Senior Pastor Reverend **Donald Dixon** of Hyde Park Community United Methodist Church and Pastor **Damon Lynch Jr.** of the New Jerusalem Baptist Church serve as honorary captains of Saturday night's **Gillette Civil Rights Game**...they will be honored because of their life-long commitments to civil rights and equality...**Rev. Dixon** retires this summer after a 46-year career as a minister...**Rev. Lynch** has spent 39 years as a Cincinnati pastor and is a founding member and the presiding co-chair of the board of directors of the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center.

At Great American Ball Park on **Saturday** (7:40 first pitch) the Reds and Chicago White Sox will meet in the **Gillette Civil Rights Game**, the first time the contest will be played during the regular season...the weekend's festivities will include a roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's **Harriet Tubman Theater** (Friday, 4:00 p.m.), a luncheon at **Duke Energy Center** honoring the 3 winners of Major League Baseball's **Beacon Awards** (Saturday, 11:30 a.m.) and a **Youth Summit** at **Fountain Square** downtown (Saturday, 4:00 p.m.)...more information on each event is below...the **Gillette Civil Rights Game** and ancillary events were developed to pay tribute to those who fought on and off the field for equal rights...log on to www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame.

TODAY'S GAME: Is **Game 3** (2-0) of a 3-game series vs **Brad Hainje's** Braves and **Game 3** (2-0) of a 6-game homestand that includes the upcoming **Gillette Civil Rights Game** weekend series vs the **White Sox**.

INTERLEAGUE PLAY: In its 13th season, interleague play continues for the Reds this weekend against the White Sox...Cin is **2-4 vs the American League** so far this season (2-1 vs Cle, 0-3 at KC)...beginning tomorrow will face AL teams in 9 straight games (3g vs WSox, 3g at Tor, 3g at Cle)...the Reds are **79-98 (.446) all-time** vs American League teams...their all-time results vs American League teams can be found on page 351 of the media guide.

HAIRSTON'S HEROES: This afternoon **Jerry Hairston Jr.** is hosting from **Project Connect** 30 fans in sun deck Section 143 as part of his **Hairston's Heroes** program targeting underprivileged children...the kids will receive an autographed t-shirt, while the entire group receives \$10 in concession vouchers and in-stadium welcomes via the public address announcer and scoreboard.

TOMORROW'S ROUND TABLE: The panelists for tomorrow's 4:00 p.m. **Baseball and the Civil Rights Movement** roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's **Harriet Tubman Theater** are Hall of Famer **Tony Perez**, NBA Hall of Famer **Oscar Robertson**, former All-Star and current MLB Network analyst **Harold Reynolds**, academic **Richard Lapchick**, author **Lee Lowenfish**, Judge **Nathaniel Jones** and columnist **James Clingman Jr.**...Harvard Law School professor and renowned expert on race and justice **Charles Ogletree** will moderate a discussion of the pivotal role baseball played in the **Civil Rights Movement** and its continued presence as a social institution in American society...the roundtable is open to the public and will be streamed live on MLB.com.

SATURDAY'S LUNCHEON: Scheduled to attend **Saturday's** luncheon at **Duke Energy Center** are Beacon of Change winner **Muhammad Ali**, Beacon of Hope winner **Bill Cosby** and Beacon of Life winner **Hank Aaron**...all 3 winners previously were awarded the **Presidential Medal of Freedom**, our country's highest civilian honor...Beacon Award presenters include **Sugar Ray Leonard** (Ali), Hall of Fame pitcher **Bob Gibson** (Cosby) and **Commissioner Allan H. (Bud) Selig** (Aaron)...Grammy Award-winning gospel artist **BeBe Winans** will perform at the luncheon and at that night's game...former **President Bill Clinton** will be the keynote speaker at the luncheon.

WANNA PLAY?: At Saturday afternoon's **Youth Summit** at Fountain Square (2:00 to 7:00 p.m.), Major League Baseball will launch **Wanna Play?**, a new program intended to boost efforts to reach the African-American community with a youth-oriented, experiential event...**admission is free**...activities include batting and pitching cages, baserunning contests, wiffle ball games and demonstrations with Reds players **Brandon Phillips** and **Jerry Hairston Jr.**, Reds Hall of Famer **Eric Davis** and former All-Star and current MLB Network analyst **Harold Reynolds**...at 4:00 p.m., there will be a Q&A session with *Cory in the House* star **Kyle Massey**, *Zoey 101* star **Christopher Massey**, country music artist **Rissi Palmer**, *Journey to the Center of the Earth* star **Josh Hutcherson** and **Davis**.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (16-14, .533): Including this one the Reds have gone **4-5-2 in their 11 home series** and produced a winning record on 2 of their previous 5 completed homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3, 1-2)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **257-259-1**...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38).

