The Night The Lights Went Out

Tomorrow night the Reds begin a 3-game series at KC, the site of the first doubleheader in interleague history...the Reds' only other appearance at Kauffman Stadium, a 3-game sweep of the Royals there in June 1999, was their first appearance in KC since the Red Stockings and Cowboys of the American Association met in 1889...the first game of that June 1999 series was postponed because of a ballpark power failure...the Reds swept the next day's doubleheader, 9-4 and 7-4 in 10 innings, before winning the series finale, 14-3.

TODAY'S GAME: Is Game 3 (2-0) of a 3-game series vs Max Rollinger's Nationals and Game 3 (2-0) of a 6-game road trip that also includes this weekend's visit to KC (3g)...is Game 13 (5-7) of a stretch in which the Reds will play 13-16g on the road (0-3 at Mil, 2-2 at StL, 1-2 vs Cubs, 2-0 at Wsh, 3g at KC).

INTERLEAGUE PLAY: In its 13th season, interleague play continues this weekend...the Reds went 2-1 vs Cle in May at Great American Ball Park and also will host the White Sox during the Gillette Civil Rights Game weekend (6/19-6/21)...Cin's interleague travel schedule includes visits to KC (Fri-Sun), to Tor (6/23-6/25) and to Cle (6/26-6/28)... the Reds are 79-96 (.451) all-time vs American League teams...their all-time results vs American League teams can be found on page 351 of the media guide.

TOP PICK: With the eighth pick overall, the Reds selected Arizona State University junior RHP Mike Leake in the first round of the 2009 first-year player draft...Leake, 21, this season went 16-1, 1.36 to help lead the Sun Devils to the upcoming College World Series...his 40 career wins at ASU are the most in school history...is a finalist for the Golden Spikes Award and the College Baseball Foundation's Pitcher of the Year Award...the draft is scheduled to conclude today with Rounds 31 through 50...the lists of Cin's 2008 draft picks and No. 1 draft picks are on pages 212-213 of the media guide...OF Jay Bruce is the only first-round pick currently on the Reds' roster (2005 by Cin, 12th overall)...all draft information can be found at mlb.com's home page.

MORE DRAFT TIDBITS: Seven of the 31 players who have played for the Reds this season were drafted by the organization, including 1B Joey Votto (2002, 2nd round), OF Chris Dickerson (2003, 16th round), RHP Homer Bailey (2004, 7th overall), IF Paul Janish (2004, 5th round), OF Jay Bruce (2005, 12th overall), RHP Carlos Fisher (2005, 11th round), IF Adam Rosales (2005, 12th round).

 $\underline{\text{M*A*S*H}}$: From the **Opening Day roster** the Reds are missing starters **1B Joey Votto** and **3B Edwin Encarnacion** along with starting **RHP Edinson Volquez**...all are on the disabled list...several other players missed action recently because of various ailments, including 2B Brandon Phillips (hairline fracture, tip of right thumb), SS Alex Gonzalez (strained left oblique muscle), Willy Taveras (tight right hamstring) and IF/OF Jerry Hairston Jr. (flu).

SOUTHPAW: Matt Maloney is the first lefthander to start for the Reds this season and when he made his debut on 6/6 vs Chi became only the second LH Reds starter in a span of 236 games...in 2008, righthanded pitchers started Cin's first 161 games until Adam Pettyjohn took the hill for the season finale...Pettyjohn's start snapped a streak of 180 consecutive starts by Reds righthanders...according to Elias Sports Bureau, prior to Maloney's appearance on Sat only the Reds, Padres and Cardinals had not started a lefthanded pitcher this season.

