Dixon retires this summer after a 46-year career as a minister...Rev. Lynch has spent 39 years as a Cincinnati pastor and is a founding member and the presiding co-chair of the board of directors of the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center.

At Great American Ball Park on Saturday (7:40 first pitch) the Reds and Chicago White Sox will meet in the Gillette Civil Rights Game, the first time the contest will be played during the regular season...the weekend's festivities will include a roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's Harriet Tubman Theater (Friday, 4:00 p.m.), a luncheon at **Duke Energy Center** honoring the 3 winners of Major League Baseball's **Beacon** Awards (Saturday, 11:30 a.m.) and a Youth Summit at Fountain Square downtown (Saturday, 4:00 p.m.)...more information on each event is below...the Gillette Civil Rights Game and ancillary events were developed to pay tribute to those who fought on and off the field for equal rights...log on to www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame.

TODAY'S GAME: Is Game 3 (2-0) of a 3-game series vs Brad Hainje's Braves and Game 3 (2-0) of a 6-game homestand that includes the upcoming Gillette Civil Rights Game weekend series vs the White Sox.

INTERLEAGUE PLAY: In its 13th season, interleague play continues for the Reds this weekend against the White Sox...Cin is 2-4 vs the American League so far this season (2-1 vs Cle, 0-3 at KC)...beginning tomorrow will face AL teams in 9 straight games (3g vs WSox, 3g at Tor, 3g at Cle)...the Reds are **79-98 (.446) all-time** vs American League teams...their all-time results vs American League teams can be found on page 351 of the media guide.

HAIRSTON'S HEROES: This afternoon Jerry Hairston Jr. is hosting from Project Connect 30 fans in sun deck Section 143 as part of his Hairston's Heroes program targeting underprivileged children...the kids will receive an autographed t-shirt, while the entire group receives \$10 in concession vouchers and in-stadium welcomes via the public address announcer and scoreboard.

TOMORROW'S ROUND TABLE: The panelists for tomorrow's 4:00 p.m. Baseball and the Civil Rights Movement roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's Harriet Tubman Theater are Hall of Famer Tony Perez, NBA Hall of Famer Oscar Robertson, former All-Star and current MLB Network analyst Harold Reynolds, academic Richard Lapchick, author Lee Lowenfish, Judge Nathaniel Jones and columnist James Clingman Jr....Harvard Law School professor and renowned expert on race and justice Charles Ogletree will moderate a discussion of the pivotal role baseball played in the Civil Rights Movement and its continued presence as a social institution in American society...the roundtable is open to the public and will be streamed live on MLB.com.

SATURDAY'S LUNCHEON: Scheduled to attend Saturday's luncheon at Duke Energy Center are Beacon of Change winner Muhammad Ali, Beacon of Hope winner Bill Cosby and Beacon of Life winner Hank Aaron...all 3 winners previously were awarded the Presidential Medal of Freedom, our country's highest civilian honor...Beacon Award presenters include Sugar Ray Leonard (Ali), Hall of Fame pitcher Bob Gibson (Cosby) and Commissioner Allan H. (Bud) Selig (Aaron)...Grammy Award-winning gospel artist BeBe Winans will perform at the luncheon and at that night's game...former **President Bill Clinton** will be the keynote speaker at the luncheon.

WANNA PLAY?: At Saturday afternoon's Youth Summit at Fountain Square (2:00 to 7:00 p.m.), Major League Baseball will launch Wanna Play?, a new program intended to boost efforts to reach the African-American community with a youth-oriented, experiential event...admission is free...activities include batting and pitching cages, baserunning contests, wiffle ball games and demonstrations with Reds players Brandon Phillips and Jerry Hairston Jr., Reds Hall of Famer Eric Davis and former All-Star and current MLB Network analyst Harold Reynolds...at 4:00 p.m., there will be a Q&A session with Cory in the House star Kyle Massey, Zoey 101 star Christopher Massey, country music artist Rissi Palmer, Journey to the Center of the Earth star Josh Hutcherson and Davis.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (16-14, .533): Including this one the Reds have gone 4-5-2 in their 11 home series and produced a winning record on 2 of their previous 5 completed homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3, 1-2)... in 7 seasons at GABP are 257-259-1...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38).

REDS ON THE ROAD (17-17, .500): The Reds went 6-3-2 in their 11 road series...produced winning records on each of their first 2 road trips (7-3, 3-2), a .500 record on the third trip (3-3) and losing records on each of their last 2 road trips (2-5, 2-4)...entering this season and dating to 2006, the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous

IN THE STANDINGS (73): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 36, FOURTH - 23, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...at 20-14 and again at 26-20 were a season-high 6g over .500...prior to this season hadn't been 6g over .500 since 2006, when they reached a season-high 12g over .500 at 36-24...have spent 59 days above, 7 days at and 7 days below .500.

REDS vs BRAVES: The Reds are 1,072-963 all-time vs the Braves franchise, including 3-2 this season...at Great American Ball Park: Reds are 17-11, including 3-2 this season...won 9 of the last 11g vs the Braves at GABP...last Reds sweep: at Cin: 9/28-9/29, 1987 (2g); 5/30-6/1, 2008 (3g); 4/9-4/13, 1980 (4g).

