Last night the Reds and Braves played only the **38th homerless game** in the **516-game** history of Great American Ball Park...there have been 2 homerless games this season (other, 4/29 vs Hou) and 3 involving the Braves (others, 4/22/04 & 5/3/08)...only once in the ballpark's 7-year existence has there been a streak of **2 straight games** without a home run by either team (8/6-8/7, 2005 vs Fla).

As part of this weekend's **Gillette Civil Rights Game** festivities, boxing legend **Sugar Ray Leonard** will give a motivational speech following Friday night's game, just prior to the fireworks show...30 lucky fans will watch the fireworks with Leonard in the visitors' dugout...on Sunday, Leonard will answer questions from fans from 12:30 to 12:50 p.m. in the **Fan Zone**...on Saturday, the Reds and White Sox will wear uniform jerseys circa **1964**, the year the **Civil Rights Act** was passed to outlaw racial segregation in schools, public places and employment...that piece of legislature also created the **Equal Opportunity Employment Commission**.

At Great American Ball Park on **Saturday** (7:40 first pitch) the Reds and Chicago White Sox will meet in the **Gillette Civil Rights Game**, the first time the contest will be played during the regular season...the weekend's festivities will include a roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's **Harriet Tubman Theater** (Friday, 4:00 p.m.), a luncheon at **Duke Energy Center** honoring the 3 winners of Major League Baseball's **Beacon Awards** (Saturday, 11:30 a.m.) and a **Youth Summit** at **Fountain Square** downtown (Saturday, 4:00 p.m.)...more information on each event is below...the **Gillette Civil Rights Game** and ancillary events were developed to pay tribute to those who fought on and off the field for equal rights...log on to [www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame](http://www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame).

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** Is **Game 2** (1-0) of a 3-game series vs **Brad Hainje's** Braves and **Game 2** (1-0) of a 6-game homestand that includes the upcoming **Gillette Civil Rights Game** weekend series vs the **White Sox**...during pre-game ceremonies tonight the Reds will salute fans for their contributions to the recent **St. Vincent de Paul** canned food drive...more than **20,000 pounds of food** was collected, enough to feed **7,000 people** for a day...NEWS 5 meteorologist **Valerie Abati** and Reds pitcher **Micah Owings** co-chaired the food drive, which was held 6/5-6/7.

**FRIDAY'S ROUND TABLE:** The panelists for Friday's 4:00 p.m. **Baseball and the Civil Rights Movement** roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's **Harriet Tubman Theater** are Hall of Famer **Tony Perez**, NBA Hall of Famer **Oscar Robertson**, former All-Star and current MLB Network analyst **Harold Reynolds**, academic **Richard Lapchick**, author **Lee Lowenfish**, Judge **Nathaniel Jones** and columnist **James Clingman Jr.**... Harvard Law School professor and renowned expert on race and justice **Charles Ogletree** will moderate a discussion of the pivotal role baseball played in the **Civil Rights Movement** and its continued presence as a social institution in American society...the roundtable is open to the public and will be streamed live on [MLB.com](http://MLB.com).

**SATURDAY'S LUNCHEON:** Scheduled to attend **Saturday's** luncheon at **Duke Energy Center** are Beacon of Change winner **Muhammad Ali**, Beacon of Hope winner **Bill Cosby** and Beacon of Life winner **Hank Aaron**...all 3 winners previously were awarded the **Presidential Medal of Freedom**, our country's highest civilian honor...Beacon Award presenters include **Sugar Ray Leonard** (Ali), Hall of Fame pitcher **Bob Gibson** (Cosby) and **Commissioner Allan H. (Bud) Selig** (Aaron)...Grammy Award-winning gospel artist **BeBe Winans** will perform at the luncheon and at that night's game...former **President Bill Clinton** will be the keynote speaker at the luncheon.

**WANNA PLAY?:** At Saturday afternoon's **Youth Summit** at Fountain Square (2:00 to 7:00 p.m.), Major League Baseball will launch **Wanna Play?**, a new program intended to boost efforts to reach the African-American community with a youth-oriented, experiential event...**admission is free**...activities include batting and pitching cages, baserunning contests, wiffle ball games and demonstrations with Reds players **Brandon Phillips** and **Jerry Hairston Jr.**, Reds Hall of Famer **Eric Davis** and former All-Star and current MLB Network analyst **Harold Reynolds**...at 4:00 p.m., there will be a Q&A session with *Cory in the House* star **Kyle Massey**, *Zoey 101* star **Christopher Massey**, country music artist **Rissi Palmer**, *Journey to the Center of the Earth* star **Josh Hutcherson** and **Davis**.

**M\*A\*S\*H:** From the **Opening Day** roster the Reds are missing starters **1B Joey Votto** and **3B Edwin Encarnacion** along with starting **RHP Edinson Volquez**...all are on the disabled list...several other players missed action recently because of various ailments, including **2B Brandon Phillips** (hairline fracture, tip of right thumb), **SS Alex Gonzalez** (strained left oblique muscle), **Willy Taveras** (tight right hamstring) and **IF/OF Jerry Hairston Jr.** (flu).

