A press conference will be held tonight at **5:45 p.m.** in the **field level interview room** at Great American Ball Park...Hall of Famers **Hank Aaron** and **Frank Robinson** and Major League Baseball **Commissioner Allan H. (Bud) Selig** will be available...tomorrow's pre-game ceremonies begin at **6:50**.

Tonight the Reds and White Sox will met in the **Gillette Civil Rights Game**, the first time the contest will be played during the regular season...the weekend's festivities included a round table discussion held yesterday at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's **Harriet Tubman**

Theater, a luncheon earlier today at **Duke Energy Center** honoring the 3 winners of Major League Baseball's **Beacon Awards**, followed this afternoon by a **Youth Summit** at **Fountain Square** downtown...the **Gillette Civil Rights Game** and ancillary events were developed to pay tribute to those who fought on and off the field for equal rights...log on to www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is **Game 2** (1-0) of the 3-game **Gillette Civil Rights Game** weekend series vs **Bob Beghtol's** White Sox and **Game 5** (3-1) of a 6-game homestand that included the Braves (2-1)...following Monday's day off the Reds continue their stretch of 9 consecutive games against American League teams with a 6-game road trip to **Tor's Rogers Centre** (3g) and **Cle's Progressive Field** (3g).

POMP & CIRCUMSTANCE: During pre-game ceremonies tonight the Reds, White Sox and Major League Baseball will pay tribute to 2009 Beacon of Change winner **Muhammad Ali**, Beacon of Hope winner **Bill Cosby** and Beacon of Life winner **Hank Aaron**...Grammy Award-winning gospel artist **BeBe Winans** and the **Freedom Choir** will perform...**Winans** will sing the *National Anthem*, followed by a flyover of four **A-10 Warthog fighter jets** from the **103rd Fighter Squadron** of the Pennsylvania Air National Guard...Hall of Famer and 2008 Beacon of Life winner **Frank Robinson** will throw out the ceremonial first pitch to Hall of Famer and former Reds great **Tony Perez**...**Robinson** will be accompanied by **Negro League** players **Chuck "Charlie Fine" Harmon**, **Charles "Whip" Davis**, **Don "Groundhog" Johnson**, **Ron "Bunny" Warren** and **Tom "High Pockets" Turner**...serving as honorary captains for tonight's game are the reverends **Donald G. Dixon** of Hyde Park United Methodist Church and **Damon Lynch Jr.** of New Jerusalem Baptist Church....during the seventh inning stretch, country music artist **Rissi Palmer** will perform *America the Beautiful*, followed by a rendition of *Take Me Out To the Ballgame* by 17-year-old saxophonist **BK Jackson**.

WANNA PLAY?: At this afternoon's **Youth Summit** at Fountain Square, Major League Baseball launched **Wanna Play?**, a program intended to boost efforts to reach the African-American community with a youth-oriented, experiential event...activities included batting and pitching cages, baserunning contests, wiffle ball games and demonstrations with Reds players **Brandon Phillips** and **Jerry Hairston Jr.**, Reds Hall of Famer **Eric Davis** and former All-Star and current MLB Network analyst **Harold Reynolds**...there also was a Q&A session with *Cory in the House* star **Kyle Massey**, *Zoey 101* star **Christopher Massey**, country music artist **Rissi Palmer**, *Journey to the Center of the Earth* star **Josh Hutcherson** and **Davis**.

INTERLEAGUE PLAY: In its 13th season, interleague play continues for the Reds this weekend against the White Sox...Cin is **3-4 vs the American League** so far this season (2-1 vs Cle, 0-3 at KC, 1-0 vs WSox)...beginning with last night's game the Reds were scheduled face AL teams in 9 straight games (1-0 vs WSox, 3g at Tor, 3g at Cle)...the Reds are **80-98 (.449) all-time** vs American League teams...their all-time results vs AL teams can be found on page 351 of the media guide.

DOT, DOT, DOT...: The Reds' 4-3 win here last night snapped their 9-game losing streak to the WSox, who had swept the previous 3 series...**RHP Johnny Cueto** leads the National League in ERA (2.17)...**Jay Bruce** is tied for the Major League lead with **8 outfield assists**...**Ryan Hanigan** leads all National League rookie batters in hitting (.325) and on-base percentage (.416)...**Ramon Hernandez** needs 4 runs scored to reach **500** in his career.