GILLETTE CIVIL RIGHTS GAME: At Great American Ball Park on Sat, 6/20 the Reds and Chicago White Sox will meet in the Gillette Civil Rights Game, the first time the contest will be played during the regular season...the weekend's festivities will include a roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's Harriet Tubman Theater (Fri, 6/19, 4:00 p.m.), a luncheon at Duke Energy Center honoring the 3 winners of Major League Baseball's Beacon Awards (Sat, 6/20, 11:30 a.m.) and a Youth Summit at Fountain Square downtown (Sat, 6/20, 4:00 p.m.).. scheduled to attend the Sat, 6/20 luncheon are Beacon of Change winner Muhammad Ali, Beacon of Hope winner Bill Cosby and Beacon of Life winner Hank Aaron...Beacon Award presenters include Sugar Ray Leonard (Ali), Hall of Fame pitcher Bob Gibson (Cosby) and Commissioner Allan H. (Bud) Selig (Aaron)...Grammy Award-winning gospel artist BeBe Winans will perform at the luncheon and at that night's game...former President Bill Clinton will be the keynote speaker at the luncheon...for more information, log on to www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (14-14, .500): The Reds went 3-5-2 in their 10 home series and produced a winning record on just 2 of their 5 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3, 1-2)...at 14-13 & 13-12 their record at home was above .500....in 7 seasons at GABP are 255-259-1...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38)...at 217-217-1 the Reds had evened their overall record at GABP for the first time since 6/26/04 (57-57)...also reached .500 at 219-219-1.

REDS ON THE ROAD (17-13, .567): The Reds are 2-0 this road series and 2-0 on this road trip...regardless of today's outcome have gone 6-2-2 in their 10 road series...produced winning records on each of their first 2 road trips (7-3, 3-2), a .500 record on the third trip (3-3) and a losing record in their most recent road trip (2-5)...entering this season and dating to 2006, the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips.

IN THE STANDINGS (66): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 31, FOURTH - 21, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...at 20-14 and again at 26-20 were a season-high 6g over .500...prior to this season hadn't been 6g over .500 since 2006, when they reached a season-high 12g over .500 at 36-24...have spent 54 days above, 5 days at and 7 days below .500.

REDS vs NATIONALS: The Reds are 226-189 all-time vs the franchise formerly known as the Montreal Expos, including 2-0 this season and 4-3 in 2008 after they swept the 4-game series in July at GABP and were swept in a 3-game set at Nationals Park in August...at Nationals Park: Reds are 2-3, including 2-0 this season...at RFK Stadium: Reds went 5-4...at Montreal: Reds went 98-92, including 28-20 at Jarry Park and 70-72 at Olympic Stadium...in April 2003 the Reds went 1-2 vs the Expos at Hiram Bithorn Stadium in San Juan, Puerto Rico... last Reds sweep: at Wsh: 4/24-4/26, 2006 (3g).

UP NEXT: REDS vs ROYALS: Reds are 7-4 all-time vs the Royals, including 2-1 in 2006 at Great American Ball Park, 3-0 in 1999 at Kauffman Stadium, 0-2 in 1998 at Cinergy Field and 2-1 in 1997 at Cinergy...the Reds' only other appearance at Kauffman Stadium, a 3-game sweep there in June 1999, was their first appearance in KC since the Red Stockings and Cowboys of the American Association met in 1889.

<u>Last Started</u>: Fri vs Cubs and suffered the 2-1 loss (6ip, 5h, 2er, 3bb, 6k, 1hr, 98 pitches, 64 strikes)...left trailing, 2-0...allowed only a basesloaded walk to Fontenot in the first inning and a solo HR to Zambrano in the fifth.

Red Hots: Is making his 11th start of the season, his fifth start since an emergency relief appearance on 5/16 at SD...his current 4-game losing streak is the longest by a Reds pitcher this season...in his previous 10 starts the Reds went 4-5 and scored 42 runs (4.2 r/g)...has 3 quality starts... with an 8-2 win on 4/26 vs Atl snapped his 9-game losing streak dating back to a 9-3 Diamondbacks victory on 5/25/08 at Atl...in 14 apps and 10 starts between victories went 0-9, 8.53.

In Relief: Made his only relief appearance of the season in the 16-inning, 6-5 loss at SD on 5/16...threw a career-high 5.2 innings in relief (3h, 1er, 3bb, 5k, 1hr, 81 pitches, 44 strikes)...entered the game in the 11th inning as the Reds' seventh and final pitcher...retired his first 10 batters until Scott Hairston singled with 1 out in the 14th inning...Nick Hundley homered to end the 5-hour, 14 minute struggle...in 4 starts since then is 0-3, 6.86 (19.2ip, 15er).

