Major League Baseball's **Beacon Awards** (Sat, 6/20, 11:30 a.m.) and a **Youth Summit** at **Fountain Square** downtown (Sat, 6/20, 4:00 p.m.)...scheduled to attend the **Sat, 6/20** luncheon are Beacon of Change winner **Muhammad Ali**, Beacon of Hope winner **Bill Cosby** and Beacon of Life winner **Hank Aaron**...Beacon Award presenters include **Sugar Ray Leonard** (Ali), Hall of Fame pitcher **Bob Gibson** (Cosby) and **Commissioner Allan H. (Bud) Selig** (Aaron)...Grammy Award-winning gospel artist **BeBe Winans** will perform at the luncheon and at that night's game...former **President Bill Clinton** will be the keynote speaker at the luncheon...for more information, log on to www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame.

ALL-STAR RESOLUTION: State Senator **Gary Cates** (R-Butler County) has introduced a resolution in the Ohio Senate urging Major League Baseball to select the Reds and Great American Ball Park as hosts for the **2013 All-Star Game**...the Reds last hosted the Mid-Summer Classic in **1988** at Riverfront Stadium...the club already is hosting one of MLB's jewel events this summer, when on **6/20** the Reds and White Sox meet here in the **Gillette Civil Rights Game**.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (13-12, .520): The Reds went **3-4-2** in their 9 home series and produced a winning record on 2 of their 4 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3)...at **13-12** their record at home is above .500 for the first time this season...in 7 seasons at GABP are **254-257-1**...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38)...at **217-217-1** the Reds had evened their overall record at GABP for the first time since **6/26/04** (57-57)...also reached .500 at **219-219-1**.

REDS ON THE ROAD (13-11, .542): The Reds went **5-2-1 in their first 8 completed road series**...are **0-3** so far on this road trip...produced winning records on each of their first 2 road trips (7-3, 3-2) and a .500 record on the third trip (3-3)...entering this year and dating back to 2006, **Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

IN THE STANDINGS (56): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 8, THIRD - 25, FOURTH - 18, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...at **20-14** and again at **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g** over .500 at **36-24**...have spent **44** days above, **5** days at and **7** days below .500.

REDS vs CARDINALS: The Reds are 930-1,053 all-time vs the Cardinals, including 2-1 this season...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 26-24, including 2-1 this season...**Albert Pujols'** 14 homers there trail only **Lance Berkman's** 20 (**Jason Bay**, also 14)...**at Busch Stadium:** Reds are 8-16, including 1-5 in 2008 and 3-12 there the last 2 years...lost 8 of the last 9g there, including each of the last 5g...**at Old Busch** went 119-139...**last Reds sweep:** at StL: 6/26-6/27, 2001 (2g); 6/5-6/7, 2006 (3g); 5/4-5/7, 1990 (4g)...**last Cardinals sweep:** at StL: 9/26-9/28, 2008 (3g).

Last Pitched: On 5/16 at SD and was the victim of a blown save in the 16-inning, 6-5 loss (5.2ip, 4h, 2er, 3bb, 2k, 1hr, 93 pitches, 52 strikes)...left the game with mild spasms in his mid-back, an injury that led to a stint on the disabled list...left leading, 5-2, but the Padres scored a run in the seventh off Lincoln and solo runs in the eighth off Rhodes and Weathers to tie it...Nick Hundley ended it with a homer off Micah Owings, who threw a career-high 5.2 innings in relief.

Red Hots: Is making his ninth start of the season, his first since 5/16...earlier today was reinstated from the 15-day disabled list...since 5/22 had been on the DL with back spasms...in his previous 8 starts the Reds went 4-4 and scored 43 runs (5.38 r/g)...when disabled, his .185 opponents' BA was the best mark in the National League...doesn't have enough innings pitched now to qualify...produced 3 quality starts.

Zeroes: In starts on 4/29 vs Hou and 5/5 at Fla didn't allow a run in 16 innings, the longest scoreless streak of his career and the longest by a Reds pitcher so far this season...was the longest scoreless streak by a Reds starter since **Bronson Arroyo** threw 16.0 consecutive scoreless frames from **4/21-5/1, 2006**...reliever **Mike Lincoln** threw a staff-best 19.0 straight scoreless innings last season.

Volquez To Vander Meer: Allowed 1 hit in 5.0 innings in a 4-3 loss vs Atl on 4/24 and 1 hit in 8.0 innings in a 3-0 win on 4/29 vs Hou...became the first pitcher in the Major Leagues to record consecutive starts of at least **5.0 innings** while allowing no more than **1 hit** since Wsh's **Shawn Hill** did it on each side of a trip to the disabled list in **2007**...became the first Reds pitcher with similar consecutive starts since **Ron Villone** did it in **1999** (1 hit in 7ip on 6/24 at Hou, 1 hit in 8ip on 6/30 vs Ari)...**Villone** was the first Reds pitcher to do it since **Johnny Vander Meer** threw consecutive no-hitters in **June 1938** (courtesy Elias Sports Bureau).

World Baseball Classic: Started the Dominican Republic's first game and suffered the 3-2 loss to the Netherlands (3ip, 2h, 3r, 0er, 2bb, 3k, 58 pitches)...in the first inning allowed 3 unearned runs on 2 hits, 2 errors, 1 walk and 1 wild pitch.