REDS ON THE ROAD (17-17, .500): The Reds went **6-3-2 in their 11 road series**...produced winning records on each of their first 2 road trips (7-3, 3-2), a .500 record on the third trip (3-3) and losing records on each of their last 2 road trips (2-5, 2-4)...entering this season and dating to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

IN THE STANDINGS (73): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 36, FOURTH - 23, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...at **20-14** and again at **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g over .500** at **36-24**...have spent **59** days above, **7** days at and **7** days below .500.

REDS vs BRAVES: The Reds are 1,072-963 all-time vs the Braves franchise, including 3-2 this season...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 17-11, including 3-2 this season...won 9 of the last 11g vs the Braves at GABP...**last Reds sweep:** at Cin: 9/28-9/29, 1987 (2g); 5/30-6/1, 2008 (3g); 4/9-4/13, 1980 (4g).

UP NEXT: REDS vs WHITE SOX: Reds are 2-12 all-time vs the White Sox, including 0-3 in 2006 at Great American Ball Park, 0-3 in 2001 at Comiskey Park, 0-3 in 2000 at Cinergy Field, 1-1 in 1998 at Comiskey Park and 1-2 in 1997 at Cinergy Field...Chi's 3-1 victory on 6/13/97 was the first interleague game ever for both clubs...that loss snapped Cin's 9-game winning streak vs American League teams, dating back to the 1975 World Series...WSox have won the last 9g and swept the last 3 series...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 0-3...went 1-5 vs ChiA at Cinergy Field.

IF Paul Janish pitched in the ninth inning of the 15-3 loss vs Mil on 5/6 (1ip, 5h, 5er, 0bb, 2k, Fielder 2-run HR)...he became the first Reds position player to pitch since Lenny Harris on 6/1/98 at SF.				

Reds Pitchers: Rank fourth in the National League with a 3.85 team ERA...**on the homestand are 2-0, 2.50 (18ip, 5er)**...in the last 6g are 2-4, 3.78 (50ip, 21er)...in the last 13g are 6-7, 2.95 (122ip, 40er)...have 6 team shutouts...had 6 shutouts all last season...with a 7-0 win on 5/5 at Fla reached 6 shutouts in their 26th game, their fastest to 6 team shutouts since the 1914 Reds threw their sixth shutout in their 25th game.

Reds Starters: Rank sixth in the National League with 4.08 rotation ERA...**on the homestand are 1-0, 2.25 (8ip, 2er)**...in the last 13g are 4-5, 2.64 (78.1ip, 23er)...have produced 32 quality starts (**Cueto 10, Arroyo 7, Harang 7, Owings 4, Volquez 3, Maloney 1**)...the Reds went 24-8 in those quality starts (.750)...from 6/3-6/10 produced a season-high 7 consecutive quality starts, their best stretch since they threw 8 consecutive QS from **8/6-8/14, 2005**...through the first 41g of the season used just 5 starting pitchers, their longest such streak to begin a year since **RHP John Roper** became the staff's **sixth** different starter in the **42nd game of the 1994 campaign**...on 5/23 vs Cle, in the club's 42nd game, **RHP Homer Bailey** became the Reds' sixth starting pitcher...**Aaron Harang** threw a 3-hitter in the 2-0 win vs Pit in the club's fifth game of the season...was the earliest complete game by a Reds pitcher since **Pete Harnisch** beat the Cardinals, 3-0 in Busch Stadium, in the **fourth** contest of the **1999** campaign.

Reds Relievers: Rank third in the National League with a 3.38 bullpen ERA...**on the homestand are 1-0, 2.70 (10ip, 3er)**...in their last 54g have posted a 2.62era (171.2ip, 52er) and in their last 42g have posted a 2.61era (137.2ip, 40er)...the previous note does not include the pitching performance by IF Paul Janish in the ninth inning of the 15-3 loss on 5/6 vs Mil (1ip, 5er)...had 1 blown save in their first 51g and then 3 blown saves in their next 5g...didn't blow a save until the club's 36th game, a 6-5 loss in 16 innings on 5/16 at SD...for the second straight season the Reds' bullpen was the last in the Major League to suffer a blown save...in 2008 didn't blow a save until the 41st game (5/14)...over the last 2 seasons **Francisco Cordero** has recorded **50** of the bullpen's **51** saves (34sv in 2008, 16sv in 2009)...**David Weathers** has the only other save the last 2 seasons (6/10/09 at Wsh).

Ranks among the National League leaders in saves...converted 16 of his 17 save opps...in the 12-inning, 4-2 win on 6/10 at Wsh suffered his first blown save since 7/21/08 vs SD...had converted 29 consecutive save chances, including all 15 save opps this year...including last season has recorded 50 of the bullpen's last 51 saves (34sv in 2008, 16sv in 2009, Weathers 1sv in 2009)...in his last 21 apps has posted a 1.29era (21ip, 3er)...with 227 career saves ranks 30th on that all-time list...Ugeth Urbina is 29th with 237 saves...in the 3-0 victory on 4/22 at Chi recorded his 100th save in the National League to become only the 11th pitcher in history with at least 100 saves in each league (see box below).
