With the eighth pick overall, the Reds selected Arizona State University junior RHP Mike Leake in the first round of last night's first-year player draft...**Leake**, 21, this season went 16-1, 1.36 to help lead the Sun Devils to the upcoming College World Series...his 40 career wins at ASU are the most in school history...he is a finalist for the **Golden Spikes** Award and the College Baseball Foundation's Pitcher of the Year Award.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is Game 2 (1-0) of a 3-game series vs Kyle Brostowitz' Nationals and Game 2 (1-0) of a 6-game road trip that also includes an upcoming weekend visit to KC (3g)...the Reds are coming off a brief 1-2 homestand vs the **Cubs**...is **Game 12** (4-7) of a stretch in which the Reds will play 13-16g on the road (0-3 at Mil, 2-2 at StL, 1-2 vs Cubs, 1-0 at Wsh, 3g at KC).

DRAFT DAY: In yesterday's first day of the 2009 first-year player draft the Reds selected Arizona State University Junior RHP Mike Leake (8th overall), University of Southern California junior RHP Brad Boxberger (43rd as compensation for losing Type B free agent LHP Jeremy Affeldt), Taylorsville (MS) High School SS Billy Hamilton (2nd round) and University of Houston junior **LHP Don Joseph** (3rd round)...the draft resumed today at noon with Rounds 4 through 30 and will conclude tomorrow at 11:30 a.m. with Rounds 31 through 50...the lists of Cin's 2008 draft picks and No. 1 draft picks are on pages 212-213 of the media guide...OF Jay Bruce is the only first-round pick currently on the Reds' roster (2005 by Cin, 12th overall)...all draft information can be found at mlb.com's home page.

MORE DRAFT TIDBITS: Seven of the 31 players who have played for the Reds this season were drafted by the organization, including 1B Joey Votto (2002, 2nd round), OF Chris Dickerson (2003, 16th round), RHP Homer Bailey (2004, 7th overall), IF Paul Janish (2004, 5th round), OF Jay Bruce (2005, 12th overall), RHP Carlos Fisher (2005, 11th round). IF Adam Rosales (2005, 12th round).

CENTRAL CASTING: On Sunday the Reds completed a 6-7 stretch vs National League Central Division rivals (3-0 vs Hou, 0-3 at Mil, 2-2 at StL, 1-2 vs Chi)...the Reds began the stretch in third place, 2.5g out of first and finished it in fourth place, 3.5g out...the Reds won't play within the division again until Fourth of July weekend (3g at StL), a drought that includes 21 consecutive games outside the Central and 12 interleague contests

M*A*S*H: From the Opening Day roster the Reds are missing starters 1B Joey Votto and 3B Edwin Encarnacion along with starting RHP Edinson Volquez...all are on the disabled list...several other players missed action recently because of various ailments, including 2B Brandon Phillips (hairline fracture, tip of right thumb), SS Alex Gonzalez (strained left oblique muscle), Willy Taveras (tight right hamstring) and IF/OF Jerry Hairston Jr. (flu).

SOUTHPAW: Matt Maloney is the first lefthander to start for the Reds this season and when he made his debut on 6/6 vs Chi became only the second LH Reds starter in a span of **236 games...in 2008**, righthanded pitchers started Cin's first 161 games until **Adam Pettyjohn** took the hill for the season finale...**Pettyjohn's start** snapped a streak of 180 consecutive starts by Reds righthanders...according to Elias Sports Bureau, prior to Maloney's appearance on Sat only the Reds. Padres and Cardinals had not started a lefthanded pitcher this season.

ZEROES: The Reds are tied for the National League lead with 6 team shutouts...the Reds produced their 6 shutouts in the first 26g, their fastest to 6 blankings since the 1914 staff threw its sixth shutout in the 25th game...Cin produced 6 team shutouts all of last season.

GILLETTE CIVIL RIGHTS GAME: At Great American Ball Park on Sat, 6/20 the Reds and Chicago White Sox will meet in the Gillette Civil Rights Game, the first time the contest will be played during the regular season...the weekend's festivities will include a roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's Harriet Tubman Theater (Fri, 6/19, 4:00 p.m.), a luncheon at **Duke Energy Center** honoring the 3 winners of Major League Baseball's Beacon Awards (Sat, 6/20, 11:30 a.m.) and a Youth Summit at Fountain Square downtown (Sat, 6/20, 4:00 p.m.).. scheduled to attend the Sat, 6/20 luncheon are Beacon of Change winner Muhammad Ali, Beacon of Hope winner Bill Cosby and Beacon of Life winner Hank Aaron...Beacon Award presenters include Sugar Ray Leonard (Ali), Hall of Fame pitcher Bob Gibson (Cosby) and Commissioner Allan H. (Bud) Selig (Aaron)...Grammy Award-winning gospel artist BeBe Winans will perform at the luncheon and at that night's game...former President Bill Clinton will be the keynote speaker at the luncheon...for more information, log on to www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (14-14, .500): The Reds went 3-5-2 in their 10 home series and produced a winning record on just 2 of their 5 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3, 1-2)...at 14-13 & 13-12 their record at home was above .500....in 7 seasons at GABP are 255-259-1...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38)...at 217-217-1 the Reds had evened their overall record at GABP for the first time since 6/26/04 (57-57)...also reached .500 at 219-219-1.

REDS ON THE ROAD (16-13, .552): The Reds are 1-0 this road series and 1-0 on this road trip...went 5-2-2 in their previous 9 road series...produced winning records on each of their first 2 road trips (7-3, 3-2), a .500 record on the third trip (3-3) and a losing record in their most recent road trip (2-5)...entering this season and dating to 2006, the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips.