MARK MANN'S DISABLED LIST UPDATE: **Joey Votto** (stress-related issues) is on a rehabilitation assignment in Dayton...**3B Edwin Encarnacion** (broken left wrist) will hit on the field for the second straight day...the club hopes he can begin a rehab assignment sometime next week...**RHP Edinson Volquez** (back spasms) hopes to begin throwing on the mound in the next few days...**Alex Gonzalez** (sore right elbow) was scratched from last night's lineup...he will be examined again today...**RHP Mike Lincoln** (bulging disc in his neck) has been ordered by spine specialist **Dr. Lester Duplechan** to rest for the next few days.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (17-15, .531): The Reds are **3-1** so far on this homestand (2-1 vs Atl, 3g, 1-0 vs WSox)...went **4-5-2 in their 11 previous home series** and produced a winning record on just 2 of their previous 5 completed homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3, 1-2)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **258-260-1**.

REDS ON THE ROAD (17-17, .500): The Reds went **6-3-2 in their 11 road series**...produced winning records on each of their first 2 road trips (7-3, 3-2), a .500 record on the third trip (3-3) and losing records on each of their last 2 road trips (2-5, 2-4)...entering this season and dating to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

IN THE STANDINGS (75): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: **FIRST** - 1, **SECOND** - 9, **THIRD** - 38, **FOURTH** - 23, **FIFTH** - 3, **SIXTH** - 1...at **20-14** and again at **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g over .500** at **36-24**...have spent **61** days above, **7** days at and **7** days below .500.

REDS vs WHITE SOX: Reds are 3-12 all-time vs the White Sox, including 1-0 here this season, 0-3 in 2006 at Great American Ball Park, 0-3 in 2001 at Comiskey Park, 0-3 in 2000 at Cinergy Field, 1-1 in 1998 at Comiskey Park and 1-2 in 1997 at Cinergy Field...last night's win snapped Cin's 9-game losing streak to the WSox, who swept the previous 3 series...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 1-3...went 1-5 vs WSox at Cinergy Field...**at U.S. Cellular Field:** Reds are 1-4...the Reds beat the White Sox 5-3 in the 1919 World Series.

Last Pitched: Sun at KC and suffered the 7-1 loss (6ip, 7h, 5r, 0er, 1bb, 4k, 110 pitches, 75 strikes)...left trailing, 5-1...all 5 runs were unearned following a pair of Reds errors.

Red Hots: The 23-year-old righthander is making his 14th start of the season, his third start against an American League team and his first career appearance vs the White Sox...leads the National League in ERA (2.17) and ranks third in opponents' batting average (.216)...in his 13 starts the Reds went 8-5 and scored 51 runs (3.92 r/g)...in 9 of his 13 starts threw at least 7.0 innings and in 12 of his 13 starts threw at least 6.0 innings.

Quality: Leads the team with 10 quality starts, including 5 straight for the second time this season...his strings of 5 consecutive QS (4/22-5/13, 5/24-current) are the longest stretches of quality starts by a Reds pitcher this season...last year, **Edinson Volquez** produced a string of 12 straight QS (4/22-6/20).

No Place Like Home...Is making his first appearance at Great American Ball Park since 5/24...made his last 4 starts on the road (2-2, 1.71, 26.1ip, 5er)...for the season is **1-2, 3.18** in 5 starts at home (34ip, 12er) and **5-2, 1.53** in 8 starts on the road (53ip, 9er).

Streaking I: In 5 starts from 4/22-5/13 went **4-0, 1.25** (36ip, 5er)...the 4-game winning streak was the longest of his career...allowed 4 earned runs in his first start of the season (6ip) and 17 earned runs in his last 12 starts (81ip, 1.89era).

Streaking II: In each of 4 starts from 4/22-5/8 threw at least 7.0 innings while allowing no more than 1 run, the longest streak of that kind by a Reds pitcher since **Tim Belcher** had a 4-game run from **5/27-6/13, 1992** (courtesy Elias Sports Bureau).

World Baseball Classic: Started the Dominican Republic's second game of the tournament and threw 4.2 scoreless innings to earn the 9-0 win vs Panama in the San Juan bracket (4.2ip, 3h, 1bb, 5k).

Career Highs: **Innings:** 8.0, 5/3/09 at Pit (longest) & 1.2 (shortest), 4/29/08 at StL; **Hits:** 9 (2x), 5/27/08 vs Pit & 8/8/08 vs Hou; **Runs:** 7, 4/29/08 at StL; **Earned Runs:** 6 (4x), last on 7/17/08 vs NYM; **Walks:** 8, 6/11/08 vs StL; **Strikeouts:** 10 (2x), 4/3/08 vs Ari (ML debut) & 7/22/08 vs SD; **HR allowed:** 3, 5/16/08 vs Cle (Blake & Hafner, Peralta).