UP NEXT: REDS vs WHITE SOX: Reds are 2-12 all-time vs the White Sox, including 0-3 in 2006 at Great American Ball Park, 0-3 in 2001 at Comiskey Park, 0-3 in 2000 at Cinergy Field, 1-1 in 1998 at Comiskey Park and 1-2 in 1997 at Cinergy Field...Chi's 3-1 victory on 6/13/97 was the first interleague game ever for both clubs...that loss snapped Cin's 9-game winning streak vs American League teams, dating back to the 1975 World Series... WSox have won the last 9g and swept the last 3 series...at Great American Ball Park: Reds are 0-3...went 1-5 vs ChiA at Cinergy Field.

Last Pitched: Fri at KC, in his second career start suffered the 4-1 loss (6ip, 6h, 4er, 2bb, 5k, 2hr, 104 pitches, 63 strikes)...left trailing, 4-1.. allowed a solo HR to Butler in the first inning, an RBI-single to DeJesus in the fifth and a 2-run HR to Callaspo in the sixth...KC's Luke Hochevar threw his first career complete game (3h, 80 pitches, 57 strikes)...length of game was 2:12.

Red Hots: The 25-year-old lefthander is making his third career start...in his previous 2 starts the Reds went 1-1 and scored 5 runs (2.5 r/g)...has 1 quality start...on 6/6 vs Cubs made his Major League debut after 99 minor league apps and 98 minor league starts...was born in Sandusky. Ohio and lives in Columbus...graduated from Huron (OH) High School...his media guide bio is on page 135.

Major League Debut: On 6/6 vs Cubs, in his Major League debut was the victim of a blown save in the 11-inning, 4-3 victory (6+ip, 6h, 2er, 1bb, 4k, 1hbp, 2hr, 89 pitches, 58 strikes)...left leading, 3-2, but the Cubs tied it in the eighth inning with a run off Weathers...allowed both runs on solo

homers, by Scales with 2 outs in the fourth inning and by Geovany Soto leading victim was Ryan Dempster...singled off Dempster in his first career plate app

Major League debut this season (RHP Carlos Fisher).

Southpaw: When he debuted became the first lefthander to start for the Re righthanders started Cin's first 161 games until Adam Pettyjohn took the hill by Reds righthanders...according to Elias Sports Bureau, prior to Maloney'

With The Bats: Began the season with Louisville and in 10 starts there went 4-3, 2.00 before he was recalled on 6/6 to start against the Cubs...when promoted led the Bats' staff in starts (10, tied with Homer Bailey), innings pitched (67.1) and strikeouts (58)...in his last 5 starts for Louisville went 2-2, 0.73 (37ip, 3er)...was the organization's Minor League Pitcher of the Month for April (3gs, 2-0, 1.86).

At The Plate: As a batter for Louisville hit .286 (2-7), including a solo home run on 4/17 at Indianapolis off Daniel McCutchen...in his first Major League plate appearance singled off Chi's Ryan Dempster...became first Reds pitcher to record a hit in his first career plate appearance since Scott Randall singled off Kip Wells on 9/18/03 at Pit...in the 6-3 loss vs Cubs on 6/6 pinch hit in the 14th inning and struck out to end the game.

Tomorrow vs WSox: Bronson Arroyo

Last Pitched: Sat at KC and suffered the 7-4 loss (5+ip, 11h, 6er, 2bb, 2k, 1hr, 1hbp, 91 pitches, 56 strikes)...left trailing, 5-3, but was charged with another run scored off Burton...in the second inning allowed 3 runs on an HBP and 4 hits, including Bloomquist's 2-run single and Butler's RBI-single...the Reds tied it with 3 runs in the top of the third, but in the bottom of the inning allowed 2 more runs on 4 more hits.

Red Hots: Tomorrow vs WSox will make his 14th start of the season and his third start of the season vs an American League club...ranks among the National League leaders in victories (7)...in his previous 13 starts the Reds went 7-6 and scored 59 runs (4.54 r/g)...has 7 quality starts...since he was acquired by the Reds prior to the 2006 season leads all Major League pitchers with 116 starts and ranks second in the National League with 733.2 innings pitched (Aaron Harang 1st. 736.2ip).

Short Cuts: Made the 2 shortest starts of his career (1ip, plus 4 batters) in a 14-1 loss at Tor on 6/24/08 and a 15-3 loss on 5/6/09 vs Mil...in between those 2 starts went 15-5, 3.76...since that 6/24/08 loss at Tor still ranks second in the Major Leagues with 18 wins.

In The Big Inning: Allowed at least 1 run in the first inning of 7 of his 13 starts, including each of his last 5 starts...has posted a 9.00era in the first inning (13ip, 13er) and a 4.67era after the first frame (69.1ip, 36er).

<u>Perfect</u>: Began the season 3-0 for the third time in his career but for the first time won his first 3 starts of a season...won his first 2 starts in 2006, when he started off 5-0...began the 2005 campaign 4-0...was the first Reds pitcher to begin the season in the rotation and win his first 3 starts since LHP Pete Schourek did it in 1996 and the first righthander since Jack Armstrong won his first 5 starts of 1990.
