A press conference will be held tomorrow at **5:45 p.m.** in the **field level interview room** at Great American Ball Park... Hall of Famers **Hank Aaron** and **Frank Robinson** and executives from Major League Baseball will be available... tomorrow night's pre-game ceremonies being at **6:50**.

At Great American Ball Park **tomorrow** (7:40 first pitch) the Reds and Chicago White Sox will meet in the **Gillette Civil Rights Game**, the first time the contest will be played during the regular season...the weekend's festivities will include a luncheon tomorrow at **Duke Energy Center** honoring the 3 winners of Major League Baseball's **Beacon Awards**, followed in the afternoon by a **Youth Summit** at **Fountain Square** downtown...a roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's **Harriet Tubman Theater** was held this afternoon...more information on each event is below...the **Gillette Civil Rights Game** and ancillary events were developed to pay tribute to those who fought on and off the field for equal rights... log on to www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is **Game 1** of the 3-game **Gillette Civil Rights Game** weekend series vs **Bob Rosenberg's** White Sox and **Game 4** (2-1) of a 6-game homestand that included Atlanta (2-1)...boxing legend **Sugar Ray Leonard** will give a motivational speech on the field following tonight's game, just prior to the fireworks show...30 lucky fans will watch the fireworks with **Leonard** in the visitors' dugout...following Monday's off day the Reds continue their stretch of 9 straight games against American League teams with a 6-game road trip to **Tor** (3g) and **Cle** (3g).

INTERLEAGUE PLAY: In its 13th season, interleague play continues for the Reds this weekend against the White Sox...Cin is **2-4 vs the American League** so far this season (2-1 vs Cle, 0-3 at KC)...beginning with tonight's game the Reds will face AL teams in 9 straight games (3g vs WSox, 3g at Tor, 3g at Cle)...the Reds are **79-98 (.446) all-time** vs American League teams...their all-time results vs AL teams can be found on page 351 of the media guide.

ROUND TABLE: The panelists for this afternoon's **Baseball and the Civil Rights Movement** roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's **Harriet Tubman Theater** were Hall of Famer **Tony Perez**, NBA Hall of Famer **Oscar Robertson**, former All-Star and current MLB Network analyst **Harold Reynolds**, academic **Richard Lapchick**, author **Lee Lowenfish**, Judge **Nathaniel Jones** and columnist **James Clingman Jr.**...Harvard Law School professor and renowned expert on race and justice **Charles Ogletree** moderated a discussion of the pivotal role baseball played in the **Civil Rights Movement** and its continued presence as a social institution in American society.

LUNCHEON: To be honored at **tomorrow's** luncheon at **Duke Energy Center** are Beacon of Change winner **Muhammad Ali**, Beacon of Hope winner **Bill Cosby** and Beacon of Life winner **Hank Aaron**...all 3 winners previously were awarded the **Presidential Medal of Freedom**, our country's highest civilian honor...Beacon Award presenters include **Sugar Ray Leonard** (Ali), Hall of Fame pitcher **Bob Gibson** (Cosby) and **Commissioner Allan H. (Bud) Selig** (Aaron)...Grammy Award-winning gospel artist **BeBe Winans** will perform at the luncheon and at tomorrow night's game...former **President Bill Clinton** will be the keynote speaker at the afternoon luncheon.

WANNA PLAY?: At tomorrow afternoon's **Youth Summit** at Fountain Square (2:00 to 7:00 p.m.), Major League Baseball will launch **Wanna Play?**, a program intended to boost efforts to reach the African-American community with a youth-oriented, experiential event...**admission is free**...activities include batting and pitching cages, baserunning contests, wiffle ball games and demonstrations with Reds players **Brandon Phillips** and **Jerry Hairston Jr.**, Reds Hall of Famer **Eric Davis** and former All-Star and current MLB Network analyst **Harold Reynolds**...at 4:00 p.m., there will be a Q&A session with *Cory in the House* star **Kyle Massey**, *Zoey 101* star **Christopher Massey**, country music artist **Rissi Palmer**, *Journey to the Center of the Earth* star **Josh Hutcherson** and **Davis**.

M*A*S*H: From the **Opening Day** roster the Reds are missing starters **1B Joey Votto** (stress-related issues) and **3B Edwin Encarnacion** (broken left wrist) along with starting **RHP Edinson Volquez** (back spasms) and reliever **RHP Mike Lincoln** (bulging disc in his neck)...all are on the disabled list...several other players missed action recently because of various ailments, including **2B Brandon Phillips** (hairline fracture, tip of right thumb), **SS Alex Gonzalez** (strained left oblique muscle), **Willy Taveras** (tight right hamstring) and **IF/OF Jerry Hairston Jr.** (flu).

