Last night's game was the **fourth sellout** this season and the **43rd sellout** overall at Great American Ball Park...on the field the Reds are **20-23** when playing in front of sellout crowds at GABP (**2-2 in 2009**, 2-3 in 2008, 1-2 in 2007, 3-4 in 2006, 1-1 in 2005, 7-4 in 2004, 4-7 in 2003)...below are the previous 2009 sellouts at GABP:

### Today's Transaction

Today the Reds sent to Class AAA Louisville on a rehabilitation assignment **3B Edwin Encarnacion**...yesterday the Reds optioned to Louisville **LHP Matt Maloney**; recalled from Louisville **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo**; placed on the 15-day disabled list, retroactive to 6/19, **SS Alex Gonzalez**; transfered **Encarnacion** to the 60-day DL; selected from Louisville the contract of **IF Danny Richar**; transfered **1B Joey Votto's** rehabilitation assignment from Class A Sarasota to Class A Dayton.

**TODAY'S GAME:** Is **Game 3** (1-1) of the 3-game **Gillette Civil Rights Game** weekend series vs **Bob Beghtol's** White Sox and **Game 6** (3-2) of a 6-game homestand that included the Braves (2-1)...following tomorrow's day off the Reds continue their stretch of 9 consecutive games against American League teams with a 6-game road trip to **Tor's Rogers Centre** (3g) and **Cle's Progressive Field** (3g).

**AARON'S ACES:** This afternoon **Aaron Harang** is hosting 30 fans in sun deck Section 143 as part of his **Aaron's Aces** program targeting local **military families**...guests receive an autographed t-shirt, in-stadium welcomes via the public address announcer and scoreboard and a \$10 concession voucher...when he is not scheduled to pitch, **Aaron** meets the guests in the bullpen...fans with family members currently on active duty or who recently returned from active duty can sign up online at [www.reds.com/community](http://www.reds.com/community), then click on ticket programs.

**INTERLEAGUE PLAY:** In its 13th season, interleague play continues for the Reds this weekend against the White Sox...Cin is **3-5 vs the American League** so far this season (2-1 vs Cle, 0-3 at KC, 1-1 vs WSox)...are in the middle of a stretch of 9 consecutive games vs AL rivals (1-1 vs WSox, 3g at Tor, 3g at Cle)...the Reds are **80-99 (.447) all-time** vs American League teams...their all-time results vs AL teams can be found on page 351 of the media guide.

**DOT, DOT, DOT...:** The Reds couldn't hold on to a 5-0 lead in last night's 10-8 loss, their biggest blown lead of the season...**Jay Bruce** is tied for the Major League lead with **8 outfield assists**...**Ryan Hanigan** leads all National League rookie batters in hitting (.328) and on-base percentage (.415)...**Chris Dickerson** ranks second among all NL rookies in on-base percentage (.380)...**Ramon Hernandez** needs 4 runs scored to reach **500** in his career.

**M\*A\*S\*H:** From the **Opening Day roster** the Reds are missing starters **1B Joey Votto** (stress-related issues), **SS Alex Gonzalez** (right elbow) and **3B Edwin Encarnacion** (broken left wrist) along with starting **RHP Edinson Volquez** (right elbow) and reliever **RHP Mike Lincoln** (bulging disc in his neck)...all are on the disabled list...several other players missed action recently because of various ailments, including **2B Brandon Phillips** (hairline fracture, right thumb), **OF Willy Taveras** (tight right hamstring) and **IF/OF Jerry Hairston Jr.** (flu).

**MARK MANN'S DISABLED LIST UPDATE:** **Joey Votto** (stress-related issues) is on a rehabilitation assignment at Class A Dayton...**3B Edwin Encarnacion** (broken left wrist) began a rehabilitation assignment today at Class AAA Louisville...**RHP Edinson Volquez** (right elbow tendinitis) is rehabbing with the team...**Alex Gonzalez** (4 loose bodies, right elbow) will have surgery tomorrow...he is expected to miss approximately 4 weeks...**RHP Mike Lincoln** (bulging disc in his neck) has been ordered by spine specialist **Dr. Lester Duplechan** to rest for the next few days.

