Reds Director of Safety and Security **Kerry Rowland** has been requested by Major League Baseball to work the security detail at the **2009 All-Star Game** in St. Louis...**Rowland** has been with the Reds since 2002.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is **Game 2** (0-1) of a 3-game series vs **Colby Curry's** Royals and **Game 5** (2-2) of a 6-game road trip that also included a visit to **Wsh** (2-1)...is **Game 15** (5-9) of a stretch in which the Reds will play 13-16g on the road (0-3 at Mil, 2-2 at StL, 1-2 vs Cubs, 2-1 at Wsh, **0-1 at KC**).

INTERLEAGUE PLAY: In its 13th season, interleague play continues for the Reds this weekend...Cin went **2-1 vs Cle** in May at Great American Ball Park and also will host the **White Sox** during the **Gillette Civil Rights Game** weekend (6/19-6/21)...Cin's interleague travel schedule includes visits to **KC** (0-1), to **Tor** (6/23-6/25) and to **Cle** (6/26-6/28)...the Reds are **79-97 (.449) all-time** vs American League teams...their all-time results vs American League teams can be found on page 351 of the media guide.

TOP PICK: With the eighth pick overall, the Reds selected Arizona State University junior **RHP Mike Leake** in the first round of the 2009 first-year player draft...**Leake**, 21, this season went 16-1, 1.36 to help lead the Sun Devils to the upcoming College World Series...his 40 career wins at ASU are the most in school history...is a finalist for the **Golden Spikes Award** and the College Baseball Foundation's **Pitcher of the Year Award**...the lists of Cin's 2008 draft picks and No. 1 draft picks are on pages **212-213** of the media guide...**OF Jay Bruce** is the only first-round pick currently on the Reds' roster (2005 by Cin, 12th overall)...all draft information can be found at reds.com.

MORE DRAFT TIDBITS: Seven of the 31 players who have played for the Reds this season were drafted by the organization, including **1B Joey Votto** (2002, 2nd round), **OF Chris Dickerson** (2003, 16th round), **RHP Homer Bailey** (2004, 7th overall), **IF Paul Janish** (2004, 5th round), **OF Jay Bruce** (2005, 12th overall), **RHP Carlos Fisher** (2005, 11th round), **IF Adam Rosales** (2005, 12th round).

M*A*S*H: From the **Opening Day** roster the Reds are missing starters **1B Joey Votto** and **3B Edwin Encarnacion** along with starting **RHP Edinson Volquez**...all are on the disabled list...several other players missed action recently because of various ailments, including **2B Brandon Phillips** (hairline fracture, tip of right thumb), **SS Alex Gonzalez** (strained left oblique muscle), **Willy Taveras** (tight right hamstring) and **IF/OF Jerry Hairston Jr.** (flu).

SOUTHPAW: **Matt Maloney** is the only **lefthander** to start for the Reds this season and when he made his debut on 6/6 vs Chi became only the second LH Reds starter in a span of **236 games**...in **2008**, righthanded pitchers started Cin's first 161 games until **Adam Pettyjohn** took the hill for the season finale...**Pettyjohn's start** snapped a streak of **180 consecutive starts** by Reds righthanders...according to **Elias Sports Bureau**, prior to **Maloney's** appearance on 6/6 vs Cubs only the Reds, Padres and Cardinals had not started a lefthanded pitcher this season.

MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUT: **RHP Carlos Fisher** and **LHP Matt Maloney** made their Major League debuts this season...in **2008**, 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts: **RHP Johnny Cueto**, **IF Paul Janish**, **OF Jay Bruce**, **LHP Daniel Ray Herrera**, **RHP Daryl Thompson**, **IF Adam Rosales**, **OF Chris Dickerson**, **RHP Ramon Ramirez**, **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** and **RHP Josh Roenicke**.

ZEROES: The Reds produced their **6 shutouts** in the first **26g**, their fastest to 6 blankings since the **1914 staff** threw its sixth shutout in the **25th** game...Cin produced 6 team shutouts all of last season.

GILLETTE CIVIL RIGHTS GAME: At Great American Ball Park on **next Saturday** the Reds and Chicago White Sox will meet in the **Gillette Civil Rights Game**, the first time the contest will be played during the regular season...the weekend's festivities will include a roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's **Harriet Tubman Theater** (Fri, 6/19, 4:00 p.m.), a luncheon at **Duke Energy Center** honoring the 3 winners of Major League Baseball's **Beacon Awards** (Sat, 6/20, 11:30 a.m.) and a **Youth Summit** at **Fountain Square** downtown (Sat, 6/20, 4:00 p.m.)...scheduled to attend the **Sat, 6/20** luncheon are Beacon of Change winner **Muhammad Ali**, Beacon of Hope winner **Bill Cosby** and Beacon of Life winner **Hank Aaron**...Beacon Award presenters include **Sugar Ray Leonard** (Ali), Hall of Fame pitcher **Bob Gibson** (Cosby) and **Commissioner Allan H. (Bud) Selig** (Aaron)...Grammy Award-winning gospel artist **BeBe Winans** will perform at the luncheon and at that night's game...former **President Bill Clinton** will be the keynote speaker at the luncheon...for more information, log on to www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (14-14, .500): The Reds went **3-5-2 in their 10 home series** and produced a winning record on just 2 of their 5 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3, 1-2)...at 14-13 & 13-12 their record at home was above .500....in 7 seasons at GABP are **255-259-1**...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38)...at **217-217-1** the Reds had evened their overall record at GABP for the first time since **6/26/04** (57-57)...also reached .500 at **219-219-1**.

