The 1956 Reds was the first team in Major League history to have 8 African-American players appear on their roster in the same season: Frank Robinson. Chuck Harmon. Joe Black, Curt Flood, Pat Scantlebury, Bob Thurman, George Crowe and Brooks Lawrence.

At Great American Ball Park on Saturday the Reds and Chicago White Sox will meet in the Gillette Civil Rights Game, the first time the contest will be played during the regular season...the weekend's festivities will include a roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad

Freedom Center's Harriet Tubman Theater (Fri, 6/19, 4:00 p.m.), a luncheon at Duke Energy Center honoring the 3 winners of Major League Baseball's Beacon Awards (Sat, 6/20, 11:30 a.m.) and a Youth Summit at Fountain Square downtown (Sat, 6/20, 4:00 p.m.)...scheduled to attend Saturday's luncheon are Beacon of Change winner Muhammad Ali, Beacon of Hope winner Bill Cosby and Beacon of Life winner Hank Aaron...Beacon Award presenters include **Sugar Ray Leonard** (Ali), Hall of Fame pitcher **Bob Gibson** (Cosby) and **Commissioner Allan H. (Bud) Selig** (Aaron)...Grammy Award-winning gospel artist **BeBe Winans** will perform at the luncheon and at that night's game...former President Bill Clinton will be the keynote speaker at the luncheon...for more information, log on to www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame.

TODAY'S GAME: Is Game 3 (0-2) of a 3-game series vs Steve Stewart's Royals and Game 6 (2-3) of a 6-game road trip that also included a visit to Wsh (2-1)...is Game 16 (5-10) of a stretch in which the Reds will play 13-16g on the road (0-3 at Mil, 2-2 at StL, 1-2 vs Cubs, 2-1 at Wsh, 0-2 at KC)...following tomorrow's off day the Reds begin a 6-game homestand vs the Braves and White Sox.

INTERLEAGUE PLAY: In its 13th season, interleague play continues for the Reds this weekend...Cin is 2-3 vs the American League so far this season...went 2-1 vs Cle in May at Great American Ball Park and also will host the White Sox during the upcoming Gillette Civil Rights Game weekend...Cin's interleague travel schedule includes visits to KC (0-2), to Tor (6/23-6/25) and to Cle (6/26-6/28)...the Reds are 79-98 (.446) all-time vs American League teams...their all-time results vs American League teams can be found on page 351 of the media guide.

TOP PICK: With the eighth pick overall, the Reds selected Arizona State University junior RHP Mike Leake in the first round of the 2009 first-year player draft...Leake, 21, this season went 16-1, 1.36 to help lead the Sun Devils to the upcoming College World Series...his 40 career wins at ASU are the most in school history...is a finalist for the Golden Spikes Award and the College Baseball Foundation's Pitcher of the Year Award...the lists of Cin's 2008 draft picks and No. 1 draft picks are on pages 212-213 of the media guide...OF Jay Bruce is the only first-round pick currently on the Reds' roster (2005 by Cin, 12th overall)...all draft information can be found at reds.com.

MORE DRAFT TIDBITS: Seven of the 31 players who have played for the Reds this season were drafted by the organization, including 1B Joey Votto (2002, 2nd round), OF Chris Dickerson (2003, 16th round), RHP Homer Bailey (2004, 7th overall), IF Paul Janish (2004, 5th round), OF Jay Bruce (2005, 12th overall), RHP Carlos Fisher (2005, 11th round), IF Adam Rosales (2005, 12th round).

<u>M*A*S*H</u>: From the **Opening Day roster** the Reds are missing starters **1B Joey Votto** and **3B Edwin Encarnacion** along with starting **RHP Edinson Volquez**...all are on the disabled list...several other players missed action recently because of various ailments, including 2B Brandon Phillips (hairline fracture, tip of right thumb), SS Alex Gonzalez (strained left oblique muscle), Willy Taveras (tight right hamstring) and IF/OF Jerry Hairston Jr. (flu).

SOUTHPAW: **Matt Maloney** is the only **lefthander** to start for the Reds this season and when he made his debut on 6/6 vs Chi became only the second LH Reds starter in a span of 236 games...in 2008, righthanded pitchers started Cin's first 161 games until Adam Pettyjohn took the hill for the season finale...Pettyjohn's start snapped a streak of 180 consecutive starts by Reds righthanders...according to Elias Sports Bureau, prior to Maloney's appearance on 6/6 vs Cubs only the Reds, Padres and Cardinals had not started a lefthanded pitcher this season.

ZEROES: The Reds produced their 6 shutouts in the first 26g, their fastest to 6 blankings since the 1914 staff threw its sixth shutout in the 25th game...Cin produced 6 team shutouts all of last season.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (14-14, .500): The Reds went 3-5-2 in their 10 home series and produced a winning record on just 2 of their 5 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3, 1-2)...at 14-13 & 13-12 their record at home was above .500....in 7 seasons at GABP are 255-259-1.

