Top Pick

With the eighth pick overall, the Reds selected Arizona State University junior **RHP Mike Leake** in the first round of last night's first-year player draft...**Leake**, 21, this season went 16-1, 1.36 to help lead the Sun Devils to the upcoming College World Series...his 40 career wins at ASU are the most in school history...he is a finalist for the **Golden Spikes Award** and the College Baseball Foundation's **Pitcher of the Year Award**.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is **Game 2** (1-0) of a 3-game series vs **Kyle Brostowitz'** Nationals and **Game 2** (1-0) of a 6-game road trip that also includes an upcoming weekend visit to **KC** (3g)...the Reds are coming off a brief **1-2** homestand vs the **Cubs**...is **Game 12** (4-7) of a stretch in which the Reds will play 13-16g on the road (0-3 at Mil, 2-2 at StL, 1-2 vs Cubs, **1-0 at Wsh**, 3g at KC).

DRAFT DAY: In yesterday's first day of the 2009 first-year player draft the Reds selected Arizona State University Junior **RHP Mike Leake** (8th overall), University of Southern California junior **RHP Brad Boxberger** (43rd as compensation for losing Type B free agent **LHP Jeremy Affeldt**), Taylorsville (MS) High School **SS Billy Hamilton** (2nd round) and University of Houston junior **LHP Don Joseph** (3rd round)...the draft resumed today at noon with Rounds 4 through 30 and will conclude tomorrow at 11:30 a.m. with Rounds 31 through 50...the lists of Cin's 2008 draft picks and No. 1 draft picks are on pages **212-213** of the media guide...**OF Jay Bruce** is the only first-round pick currently on the Reds' roster (2005 by Cin, 12th overall)...all draft information can be found at mlb.com's home page.

MORE DRAFT TIDBITS: Seven of the 31 players who have played for the Reds this season were drafted by the organization, including **1B Joey Votto** (2002, 2nd round), **OF Chris Dickerson** (2003, 16th round), **RHP Homer Bailey** (2004, 7th overall), **IF Paul Janish** (2004, 5th round), **OF Jay Bruce** (2005, 12th overall), **RHP Carlos Fisher** (2005, 11th round), **IF Adam Rosales** (2005, 12th round).

CENTRAL CASTING: On Sunday the Reds completed a **6-7** stretch vs **National League Central Division** rivals (3-0 vs Hou, 0-3 at Mil, 2-2 at StL, **1-2 vs Chi**)...the Reds began the stretch in third place, 2.5g out of first and finished it in fourth place, 3.5g out...the Reds won't play within the division again until **Fourth of July** weekend (3g at StL), a drought that includes 21 consecutive games outside the **Central** and 12 interleague contests.

M*A*S*H: From the **Opening Day roster** the Reds are missing starters **1B Joey Votto** and **3B Edwin Encarnacion** along with starting **RHP Edinson Volquez**...all are on the disabled list...several other players missed action recently because of various ailments, including **2B Brandon Phillips** (hairline fracture, tip of right thumb), **SS Alex Gonzalez** (strained left oblique muscle), **Willy Taveras** (tight right hamstring) and **IF/OF Jerry Hairston Jr.** (flu).

SOUTHPAW: **Matt Maloney** is the first **lefthander** to start for the Reds this season and when he made his debut on 6/6 vs Chi became only the second LH Reds starter in a span of **236 games**...in **2008**, righthanded pitchers started Cin's first 161 games until **Adam Pettyjohn** took the hill for the season finale...**Pettyjohn's start** snapped a streak of **180 consecutive starts** by Reds righthanders...according to **Elias Sports Bureau**, prior to **Maloney's** appearance on Sat only the Reds, Padres and Cardinals had not started a lefthanded pitcher this season.

ZEROES: The Reds are tied for the National League lead with **6 team shutouts**...the Reds produced their 6 shutouts in the first **26g**, their fastest to 6 blankings since the **1914 staff** threw its sixth shutout in the **25th** game...Cin produced 6 team shutouts all of last season.

GILLETTE CIVIL RIGHTS GAME: At Great American Ball Park on **Sat, 6/20** the Reds and Chicago White Sox will meet in the **Gillette Civil Rights Game**, the first time the contest will be played during the regular season...the weekend's festivities will include a roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's **Harriet Tubman Theater** (Fri, 6/19, 4:00 p.m.), a luncheon at **Duke Energy Center** honoring the 3 winners of Major League Baseball's **Beacon Awards** (Sat, 6/20, 11:30 a.m.) and a **Youth Summit** at **Fountain Square** downtown (Sat, 6/20, 4:00 p.m.)...scheduled to attend the **Sat, 6/20** luncheon are Beacon of Change winner **Muhammad Ali**, Beacon of Hope winner **Bill Cosby** and Beacon of Life winner **Hank Aaron**...Beacon Award presenters include **Sugar Ray Leonard** (Ali), Hall of Fame pitcher **Bob Gibson** (Cosby) and **Commissioner Allan H. (Bud) Selig** (Aaron)...Grammy Award-winning gospel artist **BeBe Winans** will perform at the luncheon and at that night's game...former **President Bill Clinton** will be the keynote speaker at the luncheon...for more information, log on to www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (14-14, .500): The Reds went **3-5-2** in their **10 home series** and produced a winning record on just 2 of their 5 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3, 1-2)...at 14-13 & 13-12 their record at home was above .500....in 7 seasons at GABP are **255-259-1**...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38)...at **217-217-1** the Reds had evened their overall record at GABP for the first time since **6/26/04** (57-57)...also reached .500 at **219-219-1**.