REDS ON THE ROAD (17-15, .531): The Reds are **0-1** this series and **2-2** on this road trip...went **6-2-2 in their 10 previous road series**...produced winning records on each of their first 2 road trips (7-3, 3-2), a .500 record on the third trip (3-3) and a losing record in their most recent road trip (2-5)...entering this season and dating to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

IN THE STANDINGS (68): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: **FIRST** - 1, **SECOND** - 9, **THIRD** - 33, **FOURTH** - 21, **FIFTH** - 3, **SIXTH** - 1...at **20-14** and again at **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g over .500** at **36-24**...have spent **56** days above, **5** days at and **7** days below .500.

REDS vs ROYALS: Reds are **7-5 all-time vs the Royals**, including 0-1 here this season, 2-1 in 2006 at Great American Ball Park, 3-0 in 1999 at Kauffman Stadium, 0-2 in 1998 at Cinergy Field and 2-1 in 1997 at Cinergy...the Reds' only previous appearance at Kauffman Stadium, a 3-game sweep here in June 1999, was their first appearance in Kansas City since the Red Stockings and Cowboys of the American Association met in 1889...the first game of that June 1999 series was postponed because of a power failure...the Reds swept the next day's doubleheader, 9-4 and 7-4 in 10 innings, before winning the series finale, 14-3...was the first doubleheader in interleague history.

Wins Beginning 6/29

In the 14-1 loss on 6/24/08 at Tor, **Bronson Arroyo** made the shortest start of his career and became only the sixth starting pitcher in Major League history to allow at least 10 earned runs in a game in which he retired 3 batters or fewer (1+ip, 11h, 10er)...beginning with his next start, a 9-5 win at Cle on 6/29/08, **Arroyo** has 18 victories, second-most in the Major Leagues since then:

Iron Man

Since he was acquired by the Reds prior to the 2006 season, **Bronson Arroyo** ranks among the Major League leaders in games started and innings pitched:

Last Pitched: Sun vs Cubs and suffered the 14-inning, 6-3 loss (7ip, 5h, 3r, 1er, 2bb, 2k, 1hr, 101 pitches, 62 strikes)... left trailing, 3-1...in the first inning allowed a solo HR to Theriot, the only one of Theriot's 13 career home runs to be hit outside Wrigley Field...following his own throwing error, allowed a pair of unearned runs in the third inning on Lee's 2-out, 2-run single.

Red Hots: Is making his 13th start of the season and his second start of the season vs an American League club... with 7 victories is just 1 shy of the National League leaders...in his previous 12 starts the Reds went 7-5 and scored 55 runs (4.58 r/g)...has 7 quality starts...since he was acquired by the Reds prior to the 2006 season leads all Major League pitchers with 115 starts and ranks second in the National League with 728.2 innings pitched (**Aaron Harang** 1st, 734.2ip).

Short Cuts: Made the 2 shortest starts of his career (1ip, plus 4 batters) in a 14-1 loss at Tor on 6/24/08 and a 15-3 loss on 5/6/09 vs Mil...in between those 2 starts

went **15-5, 3.76**...since that 6/24/08 loss at Tor still ranks second in the Major Leagues with **18 wins**.

In The Big Inning: Allowed at least 1 run in the first inning of 7 of his 12 starts, including each of his last 5 starts...has posted a 9.75era in the first inning (12ip, 13er) and a 4.13era after the first frame (65.1ip, 30er).

Perfect: Began the season 3-0 for the third time in his career but for the first time won his first 3 starts of a season...won his first 2 starts in 2006, when he started off 5-0...began the 2005 campaign 4-0...was the first Reds pitcher to begin the season in the rotation and win his first 3 starts since **LHP Pete Schourek** did it in 1996 and the first righthander since **Jack Armstrong** won his first 5 starts of 1990.

Tomorrow's Pitcher: RHP Johnny Cueto

Last Pitched: Tue at Wsh and earned the 3-2 victory (7ip, 4h, 1er, 4bb, 5k, 1hr, 111 pitches, 66 strikes)...allowed only a solo HR to Dukes with 1 out in the fourth inning...threw 27 of his 111 pitches in the first inning, when he walked 2 batters and stranded 3 baserunners.

Red Hots: Tomorrow the 23-year-old righthander will make his 13th start of the season, the 44th start of his career and his first career appearance vs the Royals...ranks among the National League leaders with a 2.33era (2nd) and a .210 opponents' BA (3rd)...in his 12 starts the Reds went 8-4 and scored 50 runs (4.17 r/g)...leads the team with 9 quality starts, all in his last 10 apps and including 4 straight...his string of 5 consecutive QS from 4/22-5/13 was the longest stretch of quality starts by a Reds pitcher this season... last year, **Edinson Volquez** produced a string of 12 straight QS (4/22-6/20).

Streaking I: In 5 starts from 4/22-5/13 went **4-0, 1.25** (36ip, 5er)... the 4-game winning streak was the longest of his career...allowed 4 earned runs in his first start of the season (6ip) and 17 earned runs in his last 11 starts (75ip, 1.322era).

Streaking II: In each of 4 starts from 4/22-5/8 threw at least 7.0 innings while allowing no more than 1 run, the longest streak of that kind by a Reds pitcher since **Tim Belcher** had a 4-game run from **5/27-6/13, 1992** (courtesy Elias Sports Bureau).

World Baseball Classic: Started the Dominican Republic's second game of the tournament and threw 4.2 scoreless innings to earn the 9-0 win vs Panama in the San Juan bracket (4.2ip, 3h, 1bb, 5k).