REDS ON THE ROAD (17-16, .515): The Reds are 0-2 this series and 2-3 on this road trip...went 6-3-2 in their 11 road series, including this one...produced winning records on each of their first 2 road trips (7-3, 3-2), a .500 record on the third trip (3-3) and a losing record in their most recent road trip (2-5)...entering this season and dating to 2006, the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips.

IN THE STANDINGS (69): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 34, FOURTH - 21, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...at 20-14 and again at 26-20 were a season-high 6g over .500...prior to this season hadn't been 6g over .500 since 2006, when they reached a season-high 12g over .500 at 36-24...have spent 57 days above, 5 days at and 7 days below .500.

REDS vs ROYALS: Reds are 7-6 all-time vs the Royals, including 0-2 here this season, 2-1 in 2006 at Great American Ball Park, 3-0 in 1999 at Kauffman Stadium, 0-2 in 1998 at Cinergy Field and 2-1 in 1997 at Cinergy...the Reds' only previous appearance at Kauffman Stadium, a 3-game sweep here in June 1999, was their first appearance in Kansas City since the Red Stockings and Cowboys of the American Association met in 1889.

REDS vs BRAVES: The Reds are 1,070-963 all-time vs the Braves franchise, including 1-2 this season...at Great American Ball Park: Reds are 15-11, including 1-2 this season...won 7 of the last 9g vs the Braves at GABP.

<u>Last Pitched</u>: Tue at Wsh and earned the 3-2 victory (7ip, 4h, 1er, 4bb, 5k, 1hr, 111 pitches, 66 strikes)...allowed only a solo HR to Dukes with 1 out in the fourth inning...threw 27 of his 111 pitches in the first inning, when he walked 2 batters and stranded 3 baserunners.

Red Hots: The 23-year-old righthander is making his 13th start of the season, the 44th start of his career and his first career appearance vs the Royals...ranks among the National League leaders with a 2.33era and a .210 opponents' batting average...in his 12 starts the Reds went 8-4 and scored 50 runs (4.17 r/g)...leads the team with 9 quality starts, all in his last 10 apps and including 4 straight...his string of 5 consecutive QS from 4/22-5/13 was the longest stretch of quality starts by a Reds pitcher this season...last year, Edinson Volquez produced a string of 12 straight QS (4/22-6/20)...on 4/22 at Chi singled twice off Ted Lilly for his first career 2-hit game.

<u>Streaking !</u>: In 5 starts from 4/22-5/13 went **4-0, 1.25** (36ip, 5er)...the 4-game winning streak was the longest of his career...allowed 4 earned runs in his first start of the season (6ip) and 17 earned runs in his last 11 starts (75ip, 1.322era).

<u>Streaking II</u>: In each of 4 starts from 4/22-5/8 threw at least 7.0 innings while allowing no more than 1 run, the longest streak of that kind by a Reds pitcher since **Tim Belcher** had a 4-game run from **5/27-6/13**, **1992** (courtesy Elias Sports Bureau).

<u>World Baseball Classic</u>: Started the Dominican Republic's second game of the tournament and threw 4.2 scoreless innings to earn the 9-0 win vs Panama in the San Juan bracket (4.2ip, 3h, 1bb, 5k).

Tuesday vs Braves: RHP Aaron Harang

Last Started: Wed at Wsh, threw 7.2 scoreless innings but was a victim of a blown save in the 12-inning, 4-2 win (5h, 3bb, 2k, 123 pitches, 76 strikes)...left leading, 2-0, but the Nationals tied it with 2 runs in the ninth off Cordero...the game was delayed by rain with nobody out and a runner on first base in the bottom of the ninth inning...Cordero, who walked the leadoff hitter of the inning, returned after a 2-hour, 10-minute delay and suffered his first blown save since July of last season.

Red Hots: On Tue vs Atl will make his 14th start of the season... in his previous 13 starts the Reds went 6-7 and scored 49 runs (3.77 r/g)...in his 13 starts Reds batters hit .240 (104-433)...on 6/4 at StL suffered the 3-1 loss in a game in which Harang and Chris Carpenter each threw complete games.

<u>Home Cookin</u>': Is **4-2**, **2.84** (38ip, 12er) in 6 starts at Great American Ball Park and **1-4**, **4.47** (46.1ip, 23er) in 7 starts on the road.

<u>Streaking</u>: From 4/28-6/4 allowed a home run in 8 consecutive apps (10hr), the longest streak by a Reds pitcher since **RHP Ramon Ortiz** tied the National League record by allowing a home run in 15 consecutive apps from 5/1-7/17, 2005.

<u>Milestones</u>: On 4/23 at Chi recorded the **1,000th strikeout** of his career (**Derrek Lee**)...his 3-hitter in the club's fifth game, a 2-0 win on 4/12 vs Pit, was the quickest complete game by a Reds pitcher since **Pete Harnisch** threw a CG in the Reds' fourth game of **1999**.

<u>Staff Ace</u>: Since he was acquired from the Athletics at the **2003** trading deadline is the Reds' leader in most statistical pitching categories, including starts (180), wins (68), innings pitched (1153.1)