REDS ON THE ROAD (16-13, .552): The Reds are **1-0** this road series and **1-0** on this road trip...went **5-2-2** in their **previous 9 road series**...produced winning records on each of their first 2 road trips (7-3, 3-2), a .500 record on the third trip (3-3) and a losing record in their most recent road trip (2-5)...entering this season and dating to 2006, **the Reds** had losing records in **23** of their **previous 28 road trips**.

IN THE STANDINGS (65): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 8, THIRD - 31, FOURTH - 21, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...at **20-14** and again at **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g over .500** at **36-24**...have spent **53** days above, **5** days at and **7** days below .500.

REDS vs NATIONALS: The Reds are 225-189 all-time vs the franchise formerly known as the Montreal Expos, including 1-0 this season and 4-3 in 2008 after they swept the 4-game series in July at GABP and were swept in a 3-game set at Nationals Park in August...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 13-7 vs the franchise, including 4-0 last season season and 11-4 vs the Nationals...**at Nationals Park:** Reds are 1-3, including 1-0 this season...**at RFK Stadium:** Reds went 5-4...**at Montreal:** Reds went 98-92, including 28-20 at **Jarry Park** and 70-72 at **Olympic Stadium**...in April 2003 the Reds went 1-2 vs the Expos at Hiram Bithorn Stadium in San Juan, Puerto Rico...**last Reds sweep:** at Cin: 8/28-8/29, 1991 (2g); 5/23-5/25, 2005 (3g); 7/3-7/6, 2008 (4g)...at Wsh: 4/24-4/26, 2006 (3g)...**last Expos/Nationals sweep:** at Cin: 4/29-4/30, 1986 (2g); 8/31-9/2, 1992 (3g)...at Wsh: 8/1-8/3, 2008 (3g).

IF Paul Janish pitched in the ninth inning of the 15-3 loss vs Mil on 5/6 (1ip, 5h, 5er, 0bb, 2k, Fielder 2-run HR)...he became the first Reds position player to pitch since Lenny Harris on 6/1/98 at SF.				

Reds Pitchers: Rank fifth in the National League with a 3.91 team ERA...**on the road trip are 1-0, 2.00 (9ip, 2er)**...have allowed a homer in 5 straight games (8hr)...have 6 team shutouts...had 6 shutouts all last season...with a 7-0 win on 5/5 at Fla reached 6 shutouts in their 26th game, their fastest to 6 team shutouts since the 1914 Reds threw their sixth shutout in their 25th game.

Reds Starters: Rank sixth in the National League with 4.19 rotation ERA...**on thee road trip are 1-0, 1.29 (7ip, 1er)**...have produced 29 quality starts (**Cueto 9, Arroyo 7, Harang 6, Volquez 3, Owings 3, Maloney 1**)...the Reds went 22-7 in those quality starts (.759)...have recorded a quality start in each of the last 6g, a season-high...through the first 41g of the season used just 5 starting pitchers, their longest such streak to begin a year since **RHP John Roper** became the staff's **sixth** different starter in the **42nd game** of the **1994 campaign**...on 5/23 vs Cle, in the club's 42nd game, **RHP Homer Bailey** became the Reds' sixth starting pitcher...**Aaron Harang** threw a 3-hitter in the 2-0 win vs Pit in the club's fifth game of the season...was the earliest complete game by a Reds pitcher since **Pete Harnisch** beat the Cardinals, 3-0 in Busch Stadium, in the **fourth** contest of the **1999** campaign.

Reds Relievers: Rank third in the National League with a 3.33 bullpen ERA (NYM 2.91, Mil 3.25)...**on the road trip are 0-0, 4.50 (2ip, 1er) with 1 save**...in their last 47g have posted a 2.56era (147.2ip, 42er) and in their last 35g have posted a 2.38era (113.2ip, 30er)...none of the previous notes include the pitching performance by IF Paul Janish in the ninth inning of the 15-3 loss on 5/6 vs Mil (1ip, 5er)...didn't blow a save until the club's 36th game, a 6-5 loss in 16 innings on 5/16 at SD...for the second straight season the Reds' bullpen was the last in the Major Leagues to suffer a blown save...in 2008 didn't blow a save until the 41st game (5/14)...over the last 2 seasons **Francisco Cordero** has recorded all **49** of the bullpen's saves (34sv in 2008, 15sv in 2009).

Ranks among the National League leaders in saves...has not allowed a run in his last 12 apps (12ip, 8h, 2bb, 9k)...in his last 18 apps has posted a 0.50era (18ip, 1er)...with 226 career saves ranks 30th on that all-time list...Ugeth Urbina is 29th with 237 saves...including last season has recorded the bullpen's last 49 saves (34sv in 2008, 15sv in 2009)...dating back to last season has converted 29 consecutive save chances, including all 14 save opps this year...**suffered his last blown save on 7/21/08 vs SD**...in the 3-0 victory on 4/22 at Chi recorded his 100th save in the National League to become only the 11th pitcher in history with at least 100 saves in each league (see box below).