IN THE STANDINGS (65): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 8, THIRD - 31, FOURTH - 21, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...at 20-14 and again at 26-20 were a season-high 6g over .500...prior to this season hadn't been 6g over .500 since 2006, when they reached a season-high 12g over .500 at 36-24...have spent 53 days above, 5 days at and 7 days below .500.

REDS vs NATIONALS: The Reds are 225-189 all-time vs the franchise formerly known as the Montreal Expos, including 1-0 this season and 4-3 in 2008 after they swept the 4-game series in July at GABP and were swept in a 3-game set at Nationals Park in August...at Great American Ball Park: Reds are 13-7 vs the franchise, including 4-0 last season season and 11-4 vs the Nationals...at Nationals Park: Reds are 1-3, including 1-0 this season...at RFK Stadium: Reds went 5-4... at Montreal: Reds went 98-92, including 28-20 at Jarry Park and 70-72 at Olympic Stadium...in April 2003 the Reds went 1-2 vs the Expos at Hiram Bithorn Stadium in San Juan, Puerto Rico... Iast Reds sweep: at Cin: 8/28-8/29, 1991 (2g); 5/23-5/25, 2005 (3g); 7/3-7/6, 2008 (4g)...at Wsh: 4/24-4/26, 2006 (3g)...**last Expos/Nationals sweep**: at Cin: 4/29-4/30, 1986 (2g); 8/31-9/2, 1992 (3g)...at Wsh: 8/1-8/3, 2008 (3g).

<u>Last Started</u>: Thu at StL, in the 200th start of his career threw his second complete game of the season in the 3-1 loss (8h, 3er, 2bb, 4k, 1hr, 115 pitches, 74 starts)...Pujols drove in all 3 runs on a 2-out, 2-run HR in the third inning and an RBI-double in the sixth...induced 4 inning-ending double plays.

Red Hots: Is making his 13th start of the season...in his previous 12 starts the Reds went 5-7 and scored 45 runs (3.75 r/g)...in his 12 starts Reds batters hit .247 (97-393).

Home Cookin': Is 4-2, 2.84 (38ip, 12er) in 6 starts at Great American Ball Park and 1-4, 5.35 (38.2ip, 23er) in 6 starts on the road.

<u>Streaking</u>: Has allowed a home run in 8 consecutive apps, tied with Pit's **Ross Ohlendorf** and Det's **Armando Galarraga** for the longest such streak by a pitcher in the Major Leagues this season (courtesy Elias Sports Bureau)...is the longest streak by a Reds pitcher since **RHP Ramon Ortiz** tied the National League record by allowing a home run in **15** consecutive apps from **5/1-7/17**, **2005**.

<u>Milestones</u>: On 4/23 at Chi recorded the **1,000th strikeout** of his career (**Derrek Lee**)...his 3-hitter in the club's fifth game, a 2-0 win on 4/12 vs Pit, was the quickest complete game by a Reds pitcher since **Pete Harnisch** threw a CG in the Reds' fourth game of **1999**.

Opening Day: In the 2-1 loss vs the Mets made his fourth straight Opening Day start, the first Reds pitcher to do so since RHP Jose Rijo had the honors in 4 straight seasons from 1992-95...the only other Reds pitchers to make at least 4 consecutive Opening Day starts are Pete Donohue (5 straight, 1923-27) and Mario Soto (5, 1982-86)...Soto holds the club record for overall Opening Day starts (6)...in 4 career Opening Day starts Harang is 1-3, 3.52 (23ip, 9er).

<u>Staff Ace</u>: Since he was acquired from the Athletics at the **2003 trading deadline** is the Reds' leader in most statistical pitching categories, including starts (179), wins (68), innings pitched (1145.2) and strikeouts

(966)...since the beginning of the **2006 season** leads the National League in innings pitched (**727.0**)...in 2005 and 2007 won the BBWAA's Johnny Vander Meer Award as the club's Most Outstanding Pitcher.

Community Affairs: Is one of the club's more active members of the local community...for the third straight season, as part of his Aaron's Aces ticket program is hosting at all Sunday home games children of military personnel serving in the War On Terrorism...along with wife Jen donated \$55,000 to the Miracle League of Greater Cincinnati and Northern Kentucky and on 5/9 attended the dedication of that field at the Durham Recreation Complex in Western Hills...for his community service has been the club's nominee for the Robert Clemente Award (2007), Branch Rickey Award (2007) and Marvin Miller Man of the Year Award (2007, 2008).

Tomorrow's Pitcher: RHP Micah Owings

<u>Last Started</u>: Fri vs Cubs and suffered the 2-1 loss (6ip, 5h, 2er, 3bb, 6k, 1hr, 98 pitches, 64 strikes)...left trailing, 2-0...allowed only a bases-loaded walk to Fontenot in the first inning and a solo HR to Zambrano in the fifth.

Red Hots: Is making his 11th start of the season, his fifth start since an emergency relief appearance on 5/16 at SD...his current 4-game losing streak is the longest by a Reds pitcher this season...in his previous 10 starts the Reds went 4-5 and scored 42 runs (4.2 r/g)... has 3 quality starts...with an 8-2 win on 4/26 vs Atl snapped his 9-game losing streak dating back to a 9-3 Diamondbacks victory on 5/25/08 at Atl...in 14 apps and 10 starts between victories went 0-9. 8.53.

In Relief: Made his only relief appearance of the season in the 16-inning, 6-5 loss at SD on 5/16...threw a career-high 5.2 innings in relief (3h, 1er, 3bb, 5k, 1hr, 81 pitches, 44 strikes)...entered the game in the 11th inning as the Reds' seventh and final pitcher...retired his first 10 batters until Scott Hairston singled with 1 out in the 14th inning...Nick Hundley homered to end the 5-hour, 14 minute struggle... in 4 starts since then is 0-3, 6.86 (19.2ip, 15er).