Cueto's Most Recent Starts: **5/13 at Ari** and earned the 10-3 victory (7ip, 4h, 3er, 2bb, 4k, 2hr, 100 pitches, 67 strikes)...in the first inning allowed a solo HR to Gerardo Parra in Parra's first career plate appearance, followed by a walk to Justin Upton...then retired 12 consecutive batters until Chad Tracy walked with 1 out in the fifth...after Parra's HR didn't allow another hit until Upton doubled with 2 outs in the sixth, followed by Stephen Drew's RBI-single...with 2 outs in the seventh inning allowed a solo HR to Ojeda, his first homer since 6/15/07 at Bal (410ab)...as a batter, led off the third inning with his second bunt single of the season to spark a 3-run rally...**5/19 vs Phi** and suffered the 4-3 loss (7ip, 7h, 4er, 0bb, 4k, 1hr, 112 pitches, 68 strikes)...in the second inning allowed a solo HR to Howard...allowed 3 runs in the fifth on Rollins' RBI-double, Utley's RBI-single and a sac fly by Ibanez...**5/24 vs Cle** and received no decision in the 11-inning, 4-3 victory (7ip, 6h, 3r, 2er, 3bb, 7k, 2hhp, 1wp, 111 pitches, 67 strikeouts)...left with the score tied, 3-3...allowed all 3 runs with 2 outs...in the fourth inning gave up a run-scoring double to Luis Valbuena...in the seventh allowed an RBI-triple to Grady Sizemore, who then scored on the play after obstruction was called on 3B Adam Rosales...**5/29 at Mil** and suffered the 3-2 loss (7ip, 3h, 3er, 4bb, 3k, 2hr, 104 pitches, 64 strikes)...left trailing, 3-2...allowed just 3 hits, but 2 of the hits were home runs that produced all 3 Brewers runs...in the first inning retired the first 2 batters but then walked Braun and allowed a 2-run HR to Fielder...Hart homered leading off the Brewers' seventh...**6/3 at StL** and earned the 9-3 win (6.1ip, 7h, 1er, 0bb, 3k, 101 pitches, 69 strikes)...left leading, 4-1...allowed his only run on consecutive doubles by Rasmus and Ryan in the seventh inning...**6/9 at Wsh** and earned the 3-2 victory (7ip, 4h, 1er, 4bb, 5k, 1hr, 111 pitches, 66 strikes)...allowed only a solo HR to Dukes with 1 out in the fourth inning...threw 27 of his 111 pitches in the first inning, when he walked 2 batters and stranded 3 baserunners.

Tomorrow's Pitcher: RHP Aaron Harang

Last Started: Tue vs Atl and received no decision in the 7-2 victory (2+ip, 3h, 0r, 0bb, 3k, 35 pitches, 28 strikes)...did not return after rain a delay of 1:54 in the top of the third inning...all 13 first-inning pitches were strikes.

Red Hots: Is making his 15th start of the season, his first against an American League team...in his previous 14 starts the Reds went 7-7 and scored 56 runs (4 r/g)...in his 14 starts **Reds batters** hit .245 (114-466)...on 6/4 at StL suffered the 3-1 loss in a game in which **Harang** and **Chris Carpenter** each threw a complete game.

Home Cookin': Is **4-2, 2.70** (40ip, 12er) in 7 starts at Great American Ball Park and **1-4, 4.47** (46.1ip, 23er) in 7 starts on the road.

Streaking: From **4/28-6/4** allowed a home run in 8 consecutive apps (10hr), the longest streak by a Reds pitcher since **RHP Ramon Ortiz** tied the National League record by allowing a home run in **15** consecutive apps from **5/1-7/17, 2005**.

Milestones: On 4/23 at Chi recorded the **1,000th strikeout** of his career (**Derrek Lee**)...his 3-hitter in the club's fifth game, a 2-0 win on 4/12 vs Pit, was the quickest complete game by a Reds pitcher since **Pete Harnisch** threw a CG in the Reds' fourth game of **1999**.

Staff Ace: Since he was acquired from the Athletics at the **2003 trading deadline** is the Reds' leader in most statistical pitching categories, including starts (181), wins (68), innings pitched (1155.1) and strikeouts (971)...since the beginning of the **2006 season** ranks second in the National League **736.2** innings pitched (**Arroyo 1st, 740.1**)...in 2005 and 2007 won the BBWAA's Johnny Vander Meer Award as the club's Most Outstanding Pitcher.

Reds Pitchers: Rank fourth in the National League with a 3.88 team ERA...**on the homestand are 3-1, 3.75 (36ip, 15er)**...in the last 15g are 7-8, 3.21 (140ip, 50er)...have 6 team shutouts...had 6 shutouts all last season...with a 7-0 win on 5/5 at Fla reached 6 shutouts in their 26th game, their fastest to 6 team shutouts since the 1914 Reds threw their sixth shutout in their 25th game.