**SOUTHPAW:** **Matt Maloney** is the only **lefthander** to start for the Reds this season and when he made his debut on 6/6 vs Chi became only the second LH Reds starter in a span of **236 games**...in **2008**, righthanded pitchers started Cin's first 161 games until **Adam Pettyjohn** took the hill for the season finale...**Pettyjohn's start** snapped a streak of **180 consecutive starts** by Reds righthanders...according to **Elias Sports Bureau**, prior to **Maloney's** appearance on 6/6 vs Cubs only the Reds, Padres and Cardinals had not started a lefthanded pitcher this season.

**REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (15-14, .517):** The Reds went **3-5-2 in their previous 10 home series** and produced a winning record on just 2 of their previous 5 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3, 1-2)...at 14-13 & 13-12 their record at home was above .500...in 7 seasons at GABP are **256-259-1**...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38).

**REDS ON THE ROAD (17-17, .500):** The Reds went **6-3-2 in their 11 road series**...produced winning records on each of their first 2 road trips (7-3, 3-2), a .500 record on the third trip (3-3) and losing records on each of their last 2 road trips (2-5, 2-4)...entering this season and dating to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

**IN THE STANDINGS (72):** The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 35, FOURTH - 23, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...at **20-14** and again at **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g over .500** at **36-24**...have spent **58 days above, 7 days at and 7 days below .500**.

**REDS vs BRAVES:** The Reds are 1,071-963 all-time vs the Braves franchise, including 2-2 this season...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 16-11, including 2-2 this season...won 8 of the last 10g vs the Braves at GABP...**last Reds sweep:** at Cin: 9/28-9/29, 1987 (2g); 5/30-6/1, 2008 (3g); 4/9-4/13, 1980 (4g).

**Last Started:** Thu at Wsh and was the victim of a blown save in the 3-2 loss (5.1ip, 4h, 1er, 4bb, 4k, 2hbp, 1wp, 102 pitches, 56 strikes)...left leading, 2-0, but was charged with a run scored off Burton...the Nats took a 3-2 lead with a 2-run eighth inning off Fisher, Herrera and Masset...through 5 scoreless innings allowed 2 hits, 4 walks and 2hbp but stranded all 8 baserunners.

**Red Hots:** Is making his 12th start of the season, his sixth start since an emergency relief appearance on 5/16 at SD...his current **4-game losing streak** is the longest by a Reds pitcher this season...in his previous 11 starts the Reds went 4-6 and scored 44 runs (4 r/g)...has 3 quality starts...with an 8-2 win on 4/26 vs Atl snapped his **9-game losing streak** dating back to a 9-3 Diamondbacks victory on 5/25/08 at Atl...in 14 apps and 10 starts between victories went **0-9, 8.53**.

**In Relief:** Made his only relief appearance of the season in the 16-inning, 6-5 loss at SD on 5/16...threw a career-high 5.2 innings in relief (3h, 1er, 3bb, 5k, 1hr, 81 pitches, 44 strikes)...entered the game in the 11th inning as the Reds' seventh and final pitcher...retired his first 10 batters until Scott Hairston singled with 1 out in the 14th inning...Nick Hundley homered to end the 5-hour, 14 minute struggle...**in 5 starts since then is 0-3, 5.76 (25ip, 16er)**.

**At The Plate:** In 2007 won the National League's **Silver Slugger Award** (.333, 4hr, 15rbi)...has **6 career home runs**, including **1 this season** (5/10 vs StL, pinch-hit solo off **Ryan Franklin**)...his 5 career home runs prior to 2009 are listed on **page 149** of the media guide...on 5/7 vs Mil produced the first triple by a Reds pitcher since **Eric Milton** did it on 4/13/06 at Cubs.

**Career Highs:** **Innings** : 9.0 (2x), 5/24/07 vs Hou & 9/18/07 vs SF; **Hits:** 10, vs 5/2/08 vs NYM; **Runs:** 8, 7/28/08 at SD; **Earned Runs:** 8, 7/28/08 at SD; **Walks:** 5, 7/9/08 at Wsh; **Strikeouts:** 10, 5/20/08 at Fla; **HR allowed:** 4, 9/3/07 vs SD.