**VOTE REDS!:** Through 7/2, fans can help pick the starting lineups of the **2009 All-Star Game** in St. Louis by voting online at [reds.com/vote](http://reds.com/vote)...fans attending games at Great American Ball Park can vote using **laptop computers** set up near **Section 114** on Terrace Level...one online voter per game will be selected randomly to receive a **Kroger gift card**...fans who vote 25 times online and indicate the Reds as their favorite team automatically are entered in a sweepstakes to win a **FOX Sports Champions Club** box for 4 for an upcoming game...in-stadium paper balloting ends on **6/28**...Reds players on the ballot include **C Ramon Hernandez**, **1B Joey Votto**, **2B Brandon Phillips**, **SS Alex Gonzalez**, **3B Edwin Encarnacion**, **OF Chris Dickerson**, **OF Willy Taveras** and **OF Jay Bruce**.

**ALL-STAR RESOLUTION:** State Senator **Gary Cates** (R-Butler County) has introduced a resolution in the Ohio Senate urging Major League Baseball to select the Reds and Great American Ball Park as hosts for the **2013 All-Star Game**...the Reds last hosted the Mid-Summer Classic in **1988** at Riverfront Stadium...the club already is hosting one of MLB's jewel events this summer, when on **6/20** the Reds and White Sox meet here in the **Gillette Civil Rights Game**.

**REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (17-16, .515):** The Reds are **3-2** so far on this homestand (2-1 vs Atl, 1-1 vs WSox)...went **4-5-2 in their previous 11 completed home series** and produced a winning record on just 2 of their previous 5 completed homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3, 1-2)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **258-261-1**...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38)...**at 217-217-1** the Reds had evened their overall record at GABP for the first time since **6/26/04** (57-57)...also reached .500 at **219-219-1**.

**REDS ON THE ROAD (17-17, .500):** The Reds went **6-3-2 in their 11 road series**...produced winning records on each of their first 2 road trips (7-3, 3-2), a .500 record on the third trip (3-3) and losing records on each of their last 2 road trips (2-5, 2-4)...entering this season and dating to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

**IN THE STANDINGS (76):** The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 38, FOURTH - 24, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...at **20-14** and again at **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g over .500** at **36-24**...have spent **62** days above, **7** days at and **7** days below .500.

**REDS vs WHITE SOX:** Reds are 3-13 all-time vs the White Sox, including 1-1 here this season, 0-3 in 2006 at Great American Ball Park, 0-3 in 2001 at Comiskey Park, 0-3 in 2000 at Cinergy Field, 1-1 in 1998 at Comiskey Park and 1-2 in 1997 at Cinergy Field...Fri night's win snapped Cin's 9-game losing streak to the WSox, who swept the previous 3 series...Chi's 3-1 victory on 6/13/97 was the first interleague game ever for both clubs...that loss snapped Cin's 9-game winning streak vs American League teams, dating back to the 1975 World Series...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 1-4...went 1-5 vs WSox at Cinergy Field...**at U.S. Cellular Field:** Reds are 1-4...the Reds beat the White Sox 5-3 in the 1919 World Series.

**UP NEXT: REDS vs BLUE JAYS:** The Reds are 2-4 all-time vs the Blue Jays, including 1-2 at Great American Ball Park in 2003 and 1-2 at the Rogers Centre in 2008.

**Last Started:** Tue vs Atl and received no decision in the 7-2 victory (2+ip, 3h, 0r, 0bb, 3k, 35 pitches, 28 strikes)...did not return after rain a delay of 1:54 in the top of the third inning...all 13 first-inning pitches were strikes.

**Red Hots:** Is making his 15th start of the season, his first against an American League team...in his previous 14 starts the Reds went 7-7 and scored 56 runs (4 r/g)...in his 14 starts **Reds batters** hit .245 (114-466)...on 6/4 at StL suffered the 3-1 loss in a game in which **Harang** and **Chris Carpenter** each threw a complete game.

**Home Cookin’:** Is **4-2, 2.70** (40ip, 12er) in 7 starts at Great American Ball Park and **1-4, 4.47** (46.1ip, 23er) in 7 starts on the road.

**Streaking:** From **4/28-6/4** allowed a home run in 8 consecutive apps (10hr), the longest streak by a Reds pitcher since **RHP Ramon Ortiz** tied the National League record by allowing a home run in **15** consecutive apps from **5/1-7/17, 2005**.

**Milestones:** On 4/23 at Chi recorded the **1,000th strikeout** of his career (**Derrek Lee**)...his 3-hitter in the club’s fifth game, a 2-0 win on 4/12 vs Pit, was the quickest complete game by a Reds pitcher since **Pete Harnisch** threw a CG in the Reds’ fourth game of **1999**.

