## Gillette CIVIL RIGHTS GAME

The **1956 Reds** was the first team in Major League history to have 8 African-American players appear on their roster in the same season: **Frank Robinson, Chuck Harmon, Joe Black, Curt Flood, Pat Scantlebury, Bob Thurman, George Crowe** and **Brooks Lawrence**.

At Great American Ball Park on **Saturday** the Reds and Chicago White Sox will meet in the **Gillette Civil Rights Game**, the first time the contest will be played during the regular season...the weekend's festivities will include a roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad

Freedom Center's **Harriet Tubman Theater** (Fri, 6/19, 4:00 p.m.), a luncheon at **Duke Energy Center** honoring the 3 winners of Major League Baseball's **Beacon Awards** (Sat, 6/20, 11:30 a.m.) and a **Youth Summit at Fountain Square** downtown (Sat, 6/20, 4:00 p.m.)...scheduled to attend **Saturday's** luncheon are Beacon of Change winner **Muhammad Ali**, Beacon of Hope winner **Bill Cosby** and Beacon of Life winner **Hank Aaron**...Beacon Award presenters include **Sugar Ray Leonard** (Ali), Hall of Fame pitcher **Bob Gibson** (Cosby) and **Commissioner Allan H. (Bud) Selig** (Aaron)...Grammy Award-winning gospel artist **BeBe Winans** will perform at the luncheon and at that night's game...former **President Bill Clinton** will be the keynote speaker at the luncheon...for more information, log on to [www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame](http://www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame).

**TODAY'S GAME:** Is **Game 3** (0-2) of a 3-game series vs **Steve Stewart's** Royals and **Game 6** (2-3) of a 6-game road trip that also included a visit to **Wsh** (2-1)...is **Game 16** (5-10) of a stretch in which the Reds will play 13-16g on the road (0-3 at Mil, 2-2 at StL, 1-2 vs **Cubs**, 2-1 at Wsh, **0-2 at KC**)...following tomorrow's off day the Reds begin a 6-game homestand vs the **Braves** and **White Sox**.

**INTERLEAGUE PLAY:** In its 13th season, interleague play continues for the Reds this weekend...Cin is **2-3 vs the American League** so far this season...went **2-1 vs Cle** in May at Great American Ball Park and also will host the **White Sox** during the upcoming **Gillette Civil Rights Game** weekend...Cin's interleague travel schedule includes visits to **KC** (0-2), to **Tor** (6/23-6/25) and to **Cle** (6/26-6/28)...the Reds are **79-98 (.446) all-time** vs American League teams...their all-time results vs American League teams can be found on page 351 of the media guide.

**TOP PICK:** With the eighth pick overall, the Reds selected Arizona State University junior **RHP Mike Leake** in the first round of the 2009 first-year player draft...**Leake**, 21, this season went 16-1, 1.36 to help lead the Sun Devils to the upcoming College World Series...his 40 career wins at ASU are the most in school history...is a finalist for the **Golden Spikes Award** and the College Baseball Foundation's **Pitcher of the Year Award**...the lists of Cin's 2008 draft picks and No. 1 draft picks are on pages **212-213** of the media guide...**OF Jay Bruce** is the only first-round pick currently on the Reds' roster (2005 by Cin, 12th overall)...all draft information can be found at [reds.com](http://reds.com).

**MORE DRAFT TIDBITS:** Seven of the 31 players who have played for the Reds this season were drafted by the organization, including **1B Joey Votto** (2002, 2nd round), **OF Chris Dickerson** (2003, 16th round), **RHP Homer Bailey** (2004, 7th overall), **IF Paul Janish** (2004, 5th round), **OF Jay Bruce** (2005, 12th overall), **RHP Carlos Fisher** (2005, 11th round), **IF Adam Rosales** (2005, 12th round).

**M\*A\*S\*H:** From the **Opening Day** roster the Reds are missing starters **1B Joey Votto** and **3B Edwin Encarnacion** along with starting **RHP Edinson Volquez**...all are on the disabled list...several other players missed action recently because of various ailments, including **2B Brandon Phillips** (hairline fracture, tip of right thumb), **SS Alex Gonzalez** (strained left oblique muscle), **Willy Taveras** (tight right hamstring) and **IF/OF Jerry Hairston Jr.** (flu).

**SOUTHPAW:** **Matt Maloney** is the only **lefthander** to start for the Reds this season and when he made his debut on 6/6 vs Chi became only the second LH Reds starter in a span of **236 games**...in **2008**, righthanded pitchers started Cin's first 161 games until **Adam Pettyjohn** took the hill for the season finale...**Pettyjohn's start** snapped a streak of **180 consecutive starts** by Reds righthanders...according to **Elias Sports Bureau**, prior to **Maloney's** appearance on 6/6 vs Cubs only the Reds, Padres and Cardinals had not started a lefthanded pitcher this season.