**Owings' Most Recent Starts:** **4/21 at Chi**, in the Reds' first game of the season at Wrigley Field and suffered the 7-2 loss (4.2ip, 5h, 5r, 2er, 4bb, 3k, 1hr, 94 pitches, 61 strikes)...left trailing, 4-2, but was charged with another run scored off Lincoln...in the second inning allowed a leadoff HR to Micah Hoffpauir...in the fifth was charged with 3 unearned runs...start of the game was delayed 12 minutes by weather...gametime temperature was 40 degrees with a 15 mile per hour wind blowing left to right...**4/26 vs Atl** and earned the 8-2 victory (7ip, 6h, 1er, 3bb, 6k, 1hr, 102 pitches, 60 strikes)...left leading, 8-1...allowed only a solo HR to David Ross with 1 out in the seventh inning...his first victory since May 2008 snapped a personal 9-game losing streak...**5/2 at Pit** and suffered the 8-6 loss (5.2ip, 9h, 5er, 2bb, 0k, 99 pitches, 64 strikes)...left trailing, 5-3...in the first inning allowed 4 runs on 4 hits, 1 walk and 1 hit batter...**5/7 vs Mil** and earned the 6-5 victory (6ip, 7h, 5r, 4er, 1bb, 4k, 100 pitches, 67 strikes)...left leading, 6-5...allowed 3 runs in the fourth inning and 2 runs in the sixth...his RBI-triple in the bottom of the fourth off Braden Loper gave the Reds a 4-3 lead they would not relinquish...**5/12 at Ari**, in his first career appearance vs his former team earned the 3-1 victory (7+ip, 4h, 1er, 2bb, 4k, 1hbp, 90 pitches, 53 strikes)...took a 4-hit shutout into the eighth inning but then hit with a pitch leadoff batter Ryan Roberts...was charged with that run, which scored on Felipe Lopez' RBI-double off Arthur Rhodes...**5/21 vs Phi** and suffered the 12-5 loss (3ip, 6h, 5er, 3bb, 3k, 1hr, 71 pitches, 41 strikes)...left trailing, 5-0...allowed 1 run in the first inning, 3 runs in the second and a solo HR to Dobbs in the third...**5/26 vs Hou** and received no decision in the 6-4 victory (5ip, 6h, 3er, 4bb, 3k, 99 pitches, 62 strikes)...allowed all 3 runs in the fourth inning on a 2-run double by Rodriguez and a run-scoring single by Maysonet...**5/31 at Mil** and suffered the 5-2 loss (5.2ip, 8h, 5er, 3bb, 5k, 1hr, 103 pitches, 67 strikes)...left trailing, 5-2, but retired 10 of his 11 final batters...in the first inning allowed consecutive 2-out, RBI-singles to Cameron and Gamel...in the second allowed a sac fly to Hardy...in the third allowed Cameron's 2-run HR...**6/5 vs Cubs** and suffered the 2-1 loss (6ip, 5h, 2er, 3bb, 6k, 1hr, 98 pitches, 64 strikes)...left trailing, 2-0...allowed only a bases-loaded walk to Fontenot in the first inning and a solo HR to Zambrano in the fifth.

## Tomorrow's Pitcher: LHP Matt Maloney

**Last Pitched:** Fri at KC, in his second career start suffered the 4-1 loss (6ip, 6h, 4er, 2bb, 5k, 2hr, 104 pitches, 63 strikes)...left trailing, 4-1...allowed a solo HR to Butler in the first inning, an RBI-single to DeJesus in the fifth and a 2-run HR to Callaspo in the sixth...Hochevar threw his first career complete game (3h, 80 pitches, 57 strikes)...length of game was 2:12.

**Red Hots:** The 25-year-old lefthander tomorrow will make his third career start...in his previous 2 starts the Reds went 1-1 and scored 5 runs (2.5 r/g)...has 1 quality start...on 6/6 vs Cubs made his Major League debut after 99 minor league apps and 98 minor league starts...was born in **Sandusky, Ohio** and lives in **Columbus**...graduated from **Huron (OH) High School**...his media guide bio is on page 135.

**Major League Debut:** On 6/6 vs Cubs, in his Major League debut was the victim of a blown save in the 11-inning, 4-3 victory (6+ip, 6h, 2er, 1bb, 4k, 1hbp, 2hr, 89 pitches, 58 strikes)...left leading, 3-2, but the Cubs tied it in the eighth inning with a run off Weathers...allowed both runs on solo homers, by Scales with 2 outs in the fourth inning and by Geovany Soto leading off the seventh...stranded 4 baserunners, all in the first 2 innings...first career strikeout victim was Ryan Dempster...singled off Dempster in his first career plate appearance...pitched in front of a sellout crowd...was the second Reds player to make a Major League debut this season (**RHP Carlos Fisher**).

**Southpaw:** When he debuted became the first **lefthander** to start for the Reds this season and only the second LHP starter in a stretch of **236 games**...in 2008, righthanders started Cin's first 161 games until **Adam Pettyjohn** took the hill for the season finale...**Pettyjohn's start** snapped a streak of **180 consecutive starts** by Reds righthanders...according to **Elias Sports Bureau**, prior to **Maloney's debut** only the Reds, Padres and Cardinals had not started a lefthanded pitcher this season.

**With The Bats:** Began the season with Louisville and in 10 starts there went 4-3, 2.00 before he was recalled on 6/6 to start against the Cubs...when promoted led the Bats' staff in starts (10, tied with **Homer Bailey**), innings pitched (67.1) and strikeouts (58)...in his last 5 starts for Louisville went 2-2, 0.73 (37ip, 3er)...was the organization's Minor League Pitcher of the Month for April (3gs, 2-0, 1.86).