At The Plate: In 2007 won the National League's Silver Slugger Award (.333, 4hr, 15rbi)...has 6 career home runs, including 1 this season (5/10 vs StL, pinch-hit solo off Ryan Franklin)...his 5 career home runs prior to 2009 are listed on page 149 of the media guide...on 5/7 vs Mil produced the first triple by a Reds pitcher since Eric Milton did it on 4/13/06 at Cubs.

Owings' Most Recent Starts: 4/15 at Mil, in his Reds pitching debut suffered the 9-3 loss (5+ip, 5h, 4er, 2bb, 2k, 2hr, 89 pitches, 47 strikes)...left with the score tied, 3-3, but was charged with another run scored off Burton...the Brewers added 4 more runs off Burton in that 5-run sixth inning...Owings allowed Fielder's sac fly in the first and leadoff HR to Cameron in both the second and fourth frames...4/21 at Chi, in the Reds' first game of the season at Wrigley Field and suffered the 7-2 loss (4.2ip, 5h, 5r, 2er, 4bb, 3k, 1hr, 94 pitches, 61 strikes)...left trailing, 4-2, but was charged with another run scored off Lincoln...in the second inning allowed a leadoff HR to Micah Hoffpauir...in the fifth was charged with 3 unearned runs...start of the game was delayed 12 minutes by weather...gametime temperature was 40 degrees with a 15 mile per hour wind blowing left to right...4/26 vs Atl and earned the 8-2 victory (7ip, 6h, 1er, 3bb, 6k, 1hr, 102 pitches, 60 strikes)...left leading, 8-1...allowed only a solo HR to David Ross with 1 out in the seventh inning...his first victory since May 2008 snapped a personal 9-game losing streak...5/2 at Pit and suffered the 8-6 loss (5.2ip, 9h, 5er, 2bb, 0k, 99 pitches, 64 strikes)...left trailing, 5-3...in the first inning allowed 4 runs on 4 hits, 1 walk and 1 his batter...5/7 vs Mil and earned the 6-5 victory (6ip, 7h, 5r, 4er, 1bb, 4k, 100 pitches, 67 strikes)...left leading, 6-5...allowed 3 runs in the fourth inning and 2 runs in the sixth...his RBI-triple in the bottom of the fourth off Braden Looper gave the Reds a 4-3 lead they would not relinquish...5/12 at Ari, in his first career appearance vs his former team earned the 3-1 victory (7+ip, 4h, 1er, 2bb, 4k, 1hbp, 90 pitches, 53 strikes)...took a 4-hit shutout into the eighth inning but then hit with a pitch leadoff batter Ryan Roberts...was charged with that run, which scored on Felipe Lopez' RBI-double off Arthur Rhodes...5/21 vs Phi and suffered the 12-5 loss (3ip, 6h, 5er, 3bb, 3k, 1hr, 71 pitches, 41 strik

Last Pitched: Sat vs Cubs, in his Major League debut was the victim of a blown save in the 11-inning, 4-3 victory (6+ip, 6h, 2er, 1bb, 4k, 1hbp, 2hr, 89 pitches, 58 strikes)...left leading, 3-2, but the Cubs tied it in the eighth inning with a run off Weathers...allowed both runs on solo homers, by Scales with 2 outs in the fourth inning and by Geovany Soto leading off the seventh...stranded 4 baserunners, all in the first 2 innings...first career strikeout victim was Ryan Dempster...singled off Dempster in his first career plate appearance...pitched in front of a sellout crowd.

Red Hots: The 25-year-old lefthander tomorrow at KC will make his second career start...Sat vs Cubs made his Major League debut after 99 minor league apps and 98 minor league starts...was born in Sandusky, Ohio and lives in Columbus...graduated from Huron (OH) High School...his media guide bio is on page 135.

With The Bats: Began the season with Louisville and in 10 starts there went 4-3, 2.00 before he was recalled on 6/6 to start against the Cubs...when promoted led the Bats' staff in starts (10, tied with Homer Bailey), innings pitched (67.1) and strikeouts (58)... in his last 5 starts for Louisville went 2-2, 0.73 (37ip, 3er)...was the organization's Minor League Pitcher of the Month for April (3gs, 2-0, 1.86).