**Opening Day:** In the 2-1 loss vs the Mets made his fourth straight Opening Day start, the first Reds pitcher to do so since **RHP Jose Rijo** had the honors in 4 straight seasons from 1992-95...the only other Reds pitchers to make at least 4 consecutive Opening Day starts are **Pete Donohue** (5 straight, 1923-27) and **Mario Soto** (5, 1982-86)...**Soto** holds the club record for overall Opening Day starts (6)...in 4 career Opening Day starts **Harang** is 1-3, 3.52 (23ip, 9er).

**Staff Ace:** Since he was acquired from the Athletics at the **2003 trading deadline** is the Reds’ leader in most statistical pitching categories, including starts (181), wins (68), innings pitched (1155.1) and strikeouts (971)...since the beginning of the **2006 season** ranks second in the National League **736.2** innings pitched (**Arroyo 1st**, 740.1), sixth among all Major League pitchers...in 2005 and 2007 won the BBWAA’s Johnny Vander Meer Award as the club’s Most Outstanding Pitcher.

**Community Affairs:** Is one of the club’s more active members of the local community...for the third straight season, as part of his **Aaron’s Aces** ticket program is hosting at all Sunday home games children of military personnel serving in the **War On Terrorism**...along with wife **Jen** donated \$55,000 to the **Miracle League of Greater Cincinnati and Northern Kentucky** and on 5/9 attended the dedication of that field at the **Durham Recreation Complex** in Western Hills...for his community service has been the club’s nominee for the **Robert Clemente Award** (2007), **Branch Rickey Award** (2007) and **Marvin Miller Man of the Year Award** (2007, 2008).

**Career Highs:** **Innings:** 10.0 (longest), 7/23/07 vs Mil & 1.0 (shortest, 2x), 9/5/03 at StL & 7/28/07 vs Chi; **Hits:** 14, 9/28/05 at Mil; **Runs:** 9, 4/3/06 vs Chi; **Earned runs:** 8 (3x), last on 5/30/09 at Mil; **Walks:** 7, 7/8/08 for Cin at Chi; **Strikeouts:** 13, 9/29/07 vs Chi; **HR allowed:** 4 (3x), last on 8/19/07 at Mil (Braun solo, Hall 2-run, Fielder 2-run, Hardy solo); **Complete Games:** 13, last on 6/4/09 for Cin at StL (3-1 loss); **Shutouts:** 6, last on 4/12/09 for Cin vs Pit (2-0 win).

**Last Started:** Wed vs Atl and earned the 4-3 victory (6ip, 6h, 2er, 2bb, 0k, 1hr, 108 pitches, 67 strikes)...left leading, 4-2...allowed only a 2-run HR to Escobar in the third inning...in the fifth frame hit a 3-run HR off Vazquez that gave the Reds their 4-2 lead...was his second homer of the season, the seventh of his career.

**Red Hots:** Tue at Tor will make his 13th start of the season and his first career appearance vs the Blue Jays...in his previous 12 starts the Reds went 5-7 and scored 48 runs (4 r/g)...has 4 quality starts...with an 8-2 win on 4/26 vs Atl snapped his **9-game losing streak** dating back to a 9-3 Diamondbacks victory on 5/25/08 at Atl...in 14 apps and 10 starts between victories went **0-9, 8.53**.

**In Relief:** Made his only relief appearance of the season in the 16-inning, 6-5 loss at SD on 5/16...threw a career-high 5.2 innings in relief (3h, 1er, 3bb, 5k, 1hr, 81 pitches, 44 strikes)...entered the game in the 11th inning as the Reds’ seventh and final pitcher...retired his first 10 batters until Scott Hairston singled with 1 out in the 14th inning...Nick Hundley homered to end the 5-hour, 14 minute struggle...in **6 starts since then is 1-3, 5.23 (31ip, 18er)**.

**At The Plate:** In 2007 won the National League’s **Silver Slugger Award** (.333, 4hr, 15rbi)...has **7 career home runs**, including **2 this season** (5/10 vs StL, pinch-hit solo off **Ryan Franklin** & 6/17 vs Atl, 3-run off **Javier Vazquez**)...his 5 career home runs prior to 2009 are listed on **page 149** of the media guide...on 5/7 vs Mil produced the first triple by a Reds pitcher since **Eric Milton** did it on 4/13/06 at Cubs.