Spring Training: Went 2-0, 1.19 in his 5 spring training starts and 1 relief appearance...didn't allow a run until his 17th inning.

Career Highs: **Innings:** 8.0 (2x), 4/29/09 vs Hou & 5/5/09 at Fla; **Hits:** 9 (2x), 9/25/06 at Ana & 8/5/08 vs Mil; **Runs:** 8, 9/4/05 at KC; **Earned Runs:** 8, 9/4/05 at KC; **Walks:** 7, 4/24/09 vs Atl; **Strikeouts:** 13, 9/3/08 vs Pit; **HR allowed:** 2 (7x), last on 4/13/09 at Mil (Hart 3-run, Hardy solo).

Volquez' Most Recent Starts: **4/8 vs NYM**, in the Reds' second game of the season suffered the 9-7 loss (4.1ip, 6h, 5r, 4er, 4bb, 4k, 1hr, 107 pitches, 60 strikes)...left trailing, 5-4...allowed Delgado's 2-run HR in the second inning and 3 runs on 3 hits and an error in the fifth..**4/13 at Mil**, in the Reds' first road game of the season and earned the 7-6 victory (5ip, 7h, 6er, 4bb, 4k, 1hbp, 2hr)...left leading, 7-6...in the first inning allowed Fielder's run-scoring groundout...in the second allowed 4 runs on 3 hits and a walk, capped by Hart's 3-run HR, and in the third allowed Hart's leadoff HR...benefitted from the Reds' 6-run third..**4/19 at Hou** and earned the 4-2 victory (6ip, 4h, 1er, 5bb, 7k, 104 pitches, 62 strikes)...left trailing, 1-0, but benefited from the Reds' 3-run seventh inning highlighted by pinch-hitter Micah Owings' 2-run double...allowed only Miguel Tejada's RBI-single with 1 out in the third inning..**4/24 vs Atl**, issued a career-high 7 walks and suffered the 4-3 loss (5ip, 1h, 3er, 7bb, 7k, 1hr, 1hbp, 97 pitches, 53 strikes)...left trailing, 3-2...allowed just 1 hit, a solo HR by Jeff Francoeur with 2 outs in the fifth inning...threw 40 pitches in the fourth frame, in which he walked 5 batters to force in 2 runs...became the first pitcher in the Major Leagues to walk 5 batters in an inning since Wsh's Jason Bergmann walked 5 in the top of the third inning on 8/13/08 vs NYM and the first Reds pitcher to do it since Ryan Dempster walked 6 batters in the bottom of the second inning on 4/30/03 at Col..**4/29 vs Hou**, in the 3-0 victory allowed just 1 hit and no runs in a career-high 8.0 innings (1bb, 6k, 1hbp, 106 pitches, 67 strikes)...left leading, 3-0...allowed only Tejada's 2-out double in the first inning..**5/5 at Fla** and in the 7-0 victory threw a career-high 8.0 shutout innings for the second consecutive start (3h, 4bb, 7k, 1hbp, 1wp, 110 pitches, 62 strikes)...allowed only a double to Hermida and 3 singles...stranded 5 baserunners..**5/10 vs StL** and received no decision in the 10-inning, 8-7 loss (6.2ip, 6h, 7er, 3bb, 8k, 1hbp, 1hr, 108 pitches, 66 strikes)...left trailing, 5-4, with 2 outs and runners on first and second but was charged with 1 run scored off Herrera and another scored off Burton...committed a throwing error in the first inning that led to a run and snapped his scoreless streak at a career-high 16 innings...in the third allowed a 1-out, RBI-single to Rasmus and a 2-out, 2-run double to Duncan...in the fifth allowed a 1-out, solo HR to Pujols that snapped Pujols' 0-for-11 skid.

Tomorrow's Starter: Bronson Arroyo

Last Pitched: Wed vs Hou and threw his seventh career complete game in the 6-1 victory (5h, 1er, 1bb, 3k, 92 pitches, 58 strikes)...allowed only a sac fly to Berkman in the first inning...at 2:08 was the shortest game at GABP since September 2006.

Red Hots: Tomorrow will make his 11th start of the season and his first of the year vs the Cardinals...is tied for the National League lead in victories (7)...in his previous 10 starts the Reds went 7-3 and scored 50 runs (5 r/g)...has 6 quality starts, including 3 straight...since he was acquired by the Reds prior to the 2006 season leads all Major League pitchers with 113 starts and ranks second in the National League with 716.1 innings pitched (**Aaron Harang** 1st, 719.0).

Short Cuts: Made the 2 shortest starts of his career (1ip, plus 4 batters) in a 14-1 loss at Tor on 6/24/08 and a 15-3 loss on 5/6/09 vs Mil...in between those 2 starts went **15-5, 3.76**...since that 6/24/08 loss at Tor still ranks second in the Major Leagues with **18 wins**.

Perfect: Began the season 3-0 for the third time in his career but for the first time won his first 3 starts of a season...won his first 2 starts in 2006, when he started off 5-0...began the 2005 campaign 4-0...was the first Reds pitcher to begin the season in the rotation and win his first 3 starts since **LHP Pete Schourek** did it in 1996 and the first righthander since **Jack Armstrong** won his first 5 starts of 1990.