SOUTHPAW: **Matt Maloney** is the only **lefthander** to start for the Reds this season and when he made his debut on 6/6 vs Chi became only the second LH Reds starter in a span of **236 games**...in **2008**, righthanded pitchers started Cin's first 161 games until **Adam Pettyjohn** took the hill for the season finale...**Pettyjohn's start** snapped a streak of **180 consecutive starts** by Reds righthanders...according to **Elias Sports Bureau**, prior to **Maloney's** appearance on 6/6 vs Cubs only the Reds, Padres and Cardinals had not started a lefthanded pitcher this season.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (16-15, .516): The Reds are **2-1** so far on this homestand (2-1 vs Atl, 3g vs WSox)...went **4-5-2 in their 11 previous home series** and produced a winning record on just 2 of their previous 5 completed homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3, 1-2)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **257-260-1**.

IN THE STANDINGS (74): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: **FIRST** - 1, **SECOND** - 9, **THIRD** - 37, **FOURTH** - 23, **FIFTH** - 3, **SIXTH** - 1...at **20-14** and again at **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g over .500** at **36-24**...have spent **60** days above, **7** days at and **7** days below .500.

REDS vs WHITE SOX: Reds are 2-12 all-time vs the White Sox, including 0-3 in 2006 at Great American Ball Park, 0-3 in 2001 at Comiskey Park, 0-3 in 2000 at Cinergy Field, 1-1 in 1998 at Comiskey Park and 1-2 in 1997 at Cinergy Field...Chi's 3-1 victory on 6/13/97 was the first interleague game ever for both clubs...that loss snapped Cin's 9-game winning streak vs American League teams, dating back to the 1975 World Series...WSox have won the last 9g and swept the last 3 series...**at Great American Ball Park**: Reds are 0-3...went 1-5 vs WSox at Cinergy Field.

Wins Beginning 6/29

In the 14-1 loss on 6/24/08 at Tor, **Bronson Arroyo** made the shortest start of his career and became only the sixth starting pitcher in Major League history to allow at least 10 earned runs in a game in which he retired 3 batters or fewer (1+ip, 11h, 10er)...beginning with his next start, a 9-5 win at Cle on 6/29/08, **Arroyo** has 18 wins, tied for second-most in the Major Leagues since then:

2 starts went **15-5, 3.76**...since that 6/24/08 loss at Tor still ranks T2nd in the Major Leagues with **18 wins**.

In The Big Inning: Allowed at least 1 run in the first inning of 7 of his 13 starts, including each of his last 5 starts...has posted a 9.00era in the first inning (13ip, 13er) and a 4.67era after the first frame (69.1ip, 36er).

Perfect: Began the season 3-0 for the third time in his career but for the first time won his first 3 starts of a season...won his first 2 starts in 2006, when he started off 5-0...began the 2005 campaign 4-0...was the first Reds pitcher to begin the season in the rotation and win his first 3 starts since **LHP Pete Schourek** did it in 1996 and the first righthander since **Jack Armstrong** won his first 5 starts of 1990.

Tomorrow’s Pitcher: RHP Johnny Cueto

Last Pitched: Sun at KC and suffered the 7-1 loss (6ip, 7h, 5r, 0er, 1bb, 4k, 110 pitches, 75 strikes)...left trailing, 5-1...all 5 runs were unearned following a pair of Hairston errors.

Red Hots: The 23-year-old righthander tomorrow will make his 14th start of the season, the 45th start of his career and his first career appearance vs the White Sox...leads the National League in ERA (2.17) and ranks third in opponents’ batting average (.216)...in his 13 starts the Reds went 8-5 and scored 51 runs (3.92 r/g)...in 9 of his 13 starts threw at least 7.0 innings and in 12 of his 13 starts threw at least 6.0 innings.

Quality: Leads the team with 10 quality starts, including 5 straight for the second time this season...his strings of 5 consecutive QS (4/22-5/13, 5/24-current) are the longest stretches of quality starts by a Reds pitcher this season...last year, **Edinson Volquez** produced a string of 12 straight QS (4/22-6/20).

No Place Like Home...Is making his first appearance at Great American Ball Park since 5/24...made his last 4 starts on the road (2-2, 1.71, 26.1ip, 5er)...for the season is **1-2, 3.18** in 5 starts at home (34ip, 12er) and **5-2, 1.53** in 8 starts on the road (53ip, 9er).

Streaking I: In 5 starts from 4/22-5/13 went **4-0, 1.25** (36ip, 5er)...the 4-game winning streak was the longest of his career...allowed 4 earned runs in his first start of the season (6ip) and **17 earned runs in his last 12 starts (81ip, 1.89era)**.