**ZEROES:** The Reds produced their **6 shutouts** in the first **26g**, their fastest to 6 blankings since the **1914 staff** threw its sixth shutout in the **25th** game...Cin produced 6 team shutouts all of last season.

**REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (14-14, .500):** The Reds went **3-5-2 in their 10 home series** and produced a winning record on just 2 of their 5 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3, 1-2)...at 14-13 & 13-12 their record at home was above .500...in 7 seasons at GABP are **255-259-1**.

**REDS ON THE ROAD (17-16, .515):** The Reds are **0-2** this series and **2-3** on this road trip...went **6-3-2 in their 11 road series**, including this one...produced winning records on each of their first 2 road trips (7-3, 3-2), a .500 record on the third trip (3-3) and a losing record in their most recent road trip (2-5)...entering this season and dating to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

**IN THE STANDINGS (69):** The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 34, FOURTH - 21, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...at **20-14** and again at **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g over .500** at **36-24**...have spent **57** days above, **5** days at and **7** days below .500.

**REDS vs ROYALS:** Reds are **7-6 all-time vs the Royals**, including 0-2 here this season, 2-1 in 2006 at Great American Ball Park, 3-0 in 1999 at Kauffman Stadium, 0-2 in 1998 at Cinergy Field and 2-1 in 1997 at Cinergy...the Reds' only previous appearance at Kauffman Stadium, a 3-game sweep here in June 1999, was their first appearance in Kansas City since the Red Stockings and Cowboys of the American Association met in 1889.

**REDS vs BRAVES:** The Reds are 1,070-963 all-time vs the Braves franchise, including 1-2 this season...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 15-11, including 1-2 this season...won 7 of the last 9g vs the Braves at GABP.

**Last Pitched:** Tue at Wsh and earned the 3-2 victory (7ip, 4h, 1er, 4bb, 5k, 1hr, 111 pitches, 66 strikes)...allowed only a solo HR to Dukes with 1 out in the fourth inning...threw 27 of his 111 pitches in the first inning, when he walked 2 batters and stranded 3 baserunners.

**Red Hots:** The 23-year-old righthander is making his 13th start of the season, the 44th start of his career and his first career appearance vs the Royals...ranks among the National League leaders with a 2.33era and a .210 opponents' batting average...in his 12 starts the Reds went 8-4 and scored 50 runs (4.17 r/g)...leads the team with 9 quality starts, all in his last 10 apps and including 4 straight...his string of 5 consecutive QS from 4/22-5/13 was the longest stretch of quality starts by a Reds pitcher this season...last year, **Edinson Volquez** produced a string of 12 straight QS (4/22-6/20)...on 4/22 at Chi singled twice off Ted Lilly for his first career 2-hit game.

**Streaking I:** In 5 starts from 4/22-5/13 went **4-0, 1.25** (36ip, 5er)...the 4-game winning streak was the longest of his career...allowed 4 earned runs in his first start of the season (6ip) and 17 earned runs in his last 11 starts (75ip, 1.322era).

**Streaking II:** In each of 4 starts from 4/22-5/8 threw at least 7.0 innings while allowing no more than 1 run, the longest streak of that kind by a Reds pitcher since **Tim Belcher** had a 4-game run from **5/27-6/13, 1992** (courtesy Elias Sports Bureau).

**World Baseball Classic:** Started the Dominican Republic's second game of the tournament and threw 4.2 scoreless innings to earn the 9-0 win vs Panama in the San Juan bracket (4.2ip, 3h, 1bb, 5k).

**Career Highs:** **Innings:** 8.0, 5/3/09 at Pit (longest) & 1.2 (shortest), 4/29/08 at StL; **Hits:** 9 (2x), 5/27/08 vs Pit & 8/8/08 vs Hou; **Runs:** 7, 4/29/08 at StL; **Earned Runs:** 6 (4x), last on 7/17/08 vs NYM; **Walks:** 8, 6/11/08 vs StL; **Strikeouts:** 10 (2x), 4/3/08 vs Ari (ML debut) & 7/22/08 vs SD; **HR allowed:** 3, 5/16/08 vs Cle (Blake & Hafner, Peralta).

**Cueto's Most Recent Starts:** **5/3 at Pit**, in the 5-0 victory threw 8.0 shutout innings in the best start of his young career (4h, 1bb, 9k, 109 pitches, 68 strikes)...the 8.0 innings are a career high...allowed only 4 singles...**5/8 vs StL** and earned the 6-4 victory (7ip, 5h, 1er, 2bb, 3k, 98 pitches, 67 strikes)...left leading, 6-1...allowed only a run-scoring GIDP by Thurston in the seventh inning, snapping his career-high scoreless streak at 15 innings...**5/13 at Ari** and earned the 10-3 victory (7ip, 4h, 3er, 2bb, 4k, 2hr, 100 pitches, 67 strikes)...in the first inning allowed a solo HR to Gerardo Parra in Parra's first career plate appearance, followed by a walk to Justin Upton...then retired 12 consecutive batters until Chad Tracy walked with 1 out in the fifth...after Parra's HR didn't allow another hit until Upton doubled with 2 outs in the sixth, followed by Stephen Drew's RBI-single...with 2 outs in the seventh inning allowed a solo HR to Ojeda, his first homer since 6/15/07 at Bal (410ab)...as a batter, led off the third inning with his second bunt single of the season to spark a 3-run rally...**5/19 vs Phi** and suffered the 4-3 loss (7ip, 7h, 4er, 0bb, 4k, 1hr, 112 pitches, 68 strikes)...in the second inning allowed a solo HR to Howard...allowed 3 runs in the fifth on Rollins' RBI-double, Utley's RBI-single and a sac fly by Ibanez...**5/24 vs Cle** and received no decision in the 11-inning, 4-3 victory (7ip, 6h, 3r, 2er, 3bb, 7k, 2hhp, 1wp, 111 pitches, 67 strikeouts)...left with the score tied, 3-3...allowed all 3 runs with 2 outs...in the fourth inning gave up a run-scoring double to Luis Valbuena...in the seventh allowed an RBI-triple to Grady Sizemore, who then scored on the play after obstruction was called on 3B Adam Rosales...**5/29 at Mil** and suffered the 3-2 loss (7ip, 3h, 3er, 4bb, 3k, 2hr, 104 pitches, 64 strikes)...left trailing, 3-2...allowed just 3 hits, but 2 of the hits were home runs that produced all 3 Brewers runs...in the first inning retired the first 2 batters but then walked Braun and allowed a 2-run HR to Fielder...Hart homered leading off the Brewers' seventh...**6/3 at StL** and earned the 9-3 win (6.1ip, 7h, 1er, 0bb, 3k, 101 pitches, 69 strikes)...left leading, 4-1...allowed his only run on consecutive doubles by Rasmus and Ryan in the seventh inning.

## Tuesday vs Braves: RHP Aaron Harang

**Last Started:** Wed at Wsh, threw 7.2 scoreless innings but was a victim of a blown save in the 12-inning, 4-2 win (5h, 3bb, 2k, 123 pitches, 76 strikes)...left leading, 2-0, but the Nationals tied it with 2 runs in the ninth off Cordero...the game was delayed by rain with nobody out and a runner on first base in the bottom of the ninth inning...Cordero, who walked the leadoff hitter of the inning, returned after a 2-hour, 10-minute delay and suffered his first blown save since July of last season.

**Red Hots:** On Tue vs Atl will make his 14th start of the season...in his previous 13 starts the Reds went 6-7 and scored 49 runs (3.77 r/g)...in his 13 starts **Reds batters** hit .240 (104-433)...on 6/4 at StL suffered the 3-1 loss in a game in which **Harang** and **Chris Carpenter** each threw complete games.

**Home Cookin':** Is **4-2, 2.84** (38ip, 12er) in 6 starts at Great American Ball Park and **1-4, 4.47** (46.1ip, 23er) in 7 starts on the road.

**Streaking:** From **4/28-6/4** allowed a home run in 8 consecutive apps (10hr), the longest streak by a Reds pitcher since **RHP Ramon Ortiz** tied the National League record by allowing a home run in **15** consecutive apps from **5/1-7/17, 2005**.

**Milestones:** On 4/23 at Chi recorded the **1,000th strikeout** of his career (**Derrek Lee**)...his 3-hitter in the club's fifth game, a 2-0 win on 4/12 vs Pit, was the quickest complete game by a Reds pitcher since **Pete Harnisch** threw a CG in the Reds' fourth game of **1999**.

**Staff Ace:** Since he was acquired from the Athletics at the **2003 trading deadline** is the Reds' leader in most statistical pitching categories, including starts (180), wins (68), innings pitched (1153.1) and strikeouts (968)...since the beginning of the **2006 season** leads the National League in innings pitched (**734.2**)...in 2005 and 2007 won the BBWAA's Johnny Vander Meer Award as the club's Most Outstanding Pitcher.
